

How to create a shortcut Hyper-V Manager in Windows 10

Hyper-V, which allows running virtualized computing systems on physical servers. This tutorial will show you how to create a Hyper-V Manager shortcut in Windows 10.

Windows 10 Pro, Enterprise, and Education editions include Hyper-V virtualization technology. Hyper-V, which allows running virtualized computing systems on physical servers.

Virtualization Hyper-V feature on Windows 10

These virtualized systems can be used and managed as if they were physical computer systems, but they exist in a virtualized and isolated environment. Special software called the Hypervisor manages access between the virtual system and the physical hardware resources.

Virtualization enables the rapid deployment of computer systems, quick restoration of the system to its previous normal state, and the ability to move the system between physical servers.

Hyper-V Manager is a tool to diagnose and manage Hyper-V hosts locally and a small number of remote hosts. Hyper-V Manager is available through Programs and Features as Hyper-V Management Tools on any Windows operating system with Hyper-V included. The Hyper-V platform does not need to be enabled for remote host management.

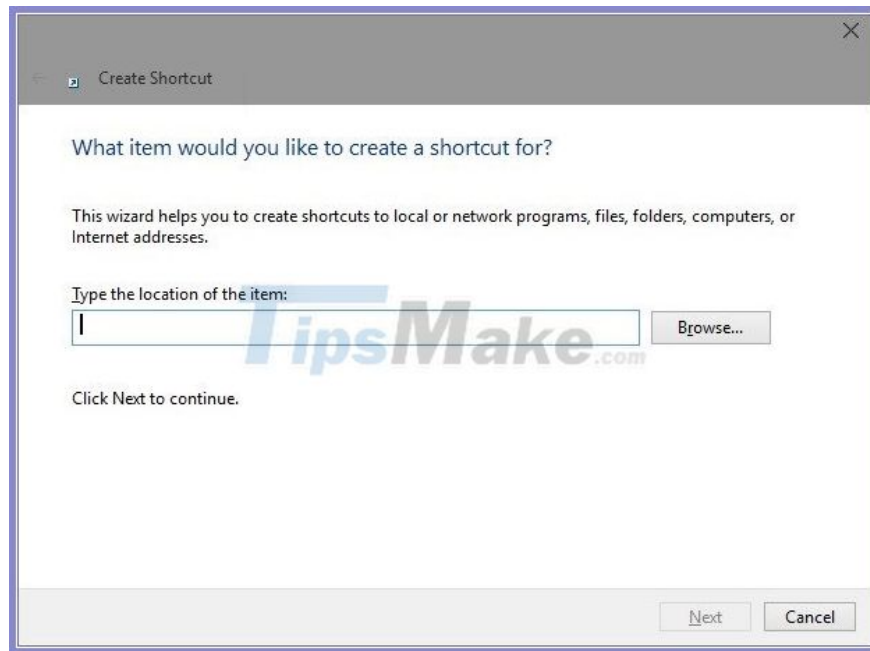
This tutorial will show you how to create a Hyper-V Manager shortcut in Windows 10.

How to manually create a Hyper-V Manager shortcut

Step 1. Right-click or click and hold on an empty area on the desktop and click New> Shortcut.

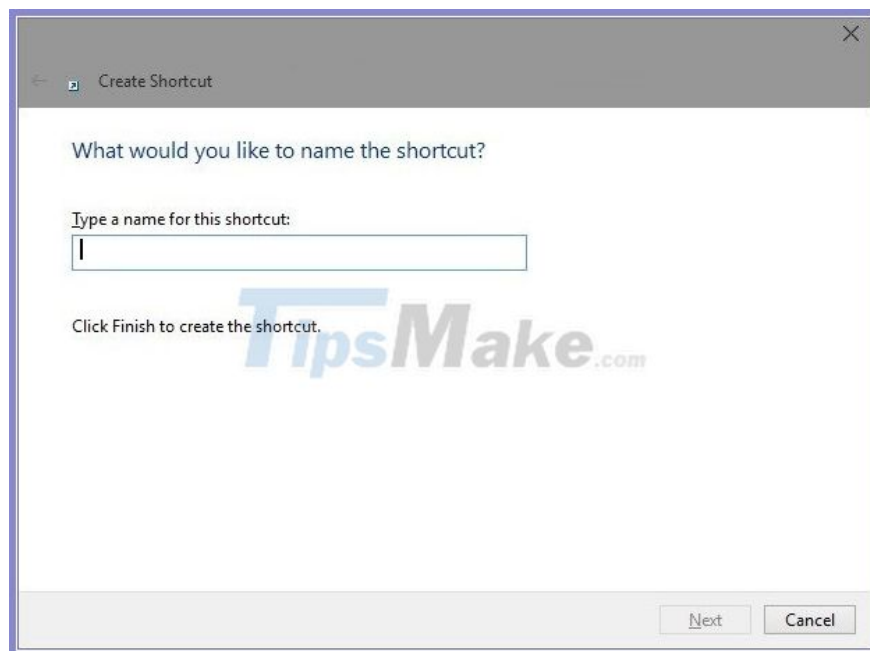
Step 2. Copy and paste the location below into the location area and click Next.

```
% windir% System32mmc.exe virtmgmt.msc
```



Step 3. Enter Hyper-V Manager as the name and click the Finish button.

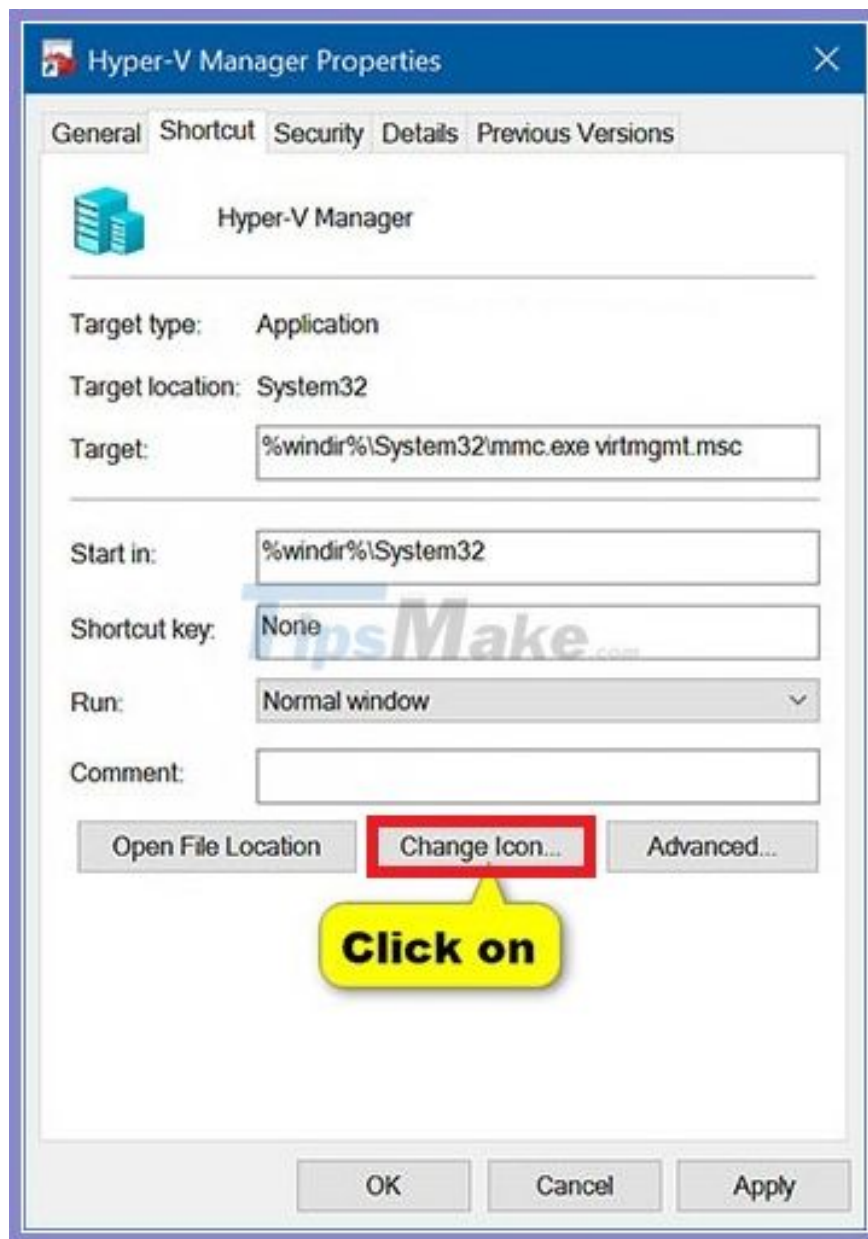
Note: You can name this shortcut whatever you want.

Step 4. Right-click or click and hold the new Hyper-V Manager shortcut and click Properties.

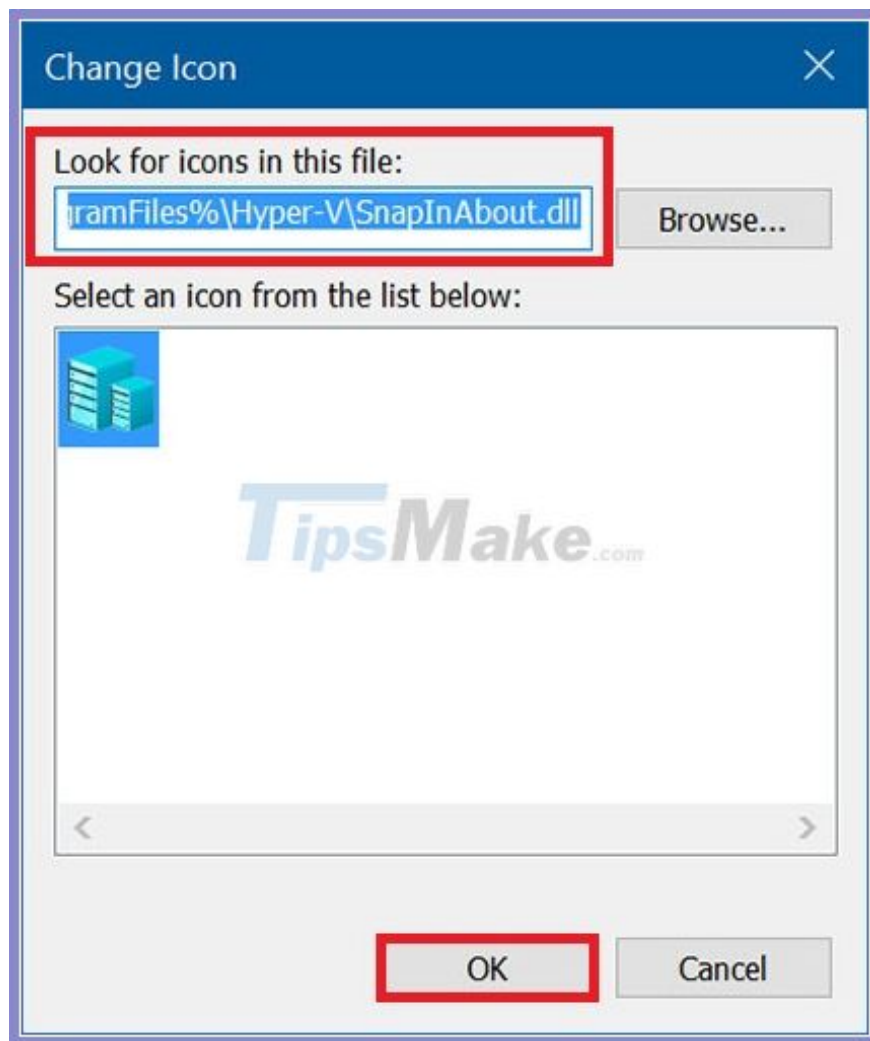
Step 5. Click the Shortcut tab, then click the Change Icon button.



Click the Change Icon button to choose an icon for the shortcut

Step 6. In the line below "Look for icons in this file", copy and paste the location below and press Enter.

% ProgramFiles% Hyper-VSnapInAbout.dll



Paste the location into "Look for icons in this file"

Step 7. Select the icon highlighted in blue above and click OK. However, you can use any icon you want.

Step 8. Click OK.

Step 9. You can either pin it to the taskbar, Start menu, add All apps, Quick Launch, assign a shortcut or move this shortcut to where you want it to be easy to use.
