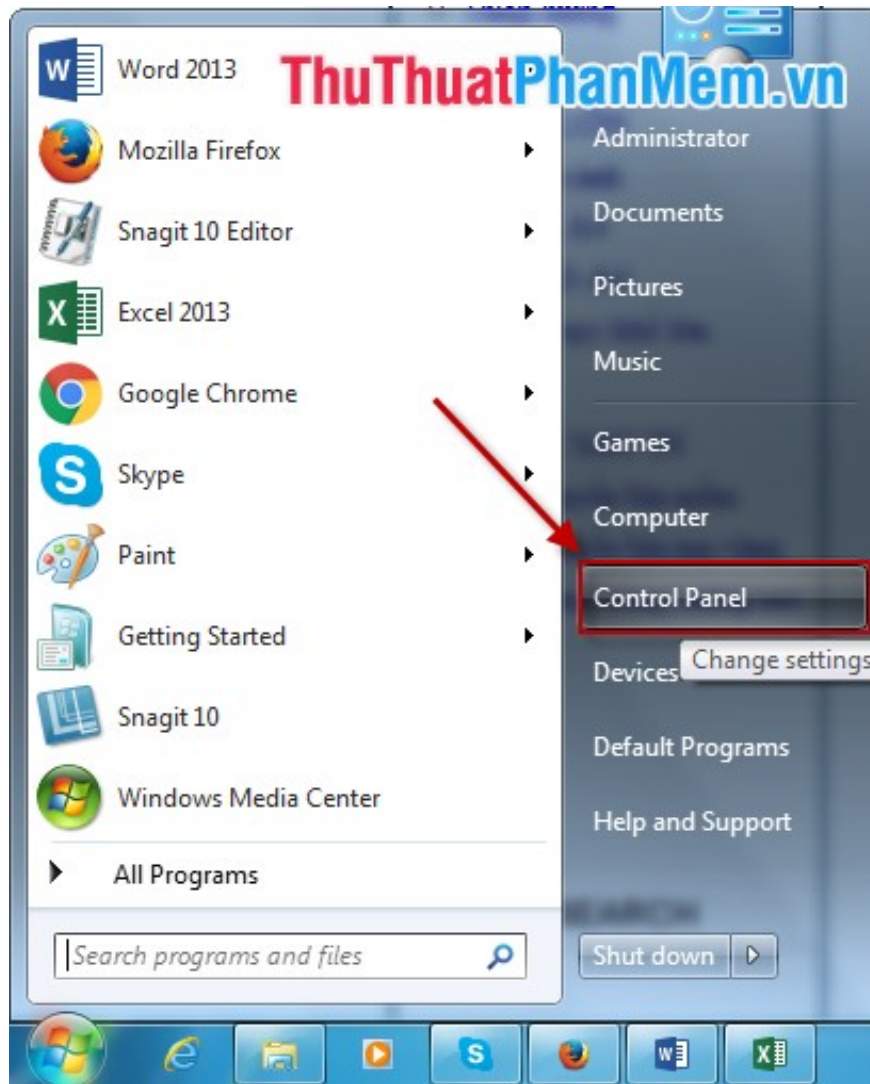

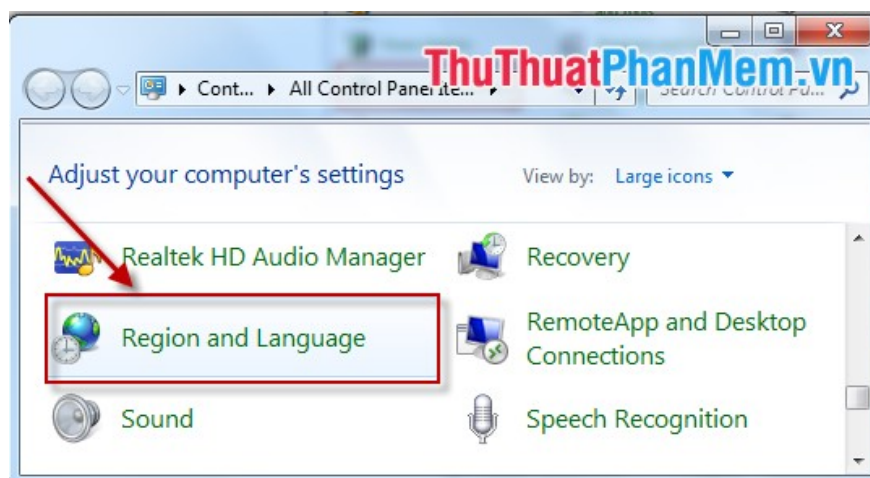

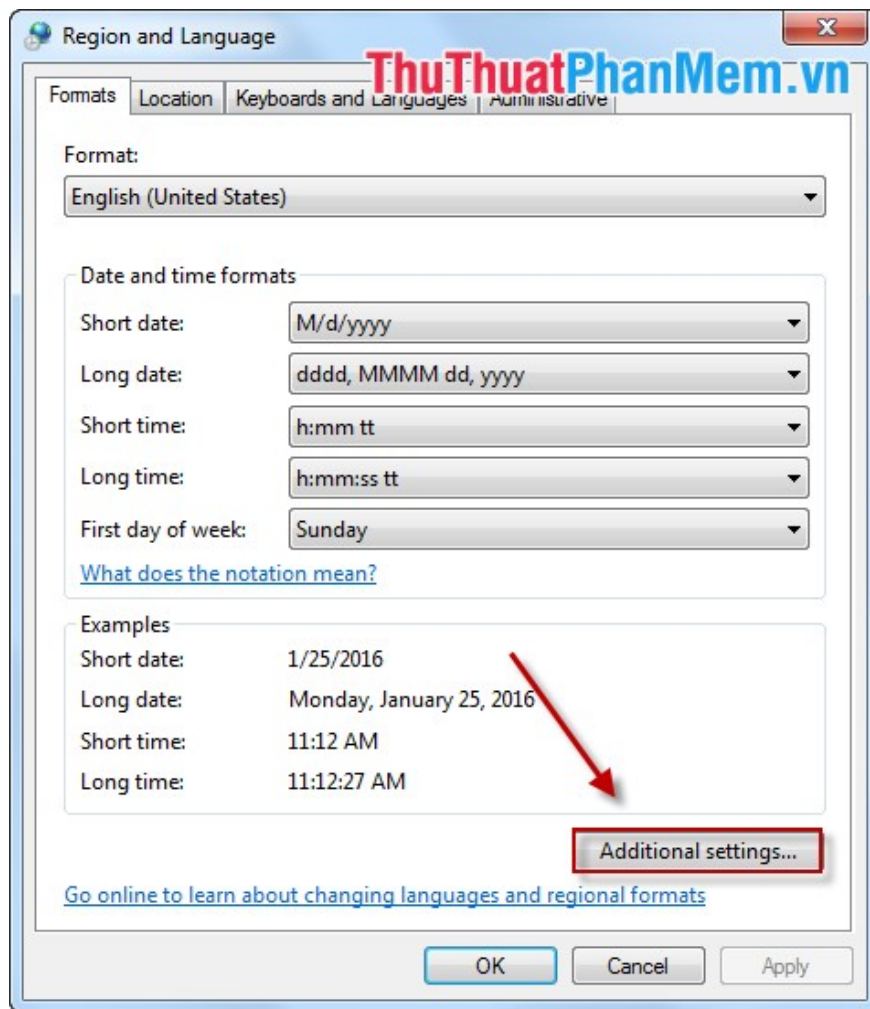
Step 1: Click **Start** -> **Control Panel** .



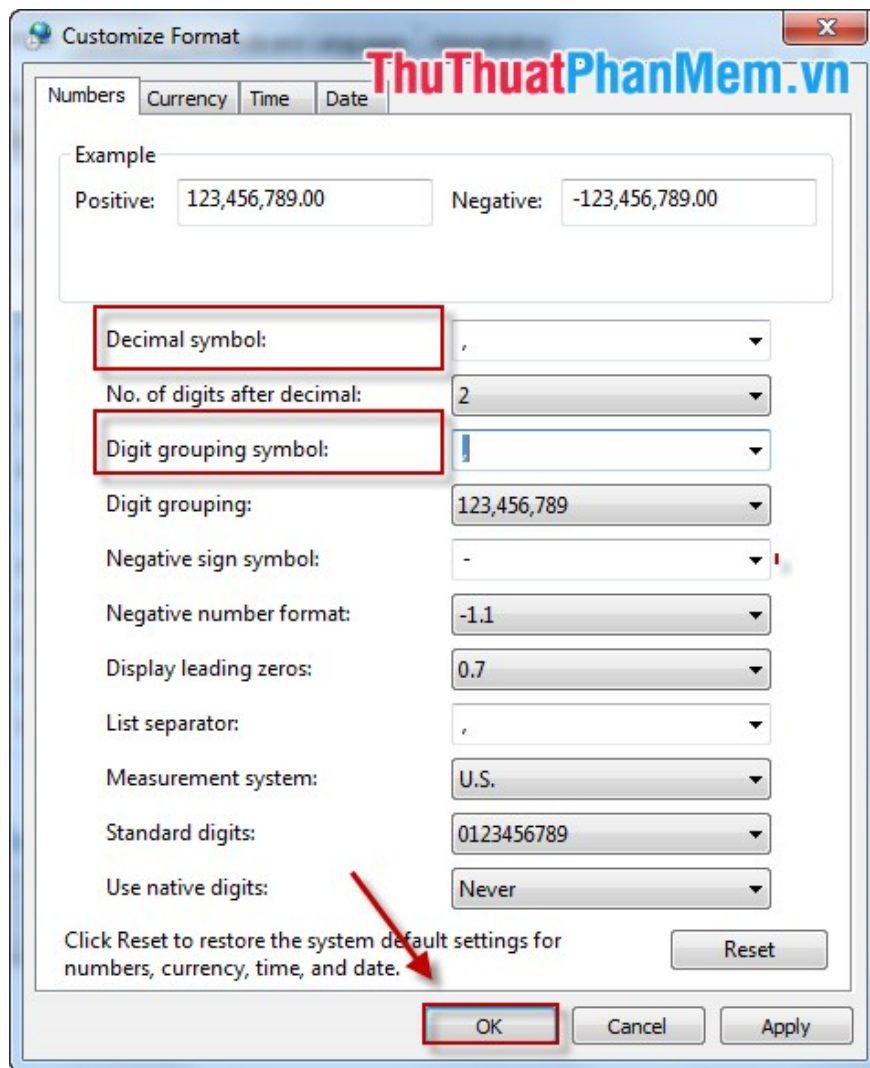
Step 2: The Control Panel dialog box appears -> select **Region and Language** .



Step 3: The **Region and Language** dialog box appears, click on **Additional Settings** .



Step 4: In the **Decimal Symbol** section enter a comma, the **Didit Grouping Symbol** section enter a period -> click **OK** to complete.



Step 5: Open the Excel file, enter the number and check.
