

How to craft a Bag in Minecraft 1.20 is extremely simple.

In previous versions of Minecraft (before 1.20), players could store items using chests while riding donkeys or Ender Chests. With the release of version 1.20, players can easily expand their inventory with Bags. In this article, TipsMake will guide players on how to craft Bags in Minecraft 1.20.

Limited inventory space is always a problem for players of Vanilla Minecraft. After some exploration, players will no longer have enough space to store more items.

Guide to crafting a bag in Minecraft 1.20

1. Bags in Minecraft

Currently, the Bag is only available in certain special editions of Minecraft 1.20 Java Snapshots. The mechanism of this item is still being changed after being revealed in Minecraft Live 2020.



Bags are like chests that players can carry with them. Each bag can hold up to 64 items or a certain stack of items. However, unlike the player's inventory, the mechanics of Bags are slightly different.

1.1. The Inventory Mechanism of the Pocket in Minecraft

A Bag allows players to store 64 stackable items and one slot for non-stackable items. However, items with different stack limits will have different sizes. Specifically, items with a limit of 16 per stack will take up 4 slots, while items with a limit of 64 will only take up 1 slot.



For example:

- If you put a non-stackable item like a tool, weapon, potion, etc., into your Bag, the Bag will be full and you won't be able to put anything else in.
- If you place 32 sticks (items limited to 64 per stack) into your Bag, the Bag will be 50% full, and you can only place 8 more Ender Gems (50% of a stack of 16 items).

This means the Bag is only suitable for storing stackable items. The total number of items you can carry will remain the same, but you can carry a wider variety of items.

1.2. How to Use Bags in Minecraft

The bag functions like a normal item, distinct from the player's chest and inventory.

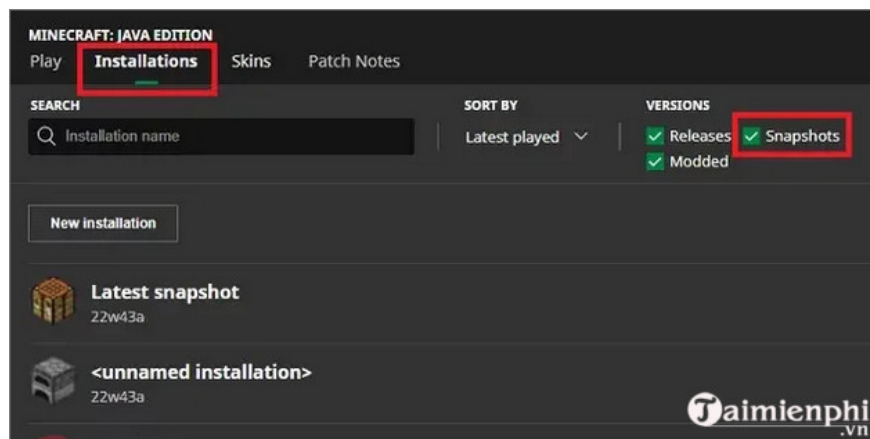


Simply left-click to select the Bag, then right-click on an item to put it in the bag, or right-click on an empty slot to retrieve an item from the bag. The last item added will be retrieved first.

2. How to enable resource packs with Bags on Java

You need to have the game in Snapshots mode to enable this feature.

Step 1: Enable the Snapshots option in the **Installation** tab .



Step 2: Open the Menu and create a new world.



Step 3: Select **Data Pack** and choose a resource package from the Data Pack.



3. How to Craft a Pouch in Minecraft 1.20

To craft the Bag, you will need 6 rabbit skins, 2 rolls of yarn, and of course, a crafting table.



Rabbit skin and rope are arranged as shown in the image above. The rope can be obtained from spiders, while the rabbit skin can be obtained from rabbits in desert, snow, and taiga ecosystems.
