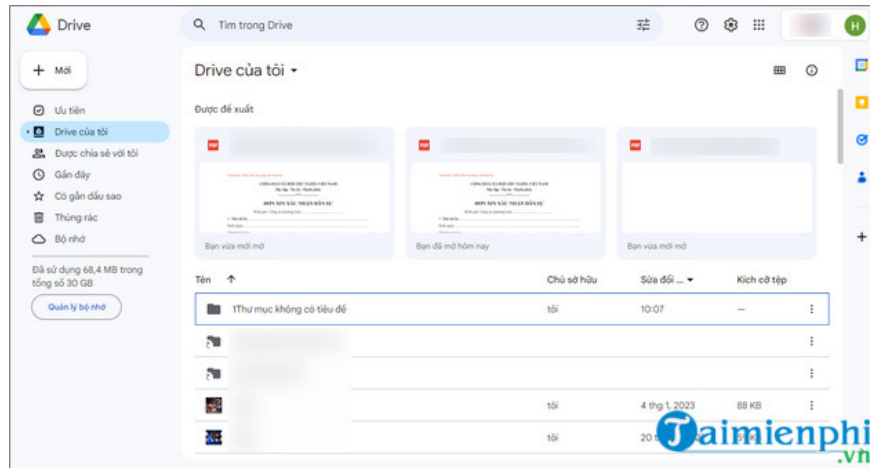

How to convert PDF to Word without software

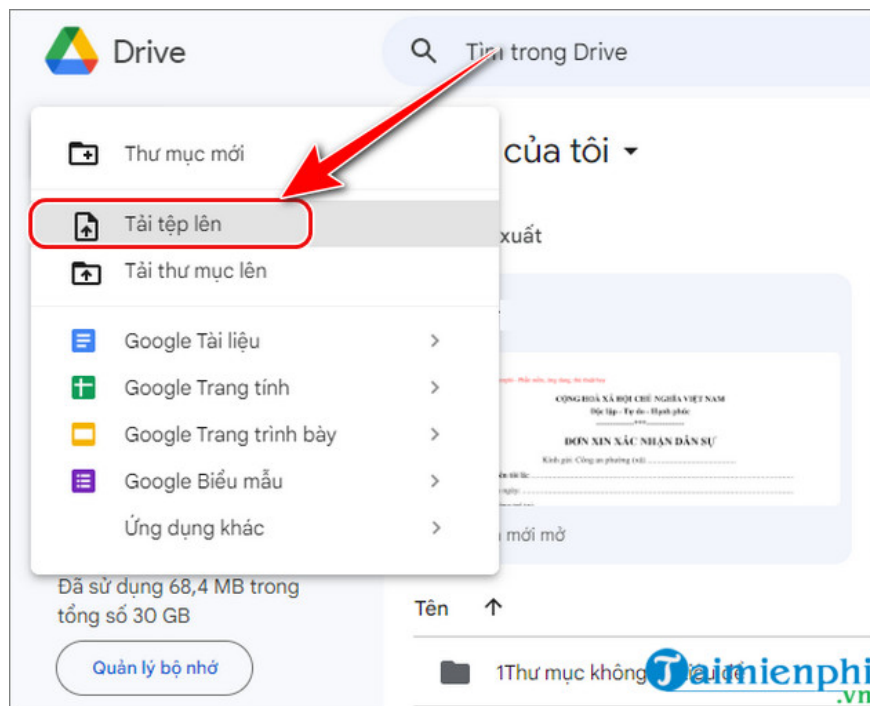
1. Convert PDF files to Word using Google Docs

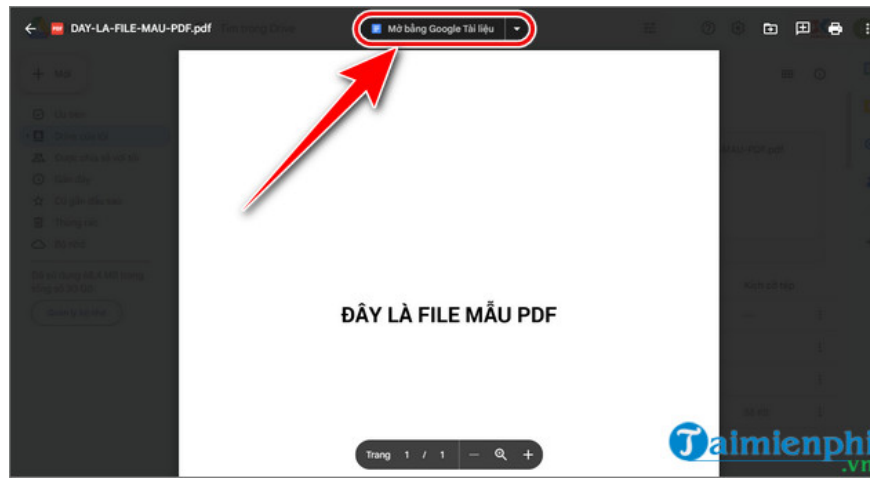
Step 1: Access the Google Drive homepage and sign in to your Google Account [HERE](#) .



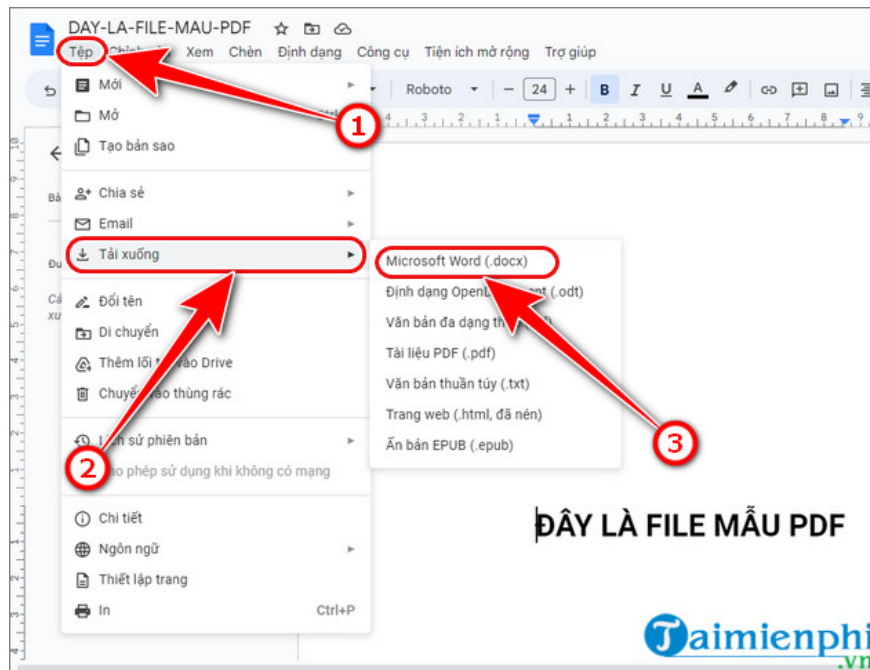
Step 2: Click the New button => Upload file to upload the PDF file to your Google Drive.



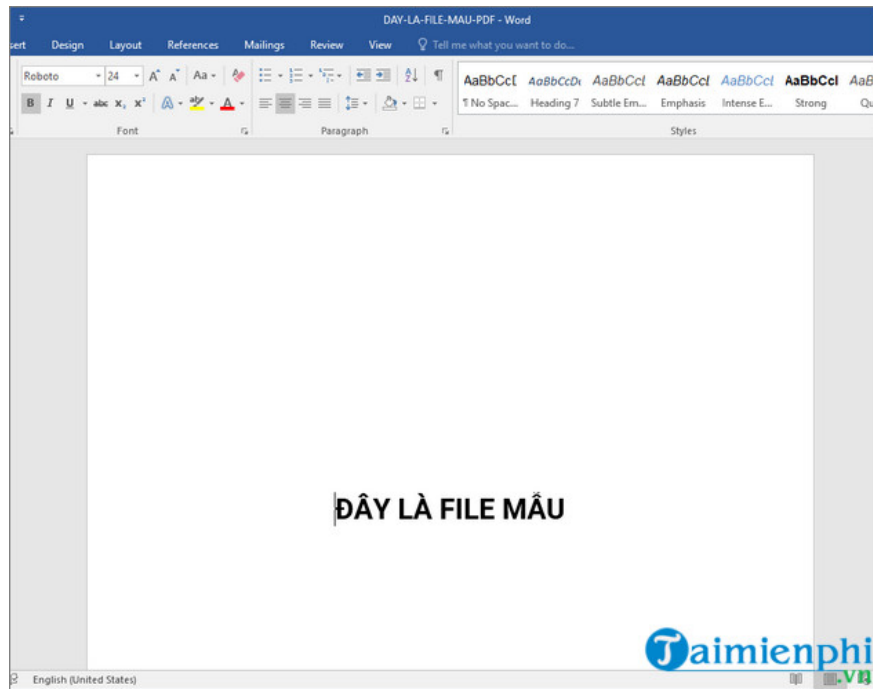
Step 3: After uploading the PDF file to Google Drive, click on the uploaded file and then click on the "Open with Google Docs" option .



Step 4: In the Google Docs interface, click **File** in the menu, select **Download**, and choose the **Microsoft Word (.docx)** format. Your file will be saved to your computer in Word format.



After downloading the Word file to your computer, you can open it in Microsoft Word to change or edit its content.

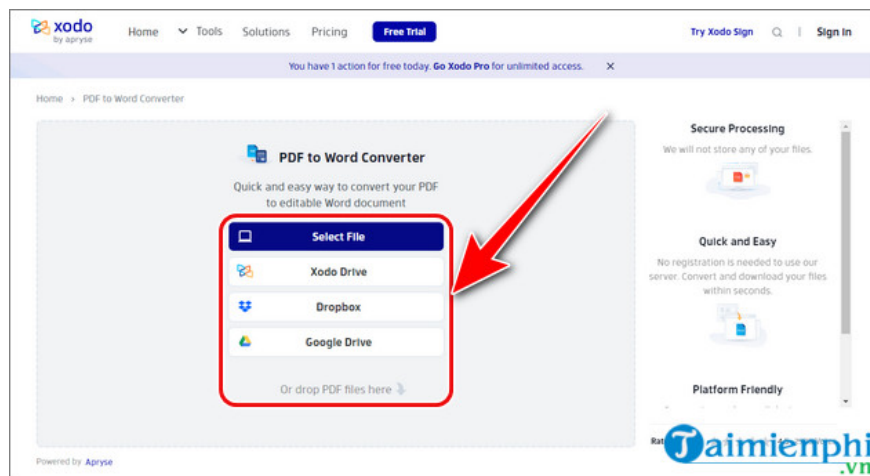


2. Convert PDF files to Word using online software.

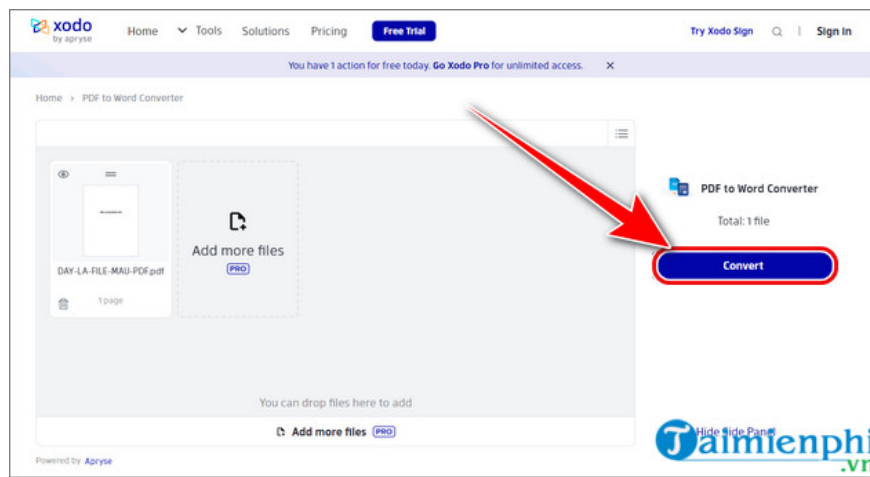

Step 1: Access Xodo's PDF to Word converter tool **HERE**.

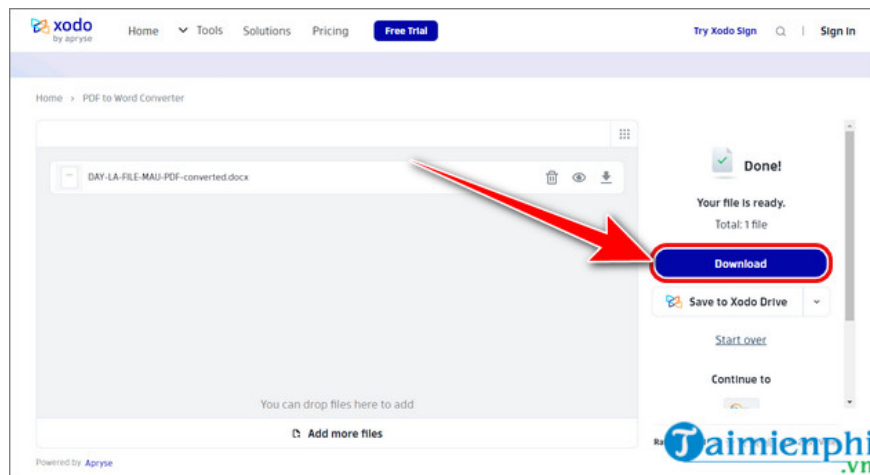
Step 2: Upload your PDF file from your computer, Dropbox, Google Drive, or drag and drop the PDF file onto the website.



Step 3: After successfully uploading the PDF file, click the **Convert** button on the right side of the page.



Step 4: After a few seconds, Xodo will convert your PDF file to .docx format. Click the **Download** button to download the Word file to your computer.
