

How to disinfect clothes at home to prevent the Covid-19 epidemic

If the clothes are made from a heat-resistant material, we can use physical methods to disinfect them. Specifically, put clothes at a temperature of 56 degrees C for 30 minutes or put them in a clothes dryer and adjust the temperature above 80 degrees C and dry for 20 minutes.



If your clothes are made of poor heat-resistant materials, you can disinfect them using specialized antibacterial fabric sprays or chemicals. Common and recommended disinfectants include phenolic, quaternary ammonium salts or chlorine-containing disinfectants. However, be sure to read the directions on the package before use to ensure the safety of both your health and your clothing.
