

# How to connect your phone to a mini speaker

## How to connect your phone to a mini speaker

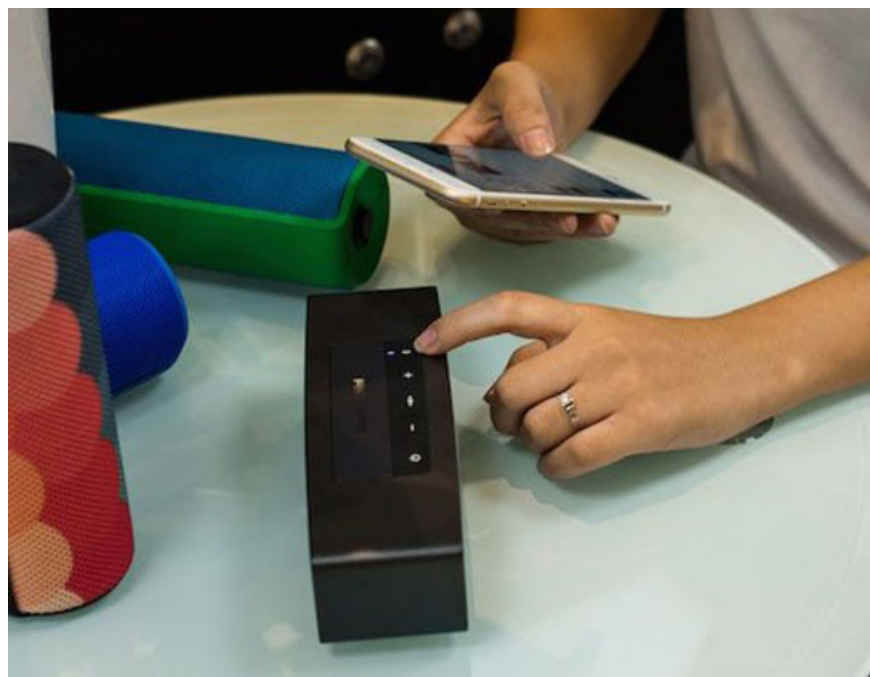
### Step 1:

First of all, you open the Bluetooth speaker source by clicking on the device's power button, depending on each speaker model, the power button position will be different, maybe at the bottom of the speaker or on the side or Can also be on top of the speaker. When you see the light source, this indicates that your portable Bluetooth speaker is turned on.



**Step 2:**

Most Bluetooth speakers, Bluetooth function will automatically be activated as soon as the device is powered on. However, with a live speaker line you need to click on the Bluetooth key on the speaker so that the speaker emits a connection signal.



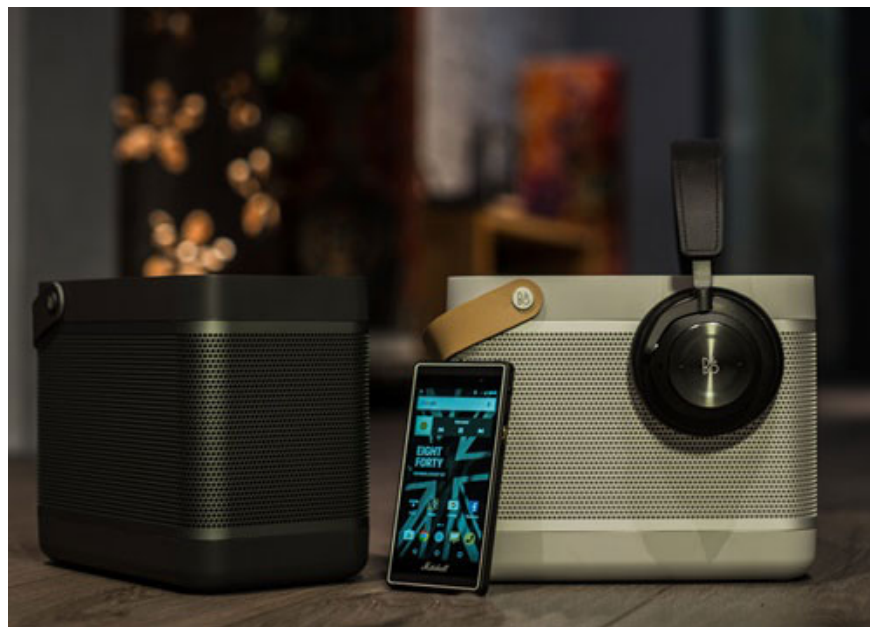
**Step 3:**

You turn on Bluetooth on your phone so your device recognizes the Bluetooth connection of the speaker. You can easily turn on Bluetooth connectivity in settings or on the status bar (swipe down or swipe up).



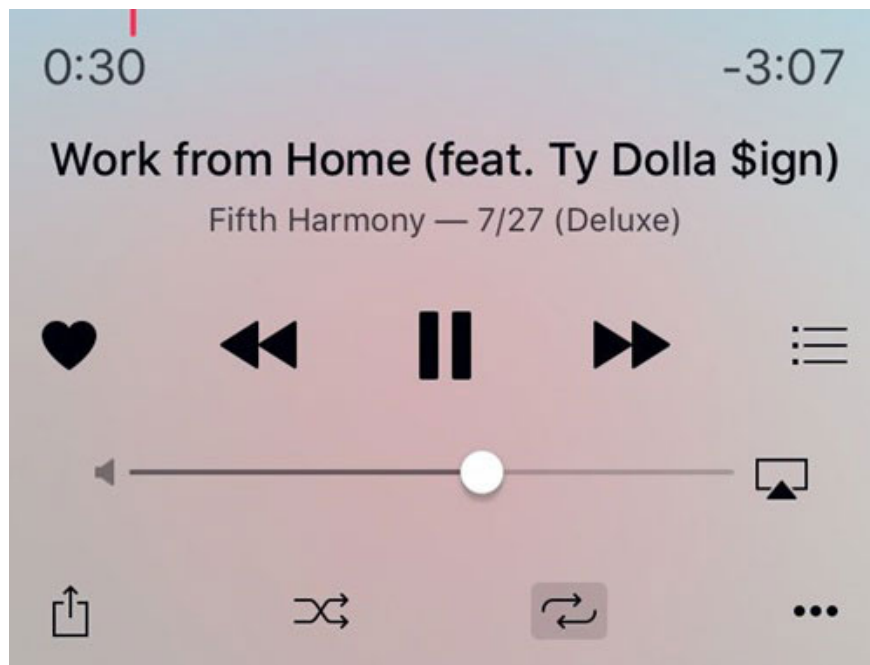
**Step 4:**

Perform Bluetooth signal detection of devices around the connection area, you need to wait a few seconds for the list of Bluetooth devices to appear. At this point, click on the right name of the Bluetooth speaker to connect (usually recorded as the product name of the Bluetooth speaker device you are using).



**Step 5:**

Connect to the Bluetooth speaker, open the music player application on your phone like Zing MP3, NhacCuaTui or go to YouTube to choose music, . and start enjoying your favorite music.



### Note when connecting the phone to the mini speaker:

If you can't connect a portable Bluetooth speaker to your phone, try to fix it by restarting the phone. In case it still fails, the possibility of error comes from the mini Bluetooth speaker, you turn off the speaker power and proceed to power on again, then press the Bluetooth key on the speaker to switch to Pair mode.

Also, for the best experience, don't forget the limit of the current Bluetooth speaker is about 10m, and the devices only connect well when they don't have too many obstacles (like a wall).

Above is **how to connect the mini speaker to the phone**, generally the steps are quite simple and do not take too much time right? In just a few steps, you will be able to successfully connect to the portable Bluetooth speaker and enjoy the great sound coming from it.
