

# How to download Dropbox file right on Facebook Messenger

Alfredo Bot is integrated on Facebook Messenger web version so users can send files from Facebook Messenger such as images, videos or any other data file directly to Dropbox cloud storage.

The integration of more bots on Facebook Messenger web version helps users to experience a lot of other interesting features right on Messenger, without having to install some other utilities to support.

In today's article, Network Administrator wants to introduce readers to Alfredo on Facebook Messenger, with support for uploading files to Dropbox right from the Messenger computer. Users can download all files from images, videos, data to individual Dropbox accounts via Messenger. So how does the Alfredo bot use on Facebook Messenger to upload the data file directly to the Dropbox account?

## Step 1:

First of all, please log in to your personal Facebook account on your computer. Then click on the link below to link directly to Alfredo bot.

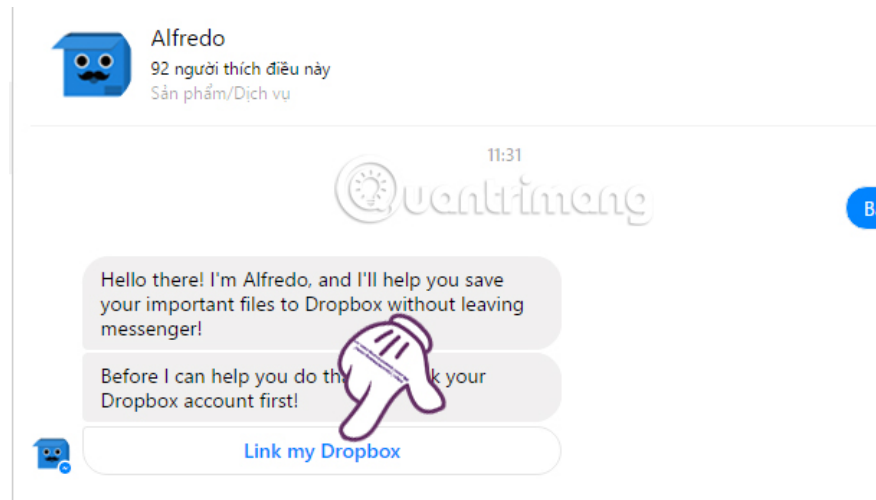
## Step 2:

At this interface, users click on the **Start** word below.



### Step 3:

Soon, Alfredo will give us a notice, click **Link my Dropbox** to link directly to the personal Dropbox account.

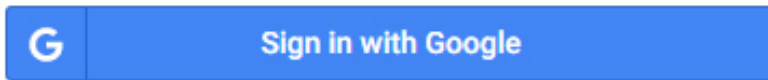


### Step 4:

In this new interface, enter all the information of your personal Dropbox account and click **Sign in** below to login.

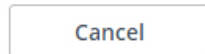

Alfredo Bot will ask users to allow **access to Dropbox accounts** , click **Allow** to agree.

## Step 5:

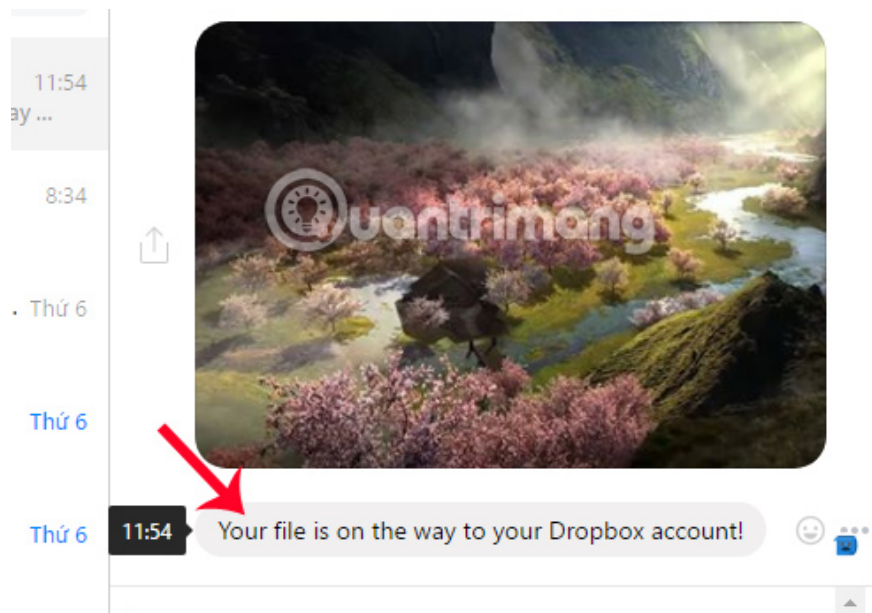
When we receive the following message, it means we can use the Alfredo bot on Messenger. Now the reader goes back to the Facebook Messenger interface on your computer.

Your Dropbox account was successfully linked! You can close this tab and go back to messenger.



## Step 6:

If you want to upload any data to Dropbox right from Facebook Messenger, we just need to drag and drop the file on the computer folder into the Messenger interface, or use the file download icon on the Messenger page. When downloading photos, videos, or certain files to Messenger successfully, you will receive a notification sent from the Alfredo bot as shown below.



Check the Dropbox account will see the data file you just uploaded.
