

How to create snowfall effect with DesktopSnowOK

DesktopSnowOK will create a snow effect on the computer screen very beautifully.

Winter has knocked on every country, every city around the world. And the image of snowfall has probably become familiar to many people, becoming a favorite sight of many people watching the snow fall early in the season. And you can also bring a blank snow scene for your computer, with the software DesktopSnowOK.

DesktopSnowOK has a very small capacity of less than 120KB which will bring about snow effect, create a winter scene with hundreds, thousands of small white snowflakes right on the computer. Especially, the tool also provides a lot of options to edit the snow speed, the amount of snow falling, etc. The following article will guide you how to create snowfall effect on your computer.

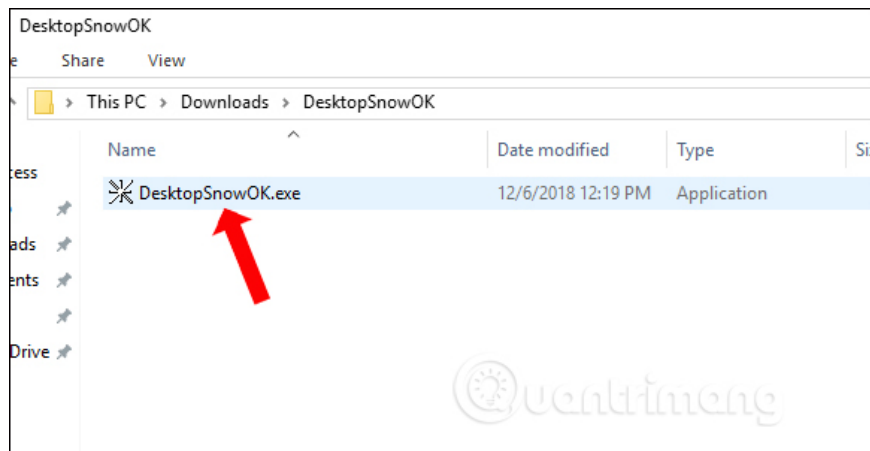

How to use DesktopSnowOK to create a snow effect

Step 1:

Users download the tool DesktopSnowOK following the link below and then proceed to extract. In the unzipped folder click on **the software installation file** .

1. Download the tool DesktopSnowOK



Step 2:

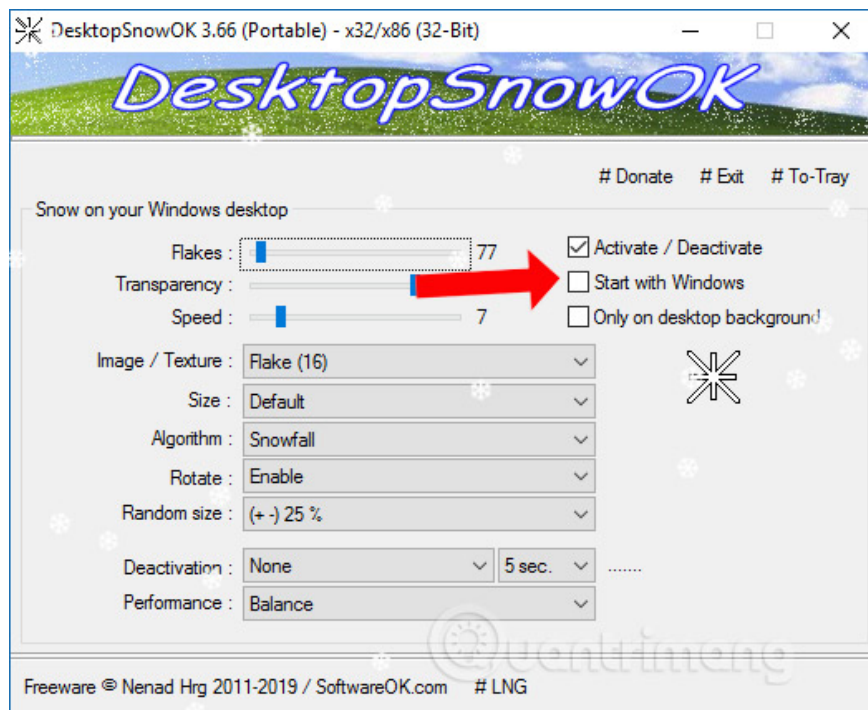
The software will launch immediately afterwards without having to proceed with the usual installation steps. The snowfall effect is immediately applied on the computer.



Step 3:

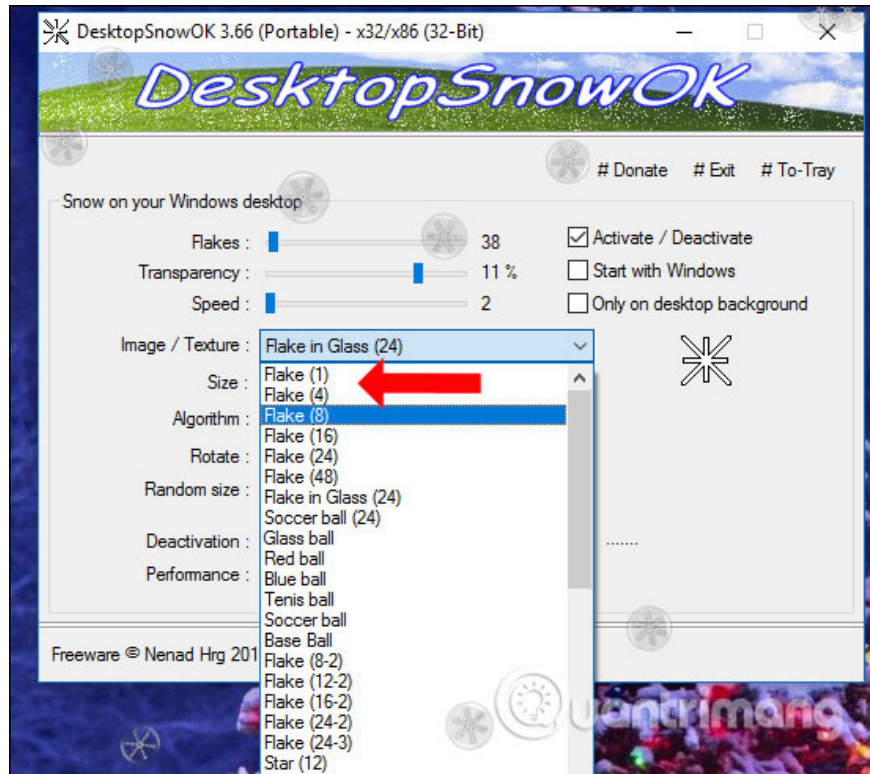
In the settings interface for the tool, users will have some items to change for the snow effect. First of all on the right will have the option to set up software startup.

1. Activate / Deactivate: Activate or deactivate DesktopSnowOK.
2. Start with Windows: Launch the tool as soon as the computer starts.
3. Only on desktop background: Only works effects on the desktop without working with other screens.



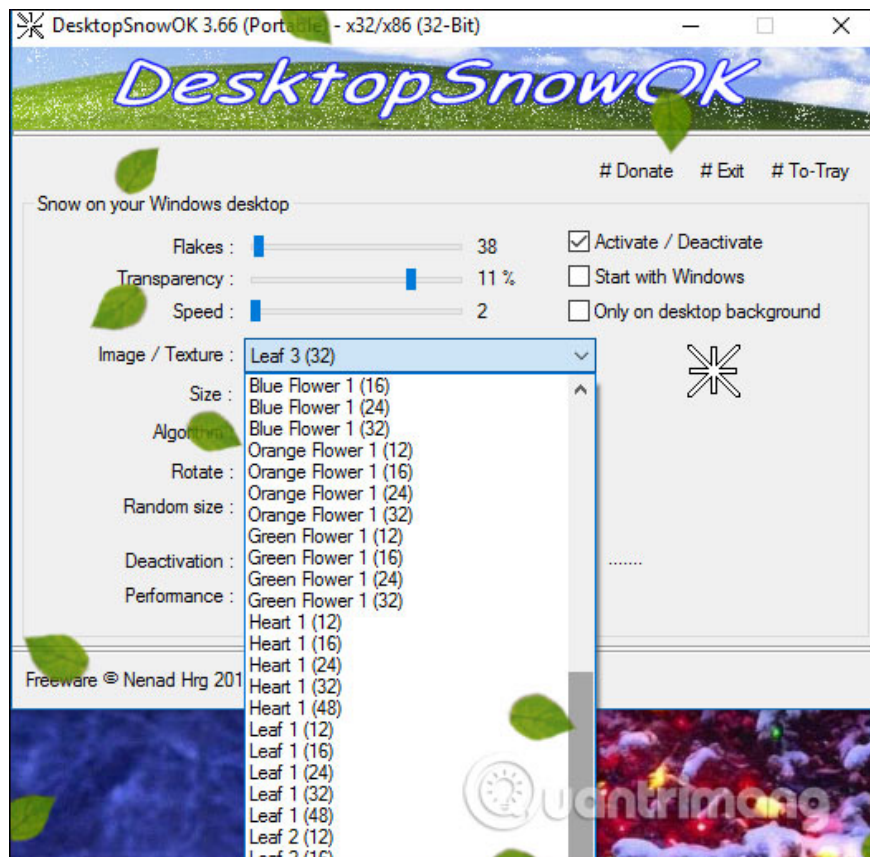
Continuing at **Snow on your Desktop** , users will adjust the snow effect.

1. Flakes: Increase or decrease the number of snowflakes on the screen.
2. Transparency: Adjust the transparency of snowflakes when falling on the screen, depending on the computer wallpaper using multiple colors or simple backgrounds.
3. Speed: Adjust the falling speed of snowflakes, fast or slow.
4. Image / Texture: Choose styles for snowflakes with Flake (1), the smallest form of snowflake, Flake (48), the largest snowflake, Flake (16) default snowflake style. Especially with Flake in Glass (24) will be snowflakes wrapped in bubbles.



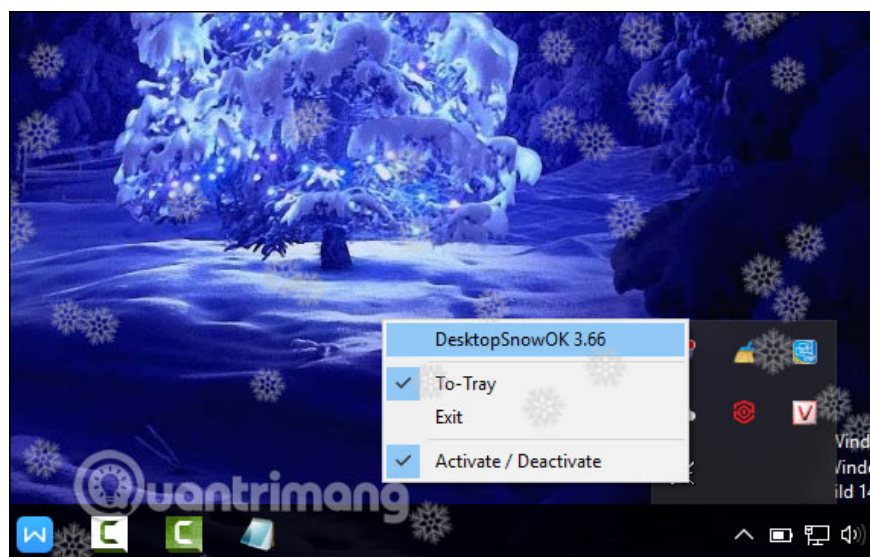
In addition to the snowflake effect, DesktopSnowOK tool also brings many other effects such as bubble effect (Glass ball), flower effect with different colors (Flower), effect of falling leaves (Leaf), .

Below will be the resizing options for effects on your computer. Depending on the type of textures the effect you choose is what you want to customize the effect accordingly.



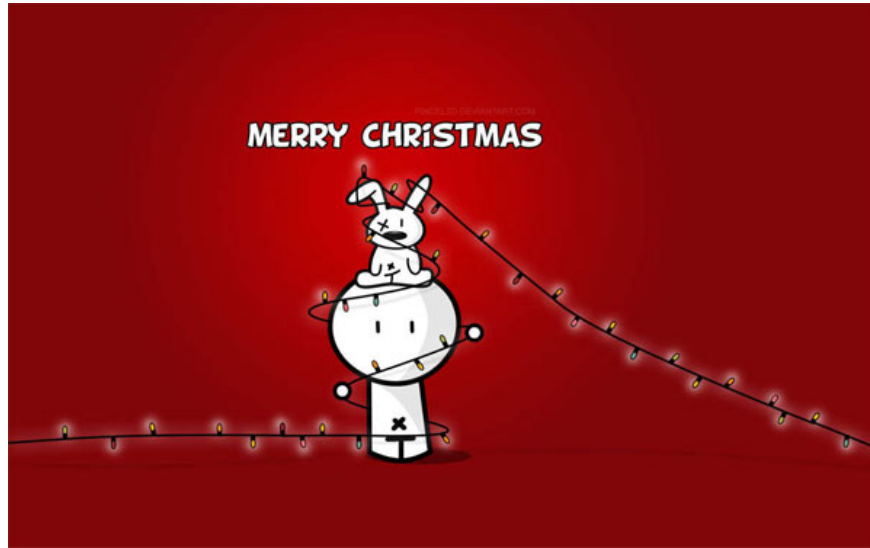
Step 4:

To edit DesktopSnowOK, users just need to open the system tray and double click on **the tool icon** , or right-click and choose DesktopSnowOK. There is also a menu to turn on, turn off the effect or exit the tool completely.
