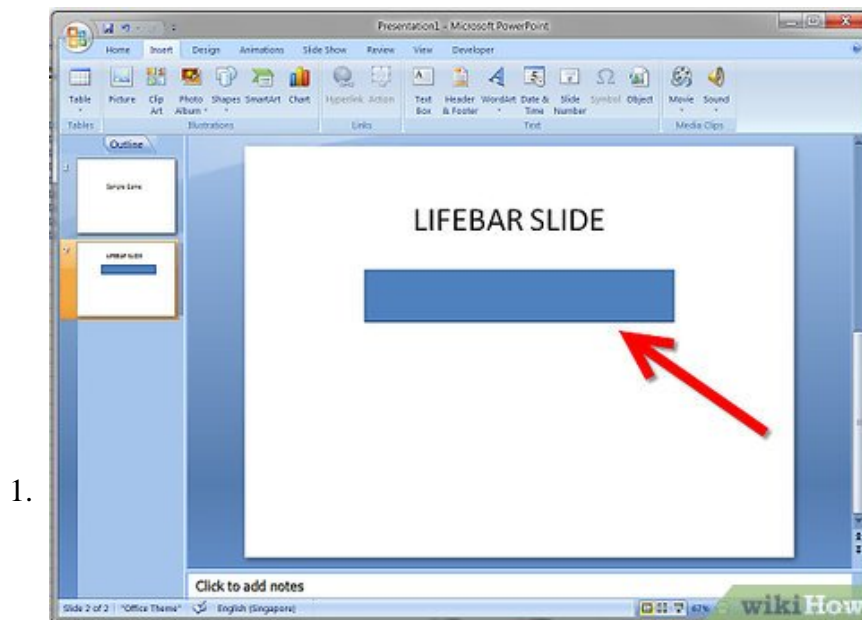


How to Create a Life Bar in PowerPoint

Have you ever wanted to create a life bar for your games in PowerPoint? Well here is your chance to read this article! Open up PowerPoint.

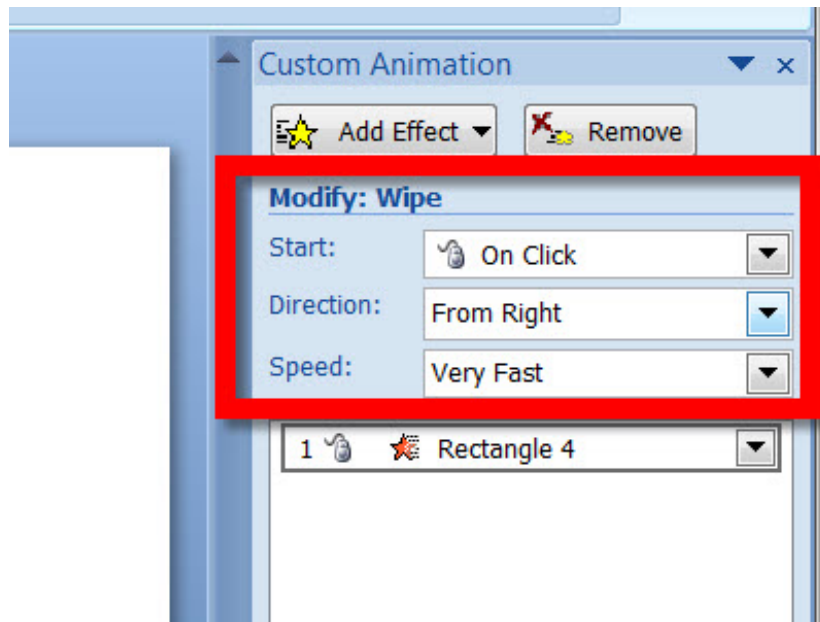
Method 1 of 2:

To create a life bar with only one-hit

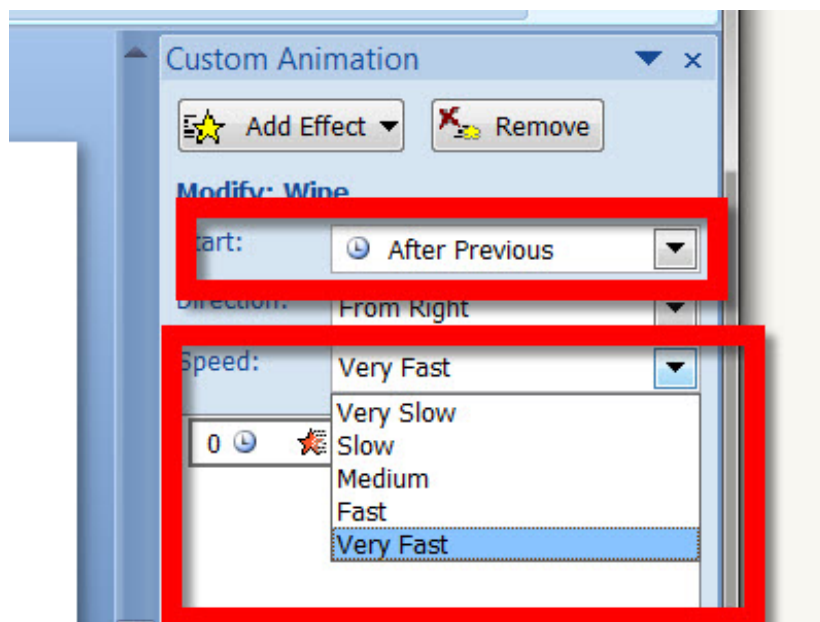


Draw up a rectangle somewhere in the slide.

2. **Add effects.** Now, animations/custom animation/add effects/exit/wipe. Click the drop down bar, then click from right.



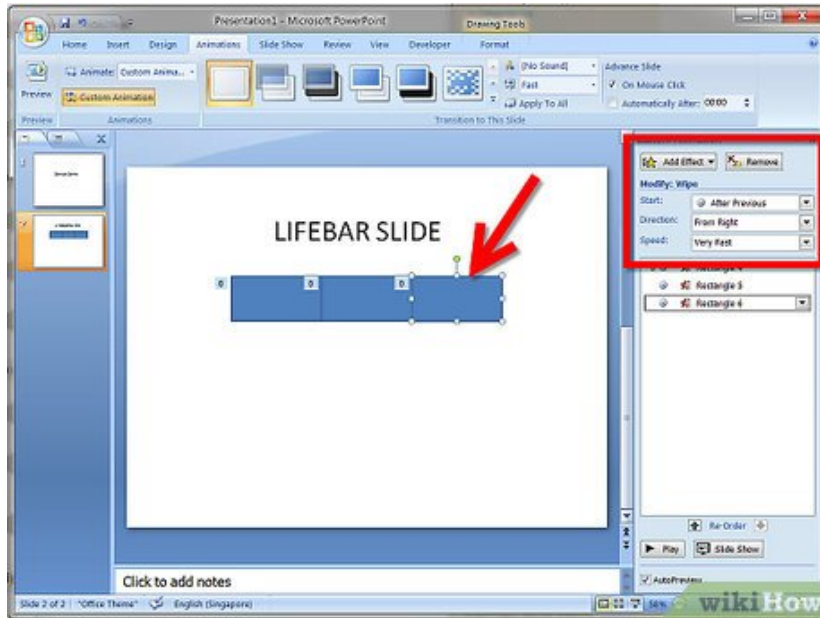
3. Set it to after previous (which makes it go down when an attack has occurred), then choose the speed.



Method 2 of 2:

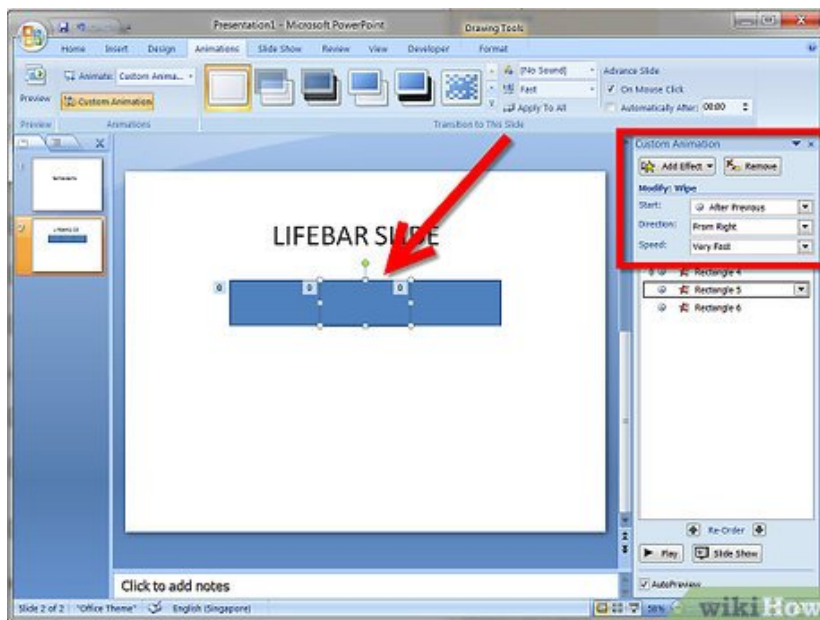
To create a life bar with a separate hit

1.



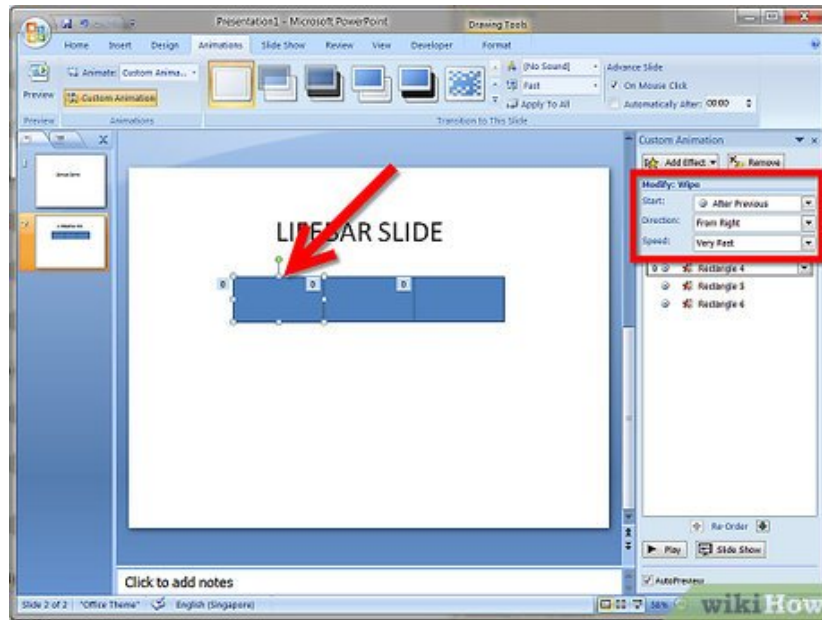
Draw up three separate rectangles, the click the last one (on the very right), then custom animation/exit/wipe/from right/after previous/then choose your speed.

2.



For the other two, select the middle one, the custom animation/exit/wipe/after previous (make sure it is just after the first rectangle that goes down first by right click/show advanced time line/choose speed.

3.



Then the last one, do the same, and then, make sure it's just right after the middle rectangle.
