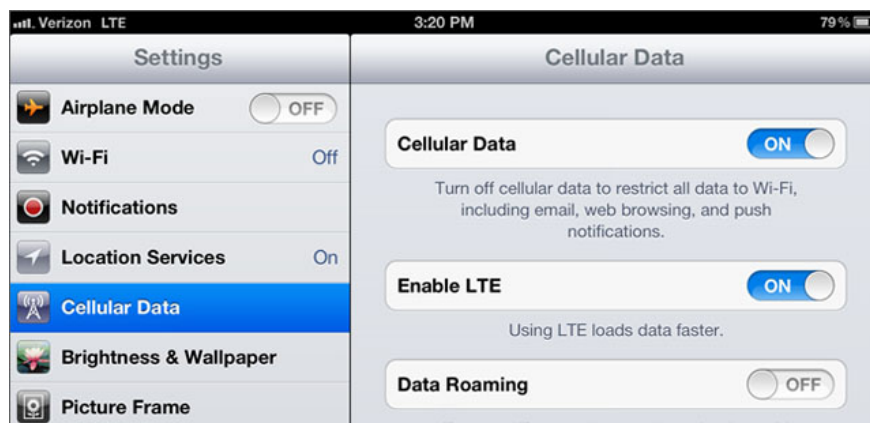


How to convert from 4G / LTE to 3G on the New iPad to save battery

When in an area without 4G coverage or when you want to save battery power, you simply turn off the 4G / LTE function on the new 3rd generation iPad and switch to 3G function to replace the low battery consumption. than.

Turn off 4G function on iPad



Go to Settings -> Cellular Data and switch Enable LTE from On to Off . As soon as it's done, the LTE icon in the status bar is replaced by the 3G icon.



If in Wi-fi area, users do not need to use 3G or 4G, so you can turn off **Cellular Data** mode .



Note that when you turn off **Cellular Data** mode, make sure that you are using less data than you expected.
