

How to create GIF images in PowerPoint

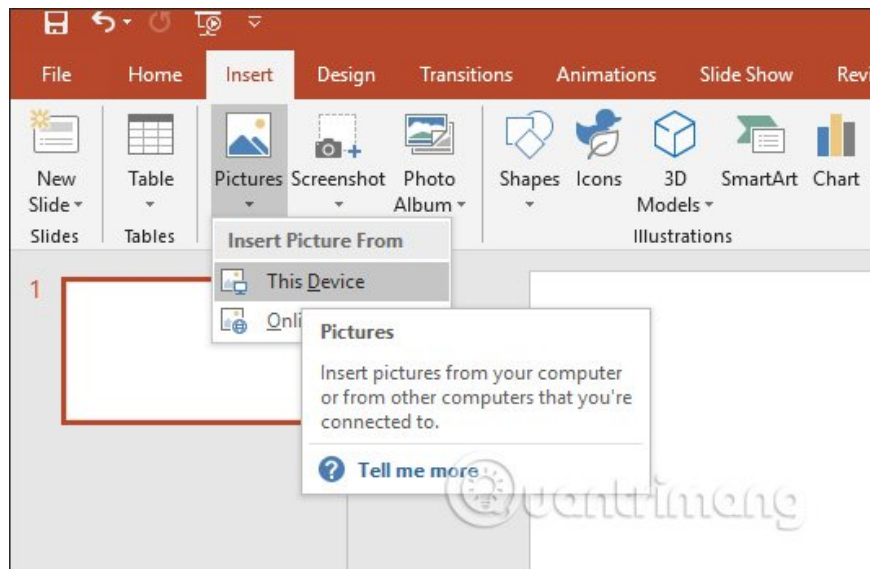
PowerPoint features an easy way to create animations, without the need for other animation software.

Often to create animations you will need software such as Photoshop to create animations or some other GIF creation software. However, in case you need to quickly create an animation or do not need the editing, complex animation settings, professional, you can create GIF images right in PowerPoint. In general, the way to make animation on PowerPoint is very simple, like when you convert PowerPoint slides to videos. The following article will guide you how to create animations in PowerPoint 2019

Instructions for creating animations in PowerPoint

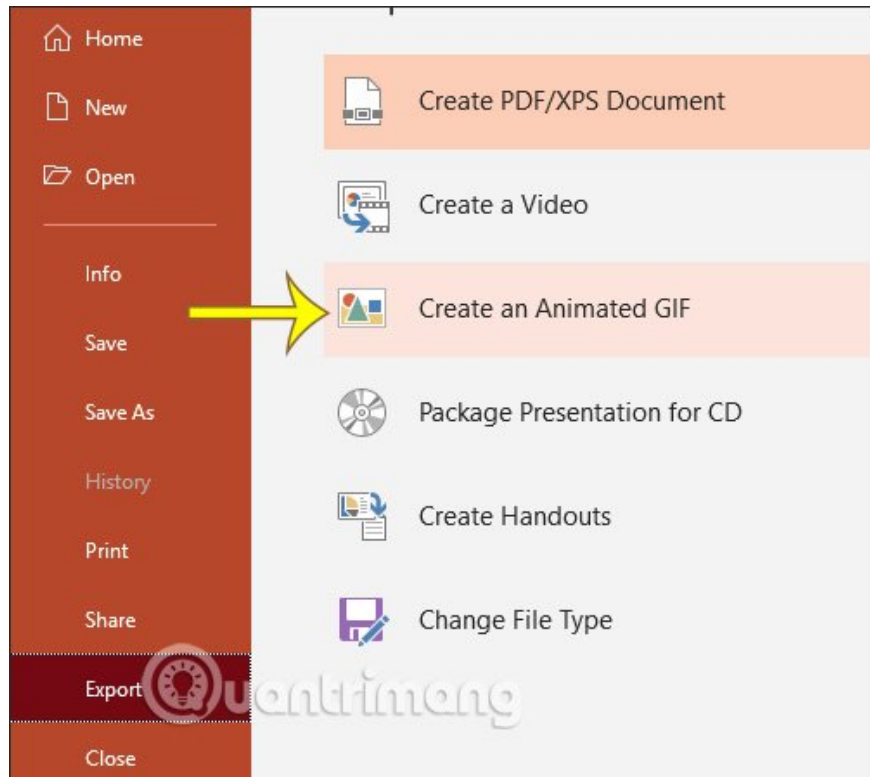
Step 1:

First of all, users need to **insert the image files** that you want to create animation on PowerPoint.



Step 2:

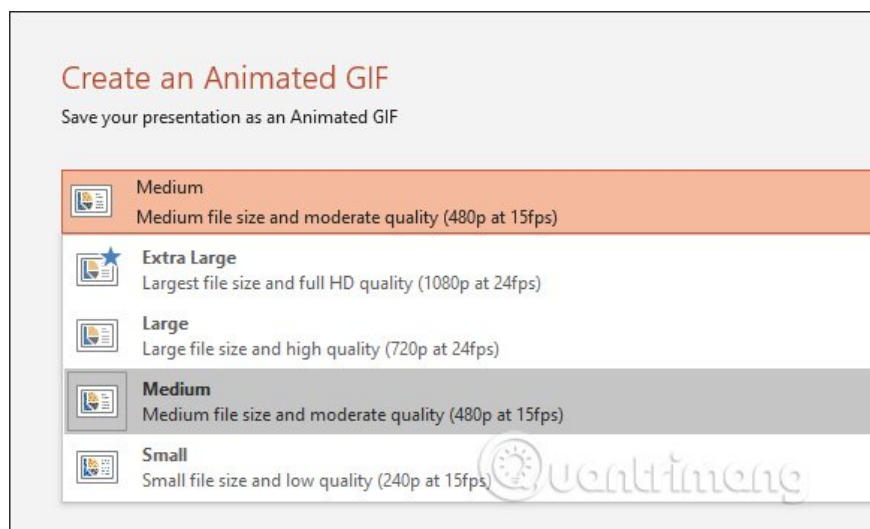
After you have inserted the image into the slide, users **click File** and select **Export** to export the content. Look to the side and click **Create an Animated GIF** .



Step 3:

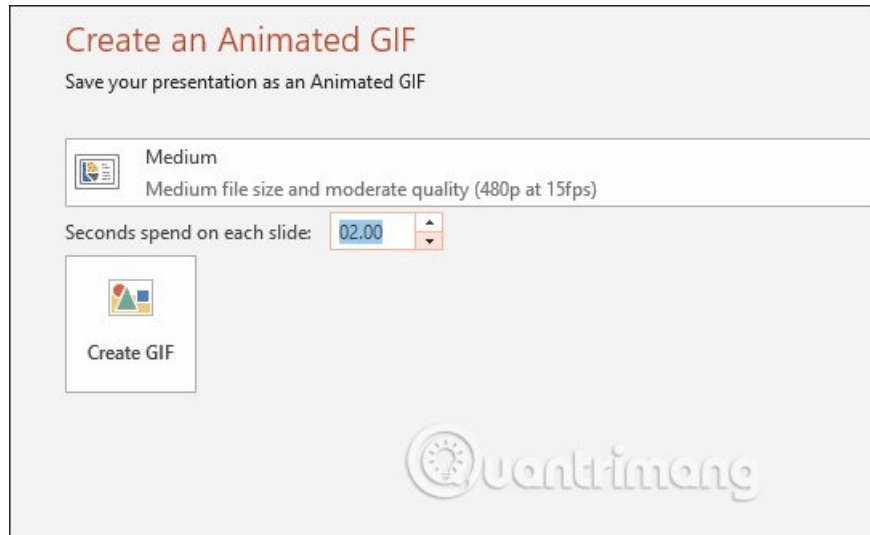
Next we proceed to set the quality and other content for the animation. First, you need to choose **the quality for your animation** in the 4 sizes below.

1. Extra Large: Large images and 1080p HD resolution at 24fps
2. Large: Large images, high resolution 720p and 24fps.
3. Medium: Moderate images, 480p and 15fps resolution.
4. Small: Small images, low resolution 240p and 15fps.



Step 4:

Then at **Seconds spend on each slide** the user selects **the time to switch between the images** in the animation, in seconds. Finally **click Create GIF** to create animations in PowerPoint. The process of creating animations takes place immediately and we just need to open the saved animation folder to create it.
