You want to display the comma delimited thousands for easy reading. Here's how you can show thousands separator commas in Excel.

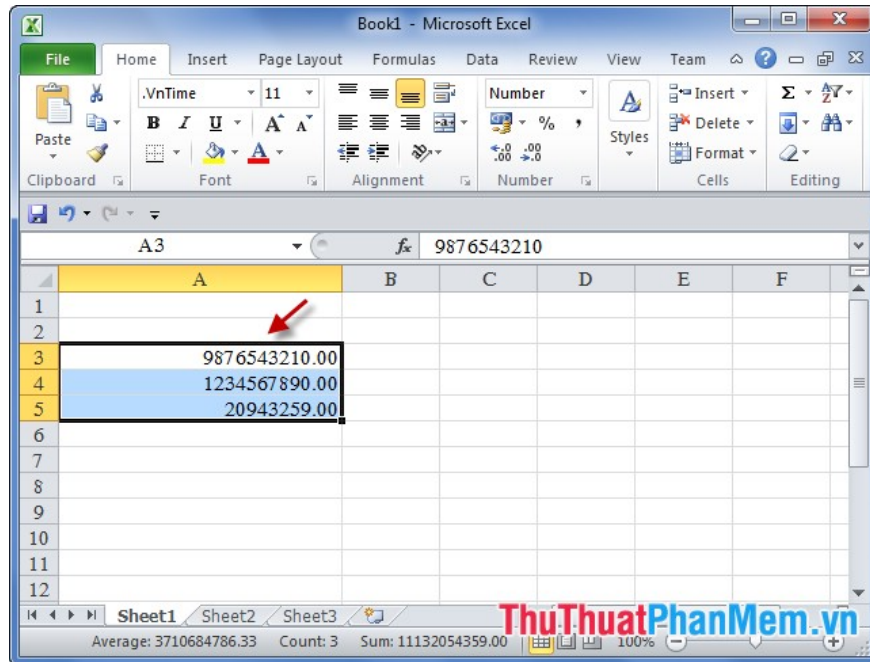


9,876,543,210.00

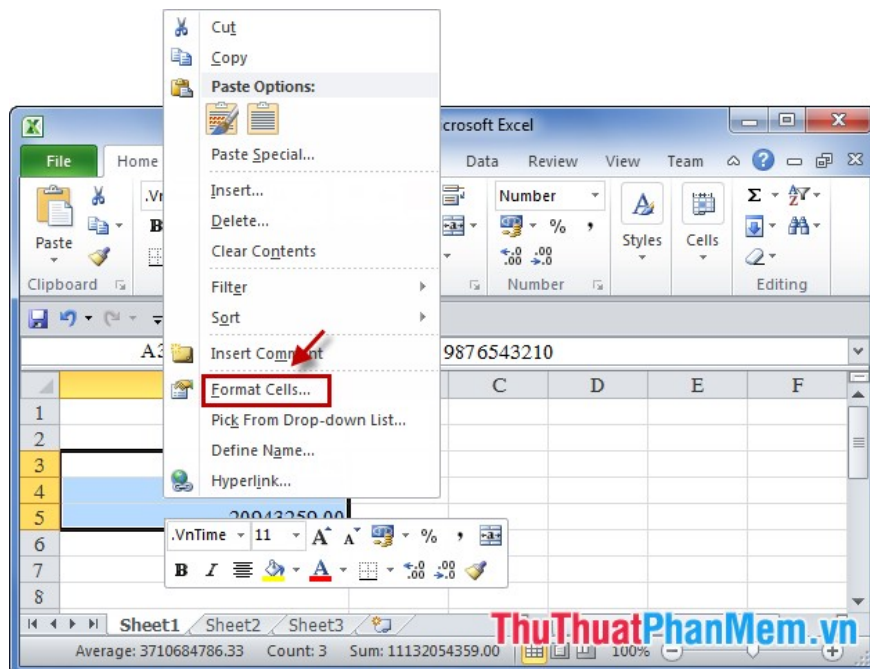
123,456,789.00

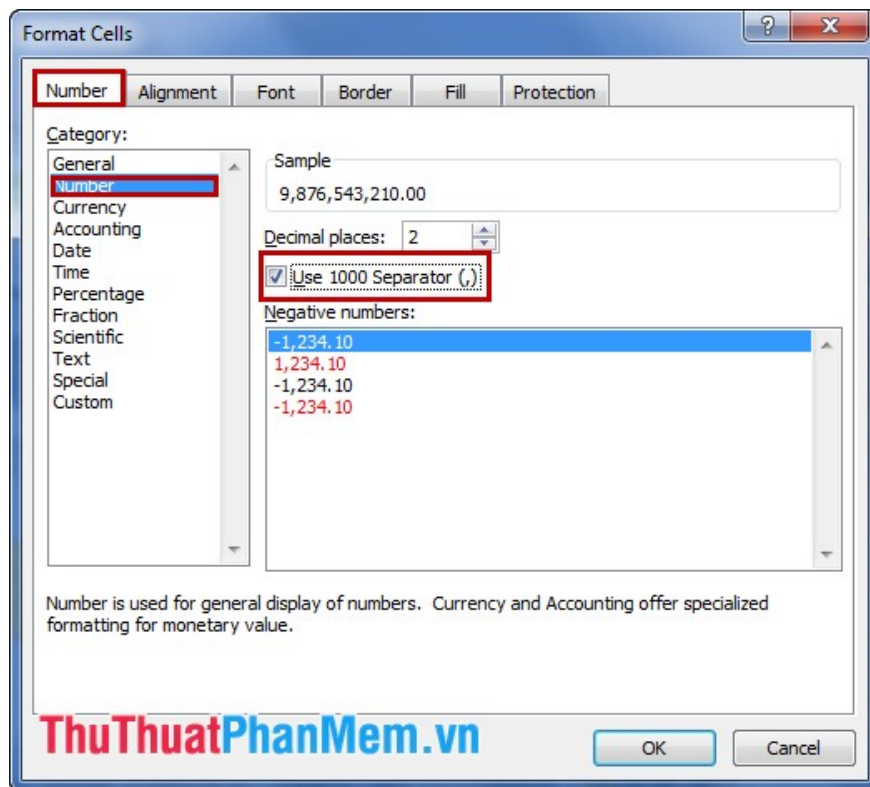
Step 1: Highlight **Cells** that need to display the thousands separator in Excel.



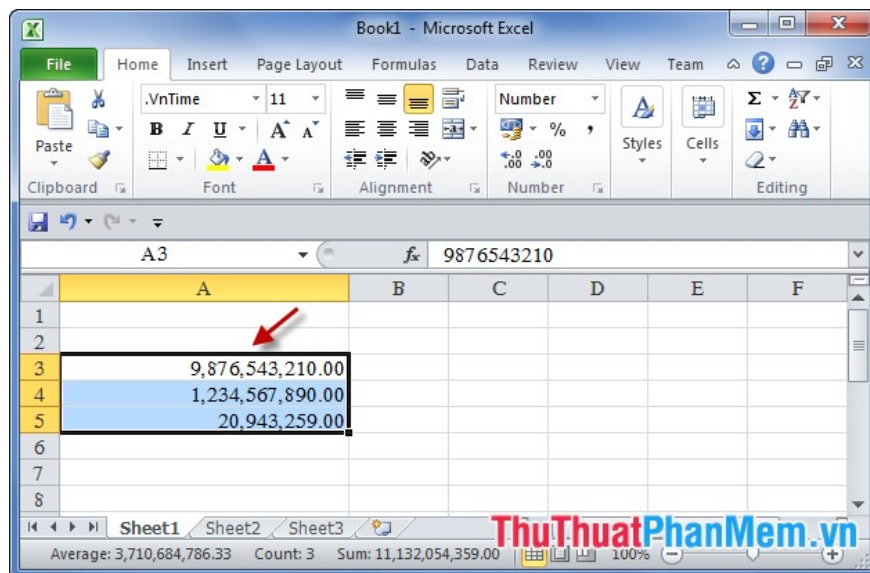
Step 2: Right-click and select **Format Cells** (or **Ctrl + 1** key combination).



Step 3: In the **Format Cells** select the **Number** tab **Number** , then tick the box before *the Use 1000 Separator* (,) and press **OK** .



You see the results below:



With the above steps, you can display thousands comma separated in Excel. It is very simple and easy to read, no matter how large the number, you don't mind reading them. From now on you can comfortably work with large numbers without worrying about confusion because of the thousands separator.
