1. Use Word to convert photos to PDF

The easiest way to convert images to PDF is to use the Microsoft Word word processing software itself. However, in order to do this, you must first install **Foxit Reader** , which is a very popular PDF reader. If you use Windows 10, it is not necessary to install this software.

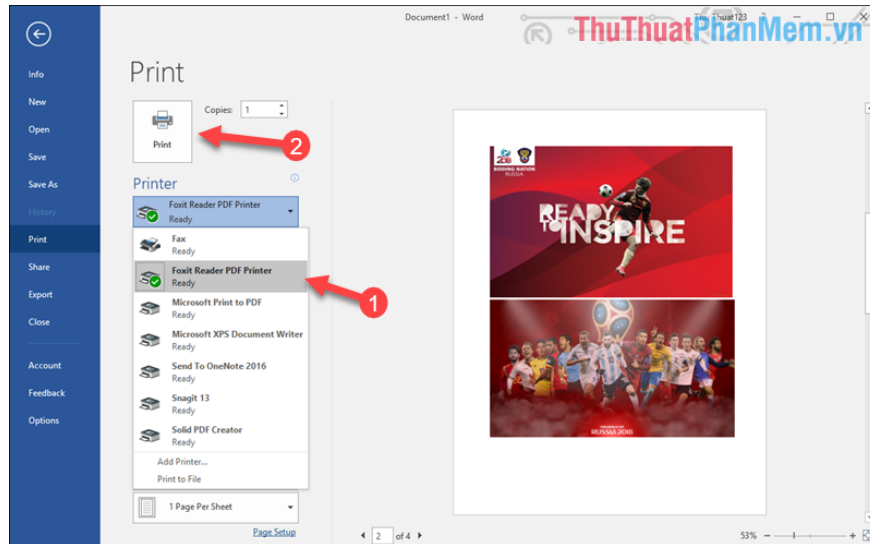
The steps are as follows:

Step 1: Open up Word and proceed to insert pictures into Word by simply copying and pasting images into Word files or choose Insert -> Picture.

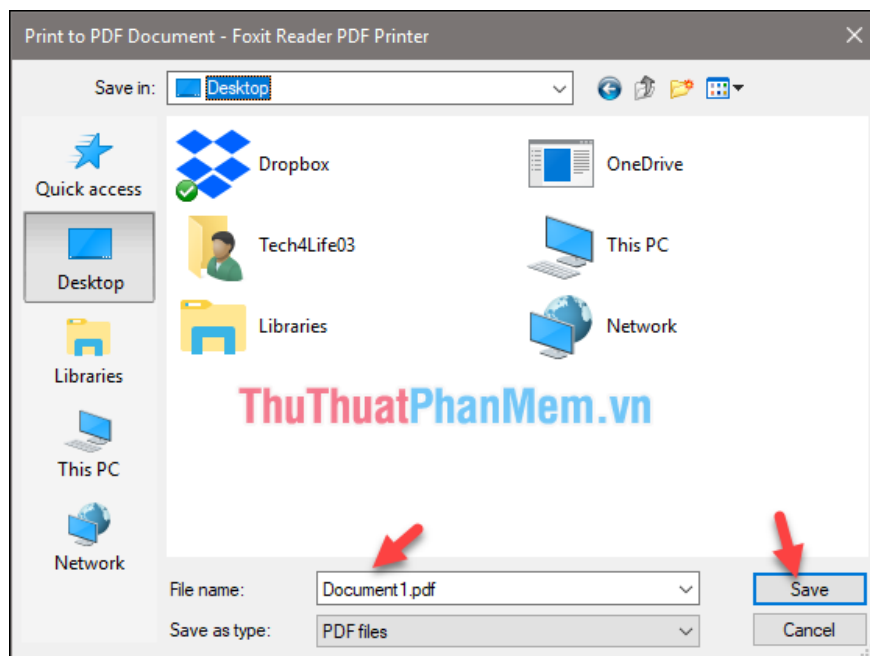


Step 2 : Press Ctrl + P to open the printing mode, in the printer name, select **Foxit Reader PDF Printer** (this is the reason we have to install Foxit reader software). In Windows 10, the option of **Microsoft print to PDF** is available .

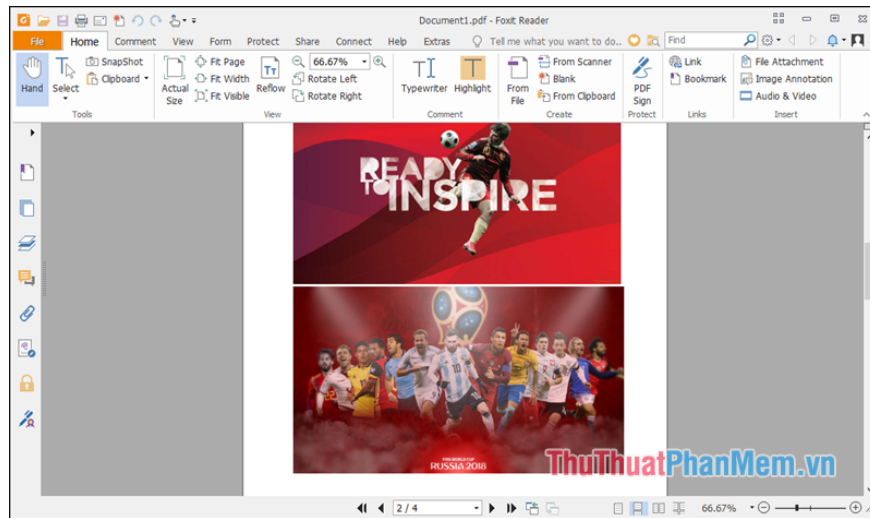
After selecting, click Print to print out the PDF file.



Step 3: A small window appears, select where to save the PDF file and click Save:



Wait a moment and we have successfully converted the image file to PDF



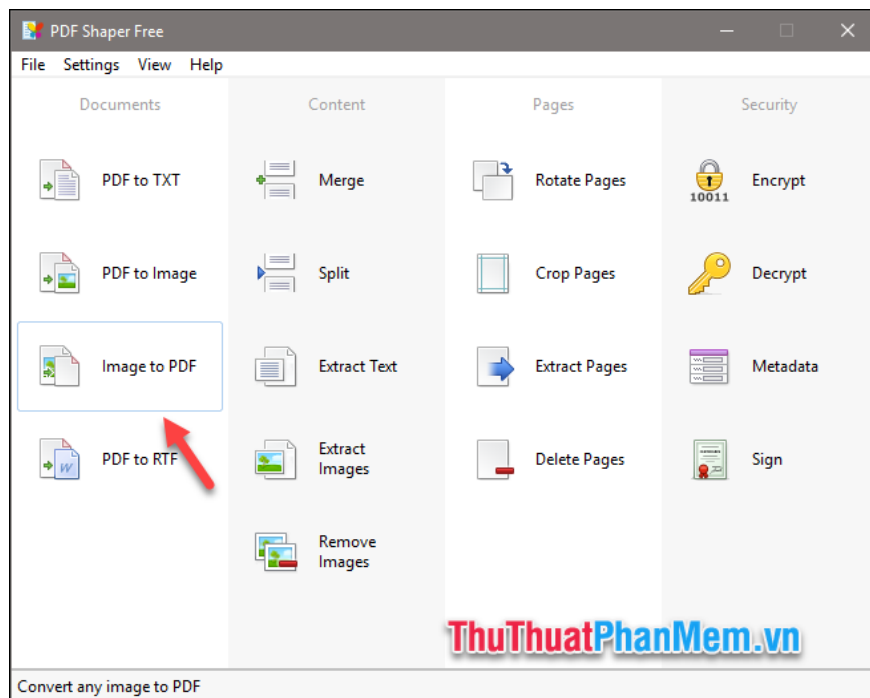
2. Use the PDF Shaper software

PDF Shaper is a versatile PDF editing and converting software with lots of cool features, including the ability to convert images to PDF. This is completely free software so you can rest assured to use.

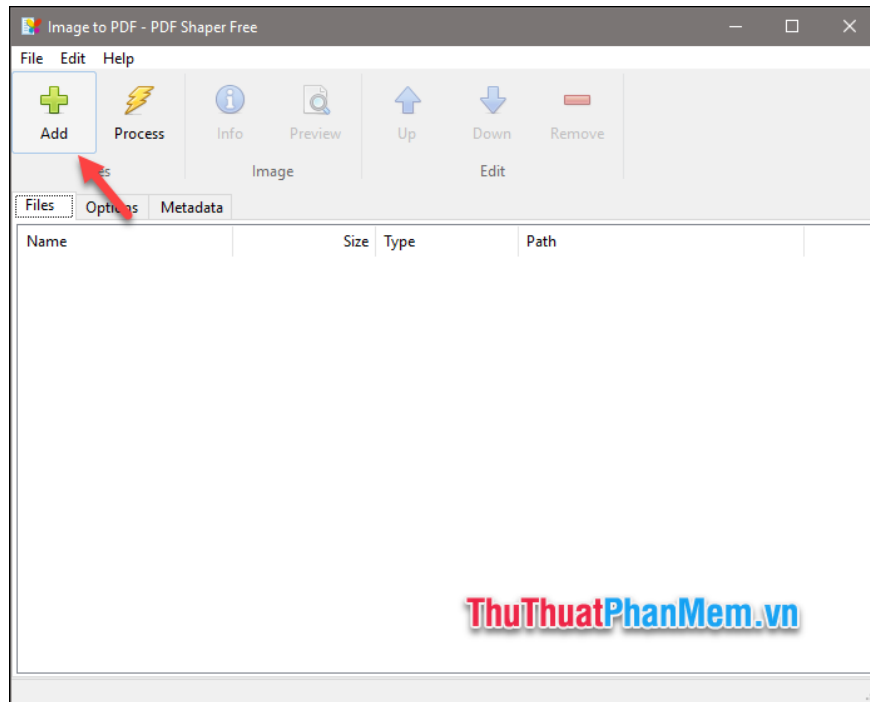
You download and install the software at the following link:

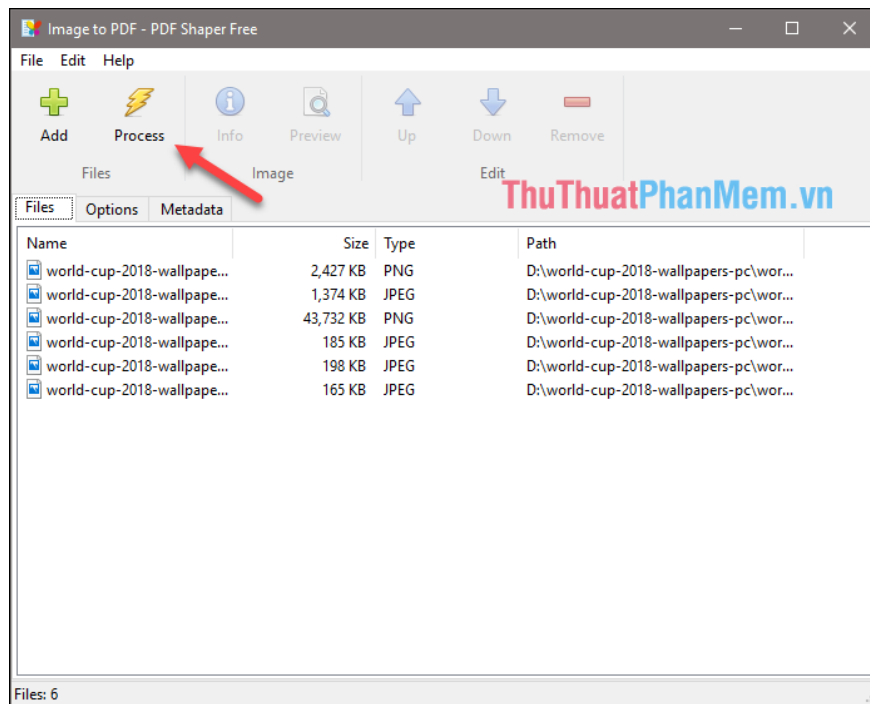
Step 1 : Open the software and select the **Image to PDF** item



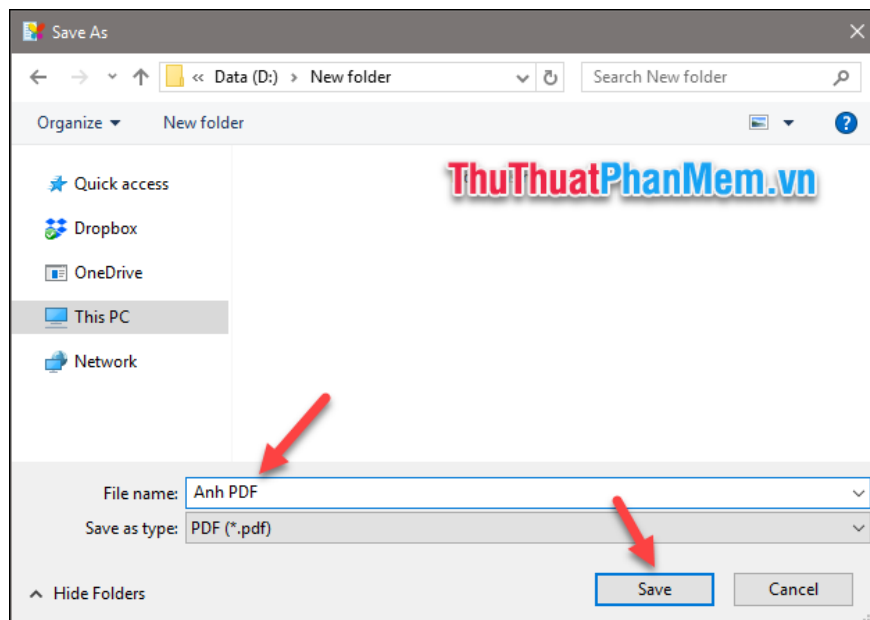
Step 2: Click the Add button to select the image on your computer. You can select multiple photos at once by holding **Ctrl** and selecting photos



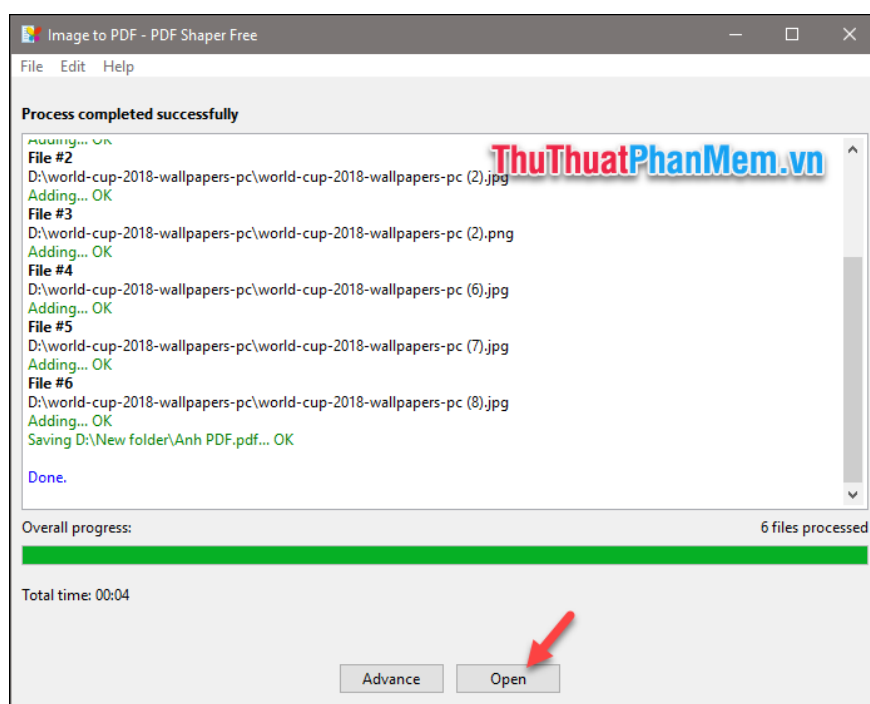
Step 3 : After selecting the image, click **Process** to start converting.



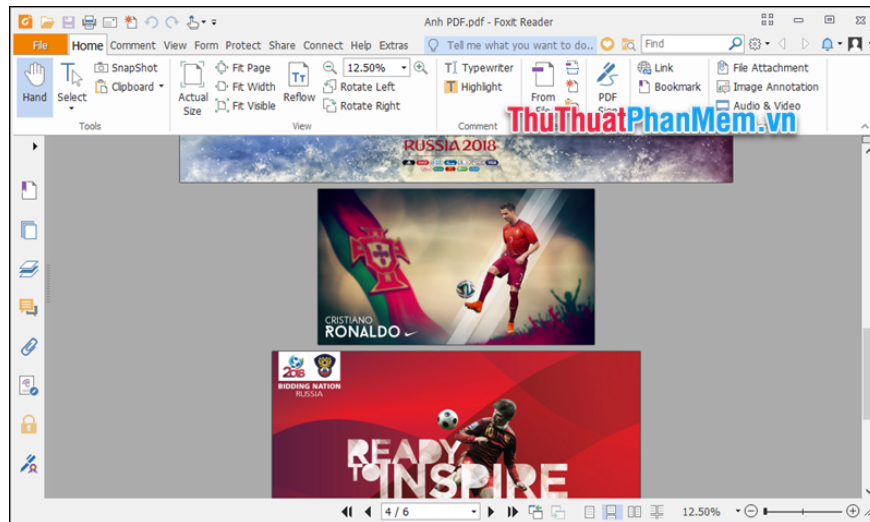
Step 4 : A new window appears, select the folder to save the PDF file, then name the file and click Save



Step 5: Wait a while for the software to convert the image into PDF, after the conversion is complete, click Open to view the PDF file:



And here is our result:

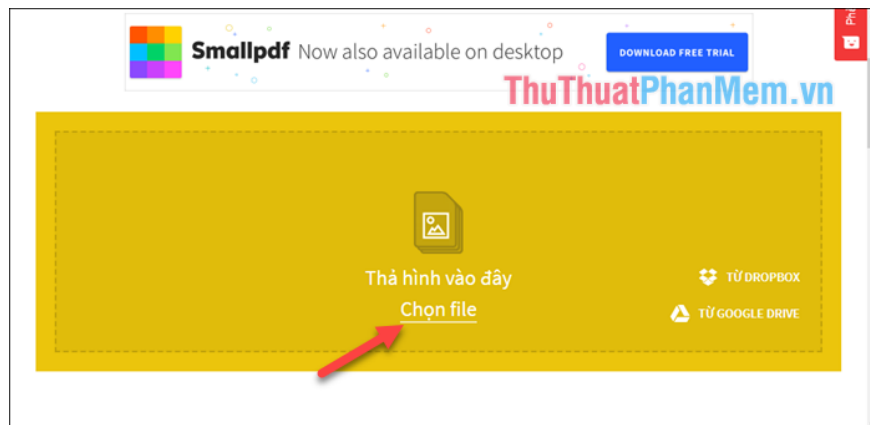


3. Use an online image to PDF converter

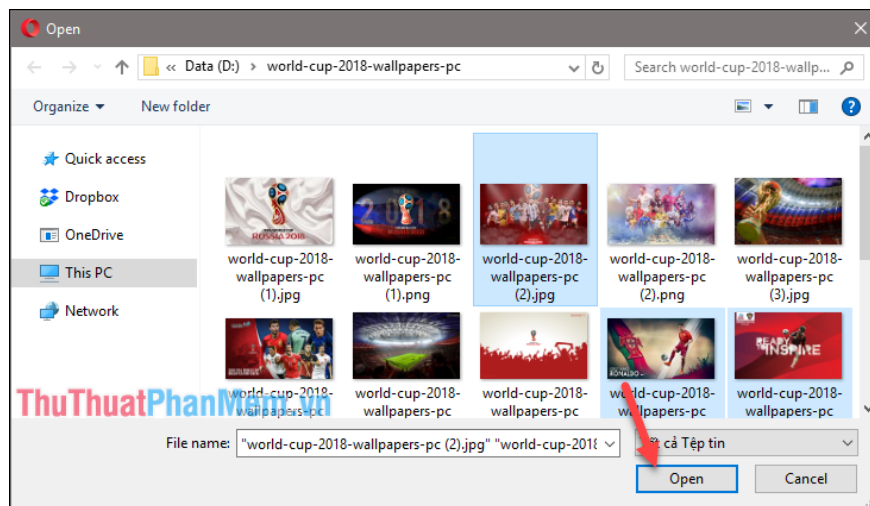
If you do not want to install PDF conversion software on your computer, you can use online tools to perform the conversion, such as **SmallPDF** , **jpg2pdf.com** , **pdf.io** . etc. For example, here we will use an online tool called SmallPDF to convert JPG to PDF. To use this tool, go to the following link:

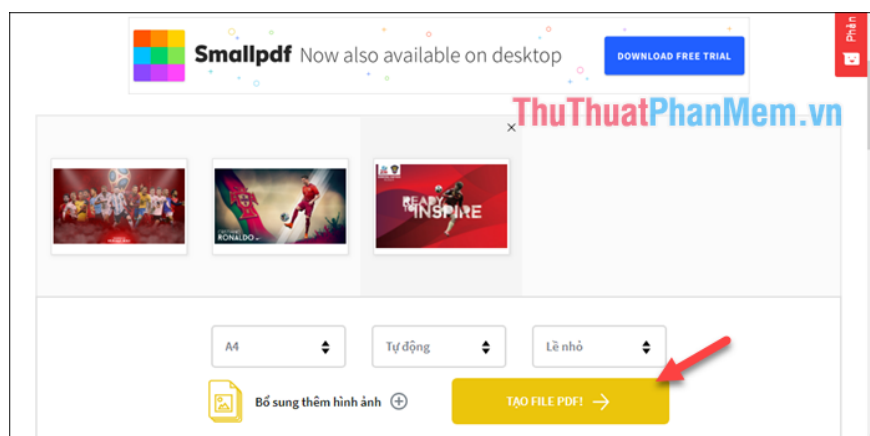
After accessing the link, at the website interface, click Select file to select the images on your computer.



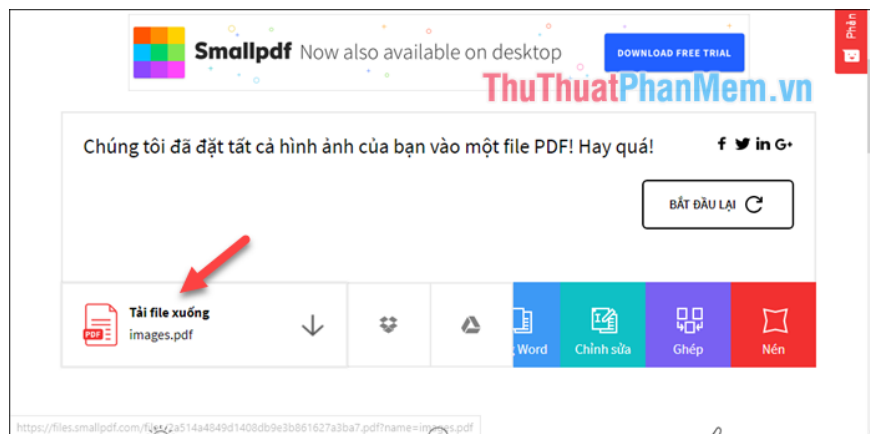
You can select multiple photos at once by holding Ctrl, then clicking Open



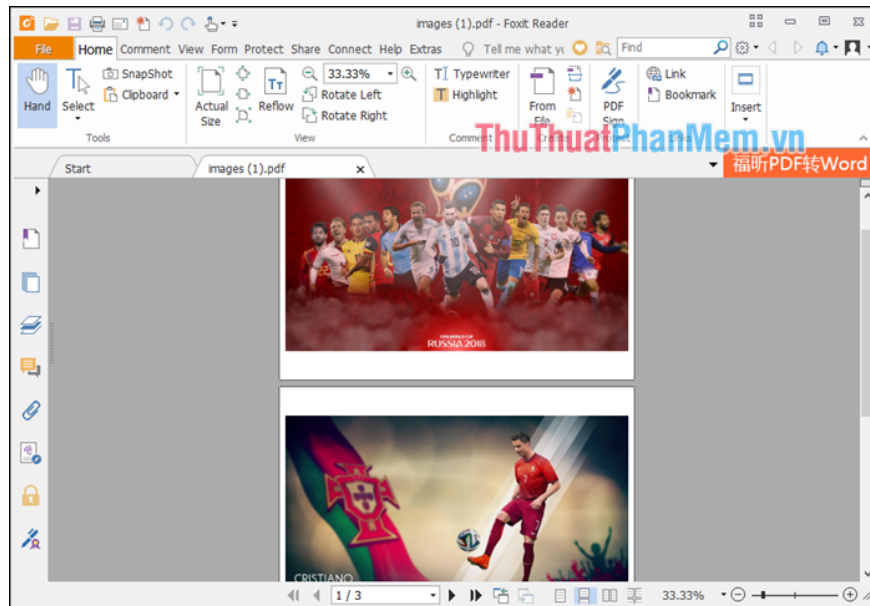
Images will be uploaded on the website, you can choose the paper size, picture style and PDF page margins. After selecting, click **Create PDF file**.



After creating the PDF file, click **Download file** to save the PDF file to your computer.
