Thankfully, there are authoritative web pages that preserve authoritative textual, visual, and statistical evidence. These web pages are Google Scholar, Academia.edu, WorldCat, JSTOR, ResearchGate, and other online libraries with .edu and .com domains. Seeking information on those websites, you can be sure to retrieve reliable

sources.

Proceed to write

Once you find three pieces of proof, you should start writing. You don't have enough time to mull over specific points to make your paper one of a kind, as it can take plenty of time. It doesn't mean, though, that your paper will not be significant. You'd better stick to the technique "even though my topic is not so unique, I can write it exclusively."
