

How to create a note on the iPhone lock screen

If you regularly use Notes on iPhone, then Notepad tweak will help you write notes right on the lock screen.

Notes Notes app on iPhone has many features in addition to writing basic notes, such as sharing notes, scanning documents, syncing notes, etc. And if you regularly use notes on iPhone, you can Try tweaking Notepad to jailbroken iOS 11 devices.

Accordingly, this tweak will help users quickly create notes right on the iPhone's lock screen. We just need to turn on the phone, touch the widget, then enter the note content. This note will always be displayed at the top of the lock screen. The following article will guide you how to install Notepad tweak on iPhone.

Instructions on how to install Notepad tweak on iPhone

Step 1:

Tweak Notepad is sold on Chariz archive but users can test it first through Xarold archive. Users access directly to tweak Notepad to the link below to access.

Step 2:

After installation is complete, the user accesses **Settings** and then select **Notepad** . In the Tweaking interface **activate Notepad** by swiping the horizontal bar to the right at Enabled.

Next we proceed to edit with the content below. The notes interface in the lock screen can be minimized, defaulted or expanded in Notepad Style.

Notepad Text Color is used to change the text color on notes to make it easier to read. Background Style to change the type of background color like color, blur, darken. Or you can hide the note title at Show Notepad Header.

After changing, **press Respring** to save the changes.

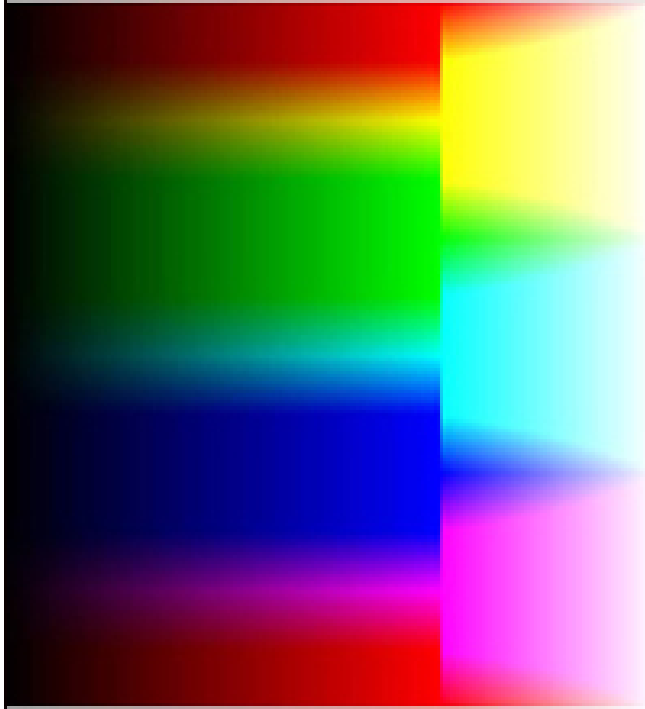

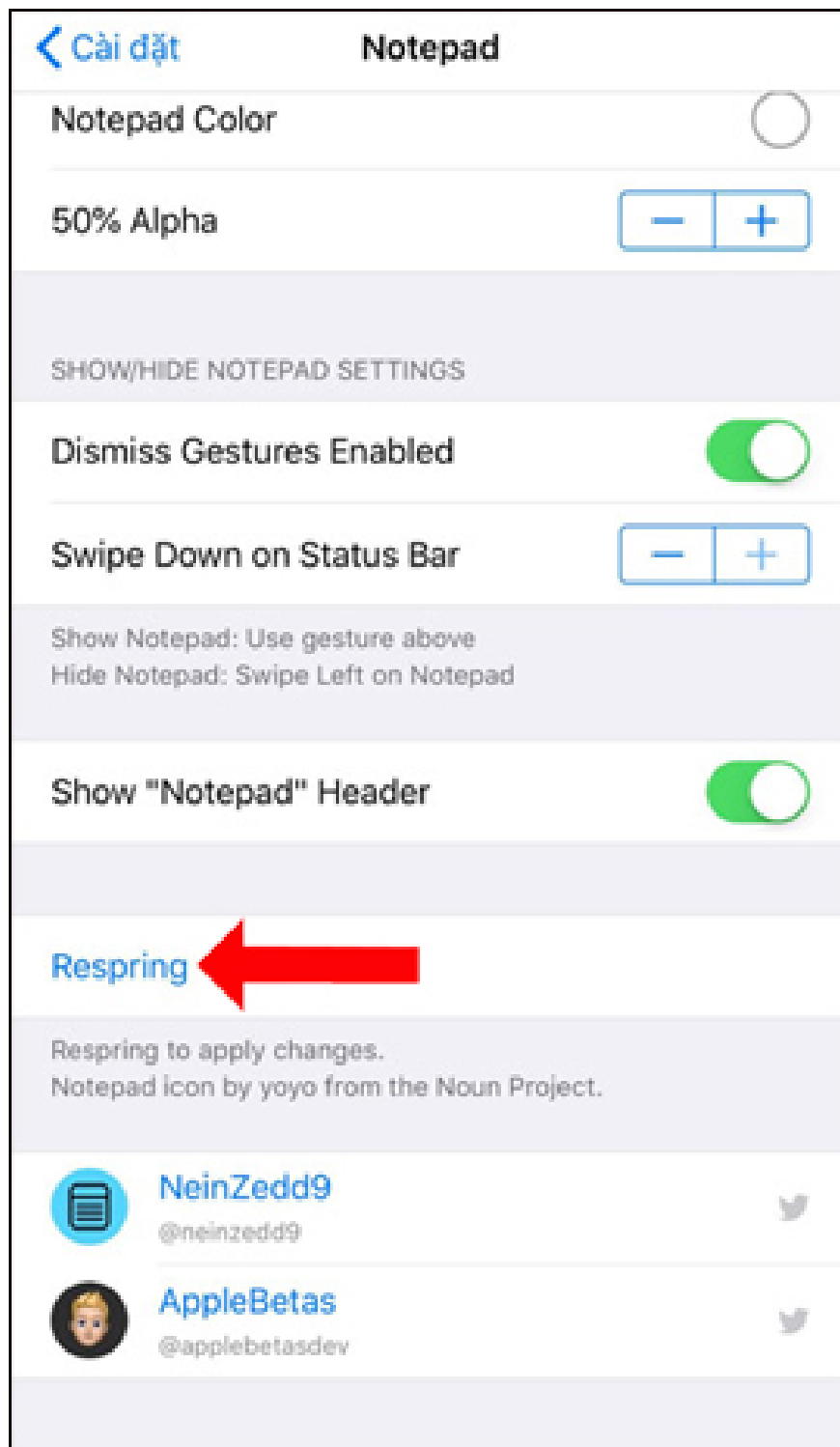

Step 3:

Now that you lock the device and open the light, you will see a frame to write a note. Users can enter the task list for the day, note down the necessary content, or even some lyrics.

When the device is turned on, the device sees the notes, scrolls down to see more notifications.
