

How to convert the font removal image into a normal photo on iPhone 7 Plus running iOS 11

On iOS 11, there is a feature to customize the mode to remove Portrait on iPhone 7 Plus, so that users can switch from image deletion to normal.

Photo capture mode removes Portrait on iPhone 7 Plus, which is one of the new features on the Camera app, which attracts many users. You just need to use this mode to produce images that blur the background, without the need to install other support applications.

However, this Portrait mode does not always work well, when it uses some unnecessary blurring effects. So how to transfer photos taken effect of deleting fonts to normal photos?

If your iPhone 7 Plus is running iOS 11, you can optionally edit, activate, or disable Portrait mode on your device. After the user takes a picture, it is possible to accept or disable the image background mode easily.

Step 1:

First of all, we will open the capture application and select the Portrait removal mode to take as usual. At the capture interface, swipe right to click the Portrait option.

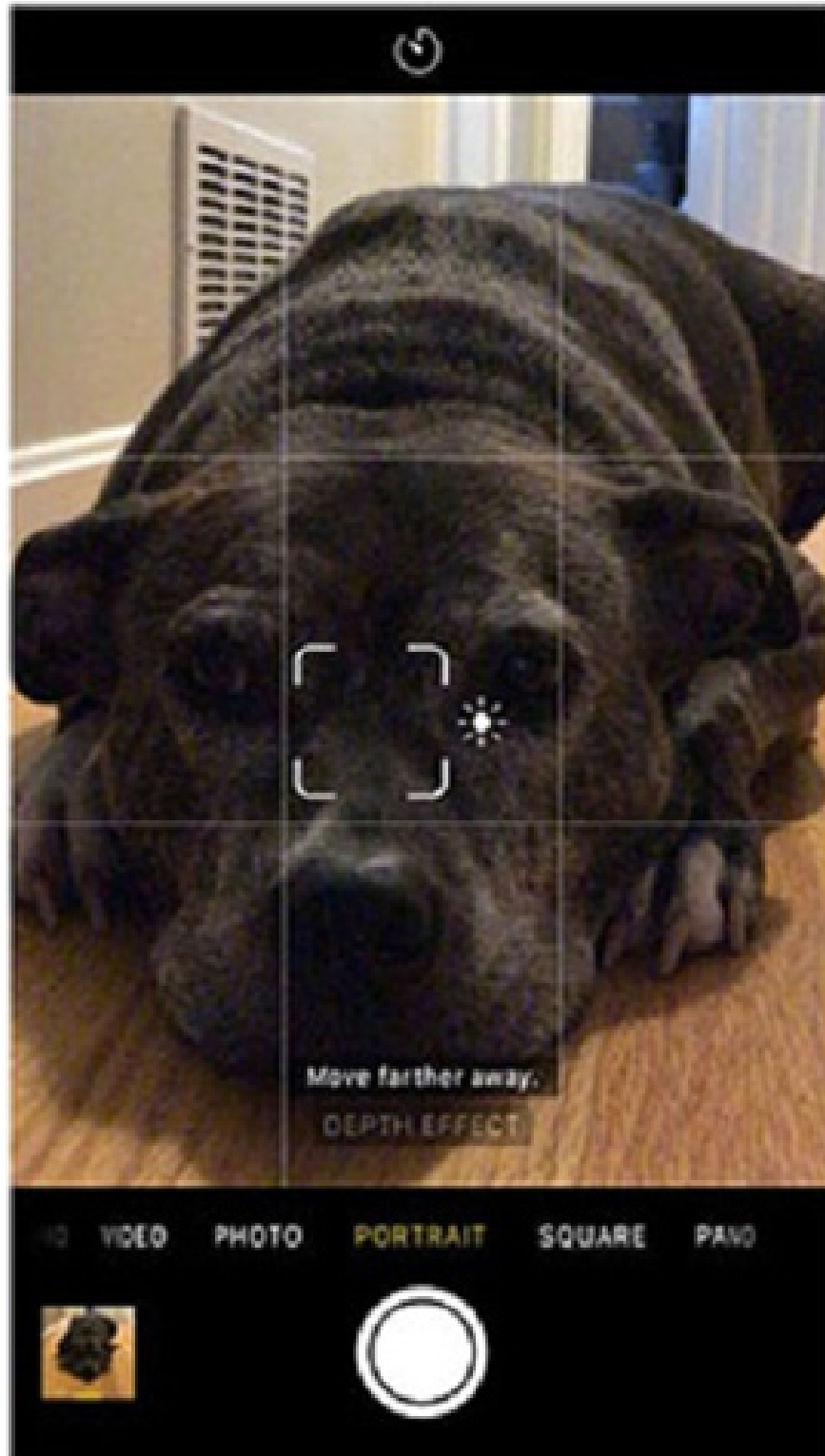
After taking photos with the font deletion mode, if you do not like it, you can delete them.

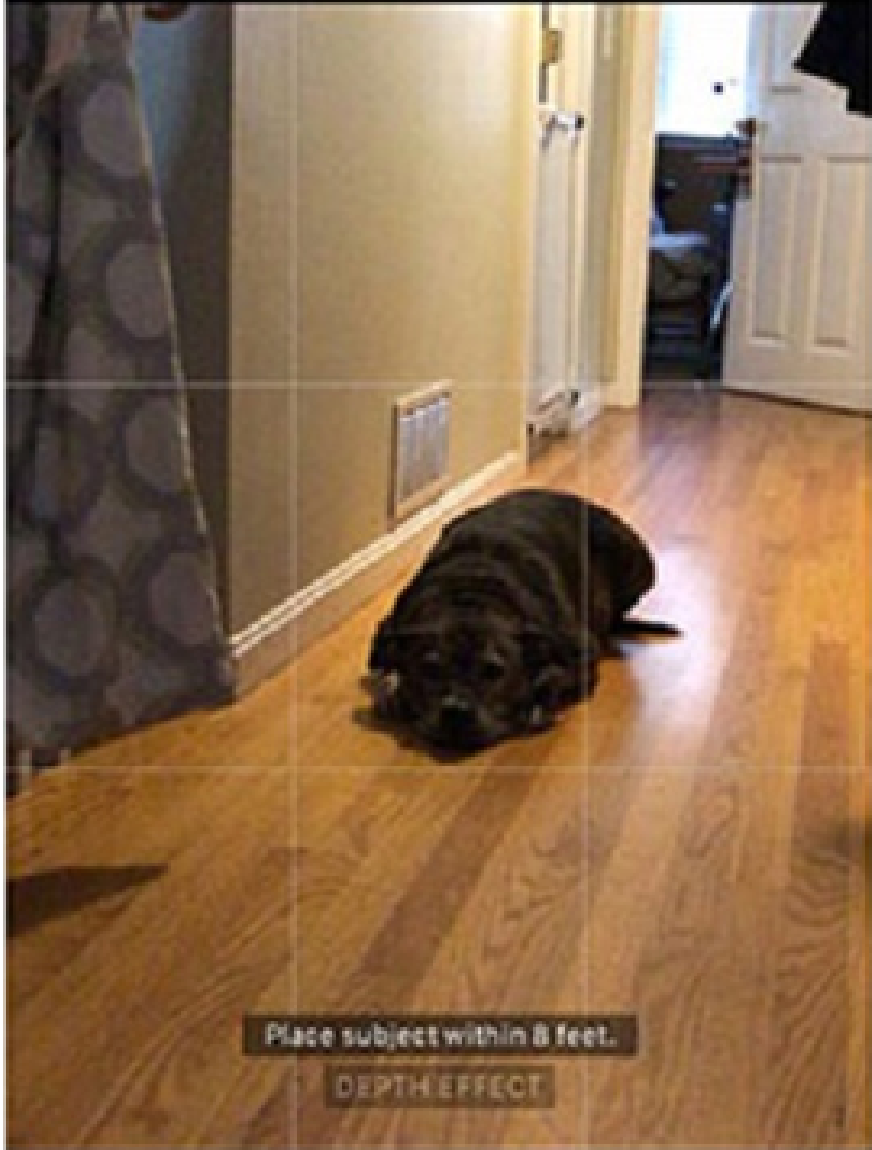


Step 2:

By removing the effect of removing the font, it is easy to understand that you will convert the font deletion format to a normal image format.

In the shooting interface, if the Depth Effect display is yellow, it means that the device is in the background image capture mode. To turn off this mode, the user **presses the Depth Effect button** . Soon, the interface will automatically convert from the font deletion format to normal image format.

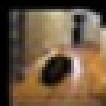


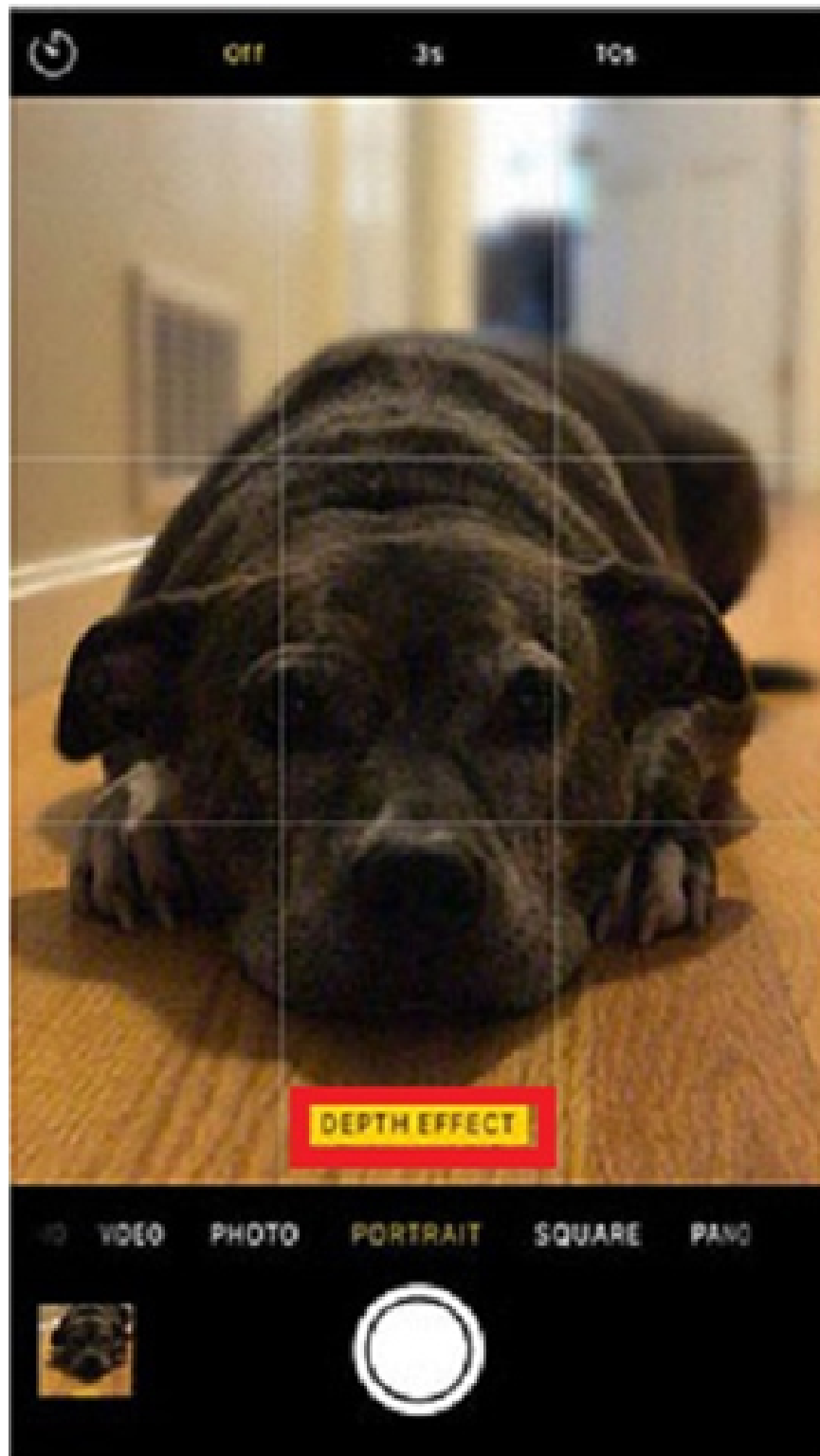


Place subject within 8 feet.
