What is the DAT file?

You may wonder what the DAT file is first.

Simply put, DAT files contain data in text or binary format. Usually, you will find them as **winmail.dat** files in email attachments, created by Microsoft Exchange Server. But many other programs can also create DAT files. Therefore, it is difficult to know that you are handling text, image, movie, or something files.

Once you have successfully opened the DAT file, it is considered that you have gone halfway through the conversion process. There are several options for converting DAT files.


Simple solutions

Suppose you are processing a DAT file, originally a DOC file. You have changed the file extension and now that you have opened the file in Microsoft Word, it looks like everything is fine. In fact, you've already "converted"

your DAT file. Congratulations!

If you manage file opening with Word, the easiest way to "convert" your file from DAT to DOC is to save the document in Microsoft Word. Not too difficult, right?

How many times have you come across pesky and puzzling, impossible to open 'winmail.dat or ATT0001.dat' files attached to your email? This handy, free online tool saves you from frustration, giving you easy access to their contents. It's quick and simple to use, with no hidden costs, registration or email required.

Now, be a bit more serious. All of the above methods are ineffective, your file will not display correctly. It may be time to use a file converter.

If Microsoft Outlook messes up your email attachments, it's likely that the Winmaildat.com online service will help you. If the file you need to decrypt is called **winmail.dat** or **ATT0001.dat**, you certainly have found the right place to solve your problem.

From the **Home** tab , click **Choose File** to browse to the DAT file on your computer. You can also enter the URL. Note that the file size limit is 10 MB. Click **Start** and wait for the result.

Winmaildat.com will tell you the source of the file, giving you an idea of ??what program you can use to open it.

There are not too many DAT files in fact. To successfully retrieve data from a DAT file or convert it to the original file, you need to know the source or original file type.
