

# How to delete iPhone backups in iTunes on Windows 10

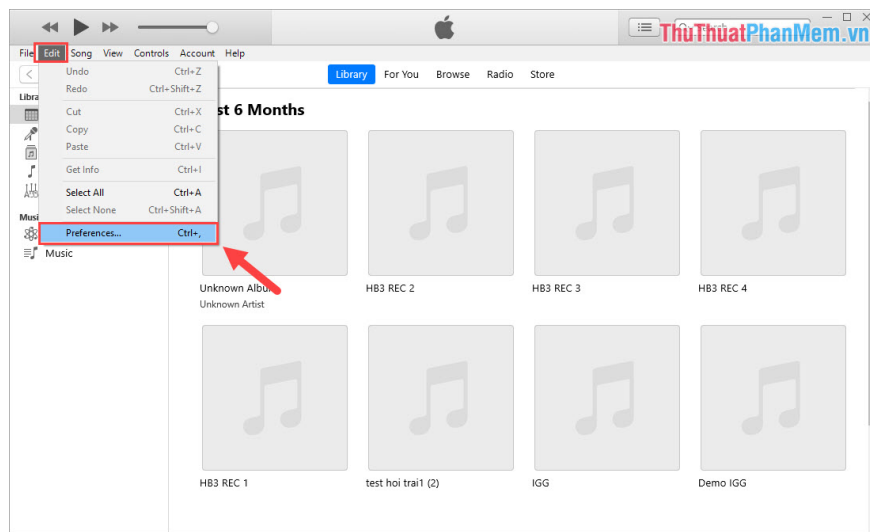

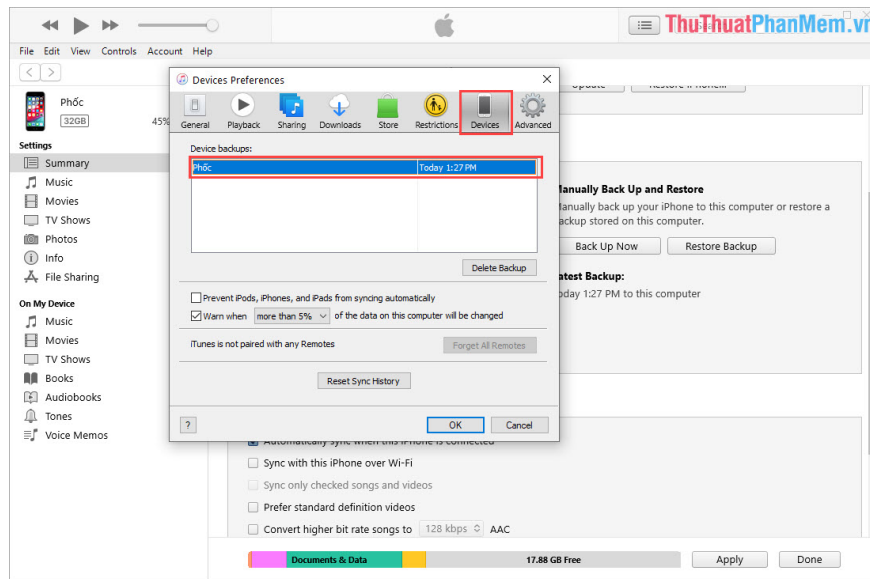


## 1. Delete iPhone backup directly on iTunes

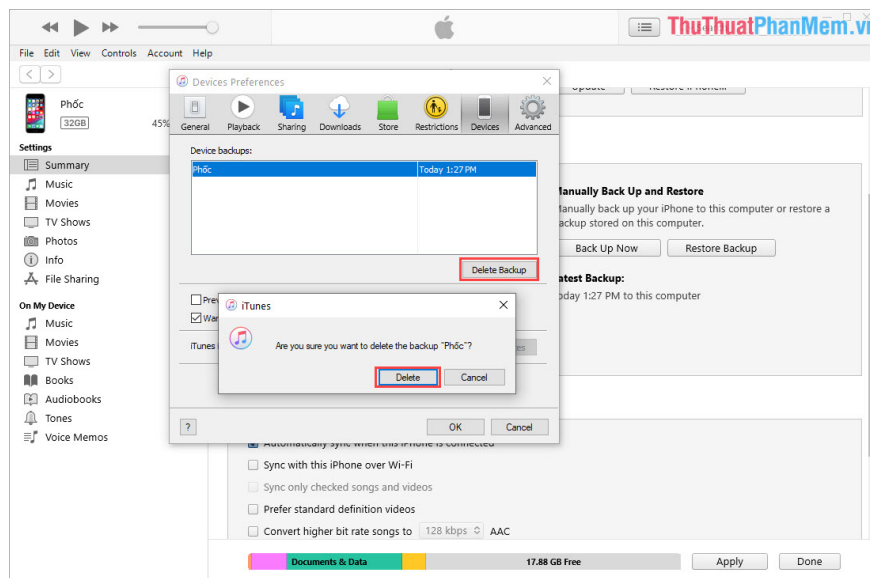
**Step 1:** You proceed to open the **iTunes** application and select **Edit -> Preferences . (Ctrl +,)** .



**Step 2:** After that, select the **Devices** tab , you will see the backups (backups) are available on your computer.



**Step 3:** You select the backups to delete and select **Delete Backup** to delete them. The system will ask if you want to delete the **Backup Backup** or not? You choose **Delete** to delete or select **No** to cancel.



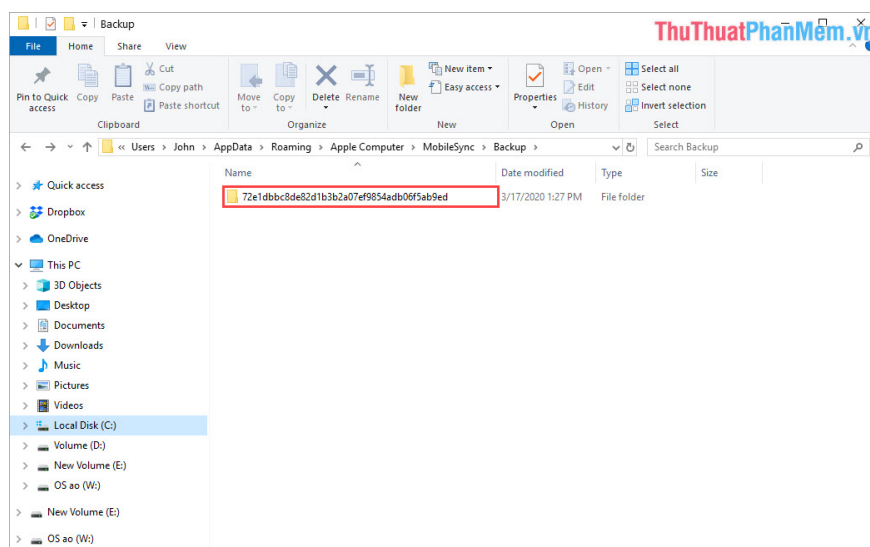
## 2. Delete the iPhone backup indirectly on the storage folder

Deleting iPhone backups indirectly in the storage folder is very confusing if you do not identify the right backups to delete because they do not display the specific names of the backups. Because of that, the indirect delete on the archive folder is only used in case it is necessary to delete all backups or only a single backup.

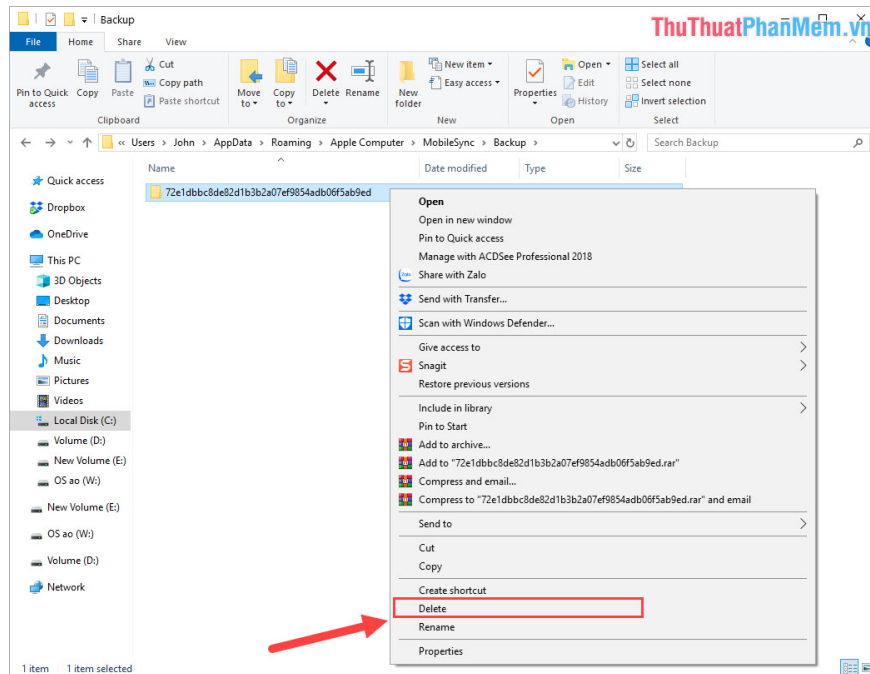
**Step 1:** First, you need to open **This PC** and access the folders in the following order:

C: UsersAppDataRoamingApple ComputerMobileSyncBackup  
**Where:** is the username of the computer account you are using.

In the Backup folder, you will see the iPhone backup on iTunes.



Your job now is to **right-click** on the backup and select **Delete** to delete them.
