

# How to disable Touch ID on iPhone, iPad?

Disable Touch ID for better security, or when you don't need it, turn off Touch ID to make it easier for you. This is how to disable Touch ID on iPhone and iPad for your reference.

Touch ID, also known as fingerprint sensor, is equipped by iPhone 5S and the following generations: iPhone 6, iPhone 6 plus, iPad air 2, iPad mini 3. Touch ID is integrated into the HOME button on the device. Apple iPhone, iPad, and made of sapphire stone can resist scratching to make Touch ID's surface more durable, identify the fingerprint of the user.

Touch ID is integrated into Apple devices to enhance security. Instead of having to type in the password to access the device or download applications from the App Store, now you just need to tap your finger on Touch ID to quickly complete those tasks.

There is no denying the benefit that Touch ID brings. But for better device security, or for whatever reason you don't want to use Touch ID, you can disable Touch ID.



## How to disable Touch ID?

If you want to disable Touch ID completely or just disable it to unlock and access the device, make sure you have enabled passcode on your iOS device to prevent others from using it and accessing it illegally. Your device.

1. Open the **Settings** app on your iPhone or iPad.



2. Go to **Touch ID & Passcode** , enter your passcode when requested.

3. In the **Use Touch ID for section**, turn off some of the options needed to turn off the Touch ID feature (turn off all settings if you want to completely disable Touch ID):



- **iPhone Unlock** (or iPad Unlock): turn off this feature to disable Touch ID, to unlock and access the device.
- **Apple Pay** : switch this feature to **OFF** to prevent Touch ID from being used on Apple Pay.
- **iTunes & App Store**: convert this setting to OFF to **disable the Touch ID used on App Store and iTunes for a fee.**

4. Make sure you have enabled Passcode, then exit the Settings application.
