

# How to connect to Wi-Fi in Windows 8, 8.1, and Windows 10

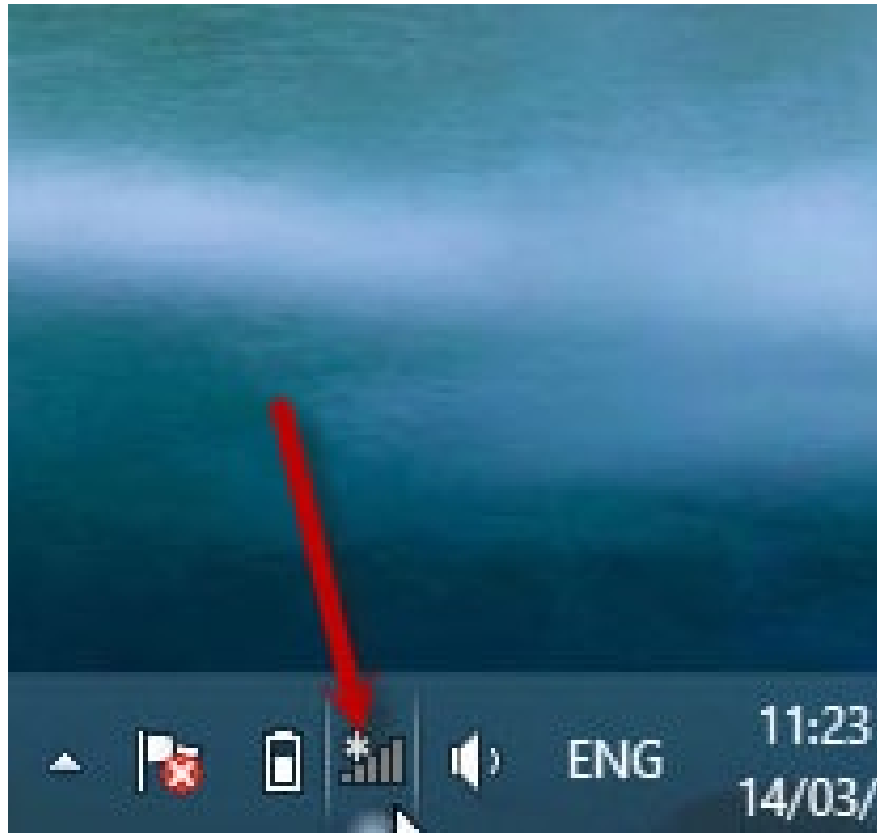

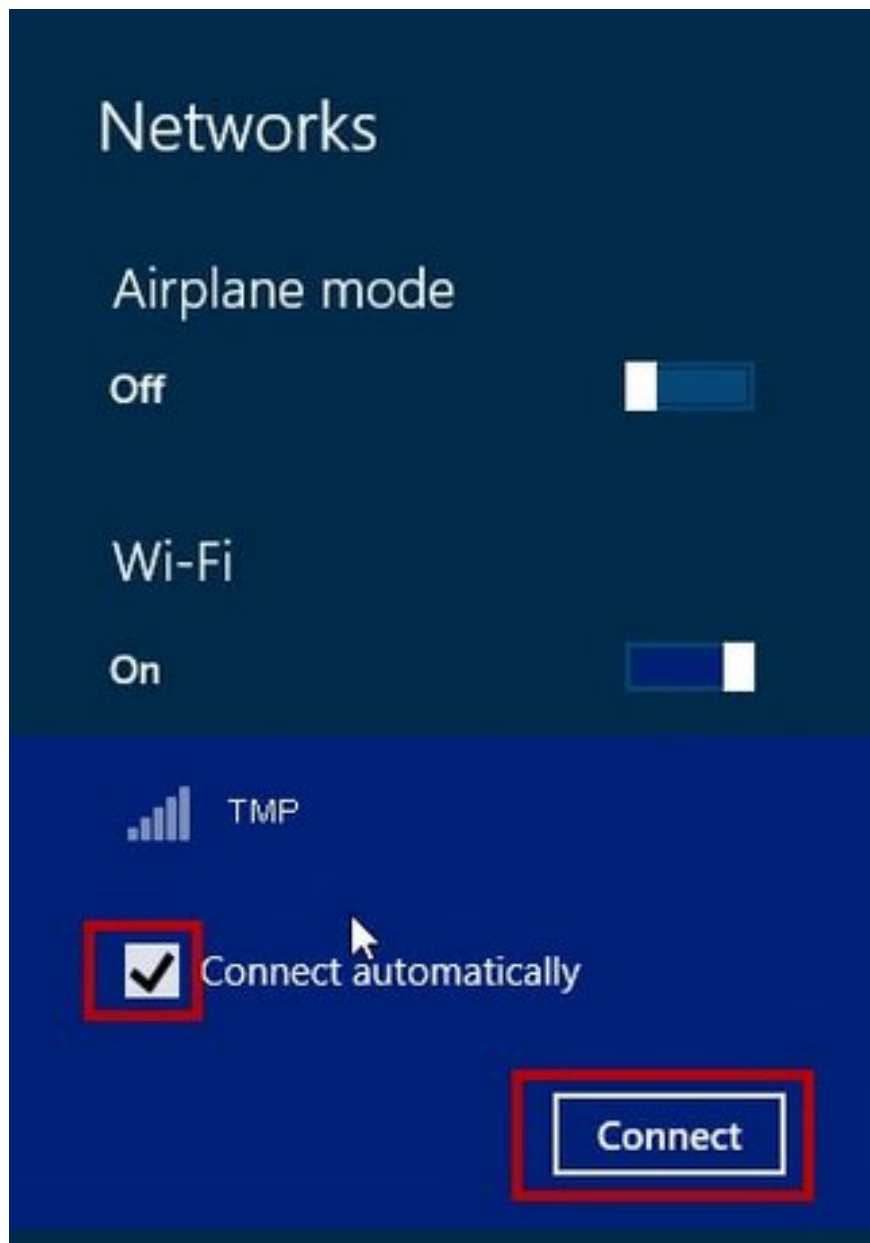


## Fi in Windows 8, 8.1, and Windows 10

: *Step 1:* Click on the Wi-Fi icon located in the taskbar (when there is no connection, there will be an asterisk (\*))



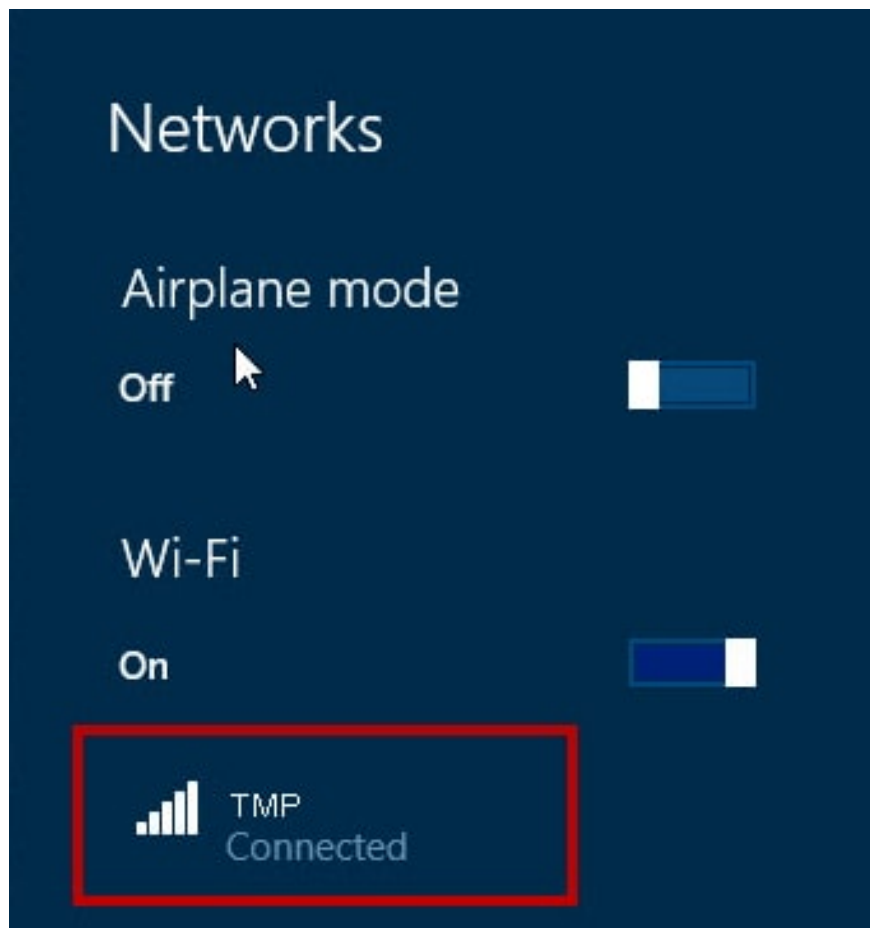
. *Step 2:* After clicking the icon, a list of available Wi-Fi networks will appear. Select the network you want to connect to and choose " **Connect**" . You should also click " **Connect automatically**" so that the computer automatically connects after startup, saving you the trouble of doing it again.



*Step 3:* Enter the correct password (if required) in the " **Enter the network security key**" field , then click "**Next**" to continue.



After a successful connection, " **Connected** " will appear (see image below)



. From here, you can access the internet via Wi-Fi.
