Benefits of playing shadow puppetry on the wall

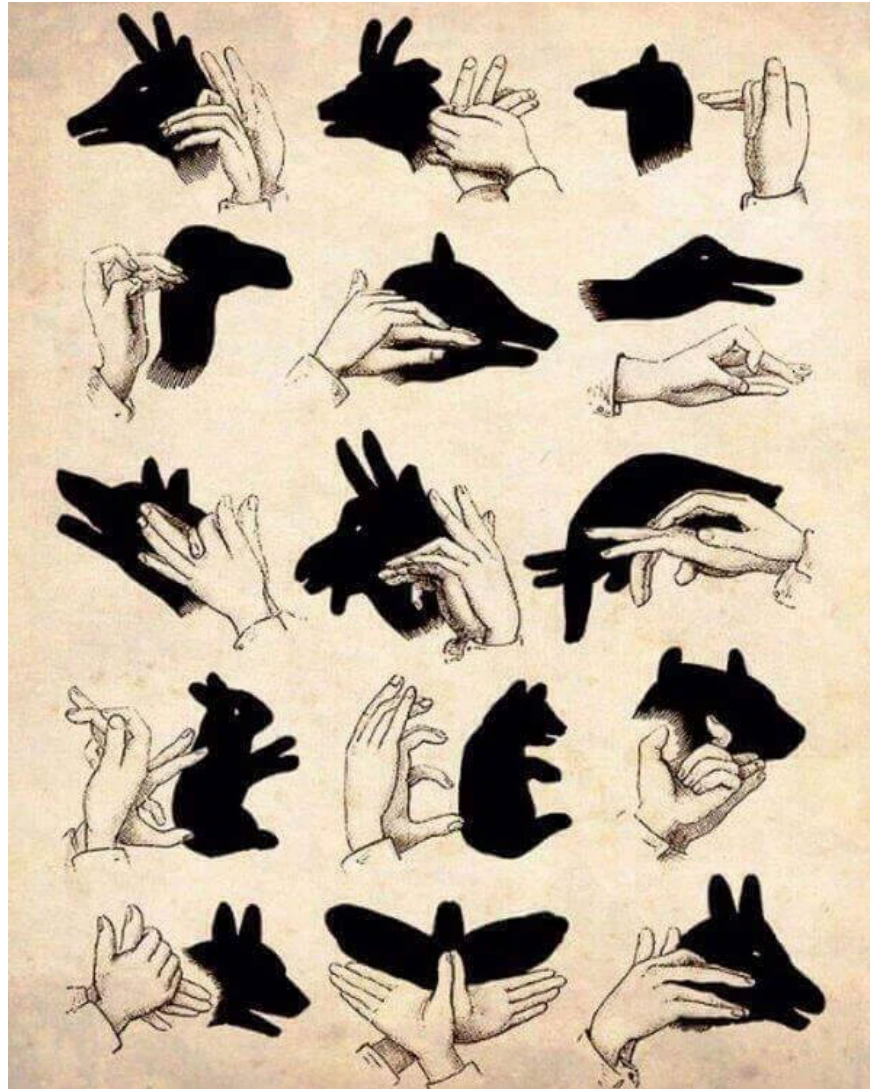
1. It helps children develop dexterity in their hands and fingers.
