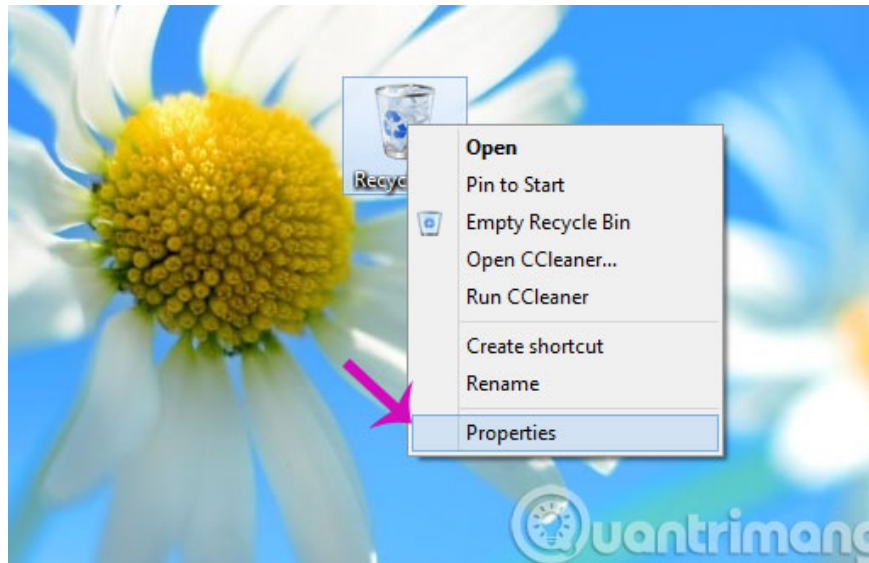

1. Download Windows 7 Professional (32-bit)
2. Download Windows 8 Pro

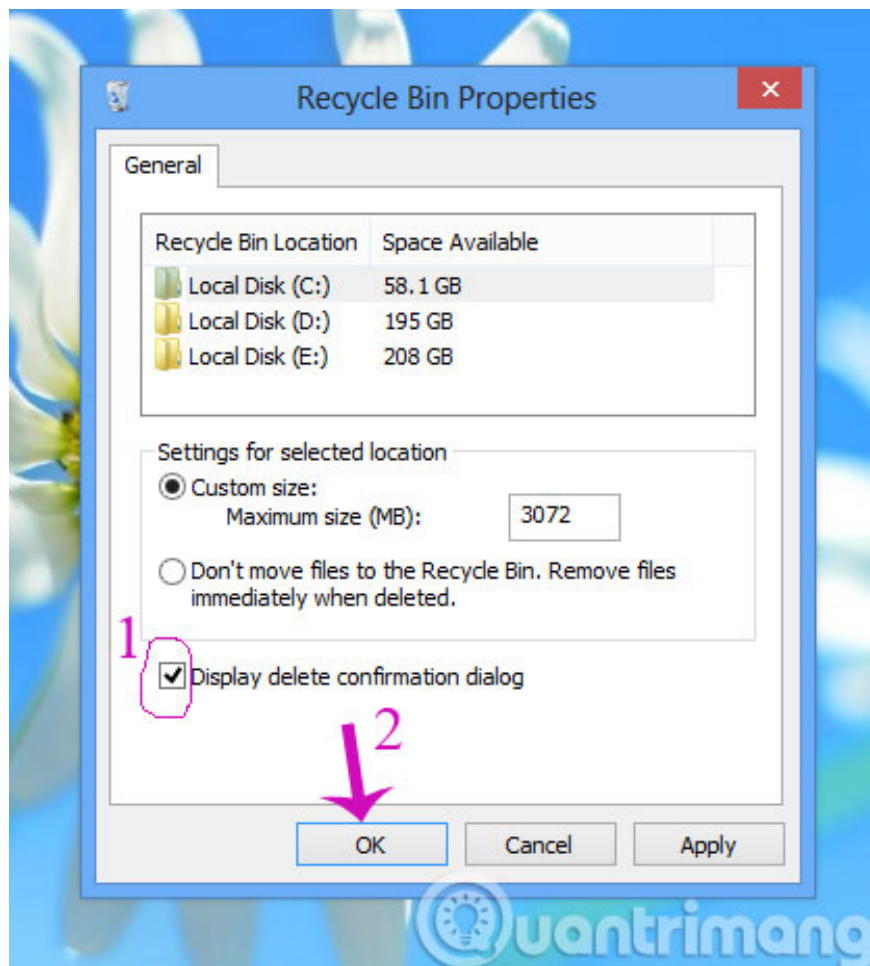
This makes it convenient for users to not have to manipulate too much, but it also causes many inconveniences, especially for those who occasionally neglect to delete important files, then clean the trash without checking. What data is in the trash. Consequently, you may lose important data.

To avoid this, you can restore the confirmation dialog that appears when deleting the file to ensure a thorough check before deleting. If you don't know how to do it, you can refer to our guide below.

Step 1 : From the Desktop screen, right-click **the trash icon** and select **Properties**



Step 2 : In the **Recycle Bin Properties** dialog box, click on the box **Display delete confirmation dialog** to display the message when deleting. Then click **OK** to finish.



So, with just 2 simple steps above, you have to show the confirmation message of deleting the file on Windows 8, avoiding the case of mistakenly deleting.
