

How to create curved typefaces in Word

When creating a winding typeface on Word, it will make the content more interesting.

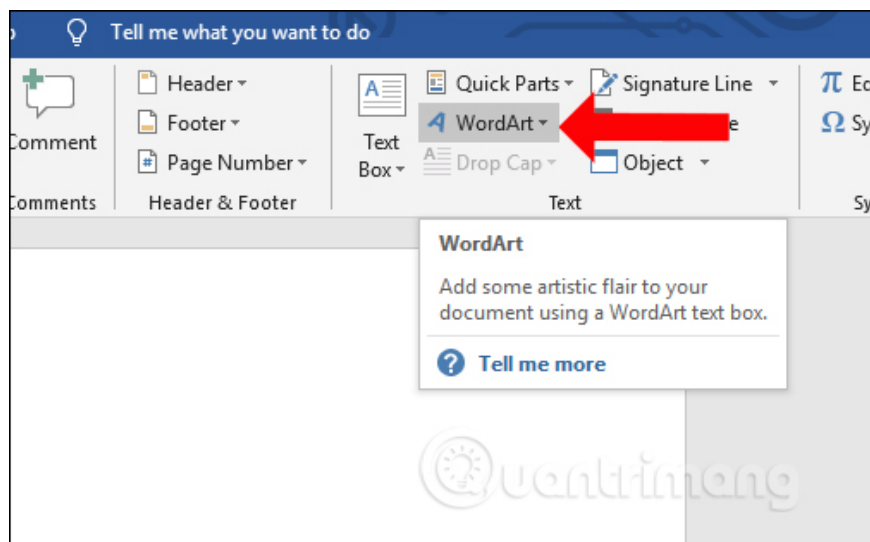

WordArt gathers many types of word art 3D text to drop shadow, . for users to freely choose for their Word documents. And in this article we will show you how to create winding typefaces in Word right after creating art letters with Word Art.

Instructions for creating curling words on Word

Step 1:

Click the **Insert** item and then select the **WordArt** section to write the art word.

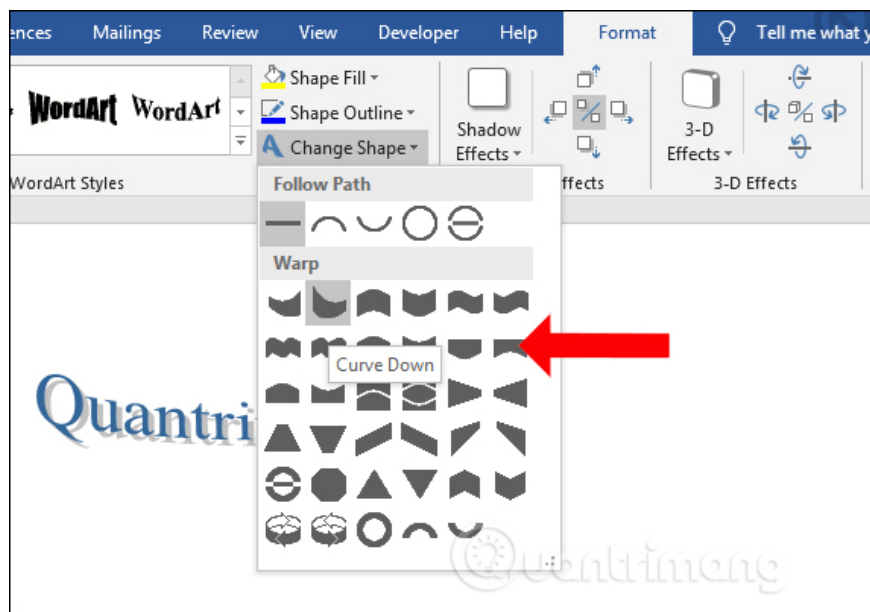


Step 2:

In the list shows the choice of artistic font style that you want to use. Then write the word to Word content.



Click on the **Format** button and then click on **Change Shape**. Here we will see there are many styles of letters with different types of curling or shaping. People find the **type of wavy text** to use for content.

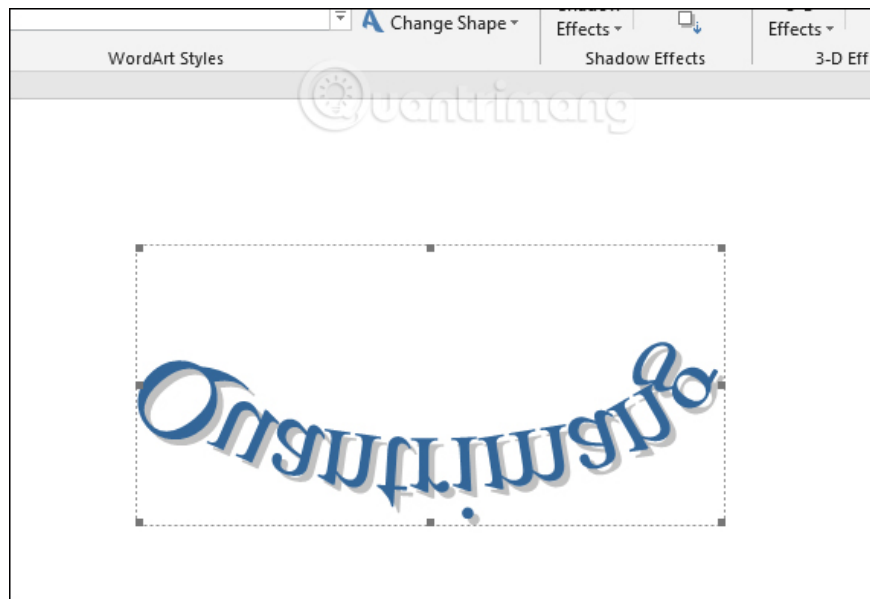


Step 3:

The resulting letter will be shaped as the arc bend pattern as shown below.

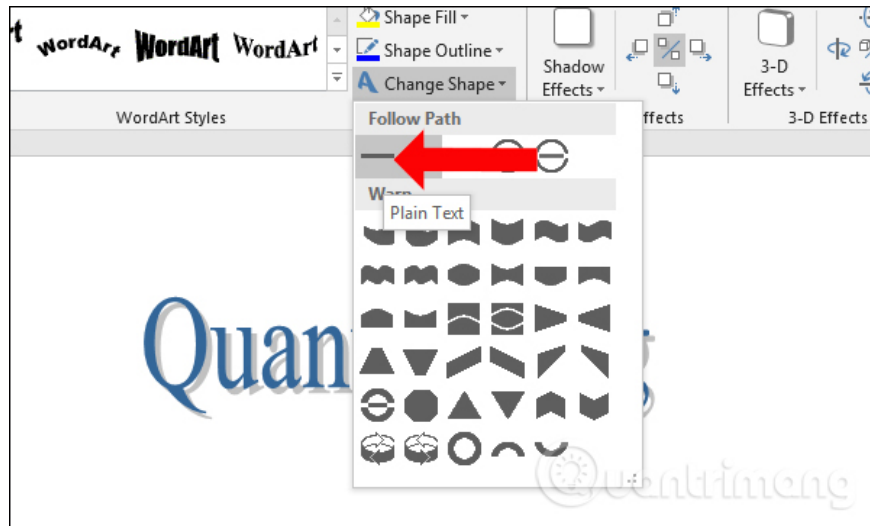


We can click on the center dots of the vertical edges to adjust the arc of the word, or flip the letter upside down when pressing the main dot between the horizontal edge and dragging it downwards as shown.



Step 4:

In case the user wants to return to the first typeface without adding a curling effect, click again on the text and select **Change Shape** then select **the horizontal text effect Plain Text** .



So in addition to using Word Art to write art, we can also use the Change Shape to change the frame for the text, with many different typefaces such as rotation, curling, wavy font style, .
