

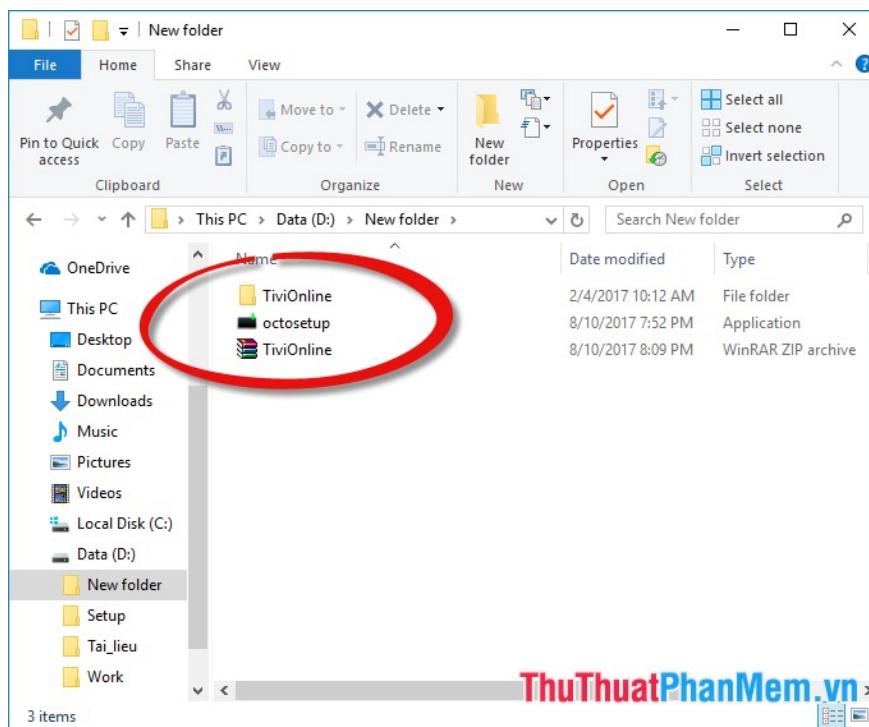

How to display file extensions (file extensions) in Windows 10. There are two ways to display file extensions (file extensions) in Windows 10.

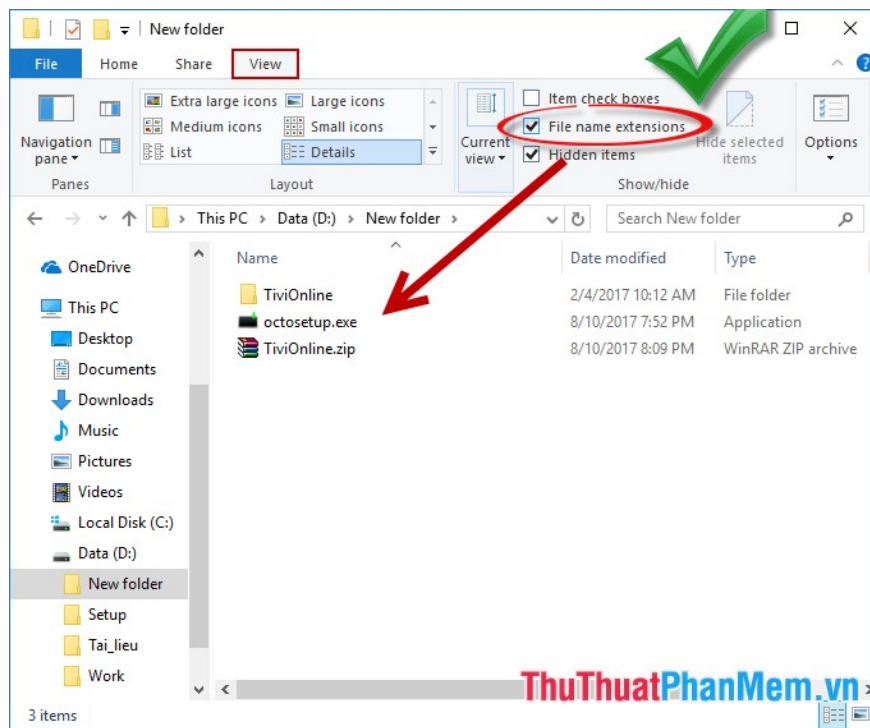
There are 2 ways to **display file extensions (file extensions) in Windows 10.**

- For example, the image below, the data file does not display the file format:

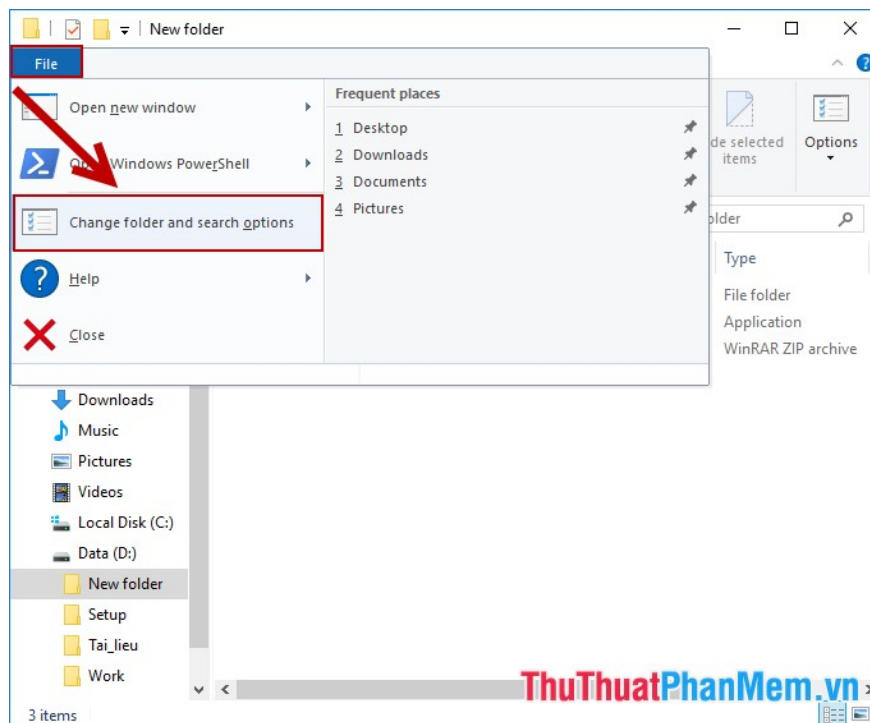


- You just need to go to the **View** tab -> in the **Show / Hide** section, select the **File name Extensions** section -> the data file displays the file extension, very useful for users to use:

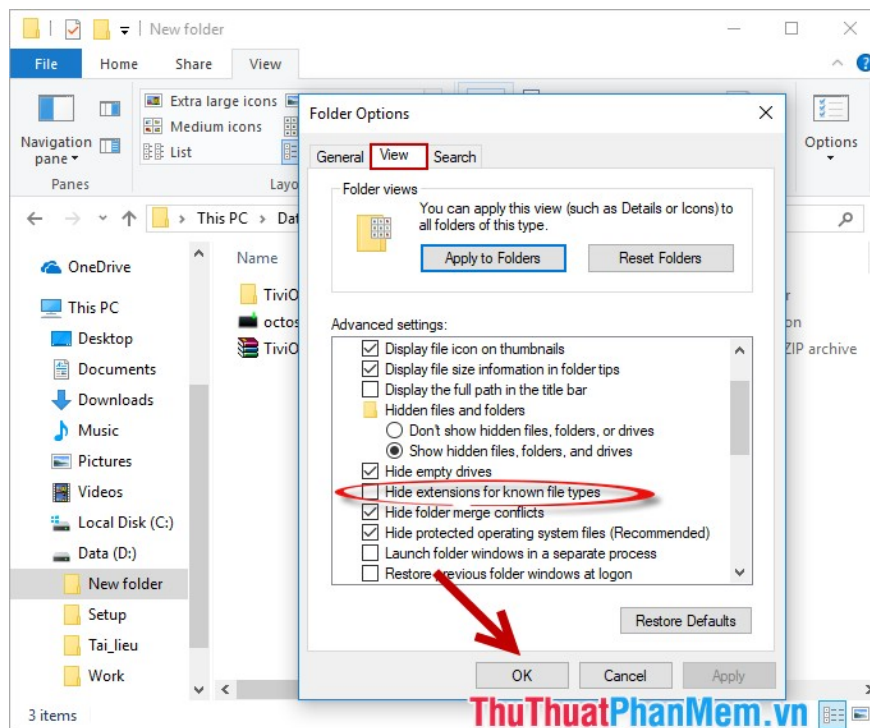


Method 2:

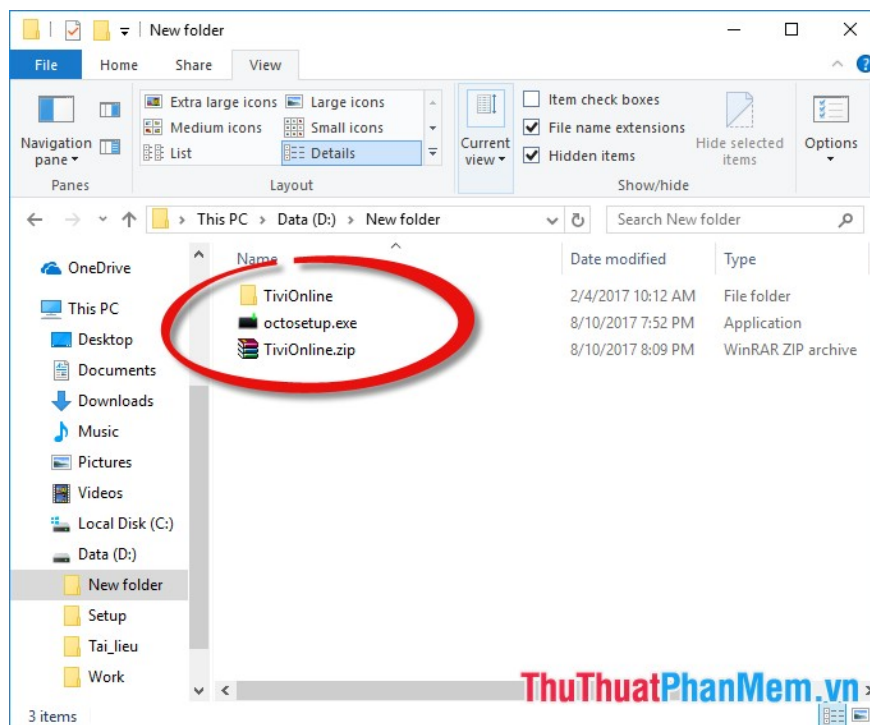
- Go to **File** -> **Change folder and search option**:



- **Folder Option dialog box** appears, select **View** tab -> move to **Hide Extensions for know file types** -> **OK**:



- After clicking **OK**, the file format is displayed:
