

How to create temporary email addresses quickly with YOPmail

When you want to protect your online privacy, you should use a disposable email address. With this email address you can sign up for the service, send an anonymous email or reduce the amount of spam in your real email address.

One of the best options for creating a temporary email address is YOPmail. Let's find out how to use it.

What is YOPmail?

YOPmail is a disposable email service. It allows you to use the email address yopmail.com and provides access to the inbox for that address even if there are already users.



You can use YOPmail when asked to enter your email address but do not want to use your real account. Use it for websites that require a login or test application, and you won't have to receive newsletters or have to handle spam in Gmail.

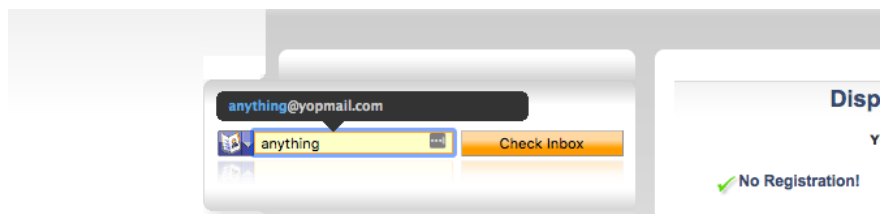
Unlike regular email accounts, YOPmail is not private or password protected, so you should not use it for important or personal purposes.

Users also do not need to set it up. When you need to enter the address form on a website and don't want to use your address, just enter the random address.

How to create a YOPmail account

In theory, you can use YOPmail without visiting YOPmail.com. When visiting a website that requires an email, enter [anything] @ yopmail.com such as anything@yopmail.com and it will be accepted as a 'genuine' email address.

If you need to access your inbox to confirm your account or download documents for free, there are two ways to do it.



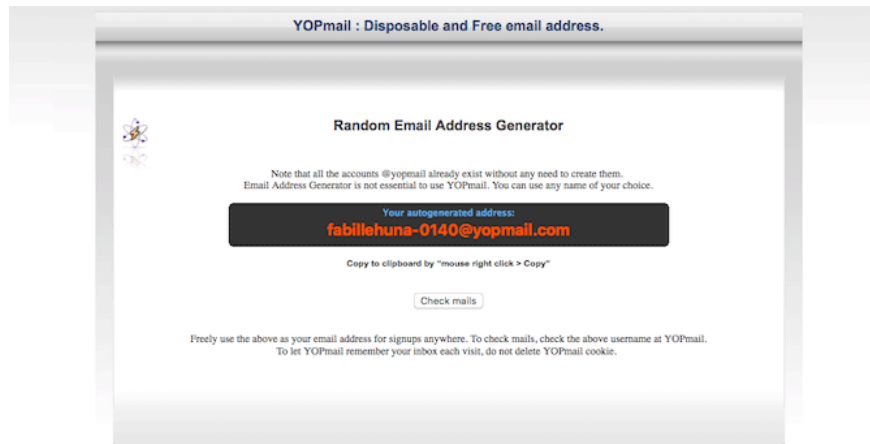
In the box at the top left of the YOPmail website, labeled **Type the Email name of your choice** , enter the first part of the address you choose and click on **Check Inbox** .

Alternatively, just go to **yopmail.com/[the address you choose]** and will be taken to the inbox without a password.

When using simple and common words for the address and see the user already. The mailbox will be full of messages and spam from others. This is normal because all inboxes in YOPmail are public and shared.

But one thing to keep in mind is that you can see other people 's mail, which also means that other people can see your mail. Therefore, you should not use an email address once for anything related to your true identity.

You can get a little privacy if you use random combinations of letters for email addresses such as dd5-73tq4@yopmail.com, and if you're lucky you'll have your own mailbox. Despite this, it is still public and insecure.



You can use the YOPmail Generator tool to create a unique address, find it in the **Random Email Address section** of the website sidebar.

Disadvantages of YOPmail disposable address

YOPmail is easy to use however some websites have generated random email addresses, so it may not accept YOPmail as a valid address.

To fix this, the service offers several alternative domain names. Use one of the addresses below and the message you receive will automatically forward to the corresponding YOPmail email address.
