

How to control VLC by mouse gestures

To control VLC, in addition to using mouse manipulation or shortcuts, you can control with mouse gestures.

Normally when you watch videos on VLC Media Player, you will use mouse or VLC shortcuts to control and execute commands on the software to watch this video. So did you try to use, control VLC with mouse gestures or not?

It sounds like it will have to rely on a software or utility to support VLC. But actually, VLC mouse gesture control is one of the available features of this software. Currently VLC is a popular video and audio player software. The tool possesses many attractive features such as downloading Youtube videos, recording videos, reversing videos, etc. or controlling software by mouse gestures that Network Administrator wants to introduce to readers in this article. .

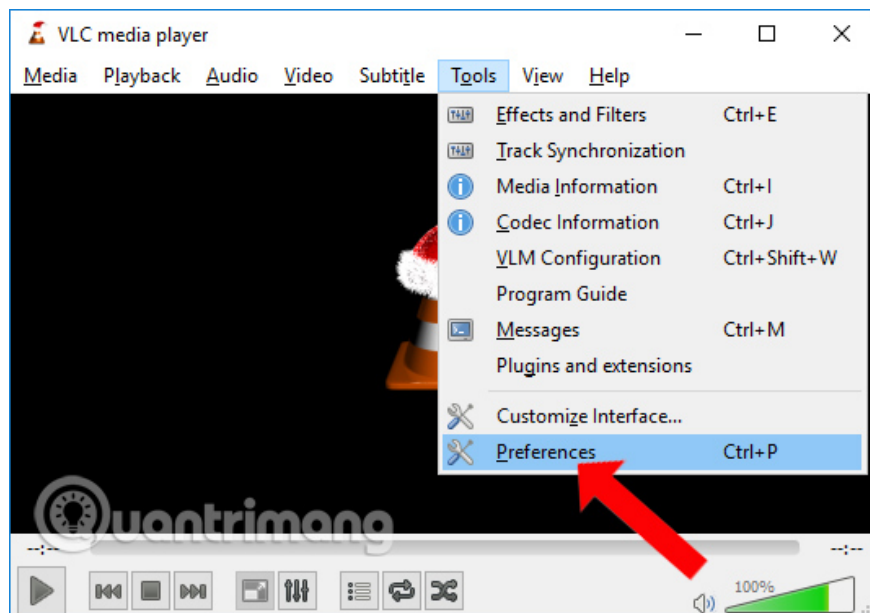

How to activate VLC control by mouse gestures

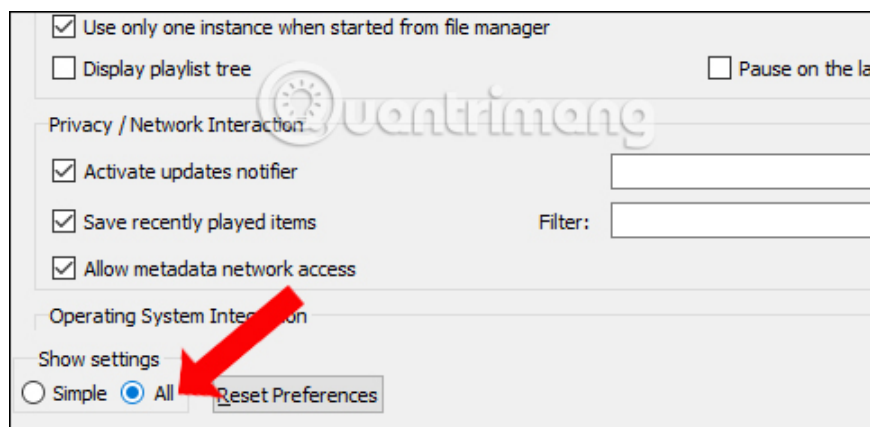
Step 1:

At the interface on VLC, click on **Tools** and then select **Preferences** .



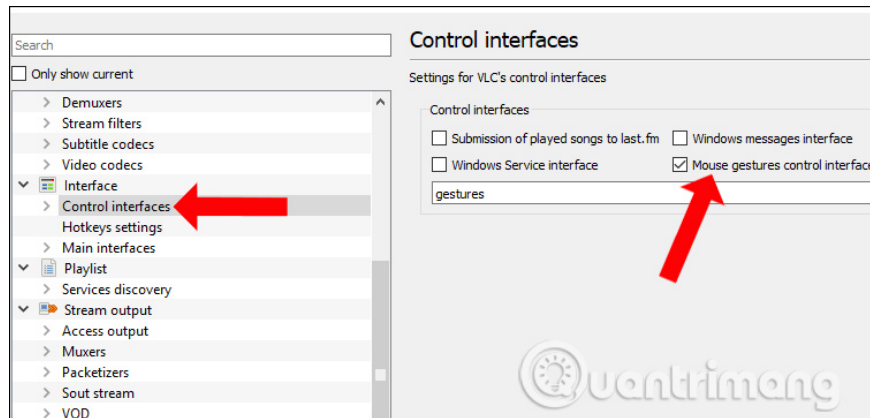
Step 2:

Appears the interface of the Advanced Preferences window. Click **the All button** in Show settings below.



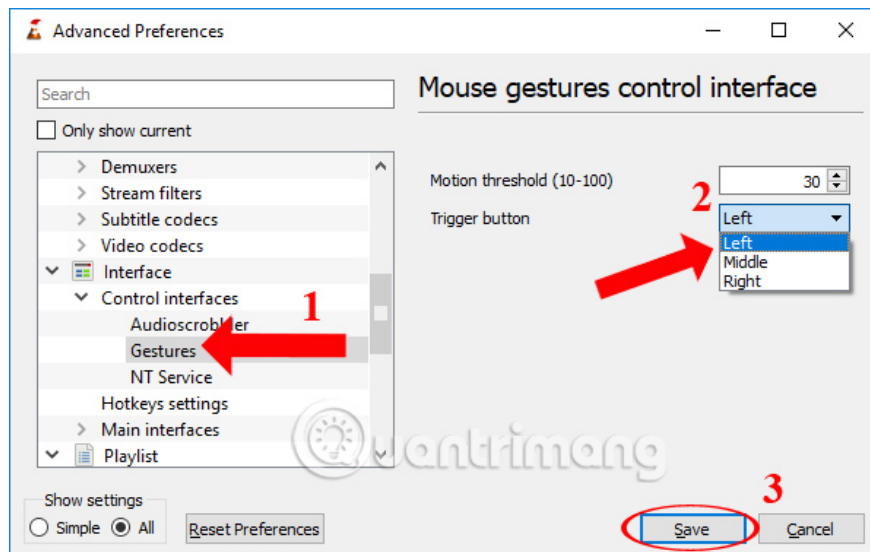
After that, a list of setup items appears to the **Interface** and click the **Control interfaces** in the left column. Or you can enter Interface into the search bar above.

Looking to the right interface, select the **Mouse gestures control interface** .



Step 3:

Next go back to the list on the left at Control Interfaces, find **Gestures** in the drop down list. Look to the right, select the button to enable the control at the Trigger button. Buttons include Left (left mouse button), Middle (middle mouse button), Right (right mouse button). Users select the easy-to-use mouse control button and then **click Save** to save the changes.



Step 4:

Now you play the video on VLC and proceed to control the video with mouse gestures.

If in step 3 above choose which button, when controlling, we need to use the right mouse button. For example, above I select Left mouse button, then hold the left mouse button during operation. Then release the left mouse button at the end of the operation to execute the command.



The mouse gestures controlling VLC include:

1. Move the mouse left: Reverse 10 seconds.
2. Move the mouse to the right: Fringes for another 10 seconds.
3. Move the mouse up: Increase the volume.
4. Move the mouse down: Reduce the volume.
5. Move the mouse left and then right: Turn on or pause.
6. Move the mouse up and down: Turn off the volume.
7. Move the mouse down and up: Turn on the volume again.
8. Move the mouse left and then up: Reduce playback speed.
9. Move the mouse to the right and then up: Speed up playback.
10. Move the mouse left and then down: Play the previous content of the playlist.
11. Move the mouse to the right and then down: Play the next content in the playlist.
12. Move the mouse up and then right: Switch the audio track.
13. Move the mouse down and then right: Move the subtitle track.
14. Move the mouse up and then left: Open full screen playback mode.
15. Move the mouse down and then left: Exit VLC media player.

An interesting feature on VLC software control by mouse gestures. With gestures from simple to advanced, users will have more ways to perform operations faster when watching videos on VLC.
