

How to control the time children use iPhone and iPad phones

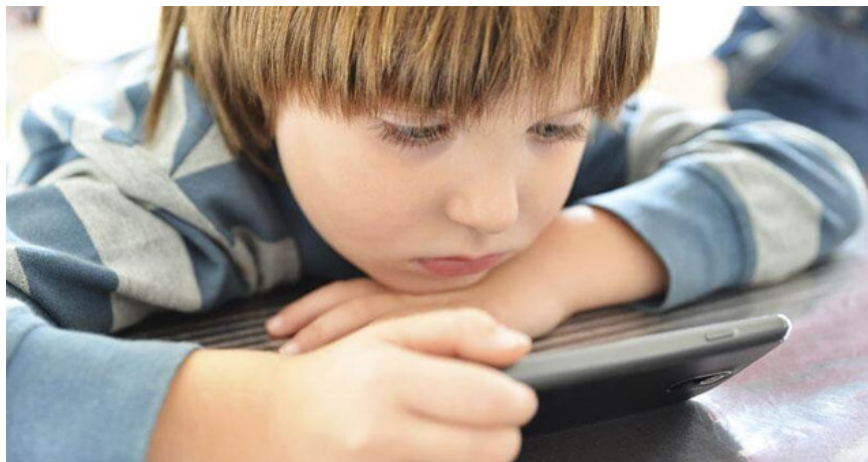

How to turn off chat on iPhone, iPad for children

Chat is probably the most dangerous feature of video games. Players (especially young children) no longer consider this chat feature a means of communication. Conversely, for children it becomes a tool to say bad things, "political views" heard from parents, bullying friends, or nonsense.



The best way is to turn off this feature. Not every game has a chat feature, but most online games integrate this feature. And you can turn off chat in settings or just swipe it.

How to limit the time to use the application on iPhone, iPad

With iOS, you can limit the time to use any application, assuming here is Fortnite Battle Royale.

1. In **Settings** enabled **Guided Access** . (Settings> General> Accessibilit> Guided Access)
2. Open **Fortnite Battle Royale application** .
3. Click on the Home button on the iPhone three times to open **Guided Access** .
4. Select **Options** at the bottom left of the screen.
5. Touch the switch next to **Time Limit** .
6. Customize the time limit you want. You can limit from one minute to 23 hours.

How to prevent young children from making in-app purchases

Many parents have to pay huge amounts of money for their children's purchases in the app (in-app purchase). They can do this inadvertently (or intentionally but do not understand the consequences). It will be bad if your child knows the iPhone password. And it will be extremely bad if the kids have your own iPhone and credit card on their Apple ID.

Just turn off the in-app purchase feature and don't show kids how you did it.
