

# How to convert CR2 images to JPEG using software or online.

If you're a professional photo editor, you definitely need to know how to convert CR2 images to JPEG using various software like Free CR2 to JPG Converter, Canon Digital Photo Professional, or online tools... because CR2 or RAW images are essential for artistic creation and professional image editing using software like Photoshop or PhotoScape.

RAW or CR2 image format is one of the most basic image formats that any professional or amateur user should know, because RAW images allow for maximum image editing, making it easy for users to post-process and change parameters such as light, color, and effects using Adobe Photoshop , Lightroom, or PhotoScape without losing pixels or damaging the image.



Because of its importance, readers should learn some of the methods for converting CR2 images to JPEG in this article to edit photos more professionally.

## **How to convert CR2 images to JPEG**

Method 1: Use software to convert CR2 (RAW) images to JPEG.

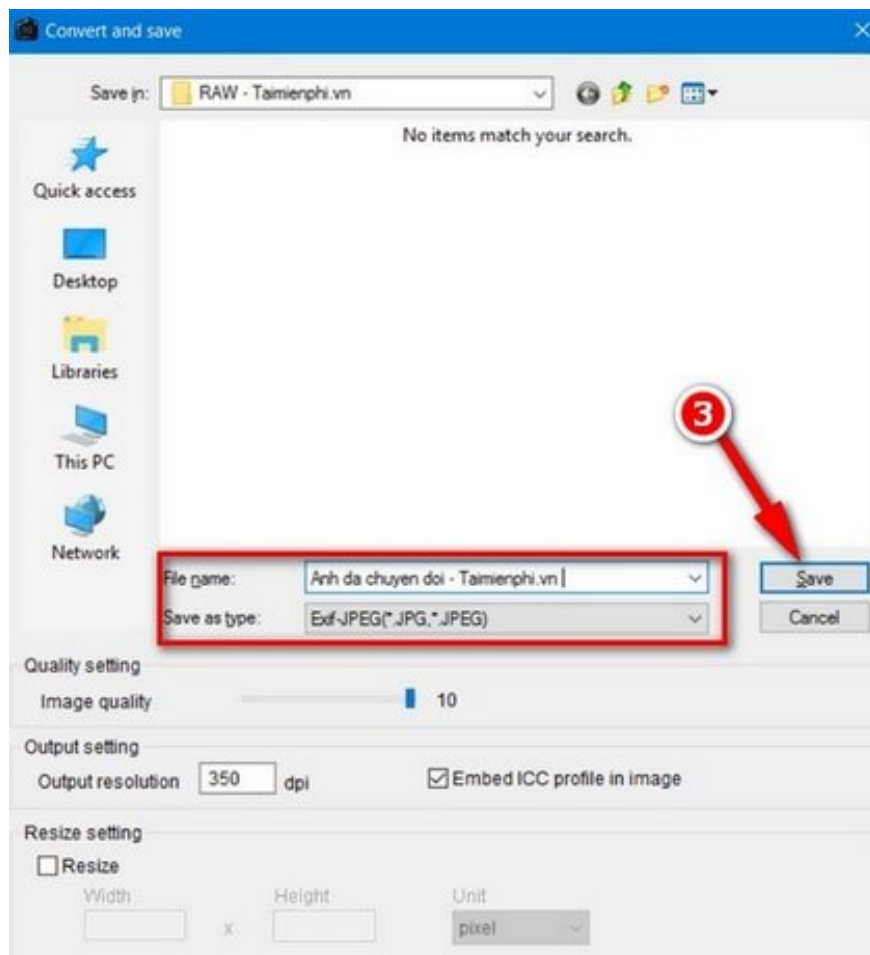
### **\* Canon Digital Photo Professional software**

To convert CR2 (RAW) images to JPEG using Canon Digital Photo Professional software, you can choose to convert one image or multiple images at once. However, first, download the latest version of Canon Digital Photo Professional to your computer. By default, you will need the installation disc to install Canon Digital Photo Professional on your computer.

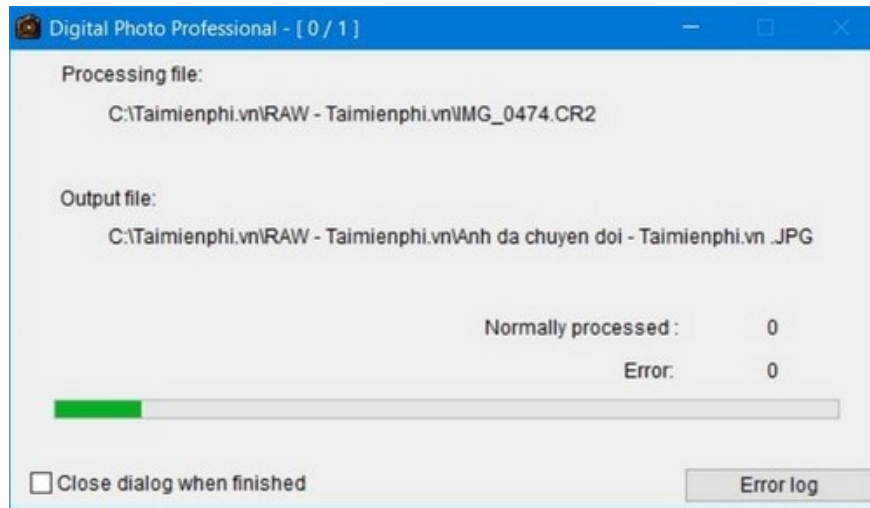
*Step 1* : To convert an image, access the RAW image folder on your computer and select any image. Then, click **File > Convert and save...**



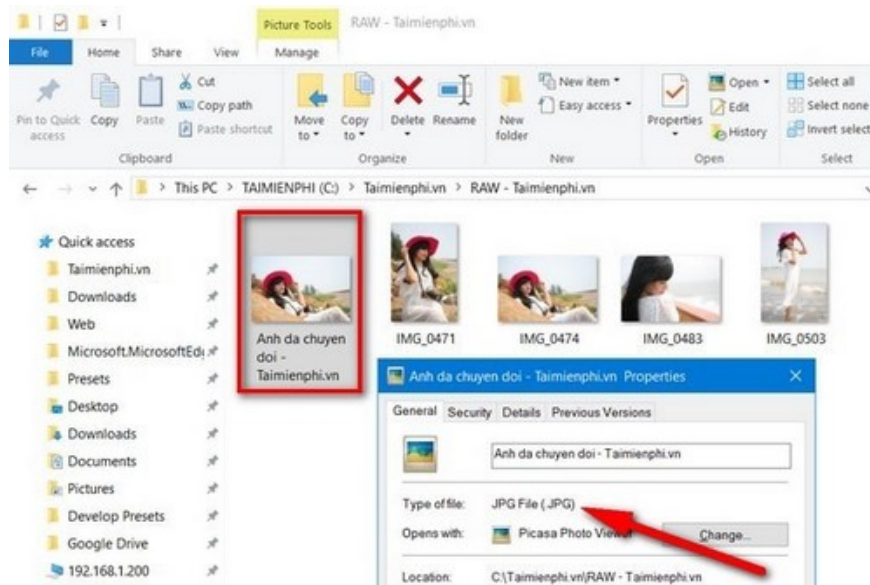
*Step 2* : Choose a location to save the RAW image after converting it to CR2 format using Canon Digital Photo Professional software. Press Save to save.



The conversion process may take a few seconds or a few minutes depending on the image size.



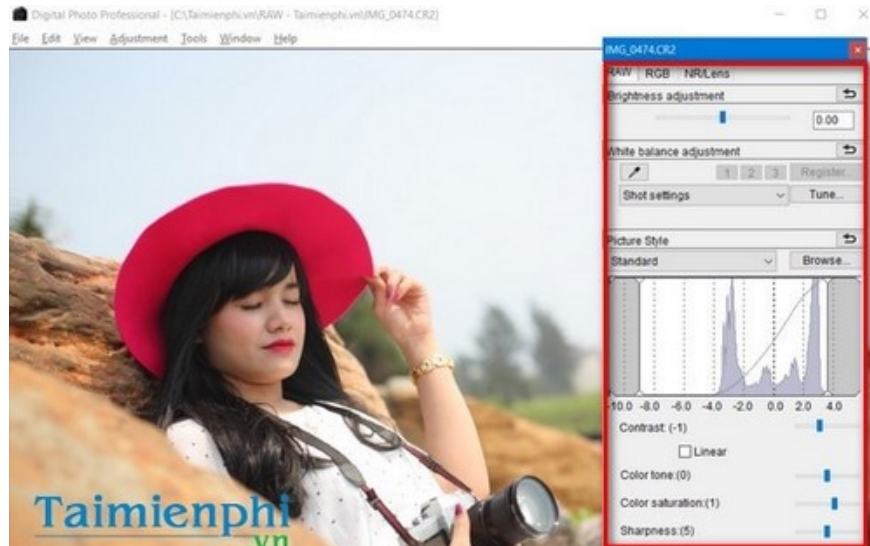
The result after conversion.



Of course, you can edit the RAW image beforehand to your liking to best suit your needs when converting CR2 to JPEG.



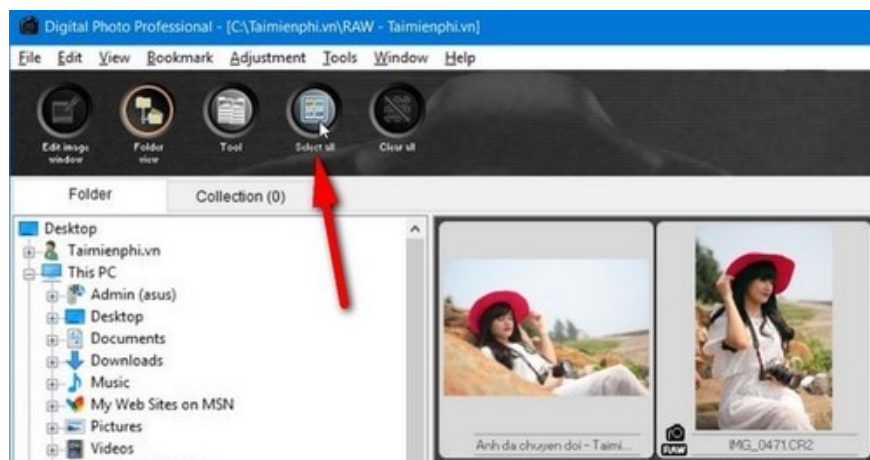
Simply double-click the image to switch to the RAW image editing interface.

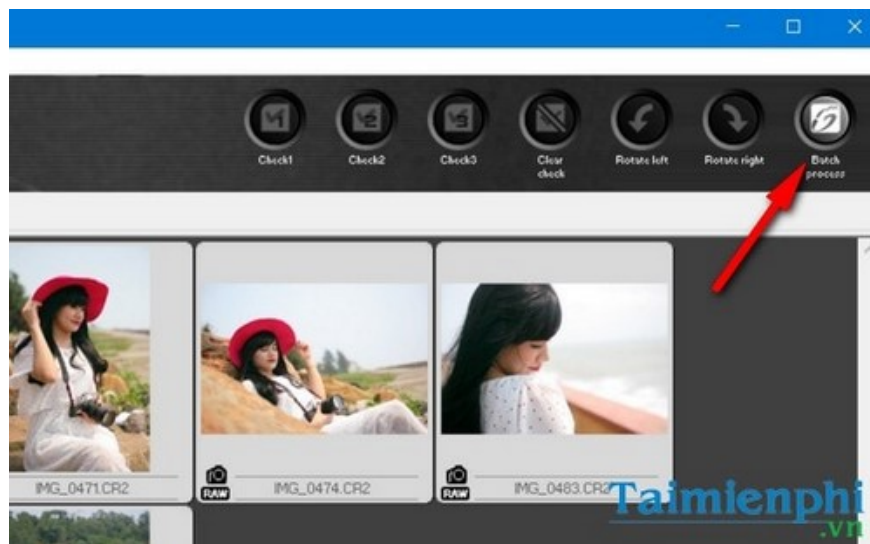


There are many customization options related to the color, brightness, and white balance of an image.

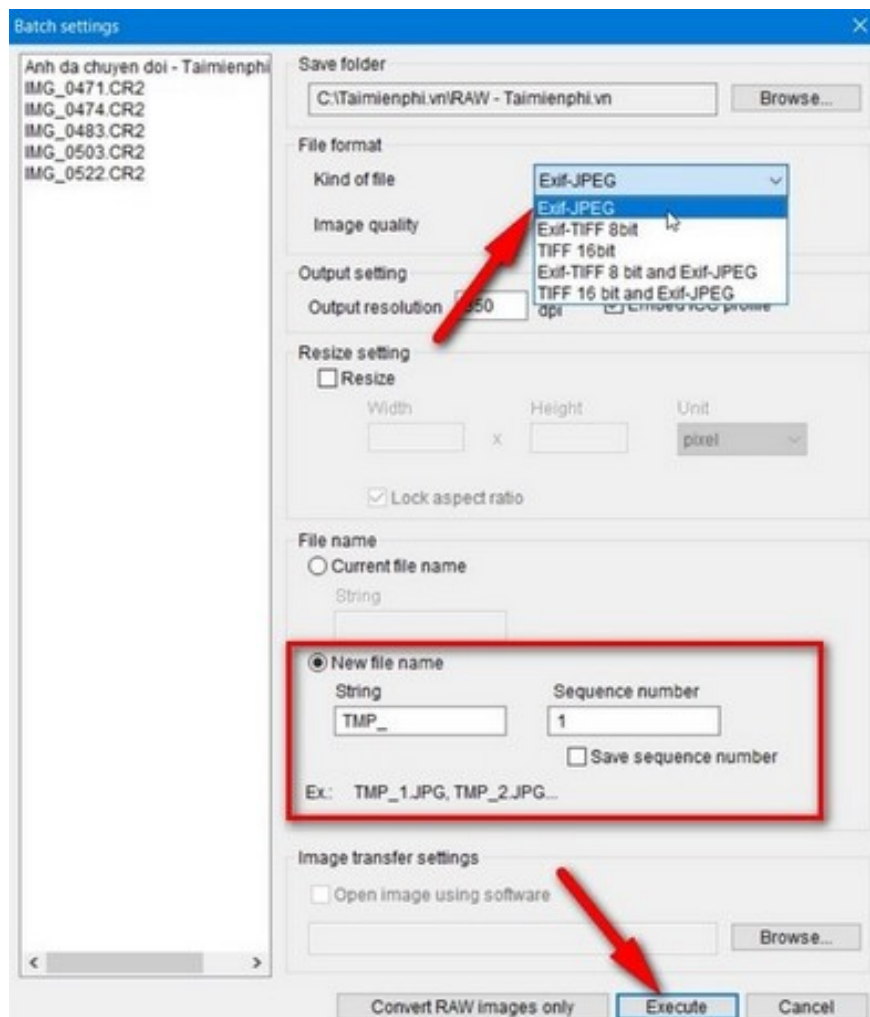
*Step 4* : If you want to convert multiple RAW images to CR2 to JPEG at the same time, follow these steps:

Click the **Select All** option on the toolbar to select all images > select **Batch process** .





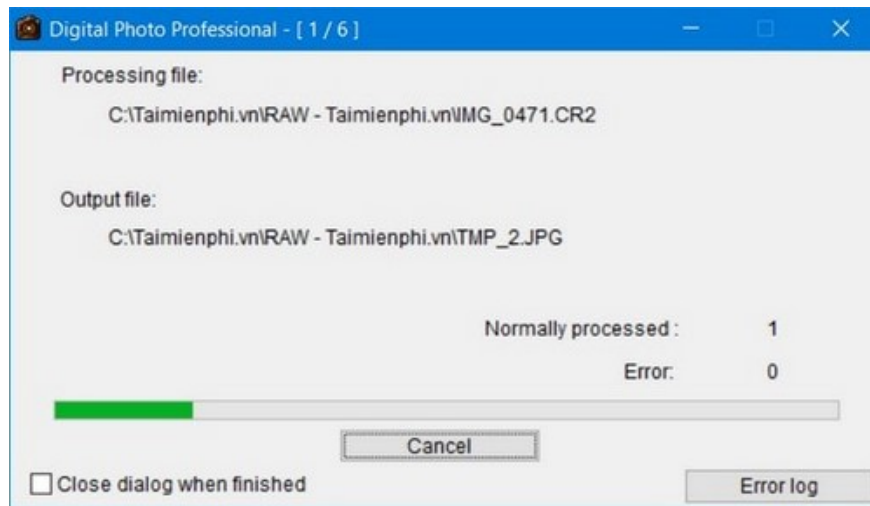
Step 5 : In the **Batch settings** interface , you need to pay attention to the path to save the image file converted from CR2 to JPEG by clicking **Browse** and navigating to the desired folder.



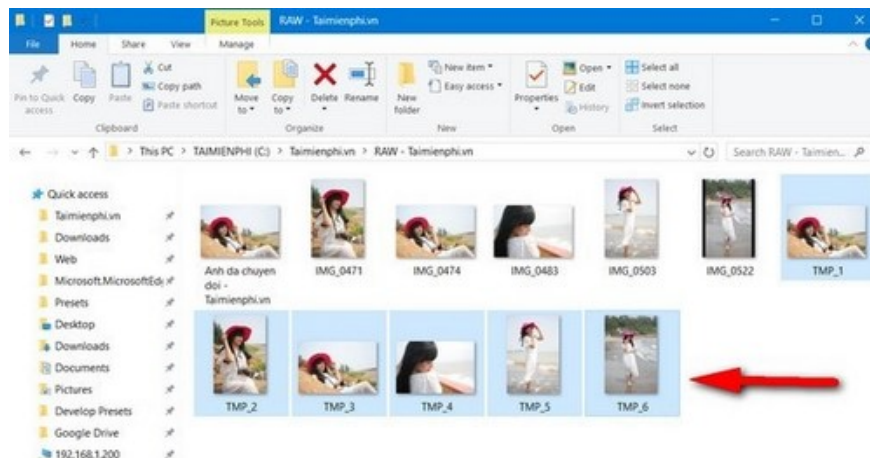
In addition, you need to select the conversion file format; here you should choose **Exif-JPEG** and the **Image quality** should be at least 10.

Step 6 : The final step is to name the file in the "New file name" section .

Then click **Execute** to proceed with the batch conversion of CR2 images to JPEG.



And this is the final result after you convert CR2 to JPEG in batch.



It's quite simple and easy to convert CR2 to JPEG, either individually or in batches, using Canon Digital Photo Professional software.

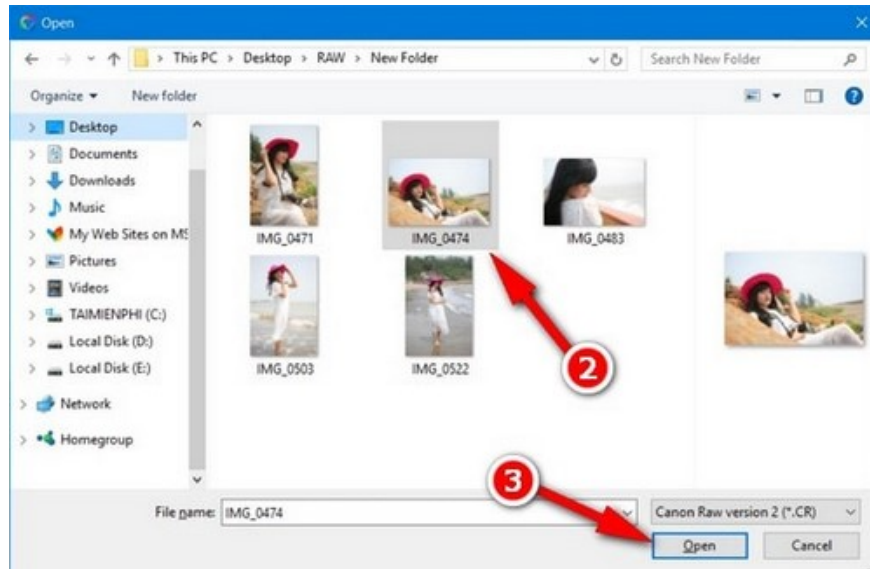
#### \* Free CR2 to JPG Converter software

You should download the latest version of Free CR2 to JPEG Converter to ensure the most efficient CR2 to JPEG conversion experience.

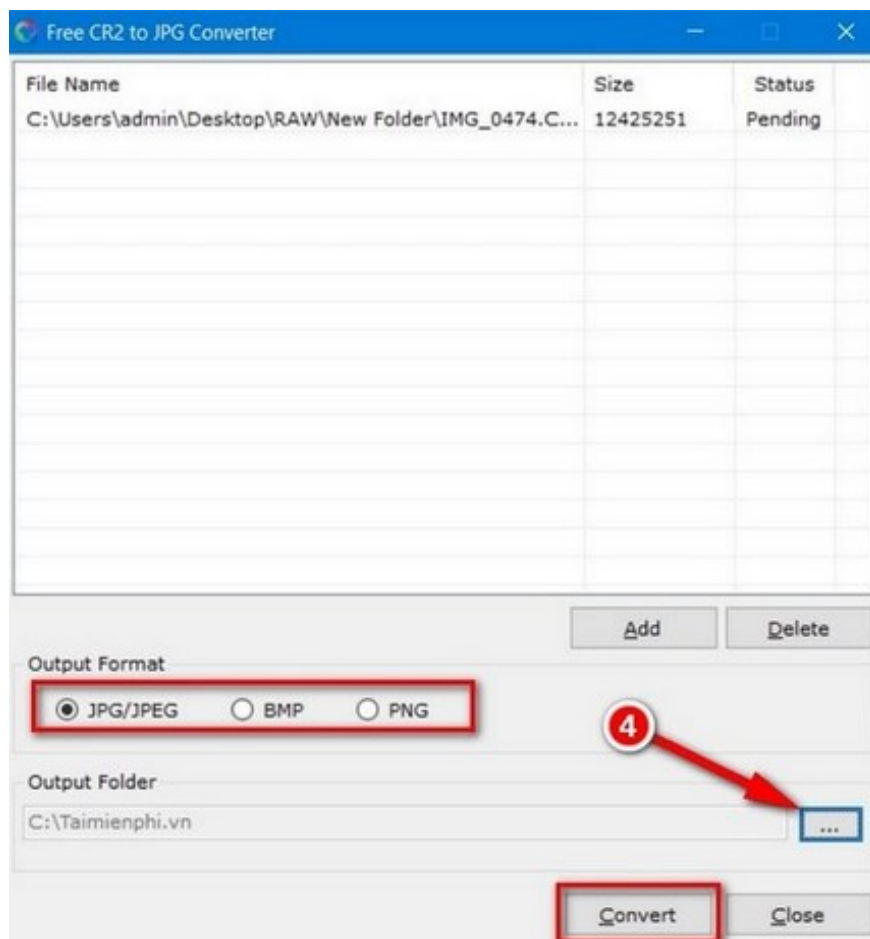
Step 1 : From the main interface of the **Free CR2 to JPG Converter** software , click " **Add**" to add images to the software.



Step 2: Click **Convert** to convert the selected image to CR2.

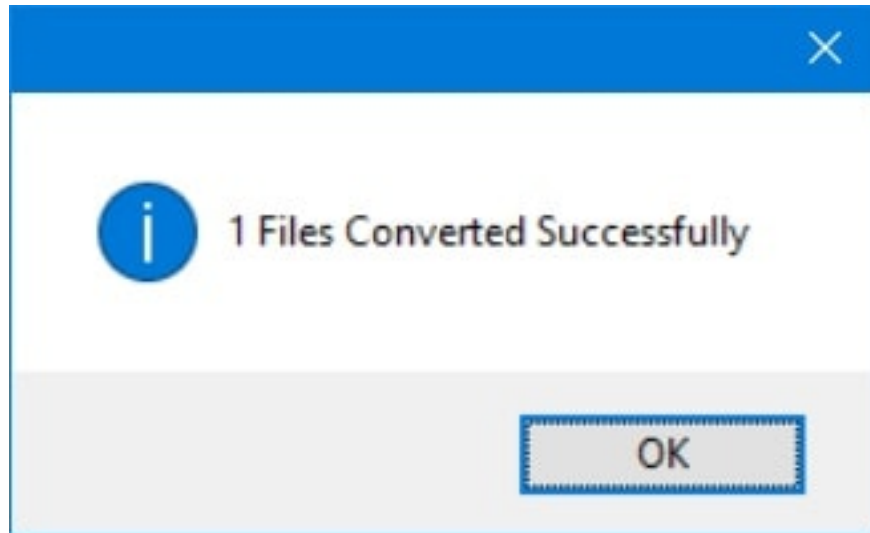


However, before that, you should choose the location to export the converted CR2 to JPG image by pressing the (.) icon.

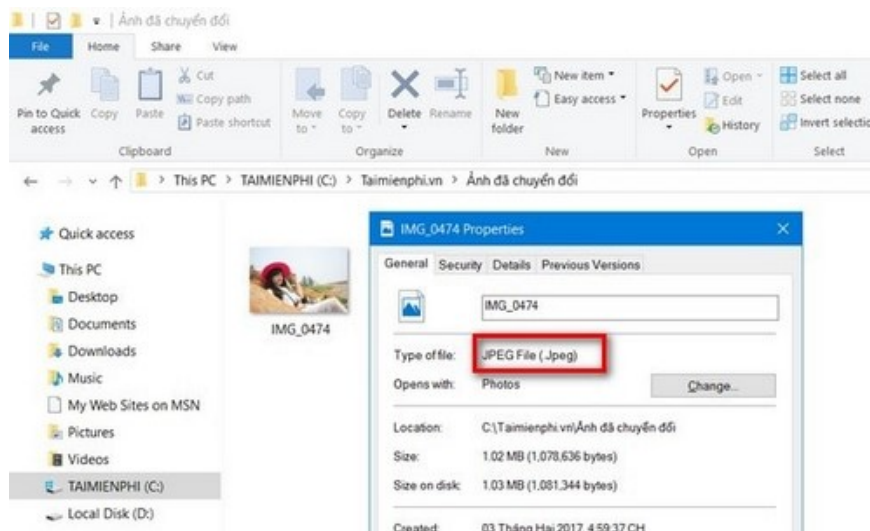


Additionally, if you want to choose an image output format other than JPG, you can also select the BMP or PNG options.

*Step 3:* A notification will appear confirming successful conversion of the image to CR2 format.



The image has been successfully converted from CR2 to JPEG.

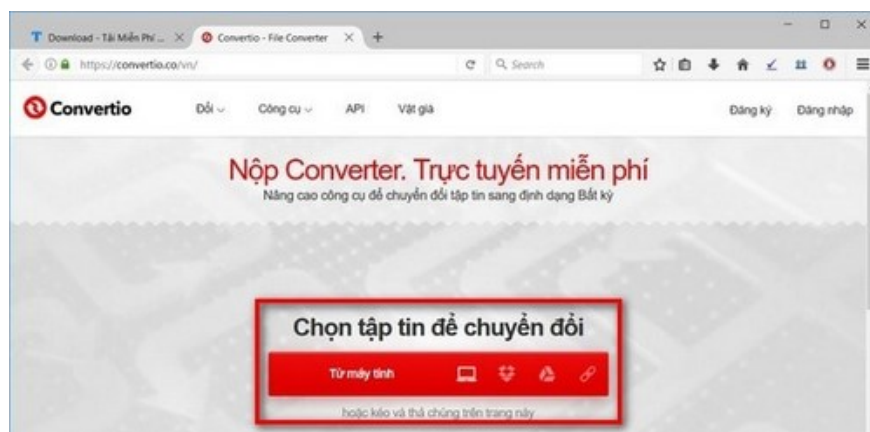


Previously, you could only open CR2 files using Canon's CR2 file reader software or Photoshop. However, after converting CR2 to JPEG, you can now successfully open CR2 files as JPEG files.

Method 2: Use an online CR2 to JPEG image converter tool – [Convertio.co](https://www.convertio.co)

This is one of the quite useful conversion services, especially for easily converting CR2 to JPEG. If you want to quickly convert CR2 or RAW image formats to JPEG without installing CR2 to JPEG conversion software like Free CR2 to JPEG Converter or Microsoft Camera Codec Pack, you can use this service.

*Step 1 :* Access the [Convertio.co](https://www.convertio.co) service page **here** .



Here you have many options to import images into the service, including from your computer, Dropbox, Google Drive, or a link. Users can even easily drag and drop files.

*Step 2:* In the "To" section, click on "**Images**" > "**JPEG**" to convert the CR2 image to JPEG.



Press **Convert** to begin converting CR2 images to JPEG.

In addition, Convertio allows you to add more photos in the **Add Files More** section and choose where to save the images in Google Drive or Dropbox.

*Step 3:* After successfully converting the image to CR2 format, simply download it by clicking the **Download** button .

Thus, with the instructions above, users can successfully convert CR2 images to JPEG using both methods: Free CR2 to JPG Converter, Adobe Photoshop, or a service. Depending on your needs, you can install software to convert CR2 to JPEG faster, or use the online service Convertio if you don't have a computer with CR2 image format conversion software installed.
