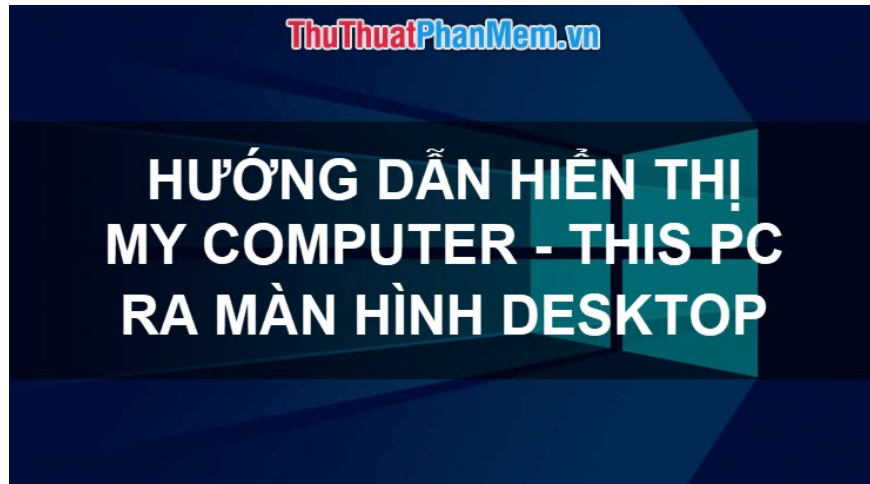


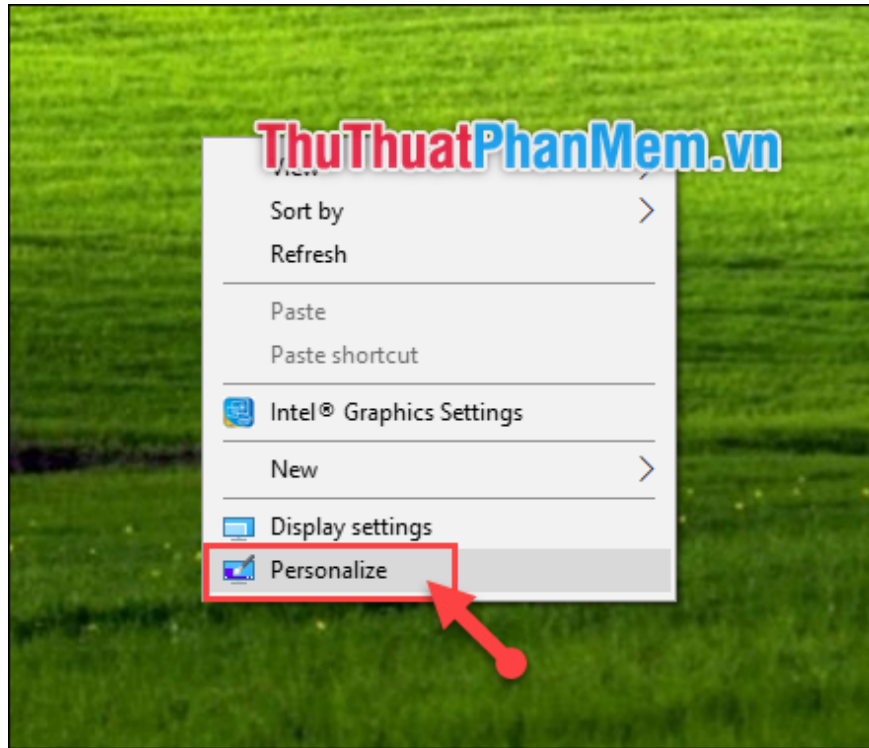
# How to display My Computer (This PC) on the Windows 10 Desktop screen

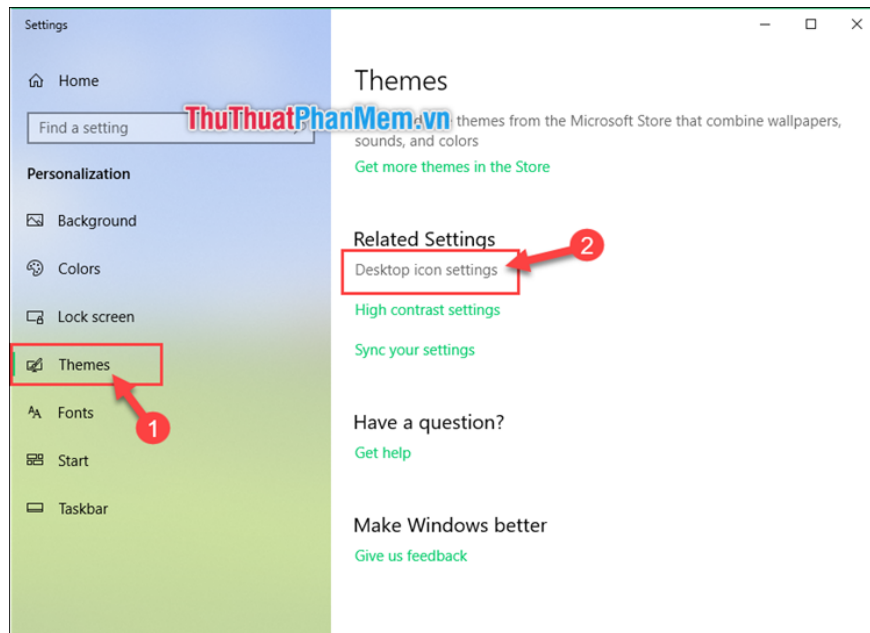

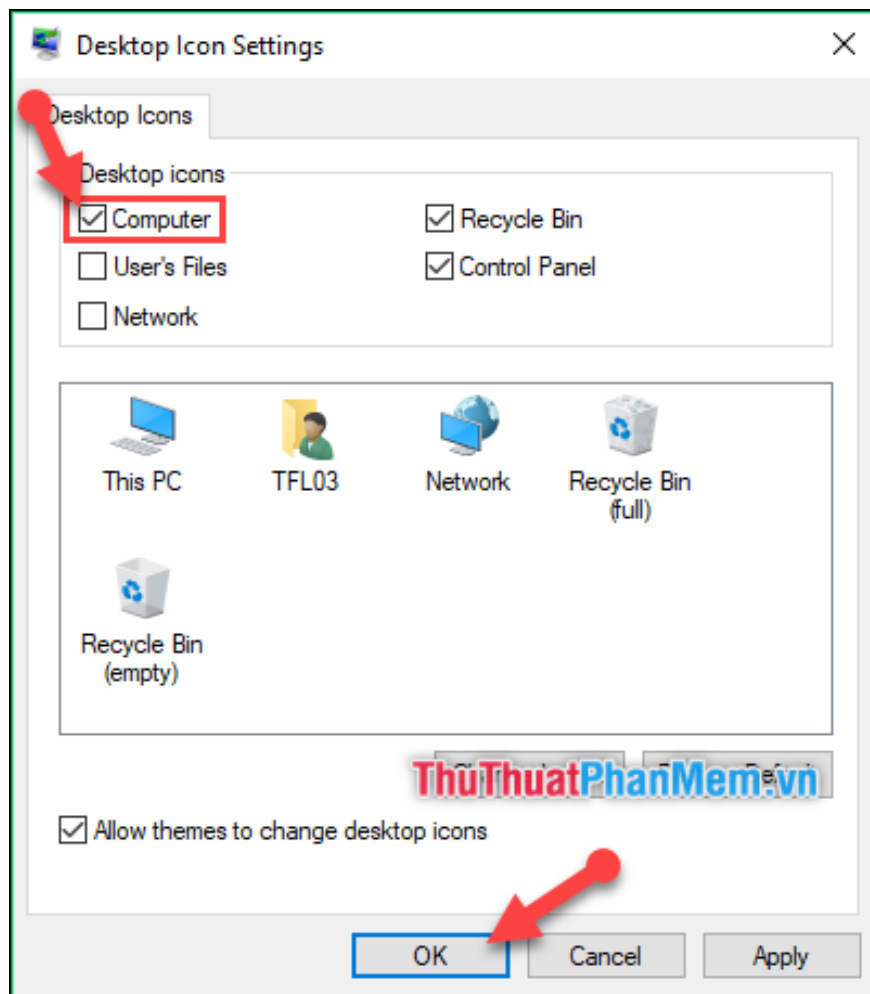
**Step 1** : At the desktop, right-click -> then select *Personalize*.
