

# How to disable the text 'Seen' texting on Facebook

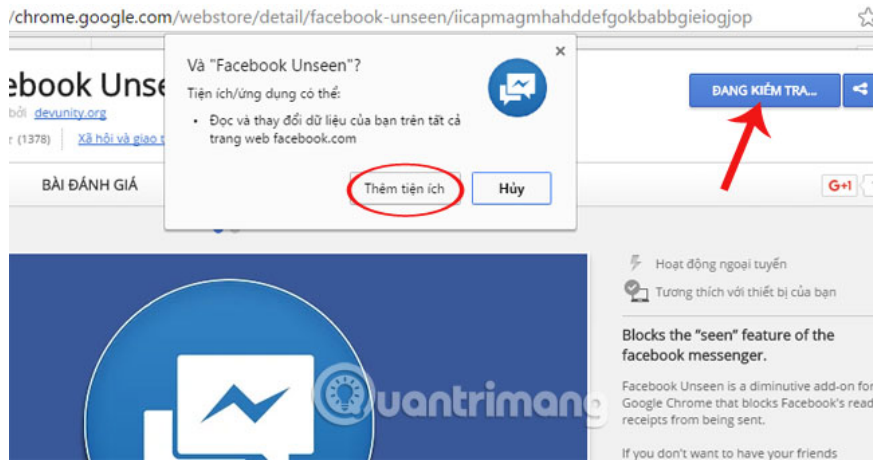
The network administrator will show you how to disable the read feature on Facebook thanks to the **Facebook Unseen utility** available on Google Chrome. When installing the utility on the computer, the sender will not know if the recipient has read the message. However, this disabled ability cannot perform Messenger on mobile.



## Step 1:

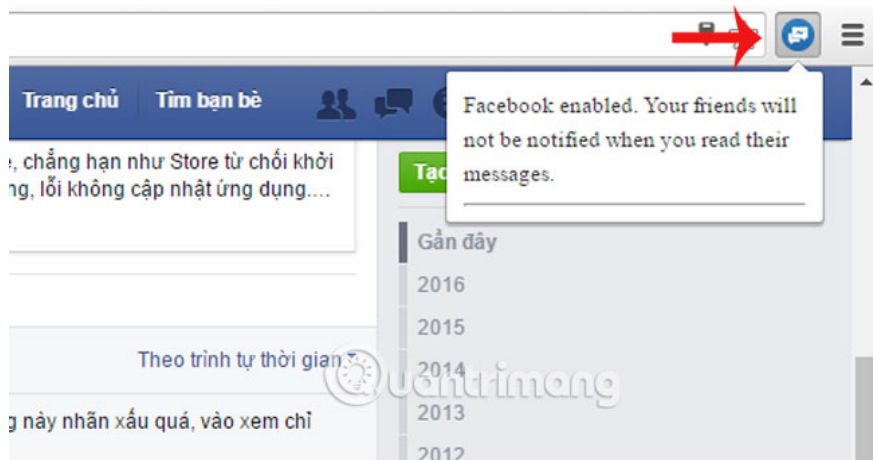
Install Facebook Unseen utility on Google Chrome

1. Download Facebook Unseen for Chrome

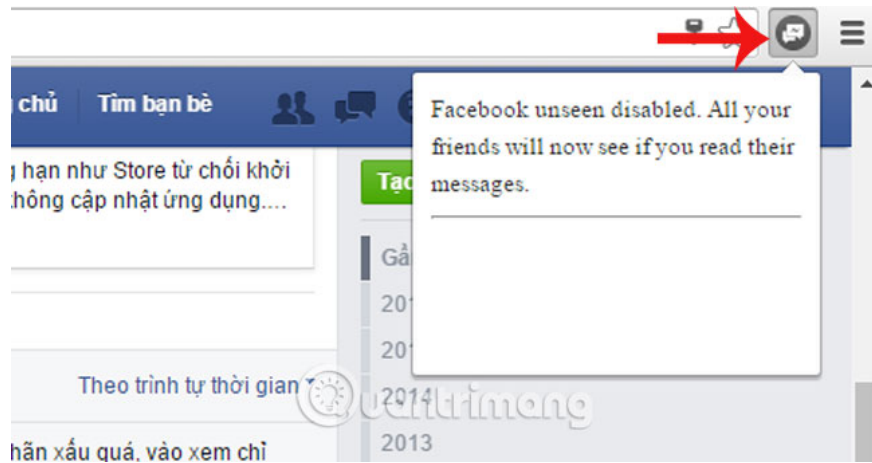


## Step 2:

After installation, on the top right of the screen will display the icon of the gadget. In particular, Facebook Unseen allows users to **enable or disable arbitrary applications**, without disabling the "Seen" notification feature completely.
