

How to download videos from Youtube to USB for viewing on cars

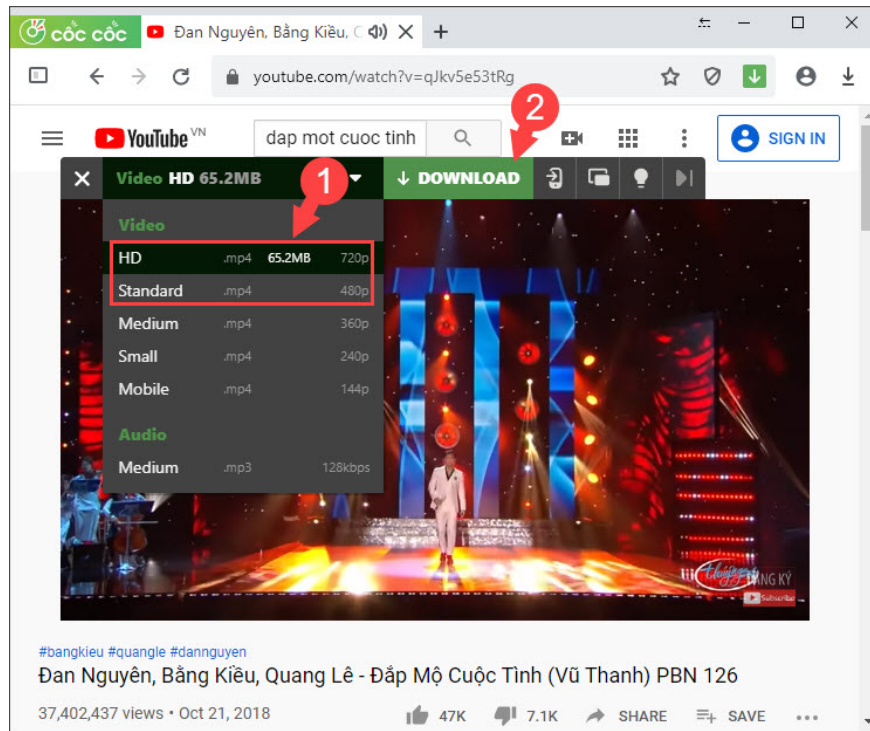
The default video downloaded from Youtube cannot be viewed on car DVD players because the video standard is not compatible and let's find a fix in the following article.

Youtube is the largest video source on the Internet and here, we can download videos and watch them anywhere and on mobility devices like cars. However, the default video downloaded from Youtube cannot be viewed on car DVD players because the video standard is not compatible and let's find a fix in the following article.



1. Download videos from Youtube to your device

There are many ways to download youtube videos to your device. The easiest way is to use the Coc Coc browser to download videos. When you choose the download video resolution should be set to **HD 720p** or **Standard 480p** (1) and then click **Download** (2) .



Instead of downloading Coc Coc, you can combine Firefox, Chrome, Microsoft Edge . with Internet Download Manager to download videos from Youtube. You should remember to choose **720p** or **480p** (1) video quality before clicking **Download this video** (2) . For older DVD players in cars, we should choose a resolution of 480p or lower because older DVD players do not yet support high-definition video playback.

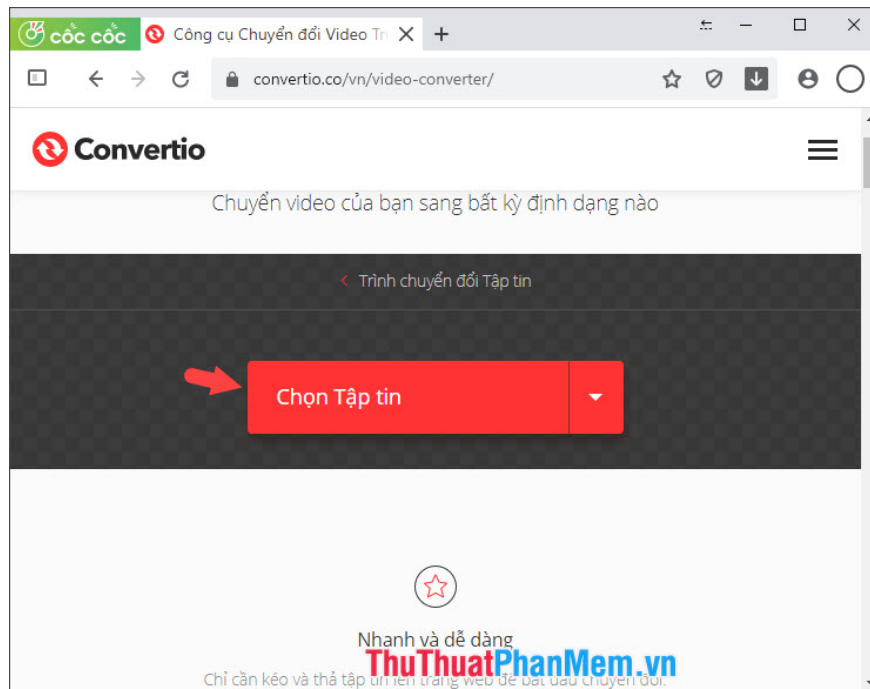


2. Convert video to compatible format and copy to USB

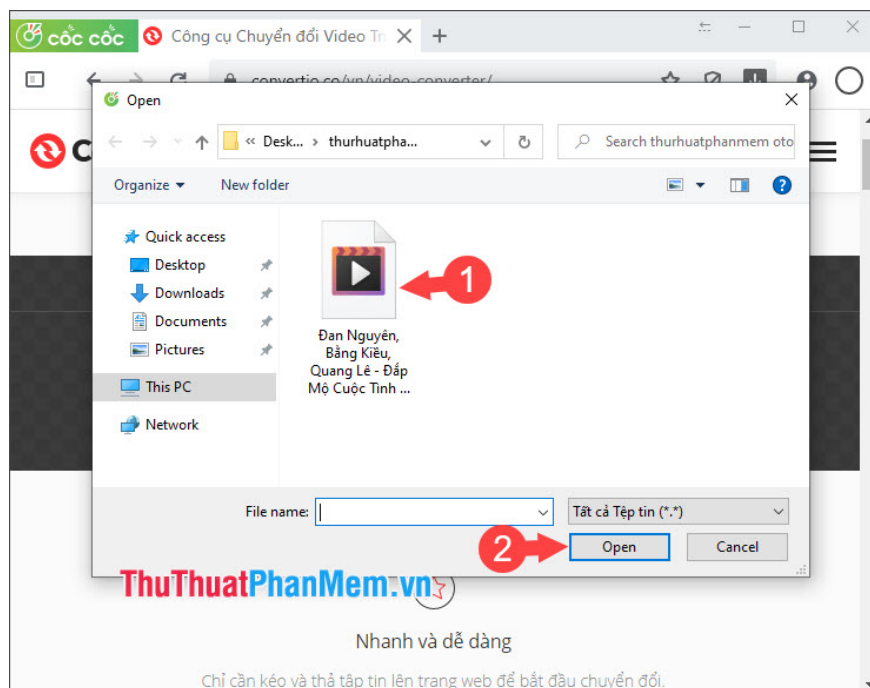
Instead of downloading video conversion software on your computer, you can use online video conversion software with **convertio** .

Step 1: You visit the website <https://convertio.co/vn/video-converter/>

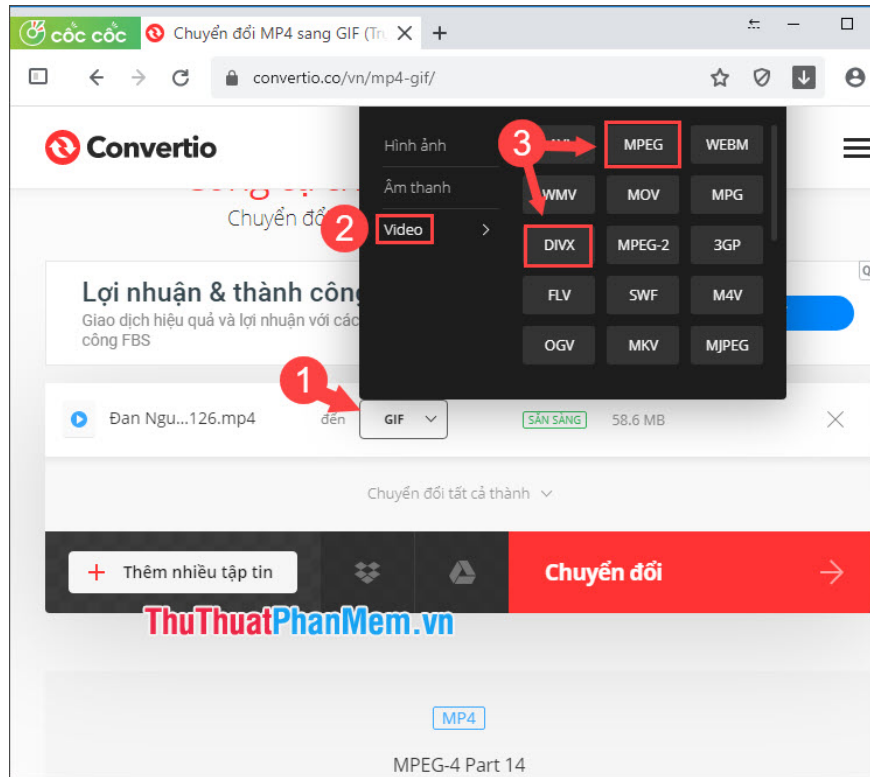
Next, click on **Select File**.



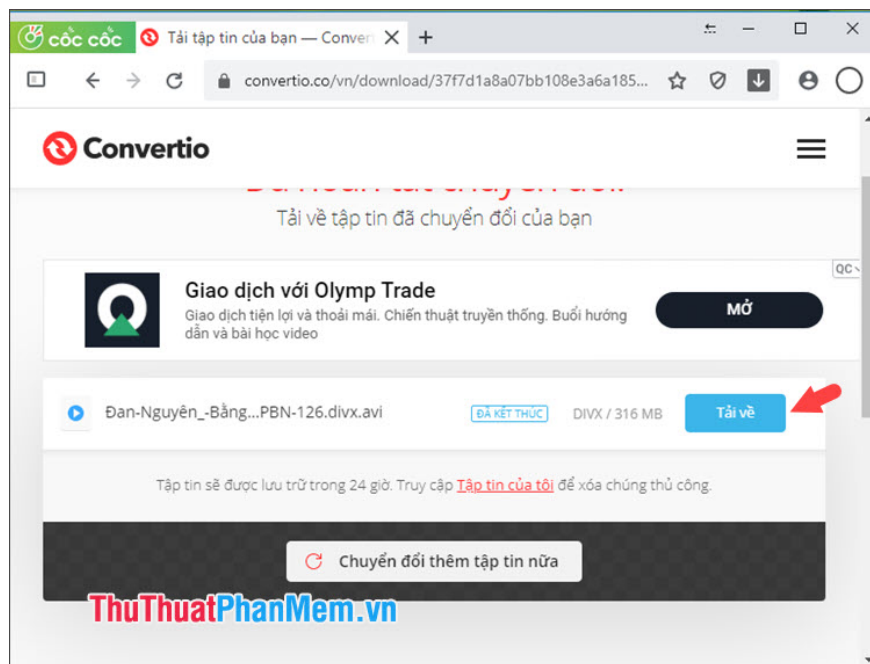
Then select the downloaded youtube video (1) => **Open** (2) to upload to the website.



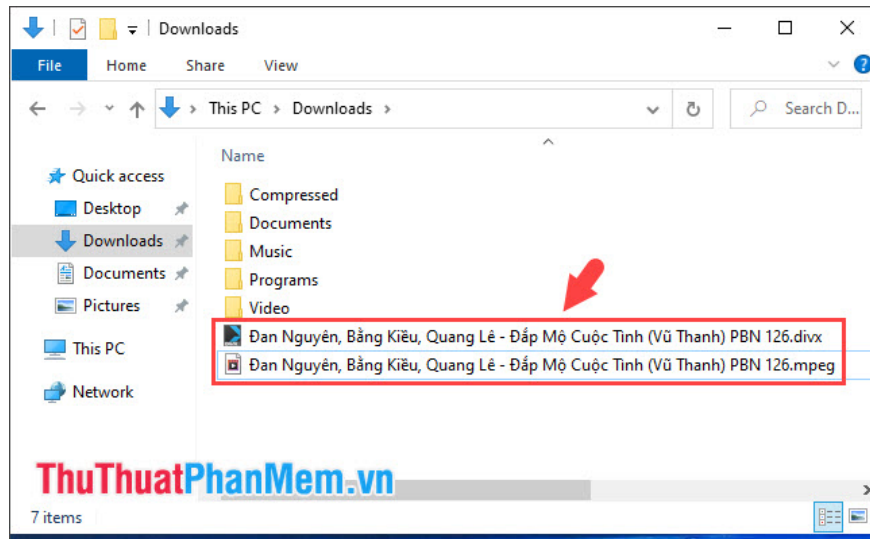
Step 2: Click the video format item (1) => **Video** (2) => **MPEG** or **DIVX** (3) . You can convert both files in the two formats above to check your DVD player compatibility. For Pioneer DVD models with the code AVH-P4250DVD / AVH-P4350DVD / AVH-P3250DVD, we can convert them to DIVX to watch.



Step 3: Wait for the upload and conversion process and click **Download** to download the computer.



Step 4: After downloading successfully, open the Download folder and copy the video file to USB to enjoy in the car. You should convert the video into two video formats, **DIVX** and **MPEG**, to check the compatibility of your car's DVD player.
