

How to comment using Gif animation on Facebook

Newly updated Facebook adds new features that allow commenting posts with animations, with many different topics.

After enabling Facebook users to comment on video posts, Facebook recently supported the use of animations when commenting posts.

Users will search for gif images by keywords and Facebook will rely on them to produce a list of results. Finally, you just need to select the animation for the article you will comment on. This helps Facebook users have more options for commentary, increase the liveliness, in addition to selecting the video that Facebook has previously introduced to users. So how to post animated images in a comment on Facebook?

Step 1:

At the comment box at any post, we will see **the GIF icon** as shown below. You will click on that icon to appear the interface of the prevailing animations.



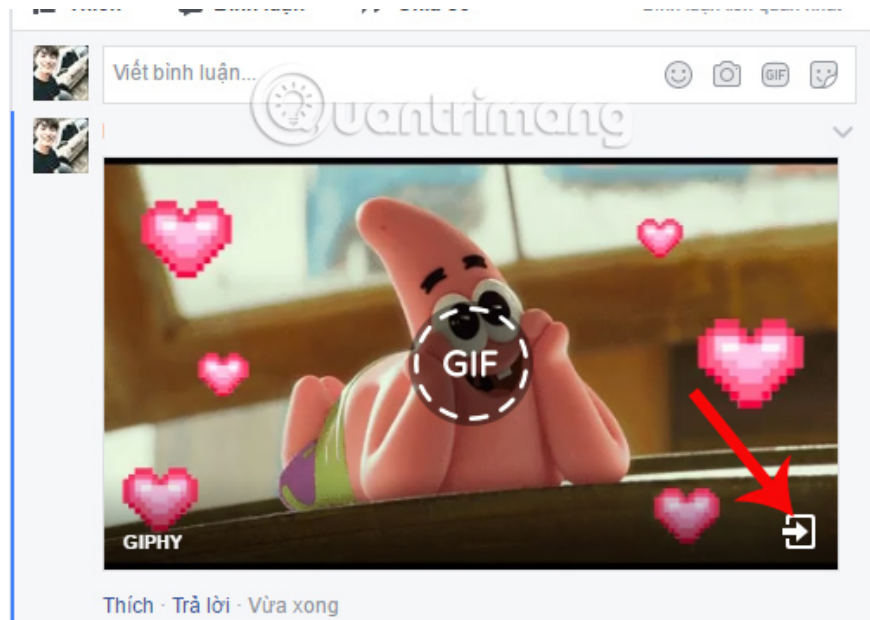
Step 2:

To search for images that match the theme you want, **type keywords into the Search GIFs** box above. Immediately after the animation results based on the search keyword you type will appear below.



Step 3:

Search for the desired image in the list below, then click on the animation to finish. The image will appear in the commentary in animation form. We can **click on the arrow icon** to access the animation link on Giphy. The user can then save the animation to the computer if desired.
