

How to downgrade iOS 17.4 to 17.3 without jailbreak, should I update iOS 17.4?

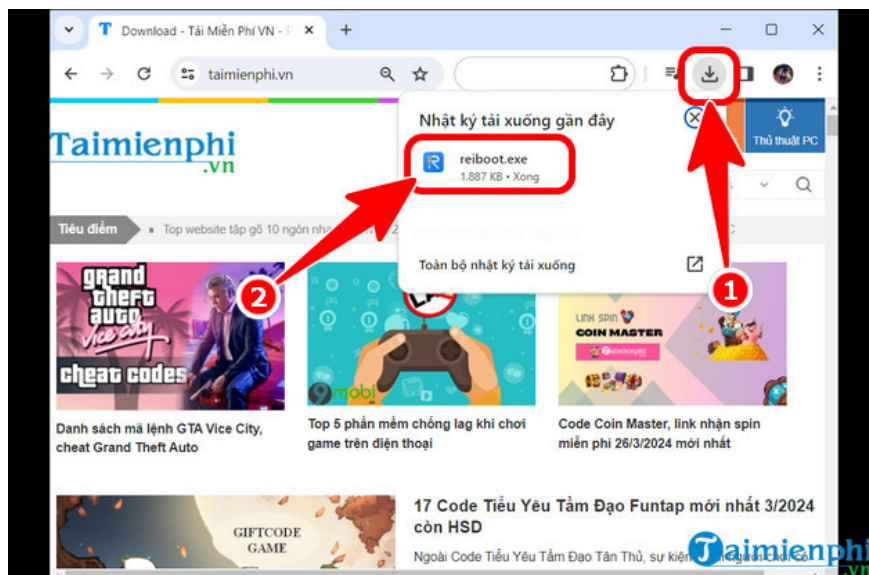

Instructions for downgrading iOS 17.4 to 17.3 without problems

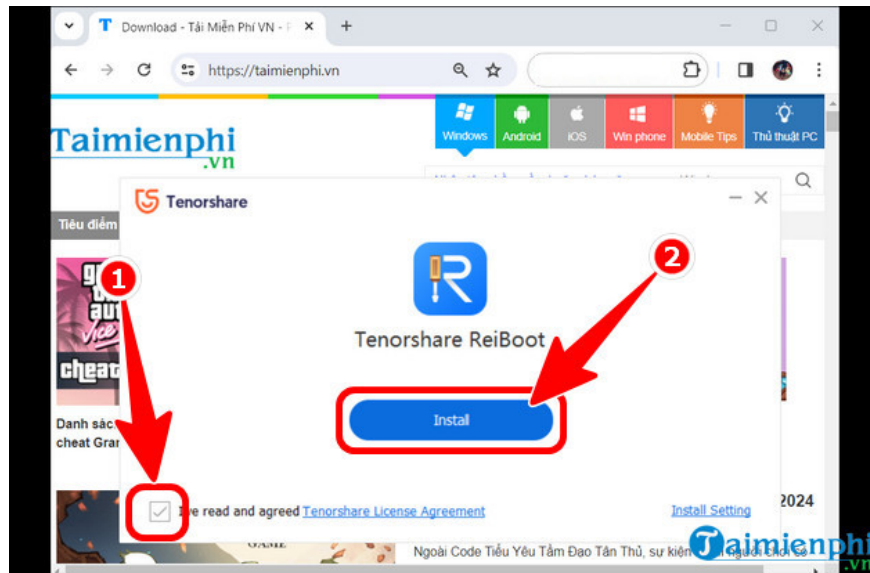
Note:* Downgrading the iOS 17.4 operating system to 17.3 can lead to loss of important data, so to ensure safety, users should **back up iCloud before doing so.

Step 1: Access the **ReiBoot** software download link here.

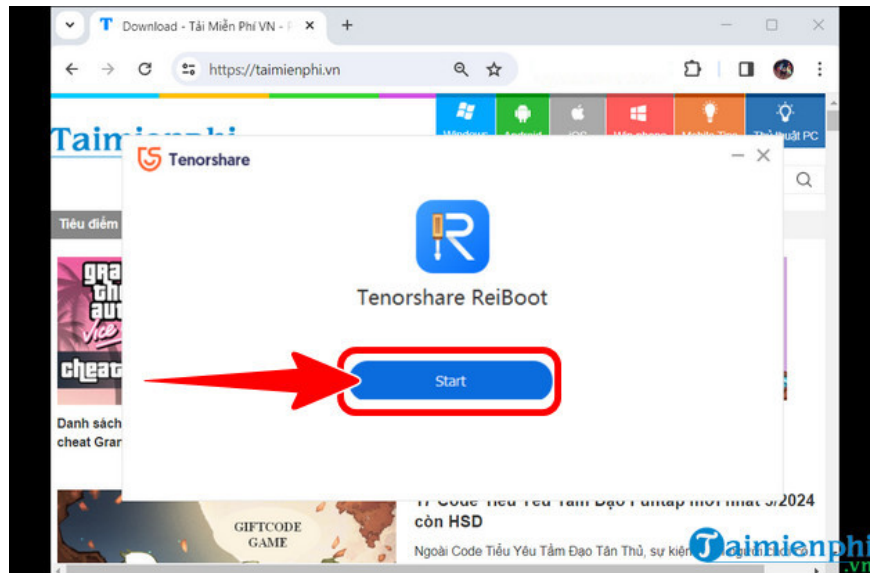
- Open **recent download log** => click **reiboot.exe** file to install the software.



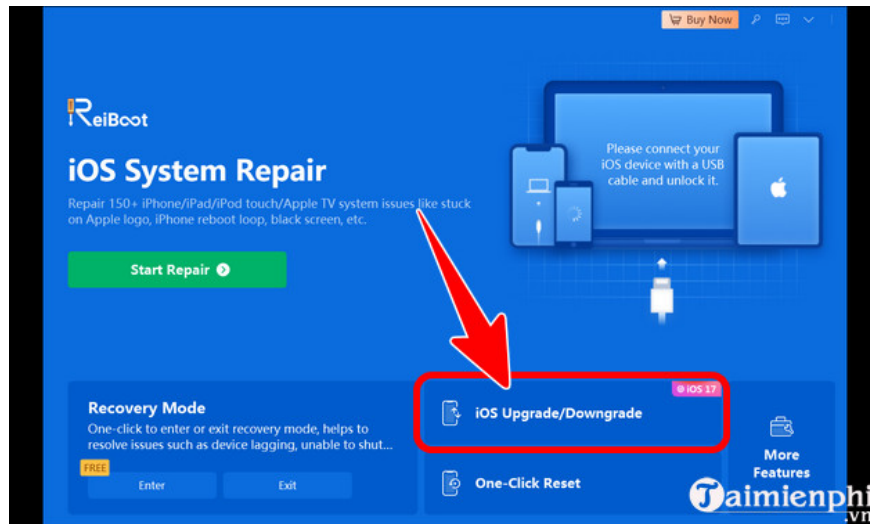
- Check the box to agree to the terms => **Install** .



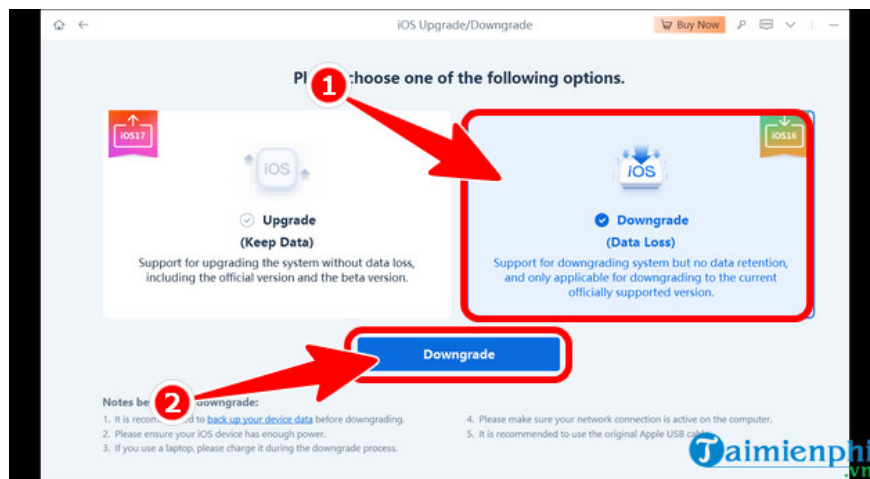
- Click **Start** , start using the software.



Step 2: Select **iOS Upgrade/Downgrade** .



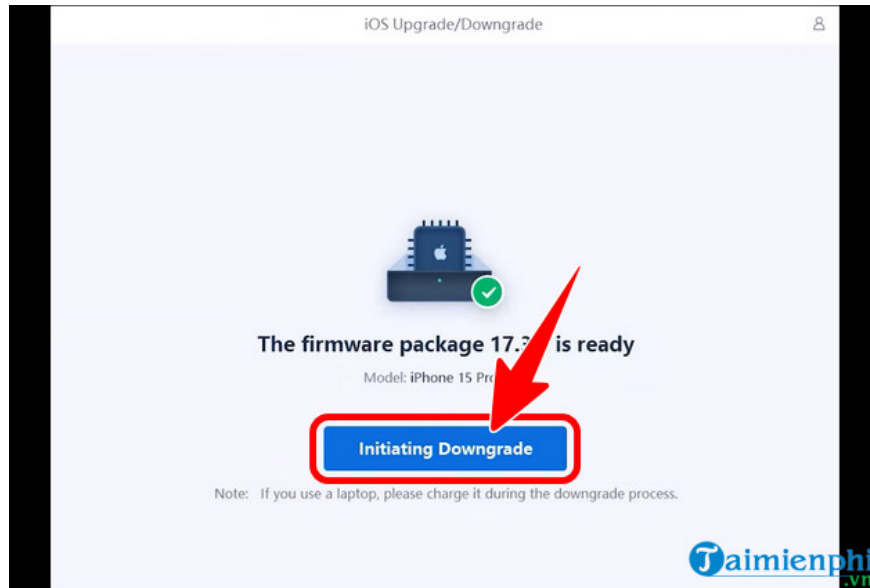
Step 3: Connect your iPhone to the computer , click **Downgrade (Data Loss)** => continue to press **Downgrade** .



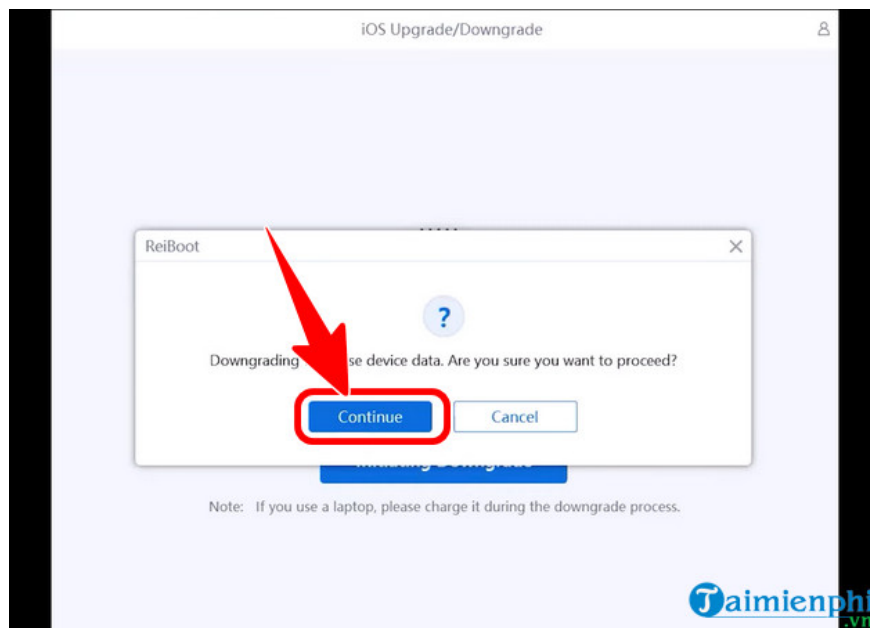
- **Firmware Version 17.3** option => **Download** .



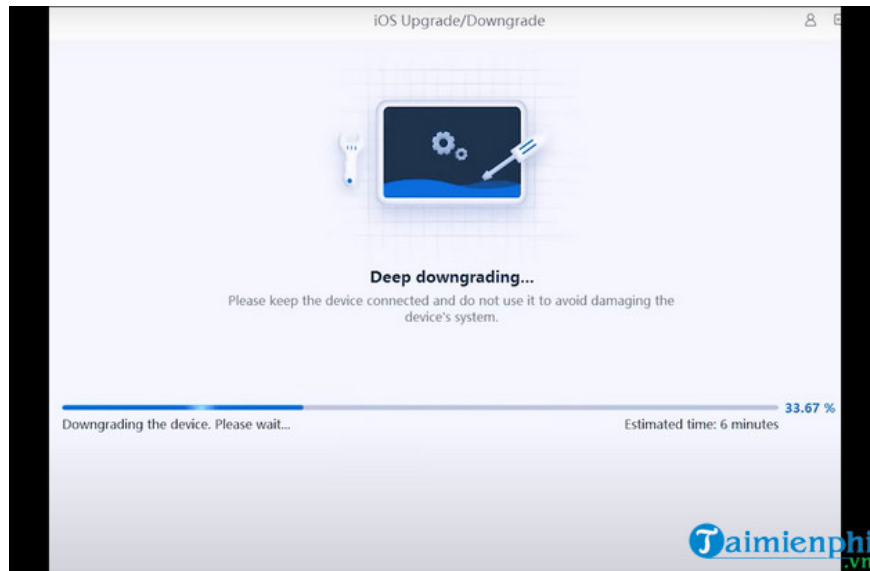
Step 4: After the system downloads the iOS 17.3 version, click **Initiating Downgrade** .



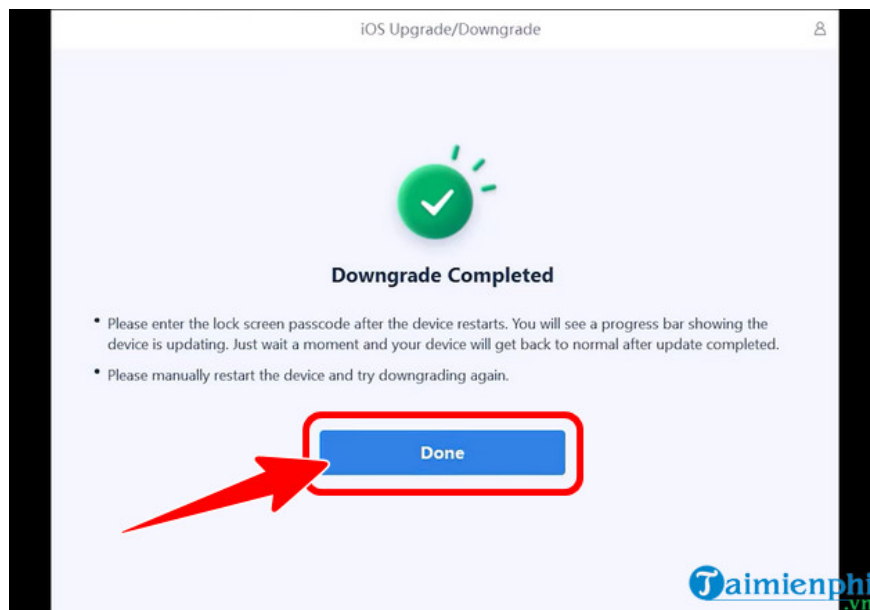
- Click **Continue** .



- Immediately, the system will automatically **downgrade iOS 17.4 to 17.3** as shown below. At this time, make sure your iPhone is stably connected to your PC.



Step 5: A **Downgrade Completed** message will display as shown below, click **Done** to complete the downgrade process. Then proceed with **iCloud data recovery** and set up your device again.



Why do you want to downgrade iOS 17.4 to 17.3?

Depending on usage needs, many users need to downgrade from iOS version 17.4 to 17.3 such as:

- **Stability:** Some users may experience stability issues after updating to iOS 17.4 version. This may include operating system errors, system slowdowns, or potential battery drain.
- **Performance:** iPhone/iPad devices may experience reduced performance after updating to iOS 17.4, especially for older iPhones.
