

How to connect iPhone to AirPods does not need to go to the Bluetooth menu

How to connect AirPods to iPhone in this article will guide you to connect AirPods to iPhone with just a few simple gestures

If you are an Apple fan then AirPods is a sure item you will own, you can pair them with your iPhone, Mac computer, Macbook, iPad and iPod Touch with just one Apple account. However, whenever you use them on another device, you must reconnect AirPods manually later on to your iPhone.

Specifically when you play sound from your iPhone on these AirPods headphones, then pause and next time you reopen the song, audiobook, podcast, lecture . or other audio file or play. Online on AirPods, it will work again immediately.

But when you connect your AirPods to a Mac, iPad, iPod Touch, Windows PC or an Android device or on any other compatible device, you are now back to using AirPods on your iPhone, you will must reconnect from the beginning.

But that doesn't matter because connecting AirPods back to your iPhone is easy. Instead of unlocking the iPhone, go to the **Settings** menu and reconnect AirPods with Bluetooth, then you can do it on the lock screen or screen. 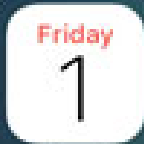
How to connect AirPods to iPhone without Bluetooth

Step 1: Open Control Center on your iPhone, if you are using iPhone line of overflow screen then swipe from the battery icon down to open the Control Center.

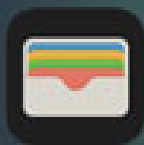

If you're using the iPhone line with the Home button, swipe from the bottom up to open the Control Center.





Step 2: Start reconnecting your AirPods, now press and hold your music player in the upper right corner by pressing 3D Touch, until you see it enlarged, press next Go to the AirPlay icon as shown below.

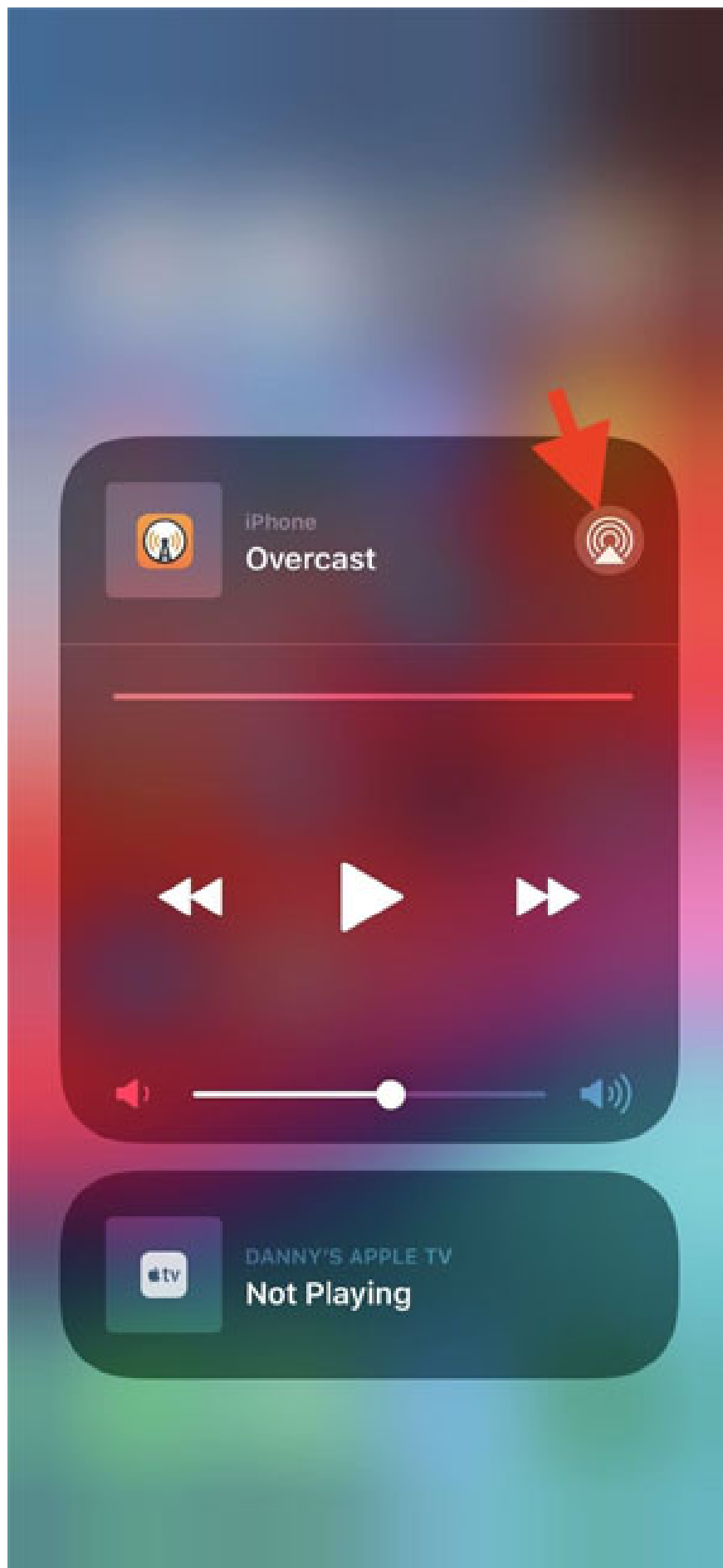

Next, in this menu you can see all available Bluetooth devices that you can connect to your iPhone, including AirPods. If you don't see your AirPods in this menu, chances are they've run out of battery and now you need to charge them with your AirPods case.




You should also check if Bluetooth is turned on, then go back to the AirPlay menu and touch AirPods and the headset will be reconnected to your iPhone. Now you can play music, videos, podcasts or other audio files via a wireless Bluetooth headset as usual.

See, there are 4 gestures for you to connect AirPods to your iPhone, just like that even if you have connected to any device before. You can also do the same steps to connect AirPods above to iPod Touch and iPad.

In addition to connecting AirPods to iPhone, you can also play music from iPhone on Mac computer, with playing music from iPhone on Mac can help you not need to copy music from iPhone to computer. In addition, it is also quite useful for you when you want to listen to a Podcast from iPhone on Mac without having to export the file, or listen to music from Spotify with the Mac speaker.
