

How to copy, transfer, and move music from your computer to your iPhone or iPad using iTunes.

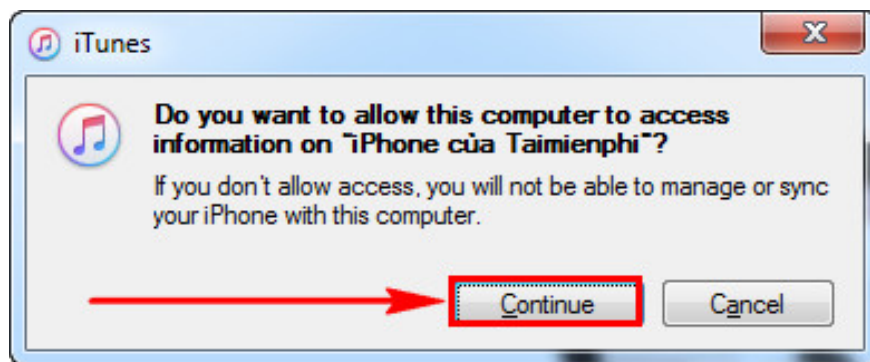

The first and most important step for users to copy, transfer, and upload music from their computer to their iPhone or iPad using iTunes is to install the latest version of iTunes software from the link below.

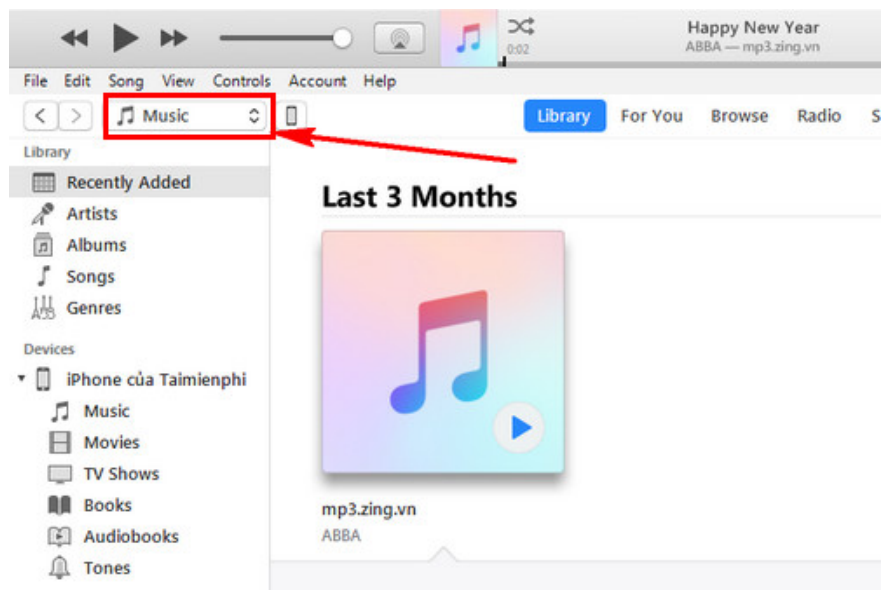

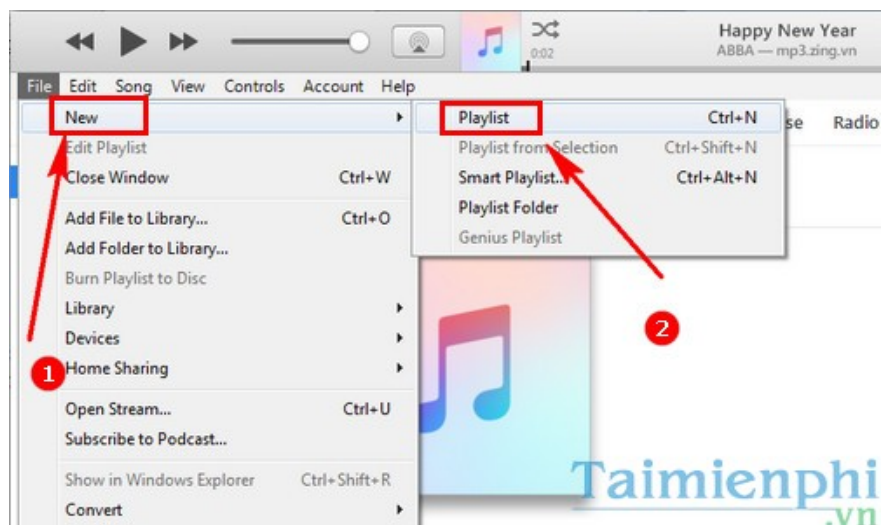
Step 2 : At the same time, on your phone, you must tap **Trust** before you can connect your iPhone to iTunes.



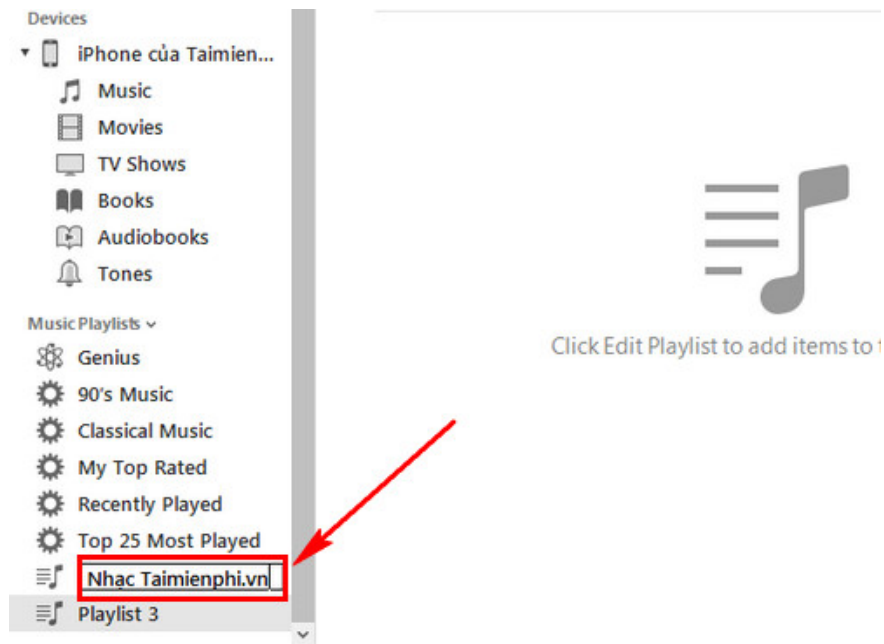
Step 3 : On iTunes, select **Music**.



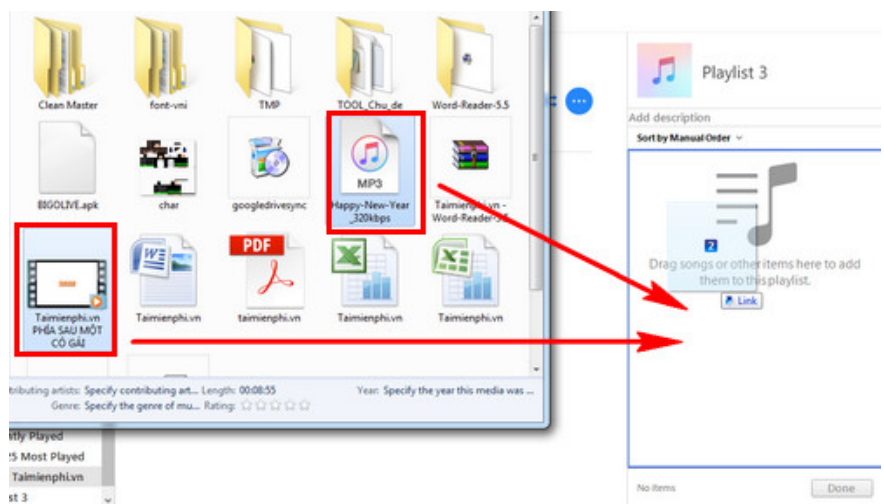
Step 4 : Next, to copy, transfer, or move music from your computer to your iPhone or iPad using iTunes, you need to create a playlist containing the music. Click **New > Playlist**.



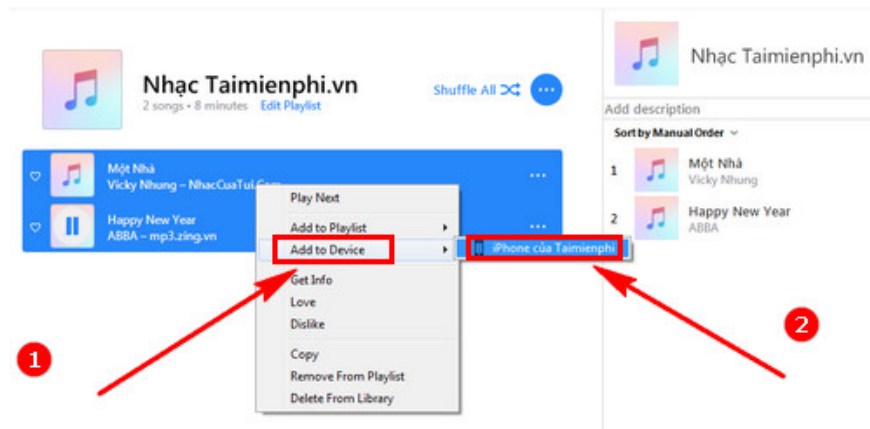
Give your music playlist a **name of your choice**.



Step 5 : Open the folder containing the music you want to copy and transfer from your computer to your iPhone or iPad using iTunes. Then, select the songs and **drag and drop them** into the empty box to the right of the Playlist, as shown in the image.



Step 6 : Finally, after selecting the songs in the playlist, highlight all the songs, right-click and select **Add to Device > iPhone of (iPhone name)**.



That's it! Immediately, your songs will be copied and transferred from your computer to your iPhone or iPad using iTunes with this simple trick. Besides copying and transferring music from your computer to your iPhone or iPad using iTunes, you can also use iTunes to install games, copy videos, back up contacts, and many other useful features.
