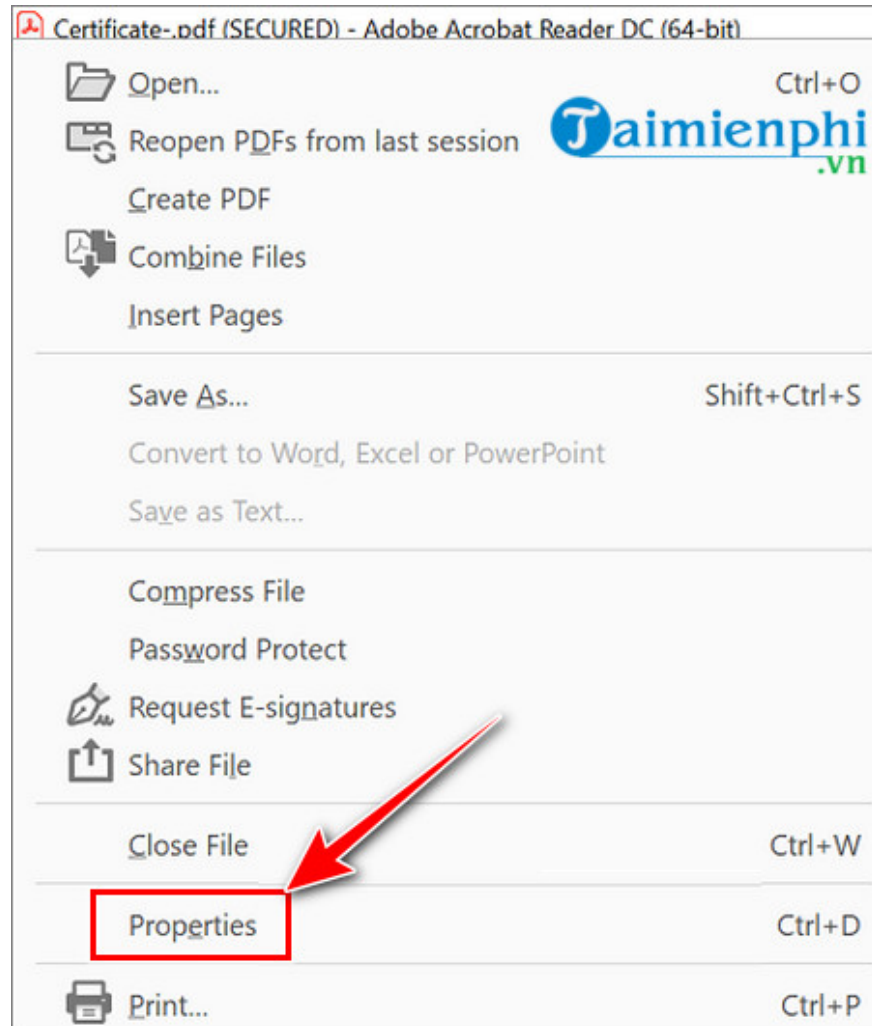

1. How to check copy permissions for a PDF file.

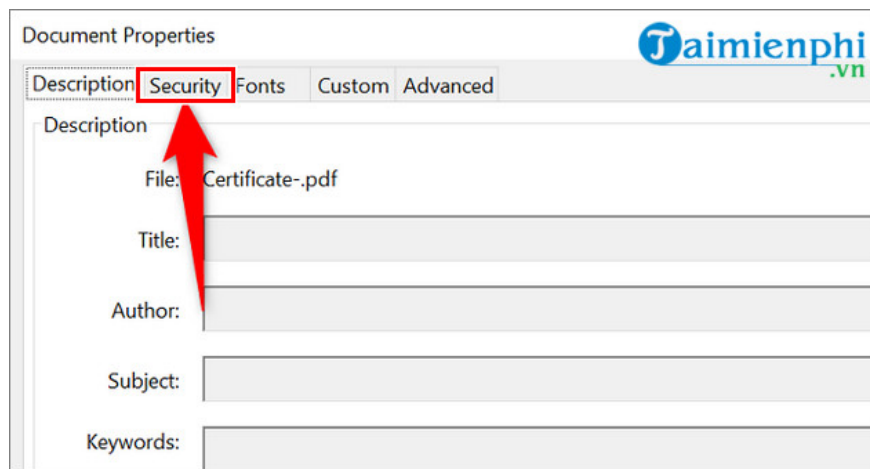

Step 1: Open the PDF file using PDF reader software such as Acrobat Reader DC.

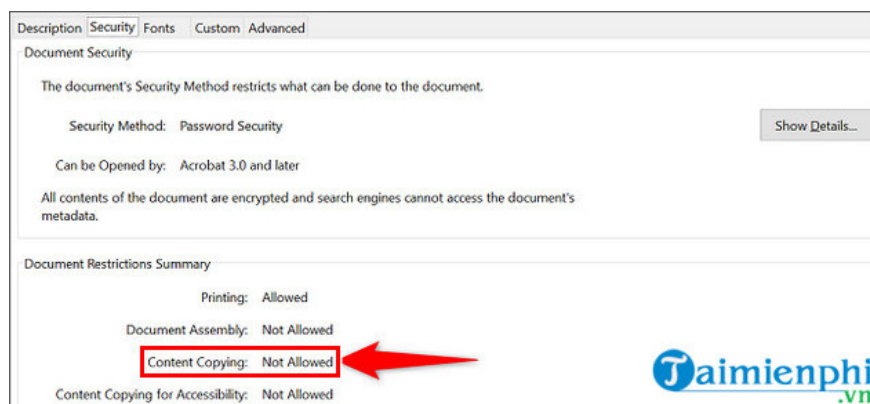
Step 2: Select the **File** tab on the Menu bar and click **Properties.** or press the **Ctrl + D** key combination .



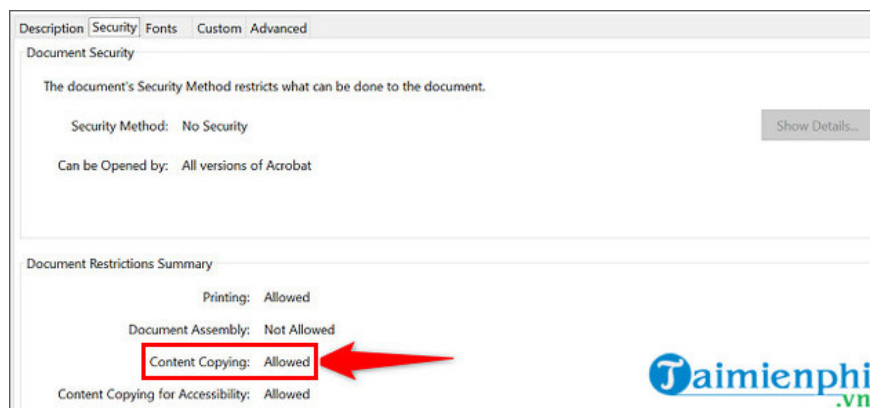
Step 3: Select the **Security** tab in the **Document Properties** section .



Step 4: Here, if the line "**Content Copying**" says "**Not Allowed**," you cannot copy content from the current PDF file.



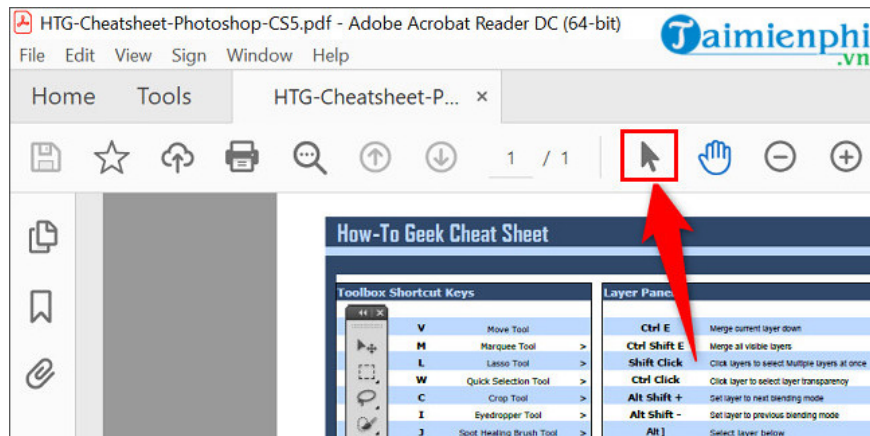
If you receive a "Allowed" notification, you can copy the contents of the PDF file.



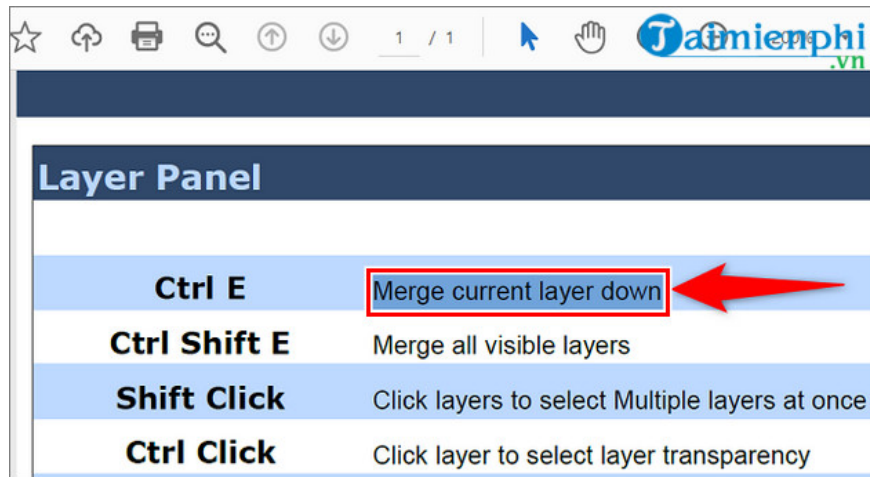
2. How to copy the content of a PDF file, copy the content of a PDF file to Word.

After confirming that this PDF file allows copying, you can perform the following simple steps to copy the contents of the PDF file to Word:

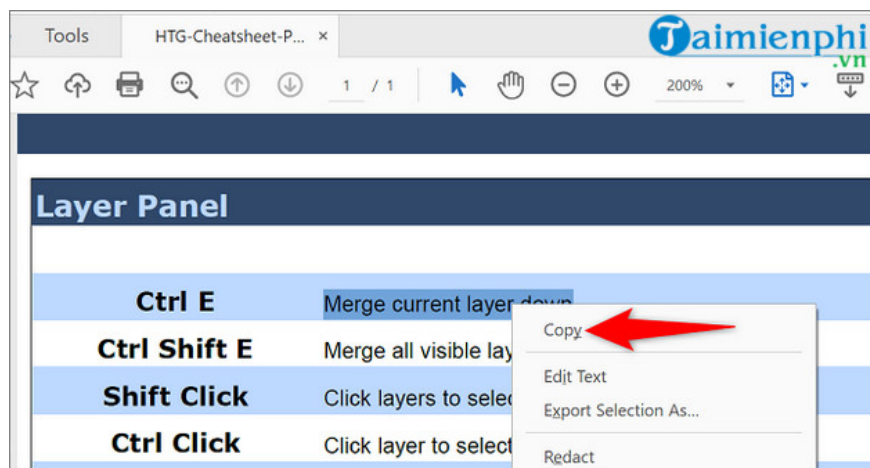
Step 1: From the list of toolbars at the top of Acrobat Reader, select the **Selection Tool** with the mouse cursor icon.



Step 2: Go to the text you want to copy in the PDF file and use your mouse cursor to highlight that text.



Step 3: Right-click and select **Copy** to copy this content.



Step 4: Paste the copied text into the Word file as usual.

3. Convert the PDF file to a Word file to copy its content.

For PDF files that don't allow copying content, a convenient way to do so is to convert the PDF to Word and copy the text from that Word file. To perform this operation, you can refer to the best PDF to Word conversion software currently available below, which ensures no font errors.
