

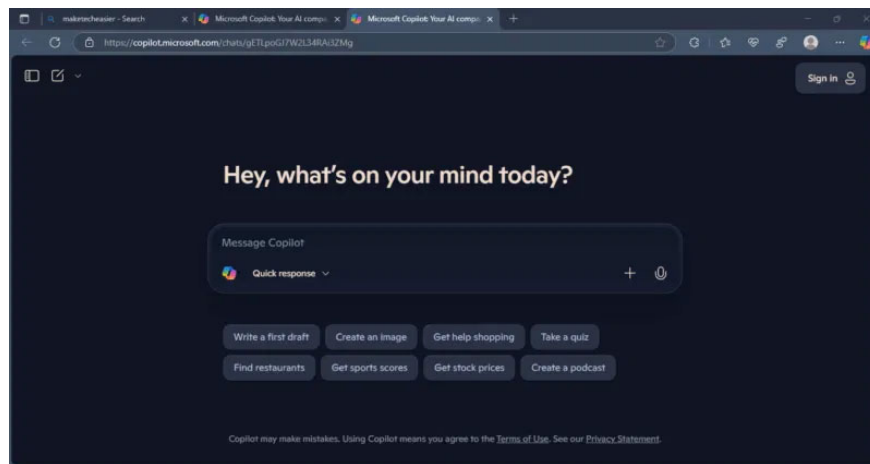
How to disable Copilot in Microsoft Edge

If you prefer a simple interface or are concerned about AI privacy, there's an easy way to disable Copilot in Microsoft Edge without any effort.

Microsoft's aggressive push to incorporate AI into everything is nothing new. Now, when you open Microsoft Edge, it feels like it's trying to be too smart with all those AI-powered features. Copilot features you can disable in Edge

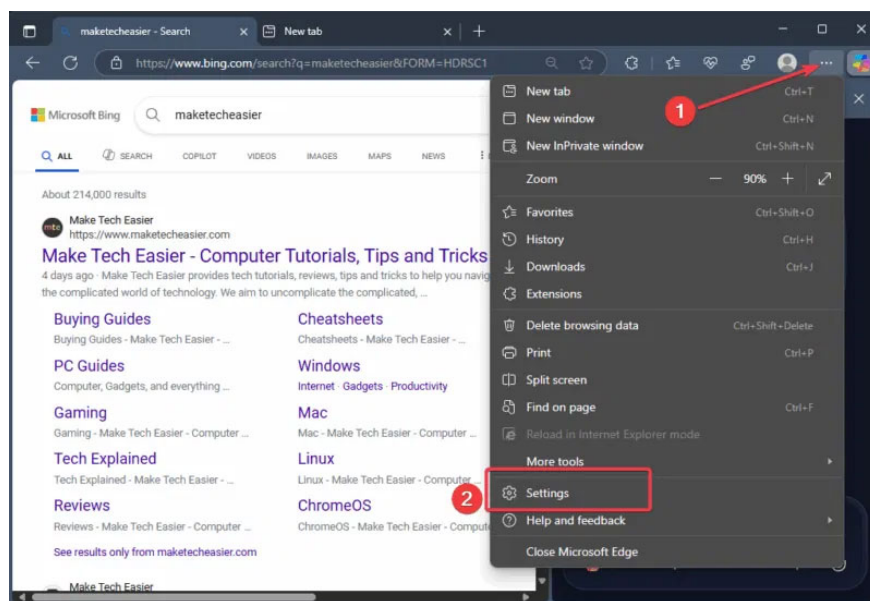
For example, there's *the Copilot-inspired New Tab Page*, where you can see features like the "Search & Chat" or "Ask Copilot" options whenever you open a new tab. These features are enabled by default, appearing all the time like a chat assistant.

While some people may appreciate the extra help to get more information about their searches, others find it annoying and confusing. There's also the fear that your data is being used to fuel AI processing.

That's why Microsoft is making Copilot mode optional. You can turn off Copilot features in Microsoft Edge if you're in the "no thanks" camp.

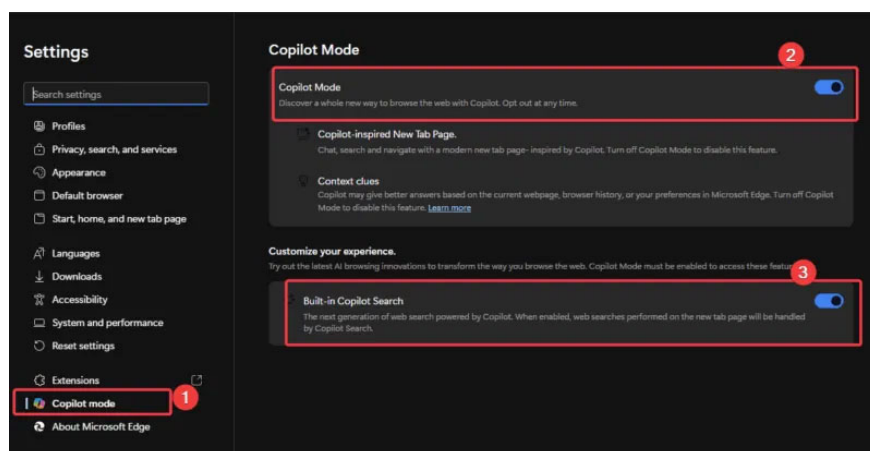
Turn off Copilot features in Microsoft Edge

If you're ready to turn off Copilot in Microsoft Edge, click the three dots in the upper-right corner and select **Settings** .



Look for **Copilot Mode** in the **Settings** menu . If it's hidden, type the following command in the address bar and press **Enter** : `edge://settings/CopilotMode`

Locate and disable the **Copilot Mode** option to restore your browser's new tabs to a simple, easy-to-understand state. This will disable both **Context Clues** and **the Copilot-inspired New Tab Page** .



Scroll down to **Customize your experience** and turn off **Built-in Copilot Search** . This will stop all AI-powered search suggestions.

When you're done, open a new tab to confirm that you've disabled Copilot features in Edge. You'll see a clean, simple tab without the AI ??prompt.

Any changes are permanent until you decide to bring Copilot back by turning the disabled features on. Also, if you change your mind, here's a more detailed guide on how to add Copilot to Edge's new tabs .

Benefits of disabling these Copilot features

Here are the reasons why disabling Copilot in Microsoft Edge is great:

1. You'll have a cleaner, less cluttered looking browser. It feels faster and simpler.
2. Turning these features off makes you less worried about sharing your data to fuel AI processing.
3. Your browsing experience returns to a simple feel without AI pop-ups. You get what you're looking for without too many unnecessary details.
4. Perfect for workplaces or professional environments with strict regulations on AI use.
