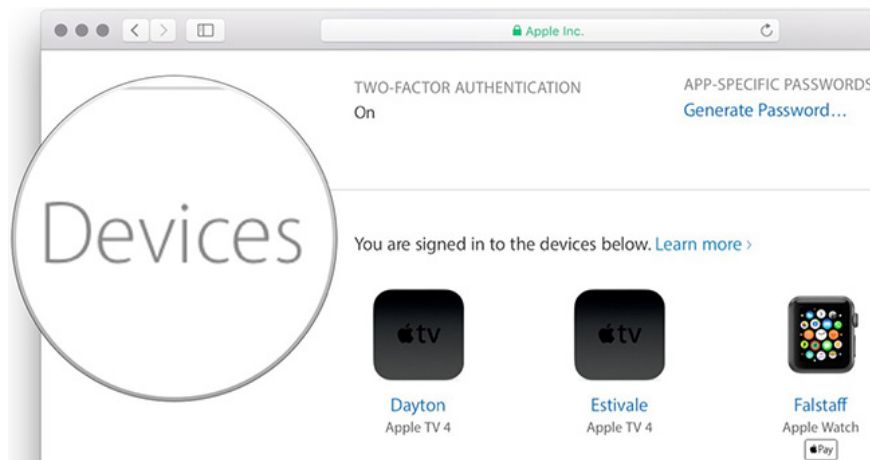
## How to delete devices associated with Apple ID

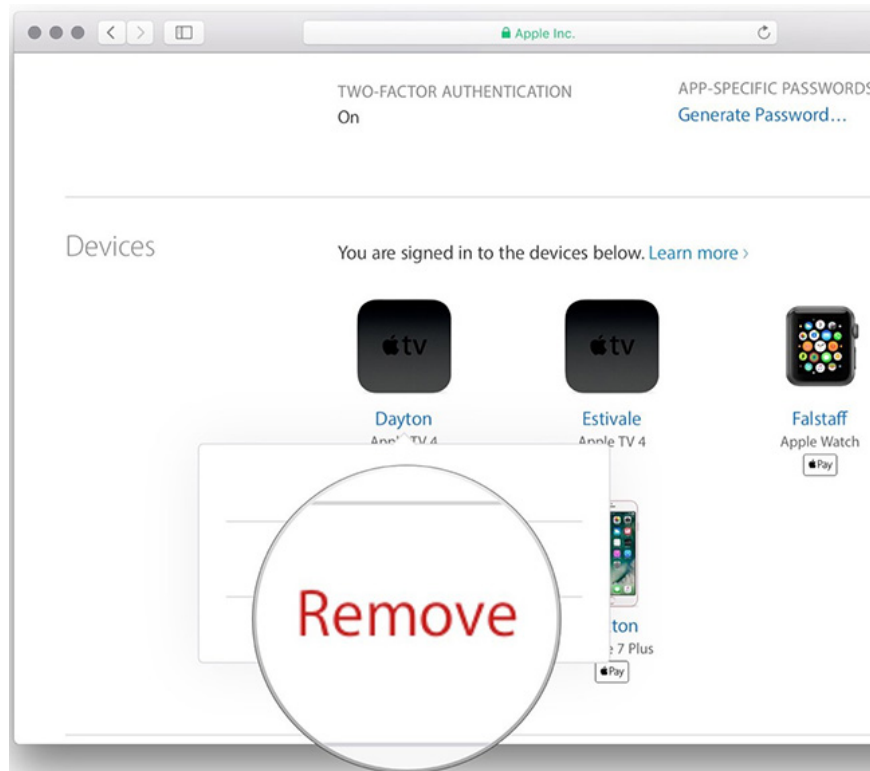
To delete devices associated with Apple ID, you can do so on the Apple ID Management page or from your iOS device.

Deleting devices associated with Apple ID will make it easier for you to sign in with your new Apple ID or use a device without an Apple ID.

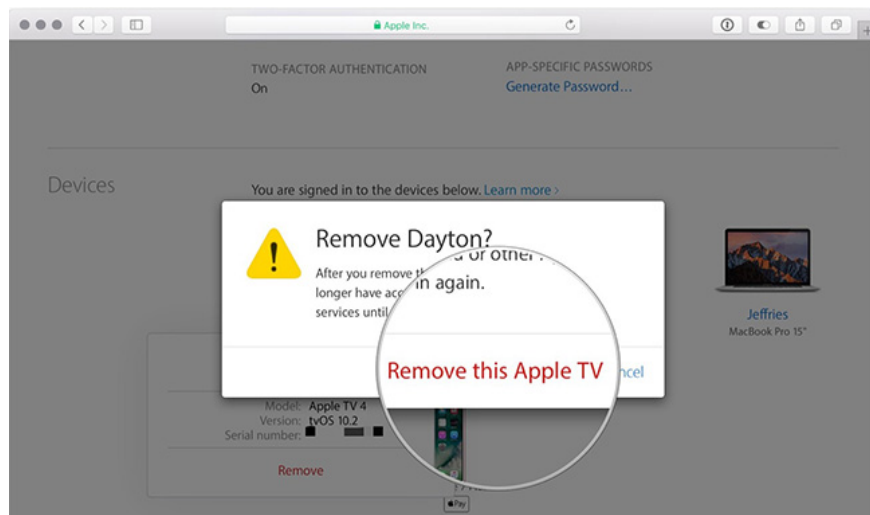
### How to delete devices associated with Apple ID on the website

1. Open [appleid.apple.com](https://appleid.apple.com) website and log in with your Apple ID.
2. Enter the two-factor authentication code if available.
3. Scroll down to **Devices / Devices** section.
4. Select a device and click **Remove / Delete** .





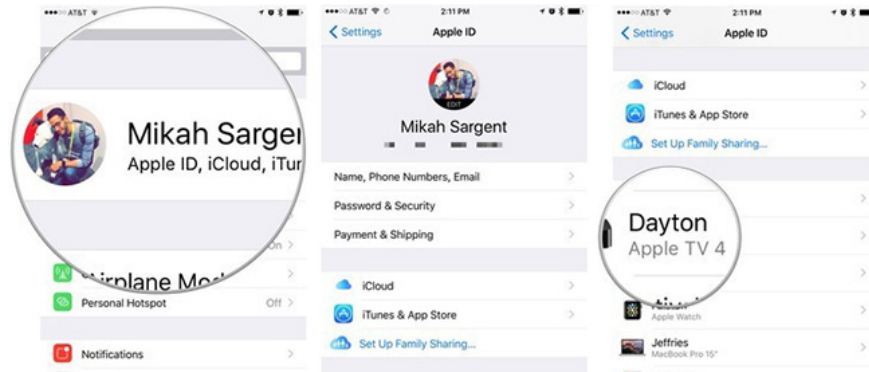
5. Click **Remove this [Device]** to confirm.



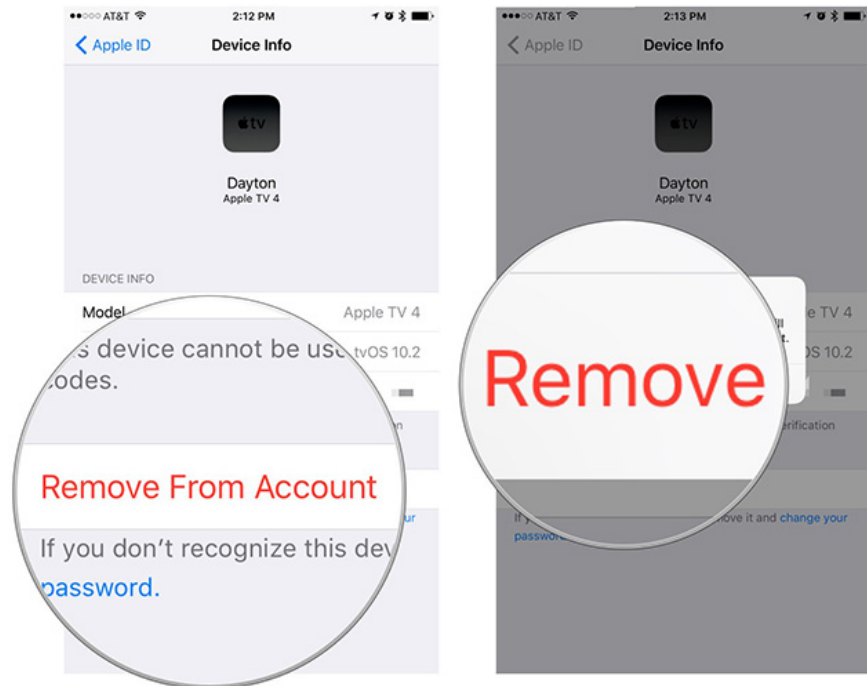
6. Repeat steps 4 and 5 until all devices are deleted.

### **How to delete devices associated with Apple ID on iOS devices**

1. Open the **Settings** application.
2. Click the Apple ID icon at the top of the screen.
3. Scroll down to the Apple device section.
4. Touch a device.



5. Click **Remove From Account** .
6. Click **Remove** to confirm.

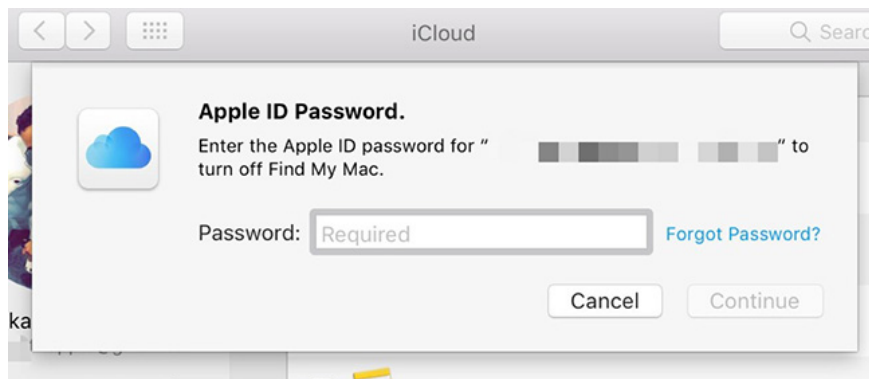


## Turn off Find My iPhone / iPad / Mac feature

Devices that enable Find My iPhone (iPad / Mac / Apple Watch / etc.) Are linked to Apple ID. In case of a device loss, you can use Find My iPhone (etc.) to find, lock, delete the device, . If you want to delete Apple ID, you need to remove this link.

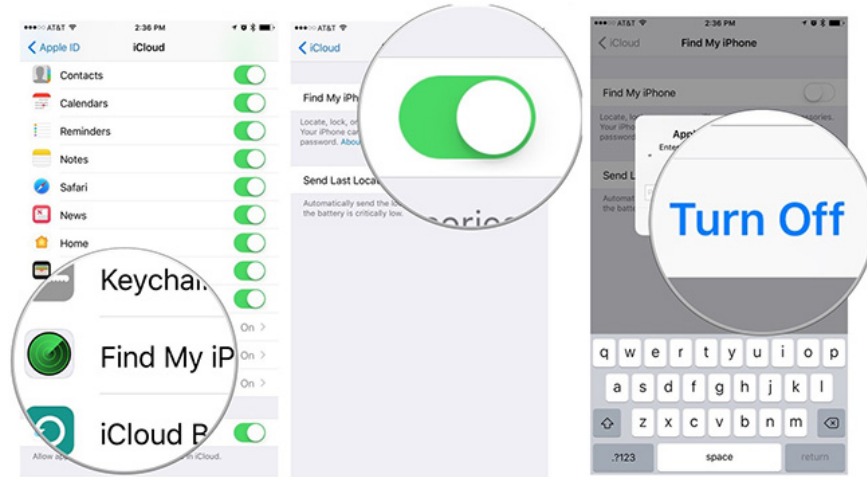
### Turn off Find My Mac

1. Open **System Preferences** .
2. Click **iCloud** .
3. Scroll down and find **Find My Mac** .
4. Uncheck the box next to **Find My Mac** .
5. Enter the Apple ID password and click **Continue** to confirm.



**Turn off Find My iPhone / iPad**

1. Open the Settings application.
2. Click the Apple ID icon at the top of the screen.
3. Click **iCloud** .
4. Scroll down and click **Find My iPhone** .
5. Turn off the switch next to the option.
6. Enter the Apple ID password and click **Turn Off** to confirm.



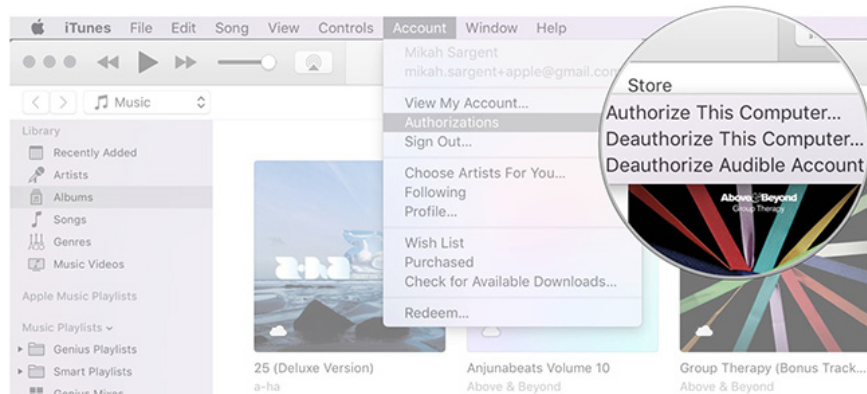
## Log out of your Apple ID account

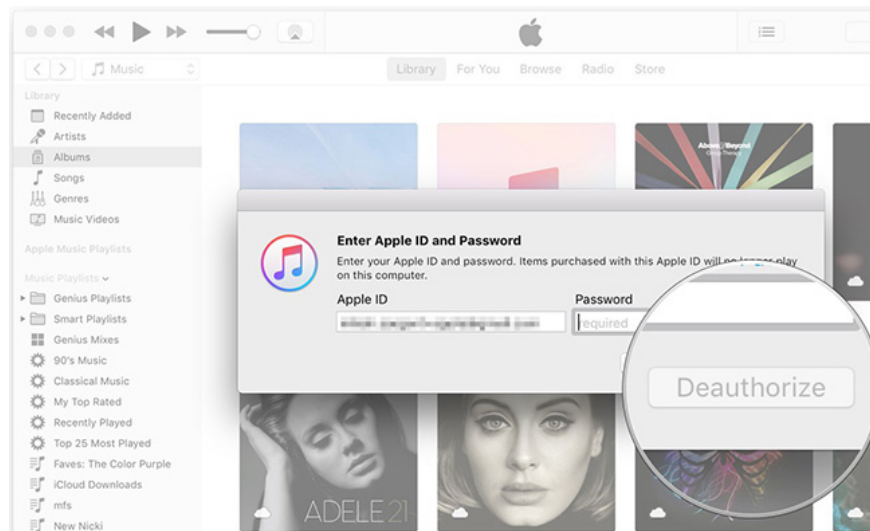
After completing these two things, you need to export the Apple ID account for all applications.

### How to cancel the Apple ID license on iTunes for Mac

Apple only allows some devices authorized to access the iTunes library.

1. Open iTunes.
2. Click Account in the menu.
3. Select the **Authorizations** and click **Deauthorize This Computer** .
4. Enter the Apple ID password and click **Deauthorize** to confirm.





## Log out of your Apple ID account on Mac

1. Open **System Preferences** .
2. Click **iCloud**.
3. Click **Sign Out** in the bottom left corner.
4. If you want to keep a copy of your iCloud data on your Mac, click **Keep a Copy** , otherwise uncheck the data categories and click Continue.
