With the help of Twee, teachers can quickly create vocabulary sets that match the level and content of the lesson.

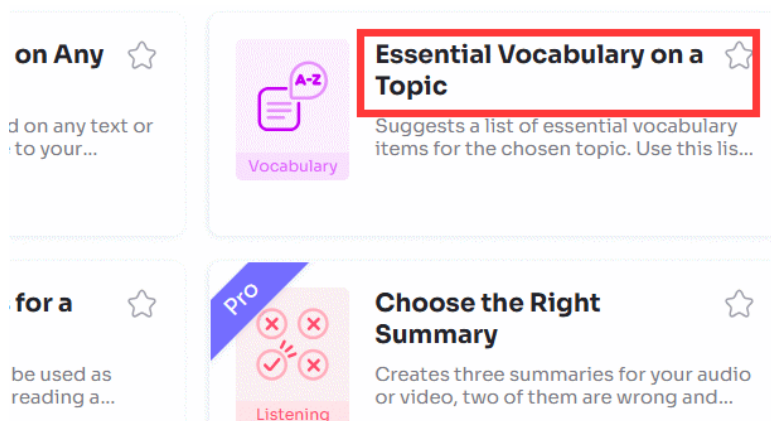

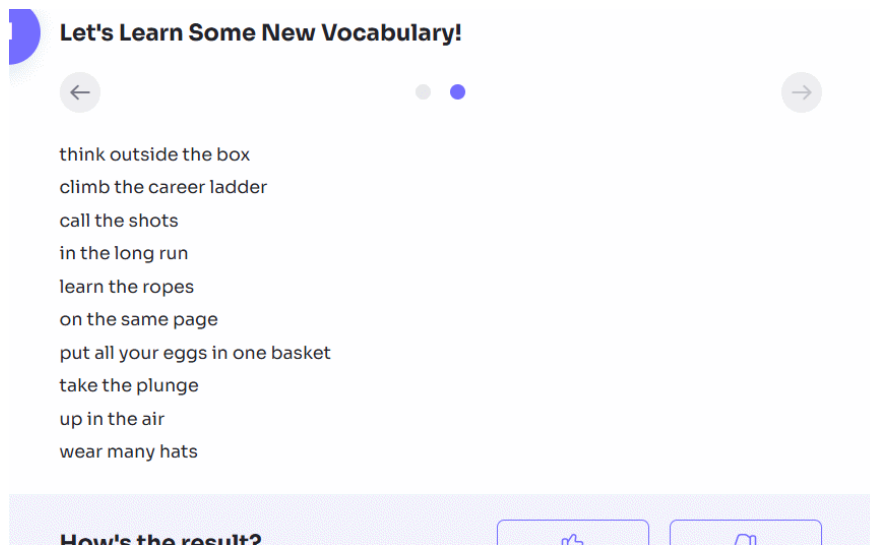
