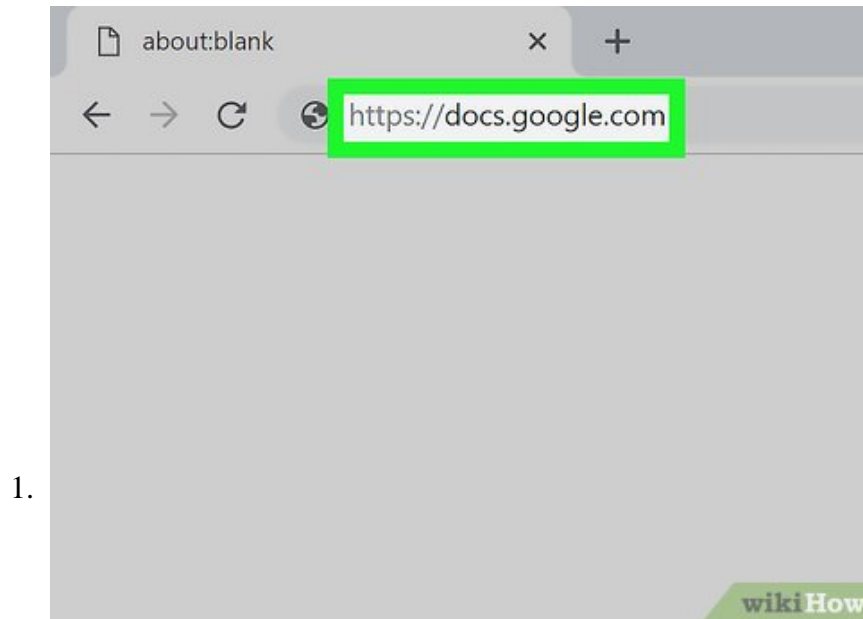


# How to Do a Word Count on Google Docs

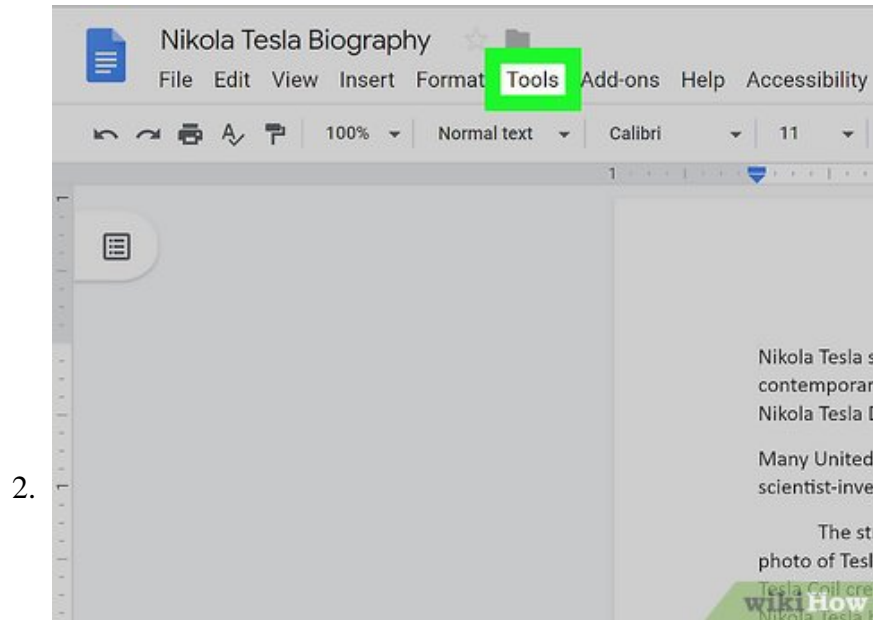

Method 1 of 2:

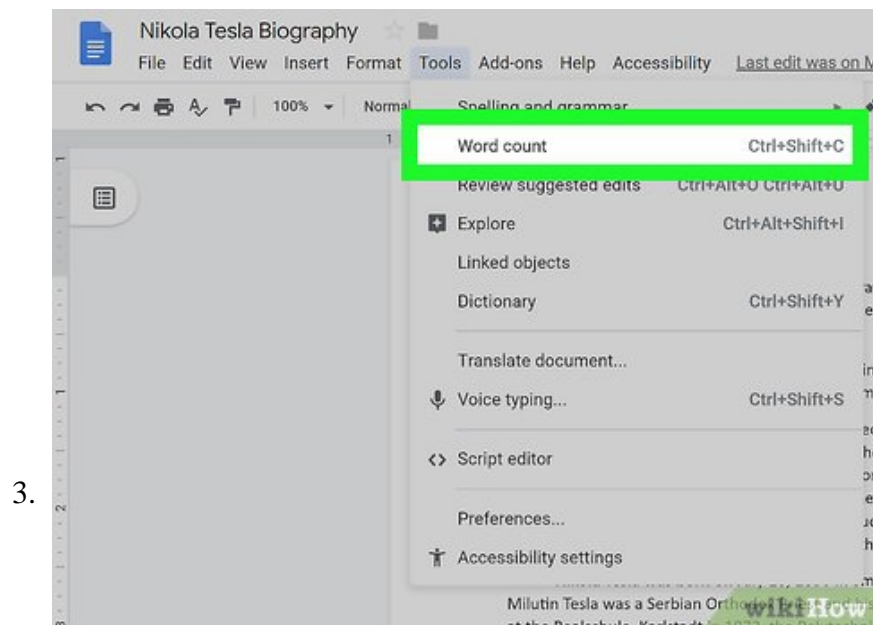
## Using a Computer



**Open your Google Doc at <https://docs.google.com>.** Log in to your Google account if prompted. This method works for both Windows and Mac computers.<sup>[1]</sup> You can also open saved documents that you didn't create in Google Docs.



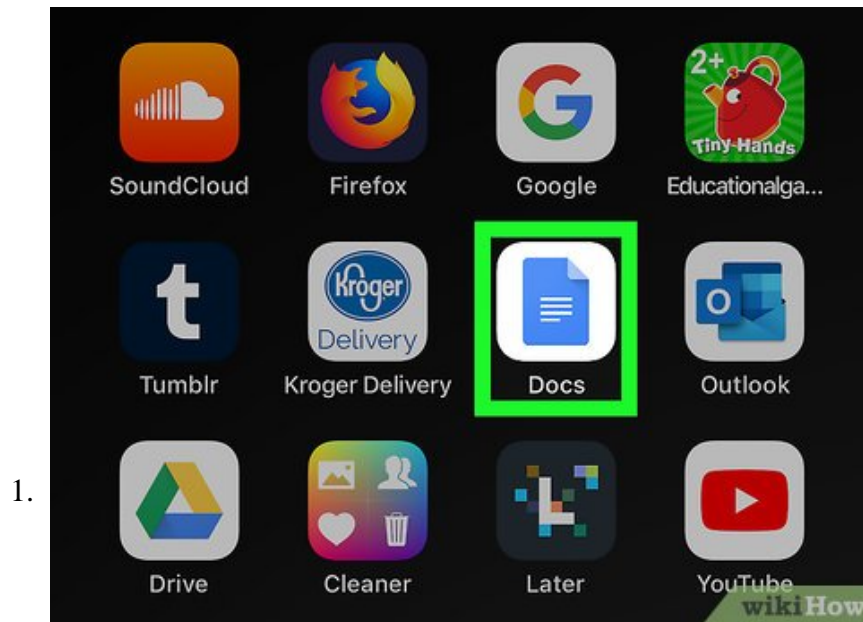
Click the **Tools** tab. You'll find this above the document.



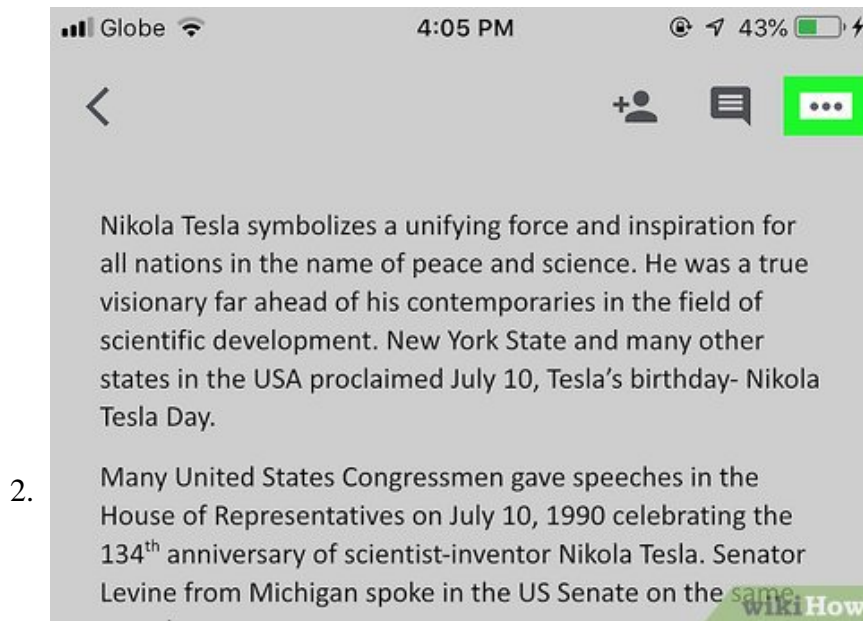
Click **Word Count**. You'll see a list of counts, including how many pages are in the document, words, characters, and characters except spaces.

Method 2 of 2:

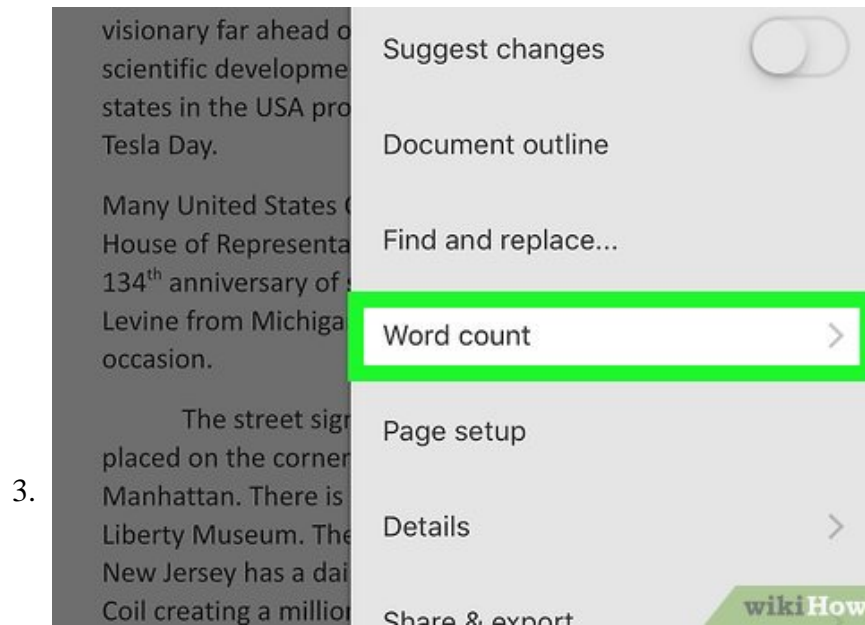
## Using the App



**Open your Google Doc in the app.** This app looks like a blue page with a corner folded. You can find this app on your home screen, in the app drawer, or by searching. You can also open saved documents that you didn't create in Google Docs.



Tap  (Android) or  (iOS).

Tap **Word Count**. You'll see a list of counts, including how many pages are in the document, words, characters, and characters except spaces.
