

How to control the Transparency feature on AirPods Pro

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What is the Transparency feature on AirPods Pro??

AirPods Pro is Apple's first in-ear headset featuring Active Noise Cancellation (ANC), designed to block out outside noise so you can focus on what's listening.



In contrast, the Transparency mode allows you to enjoy your music, while still hearing the noise from your surroundings - whether it is the sound of vehicles traveling on the road while driving, or an important announcement. about the train to work in the morning.

Transparency mode relies on a pressure-balanced ventilation system in AirPods and advanced software to maintain a consistent level of noise reduction, as well as make sure your voice sounds natural while the sound continues to play. perfect way.



How to control Transparency mode on irAirPods Pro?

There are 6 ways to control Transparency mode on irAirPods Pro?. The first method involves using the Force sensors on the ?AirPods itself with the default settings, while the second and third methods are accessed through the menus on the connected iOS device screen.

Method 1

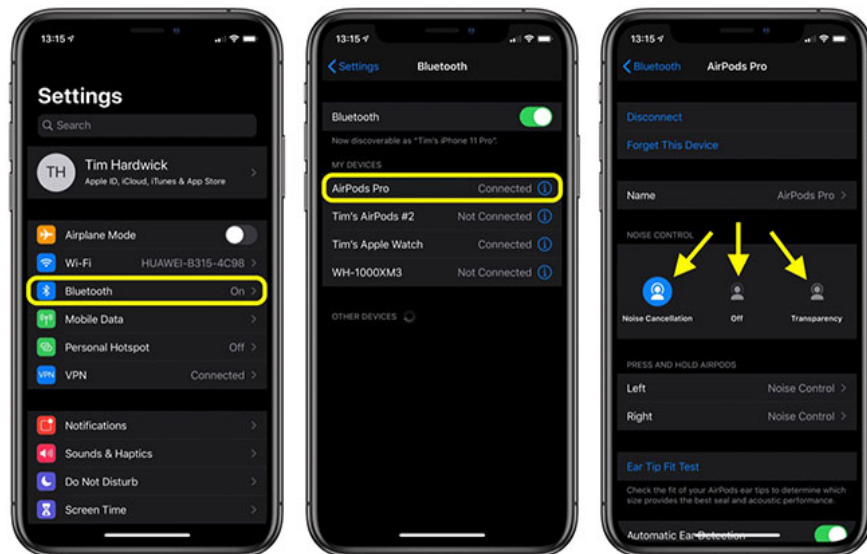
1. Allow ?AirPods? to connect to an iPhone or iPad in the usual way, by opening the AirPods case right next to your iOS device and inserting buds into your ear.
2. Press and hold the AirPod Pro body to switch between **Noise Cancellation** and **Transparency** , depending on your preference.
3. You will hear a tone when switching between the two functions.



If desired, you can customize the gesture of pressing and holding on the AirPods Pro headset and even use it to completely turn off noise control features.

Method 2

1. Allow AirPods to connect to iPhone or iPad in the usual way (as described in method 1).
2. Launch the **Settings** application on the iOS device.
3. Click **Bluetooth**.



4. In **My Devices**, touch the information icon (the "i" circled) next to AirPods Pro in the list.

5. In **Noise Control**, click **Noise Cancellation, Off** or **Transparency**, depending on your preference.

Method 3

1. Allow ?AirPods? to connect to iPhone or ?iPad? in the normal way (as above).
2. Open **Control Center** on iOS devices: On ?iPad? with the Home button (double-press the Home button); on iPhone 8 and earlier, swipe up from the bottom of the screen; and on iPad Pro or iPhone X 2018 or later, swipe down from the top right of the screen.



3. Press and hold the volume bar in the **Control Center** (the earbud pair will show in it to indicate that ?AirPods Pro? is connected).

4. Use the button strip at the bottom of the screen to switch between **Noise Cancellation, Off** or **Transparency** , depending on your preference.
