It is clear that Google stores information related to your browser history to provide relevant ads. So how do you prevent Google Android from capturing a screenshot of your search history?

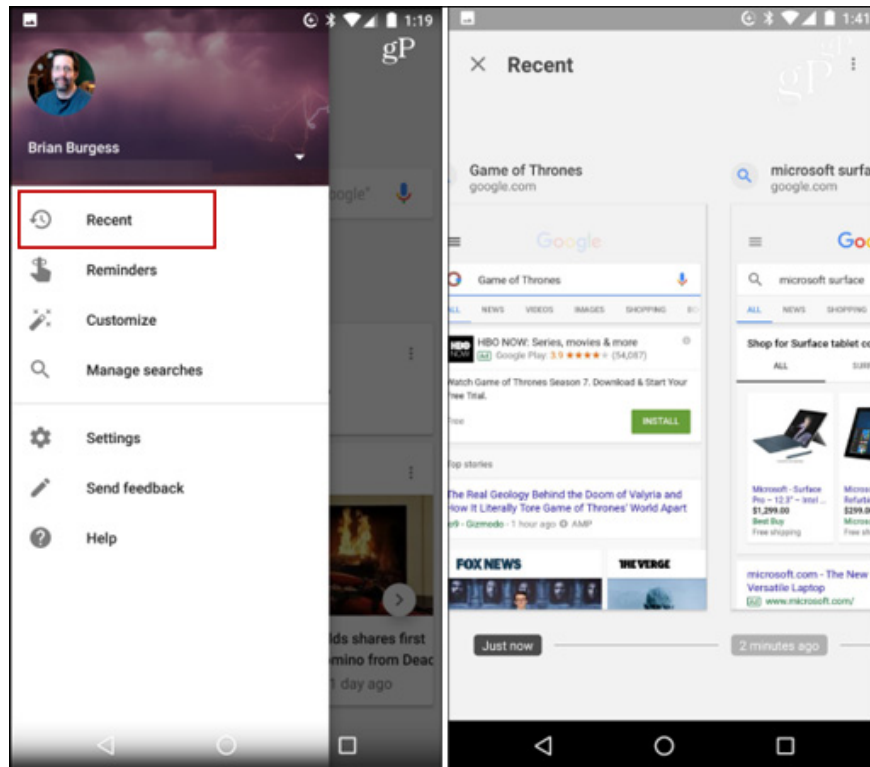

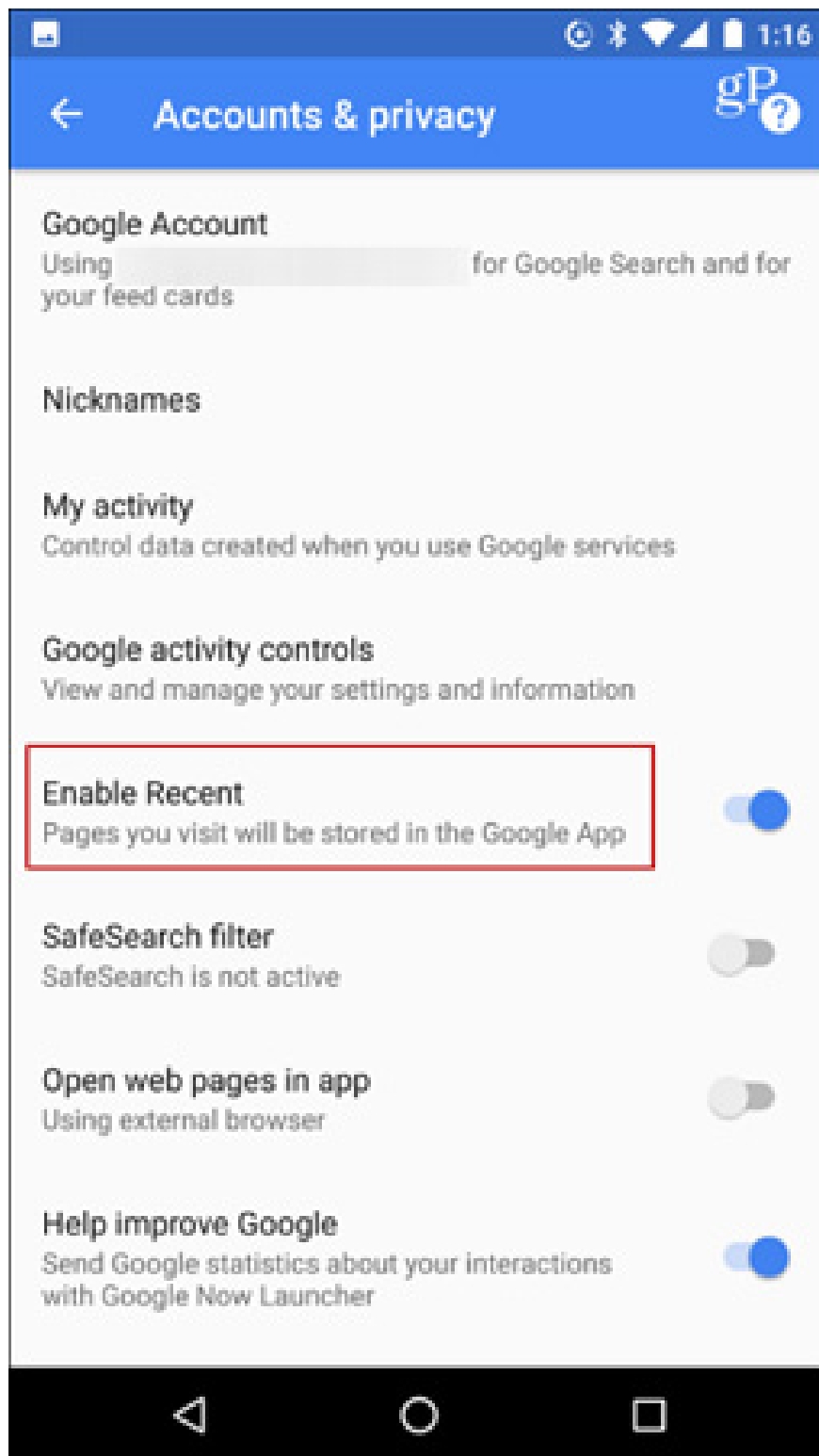

So how do you prevent Google Android from capturing a screenshot of your search history?

To do that, open the **Google Assistant** application, click the menu button and select **Recent** at the top of the list. Here, you will see a list of searches over the past seven days scrolling across the screen. If you want to delete a group or photo by yourself, swipe up to remove them.



If you want to disable all of them, go to **Settings**> **Accounts & privacy** and enable **Enable Recent**. This will delete all photos that are being saved on your device.
