

How to create a free Microsoft Teams account without EDU mail

To sign up for Microsoft Teams for free, without requiring an email from the school, you can follow the steps in this article of TipsMake.com

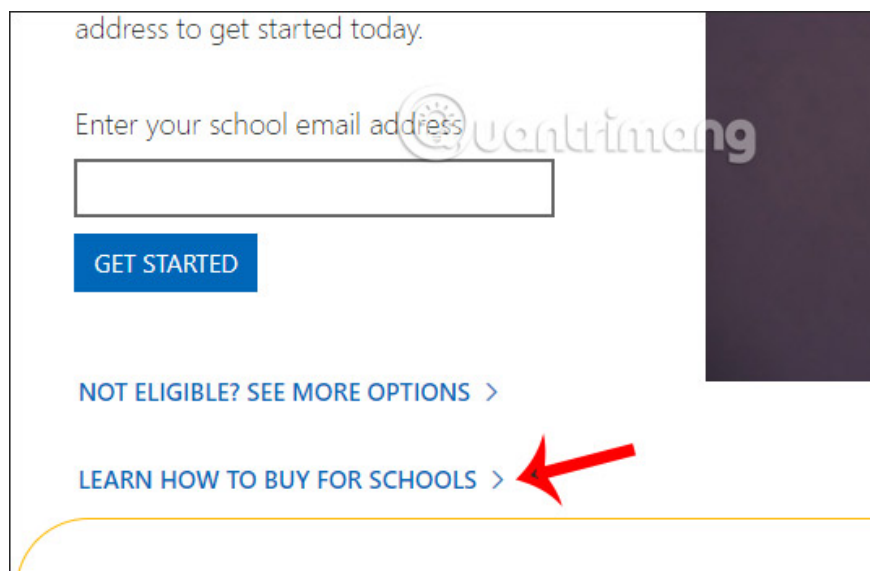

During the registration process for Microsoft Teams, we will have the option to create an account for education or an account for institutions. If the teachers want to own the interface to teach, create assignments, create tests . then it is mandatory to fill in the email edu from the school provided. So what if I do not have edu mail to sign up for Microsoft Teams? The following article will show you how to sign up for Microsoft Teams completely free without requiring edu email from the school. When registering successfully, teachers have 5TB more OneDrive and use Office 365 online for free.

Registration instructions for free Microsoft Teams

Step 1:

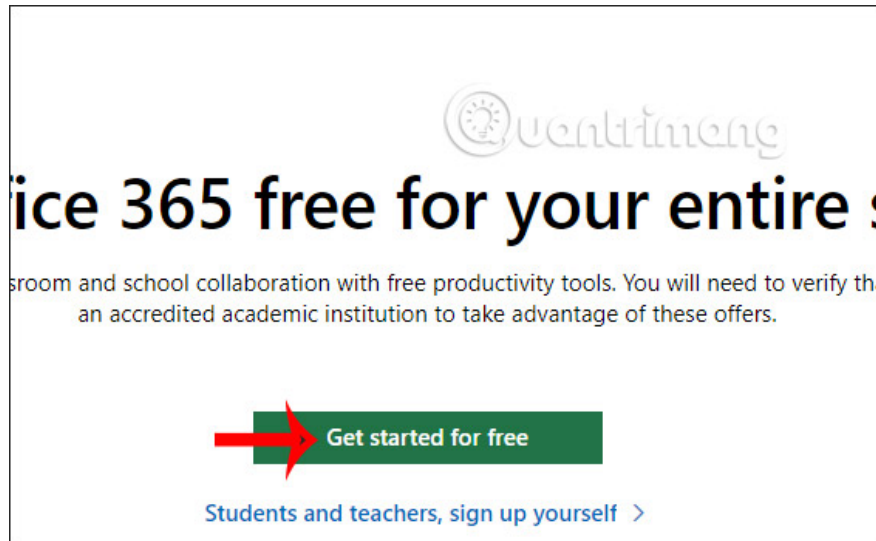
First, the user accesses the link below and press **LEARN HOW TO BUY FOR SCHOOLS** .


Step 2:

Switch to the new interface, click **Get started for free** to proceed to **create a free Office 365 Education account** .




Next, fill out **the information** at this interface. Note in this interface you do not need to fill in your own email, you can use virtual email or virtual phone number also. To find virtual email, teachers refer to the article [Here is how to create a virtual email address quickly.](#)

Click Next below to continue.

Step 3:

In this interface, the user **enters the user name** , **putting the tail** in the login address and **password** . When the import is complete, the site will check, if you notice the red, you need to enter the tail. Click **Create my account** to create an account.

Step 4:

To verify the newly created account, we **need to enter the correct personal phone number** to receive verification codes sent to the phone number. Switch to the area code +84 and fill in the phone number.

Click Text me to enter the verification code.

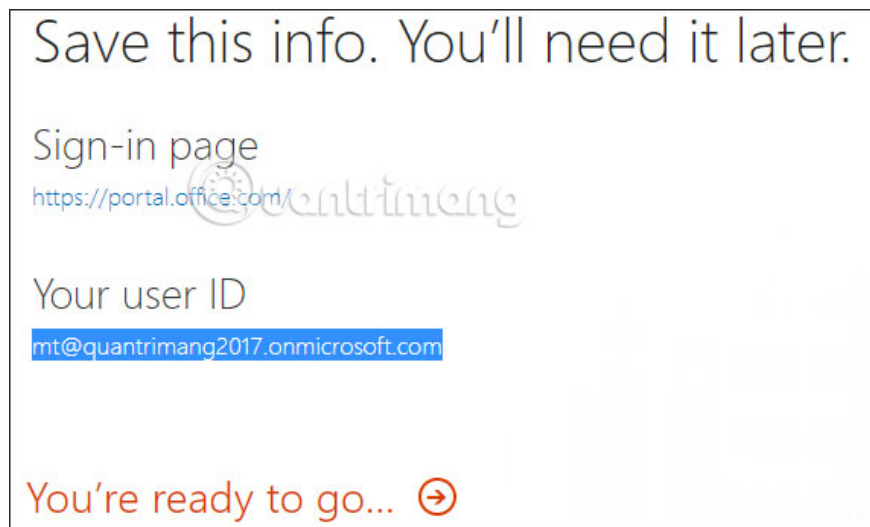

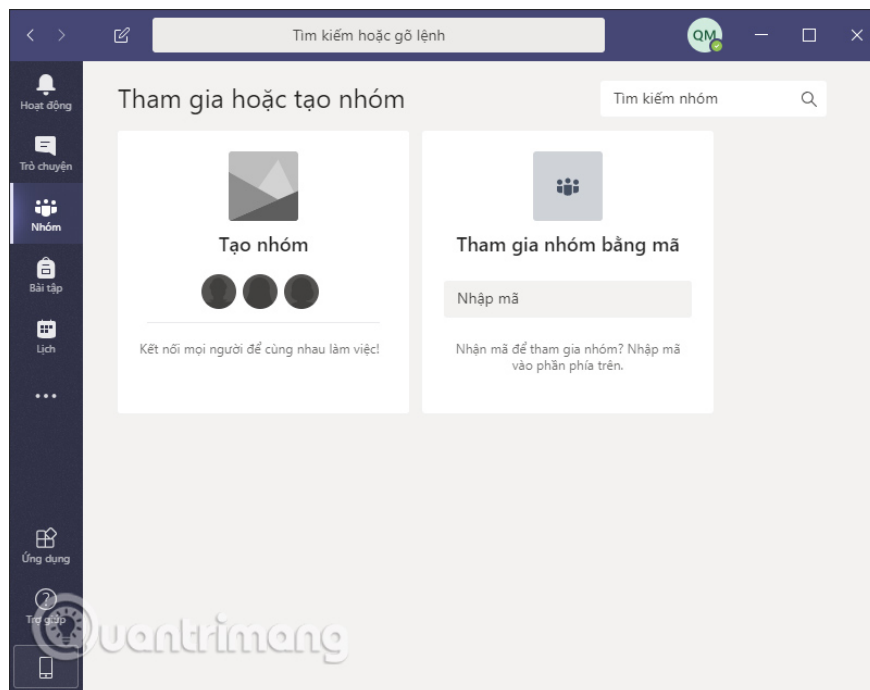

Step 5:

Finally, we wait for the process of creating a free Office 365 Education account to complete and then use the created user ID to access the Microsoft Teams interface to use for free. Teachers should also save the website at this interface to access when they want to change the password. The account is **free** to use **for 6 months** . After 6 months, you must buy to use.



The Microsoft Teams interface uses the created user ID as shown below, with all the features and tools to create online classrooms.



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
