

How to download files on Google Drive that are blocked from downloading

Currently, many files on Google Drive are blocked from downloading, downloading PDF files or many other files and then you cannot save documents for reference if needed, in case the file is deleted from the owner.

Many files on Google Drive have been blocked from downloading files. This will affect you when you want to download the file to reference the content. If so, you can use some of the ways below to download files on Google Drive that are blocked from downloading. We will use online tools to download files on Google Drive or we can customize them to download right in the browser. The article below will guide you to download files on blocked Google Drive.

Instructions for downloading Google Drive video files that are blocked from downloading

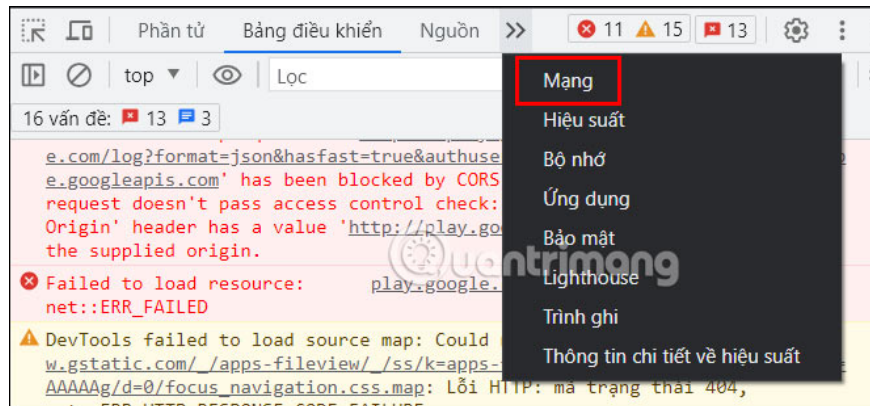
Step 1:

For example, videos downloaded on Google Drive have been blocked from downloading as shown. Press **the key combination Ctrl + Shift + I** to open the developer tools interface.



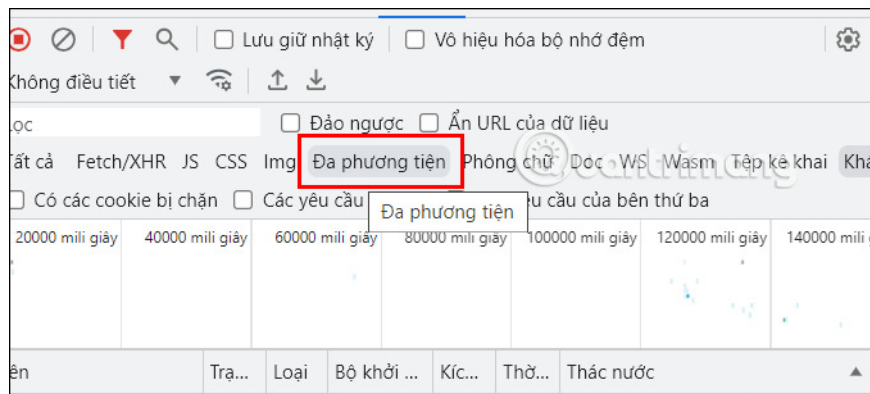
Step 2:

Displayed on the right edge of the developer content screen, we click on the **arrow icon** as shown and then click on **Network** in the displayed list.

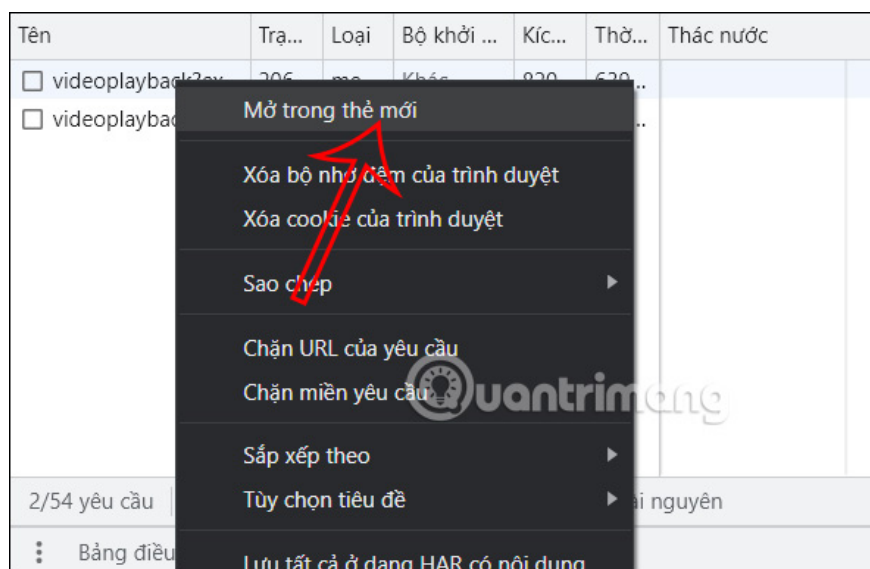


Step 3:

Next, **click on the Multimedia** tab to access existing media files in the browser. We will **play the video** to identify the URL of this video.

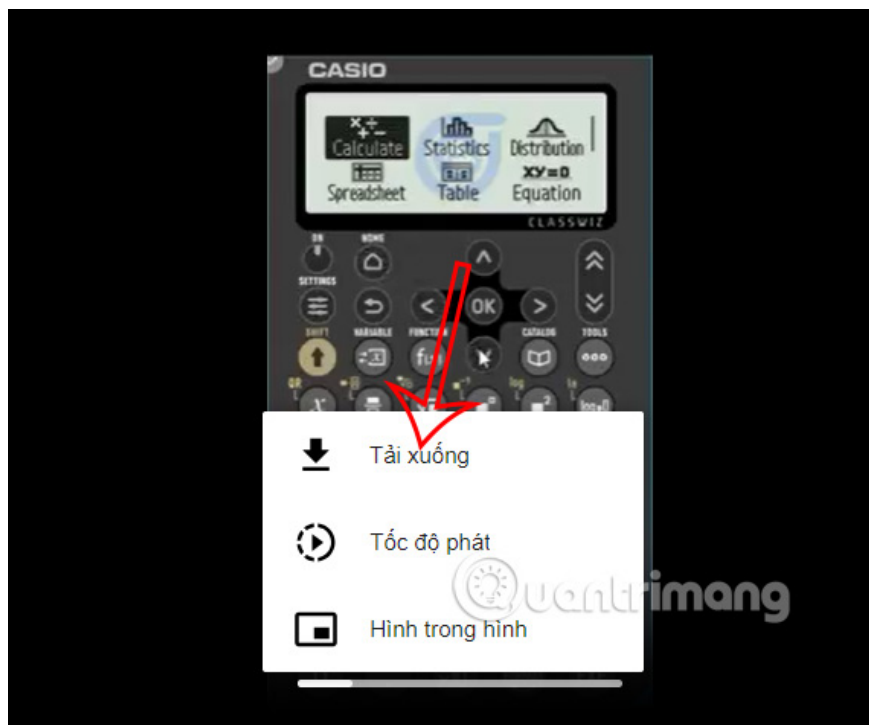


As a result, you will see the original video link available on Google Drive that we want to download. **Right-click on this video URL** and select **Open in new tab** in the list of options on your browser.



Step 4:

You will immediately see videos blocked from loading on Google Drive. We just need to click on **the 3 vertical dots icon** and select **Download** to download this video file as usual.



Instructions for downloading files on Drive that are blocked from downloading using pdf.dotool

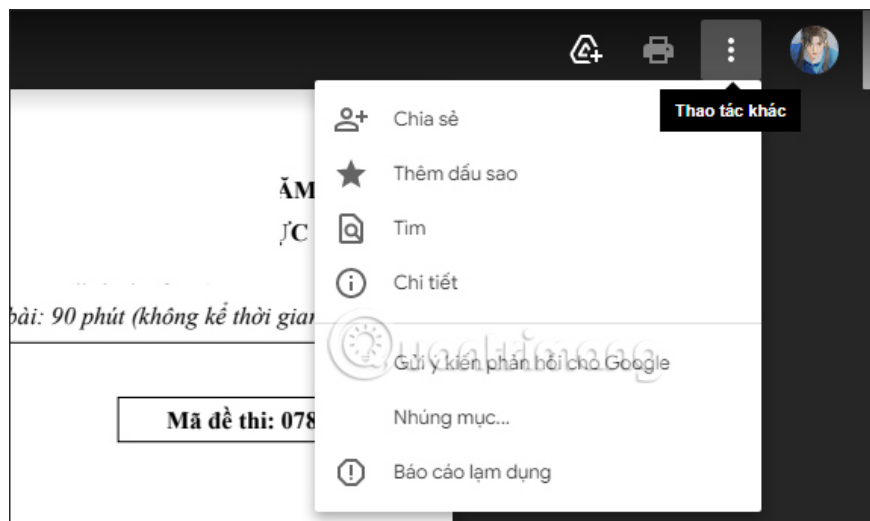
The pdf.dotool website will support downloading all files on Google Drive that are blocked from downloading with the file formats pdf, .doc, .docx, .ppt, .pptx Google Drive is blocked from downloading.

Step 1:

You access the pdf.dotool website by following the link below.

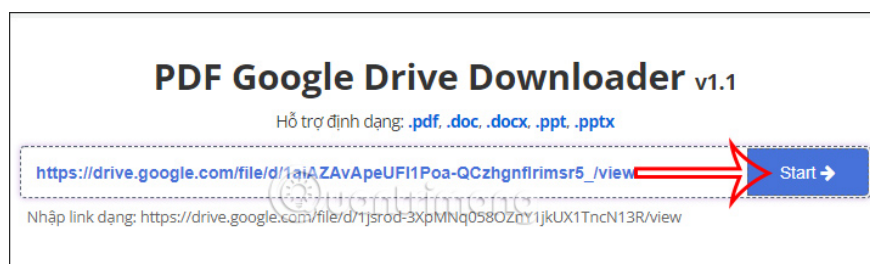

Next, we open the file on Google Drive that is blocked from downloading, such as the PDF file below and **copy the file URL** .



Step 2:

Then you access the website pdf.dotool according to the link above, **paste the URL of the PDF file** on Google Drive that is blocked from downloading, then **click the Start button** to continue.

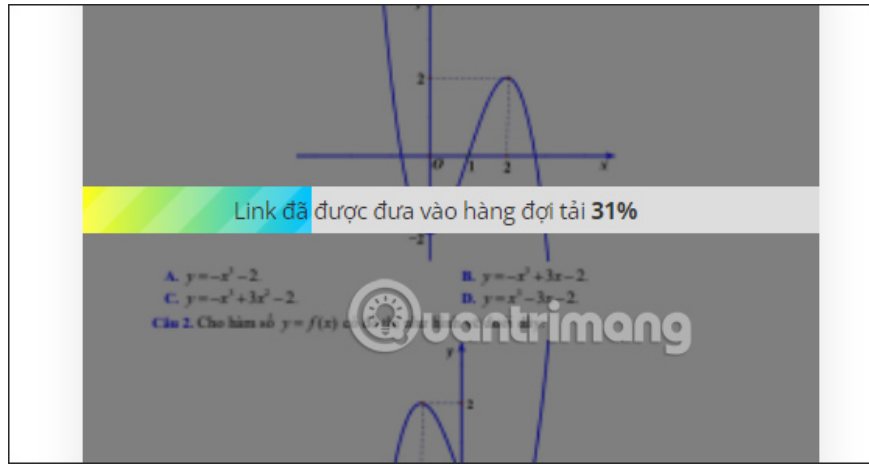


Step 3:

You will then see the number of pages currently in this PDF file and we select Low quality to download the PDF file for a free account. **Click Download** to queue to download the file.

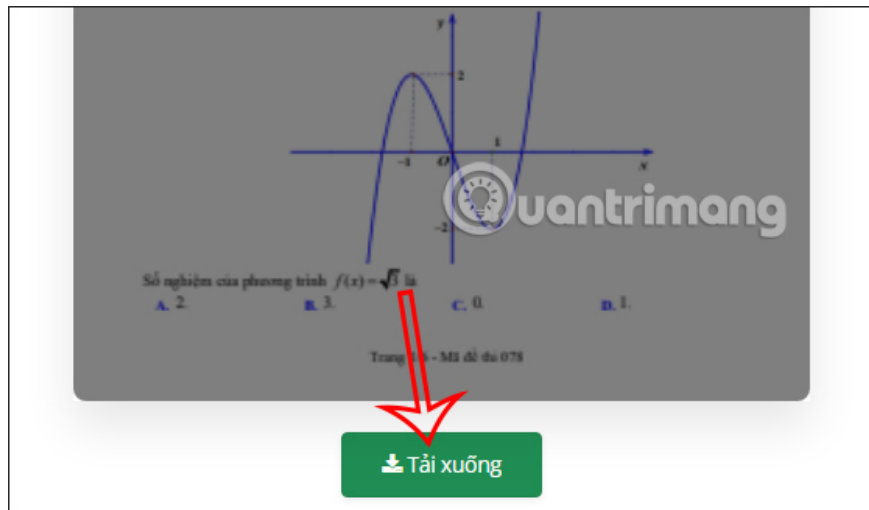


Immediately after that, the process of getting link to download will be carried out. If the number of pages in the file to download is large, this process will take more time.

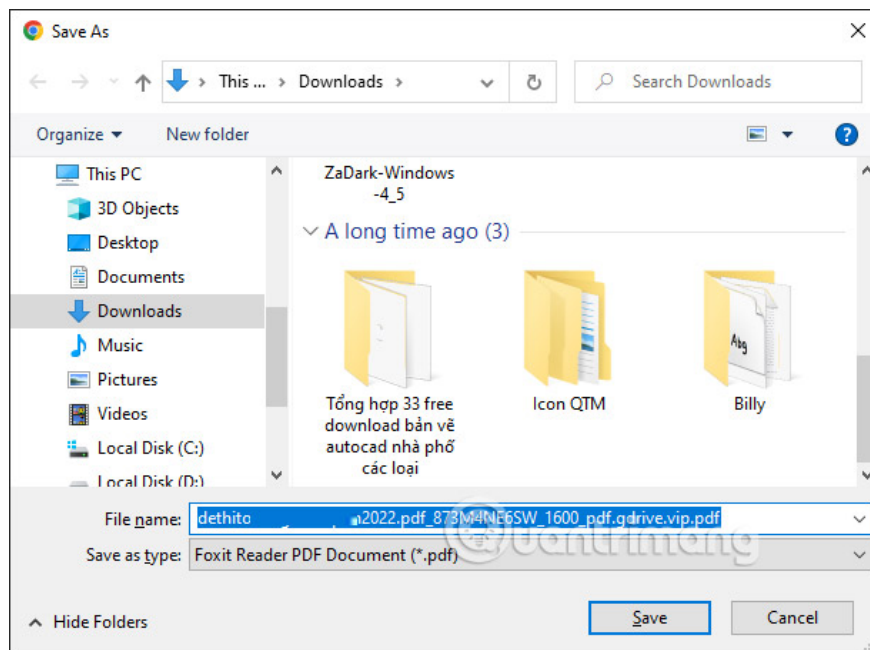


Step 4:

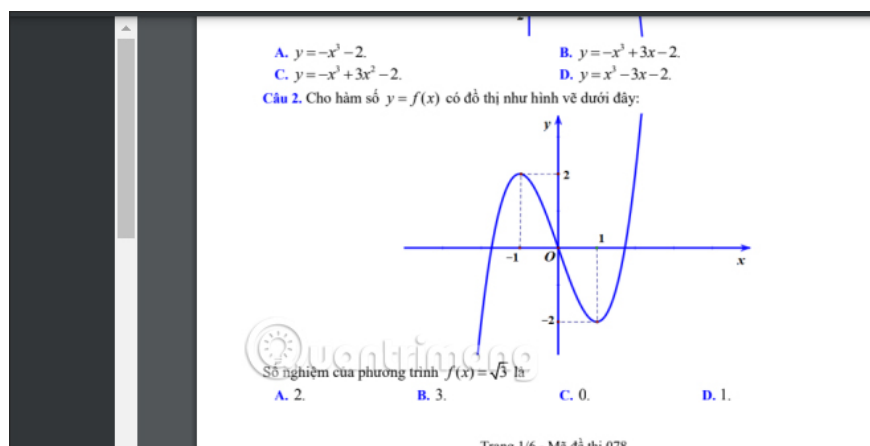
As a result, you will see the PDF file downloaded, **click the Download button** as usual.



Display a folder for you to save PDF files on your computer as usual.



PDF files are saved on the computer and can be opened with PDF file reading software or other document reading software that you use on your computer, or if you want to edit PDF files, you need to use additional PDF file editing software. .



During the process of using pdf.dotool to download blocked Drive files, there will be cases where pdf.dotool does not receive the link and you cannot download the blocked Google Drive file. Press F5 to reload the website and then re-paste the file URL or Leave a comment on the website to receive support from the website's technical team.
