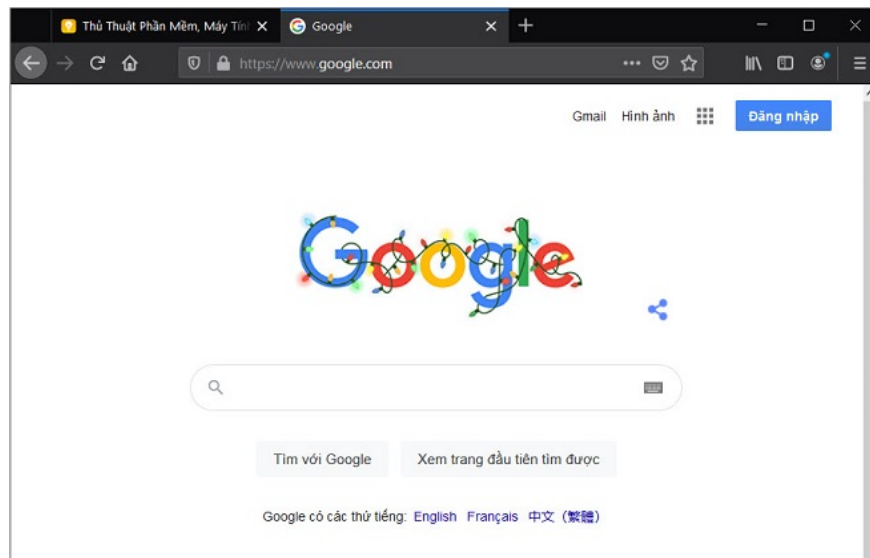


How to delete data on FireFox by keyboard shortcuts

Firefox is a browser with many features and add-ons to protect user information very well, in addition you can delete browser data manually or by using keyboard shortcuts as below instructions.

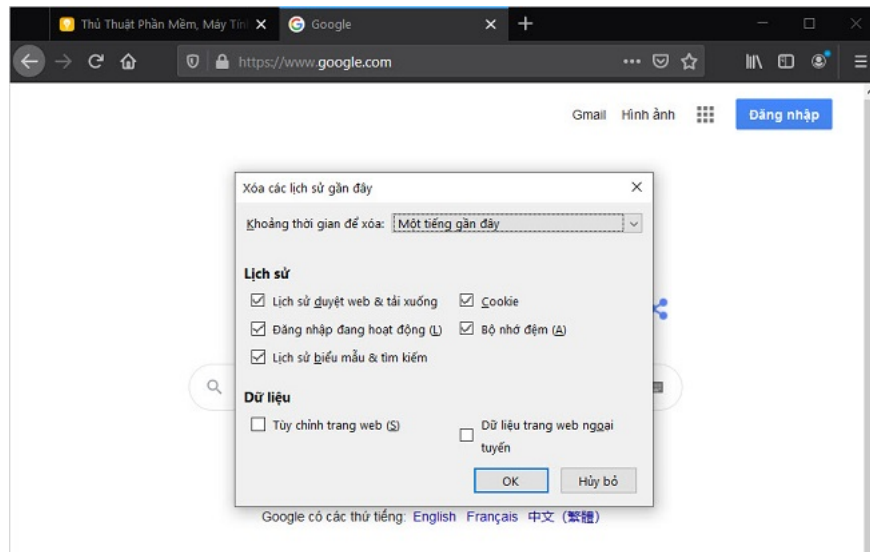
Step 1: You proceed to open the FireFox browser on your computer.



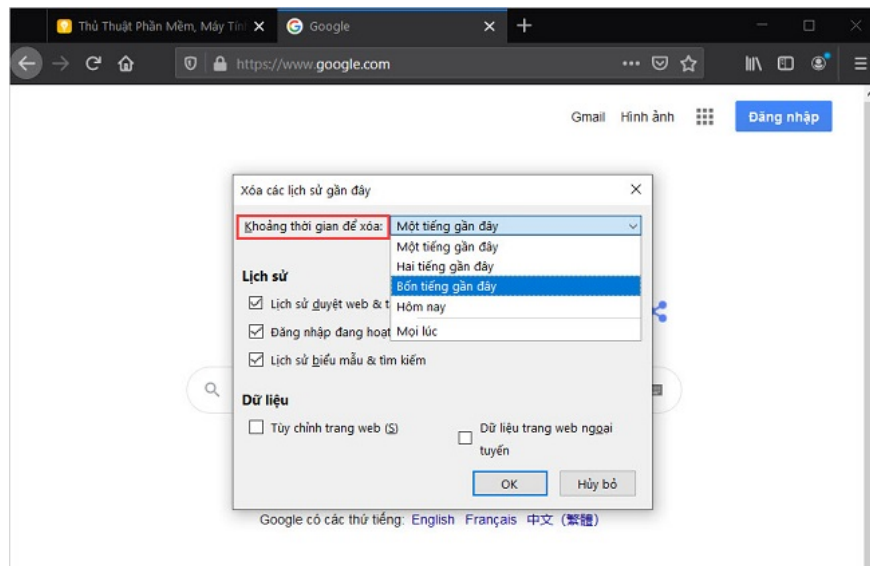
Step 2: Then, you press the following keyboard shortcut to open the data deletion window of FireFox.

1. **Keyboard shortcut for Windows and Linux:** Ctrl + Shift + Delete
2. **Keyboard shortcut for Mac OS:** Command + Shift + Delete

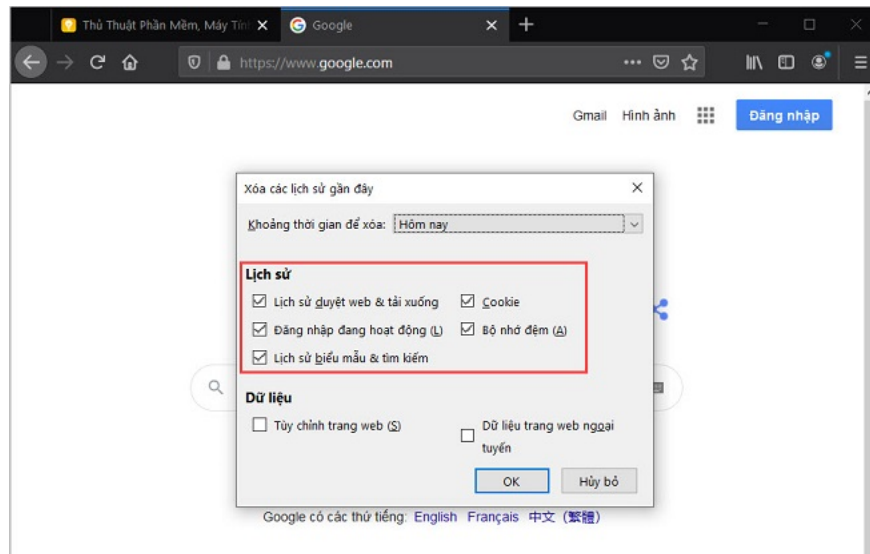
After pressing the shortcut key combination, you will see the ' **Clear Recent History** ' window appear.



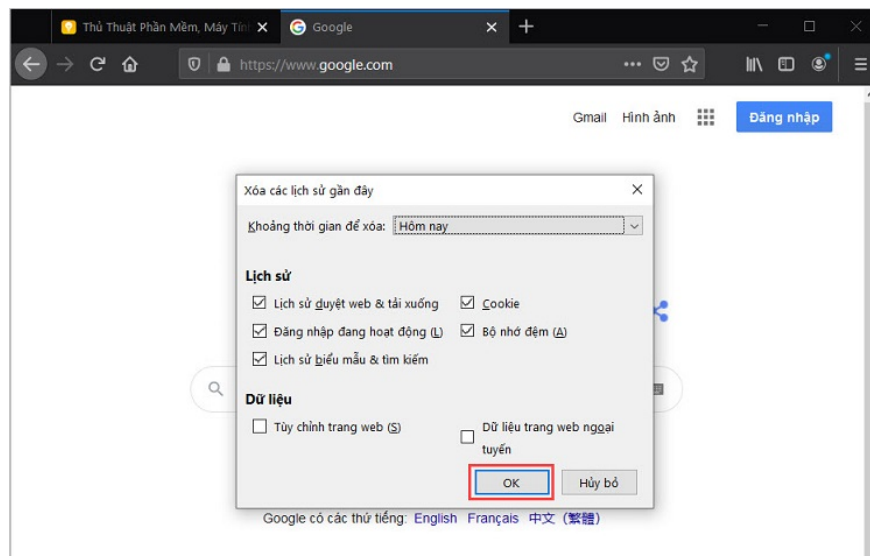
Step 3: Next, you need to set the ' **Time to delete** ' for the purpose of choosing the time you want to delete browsing data, avoiding affecting the old history.



Step 4: Then, you proceed to tick the data items to delete on the Web browser.

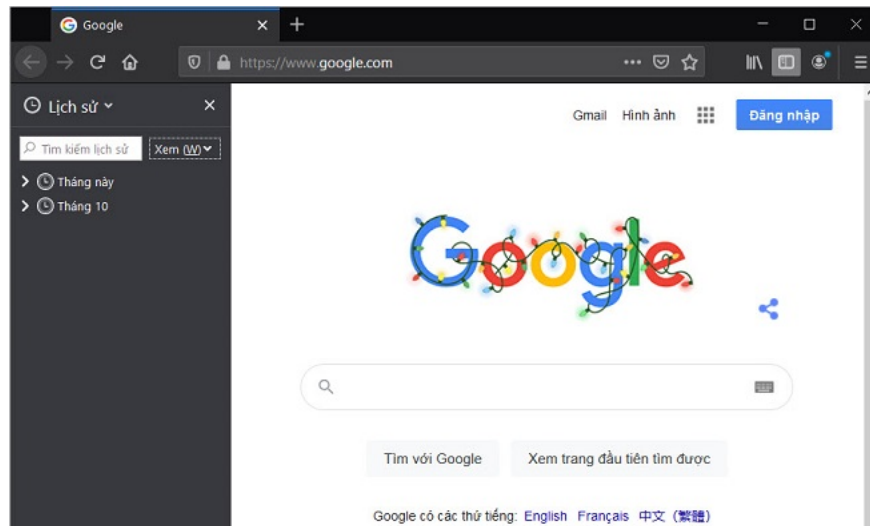


Step 5: Once done, click **OK** to FireFox to delete your browsing data.



Step 6: To check your browsing history on FireFox, you can use the following keyboard shortcuts:

1. **Keyboard shortcut on Linux and Windows:** Ctrl + H
2. **Keyboard shortcut on Mac OS:** Command + H
