

How to draw Pixel Art images with Paint

Drawing Pixel Art with Paint is very simple and you can draw with many different details.

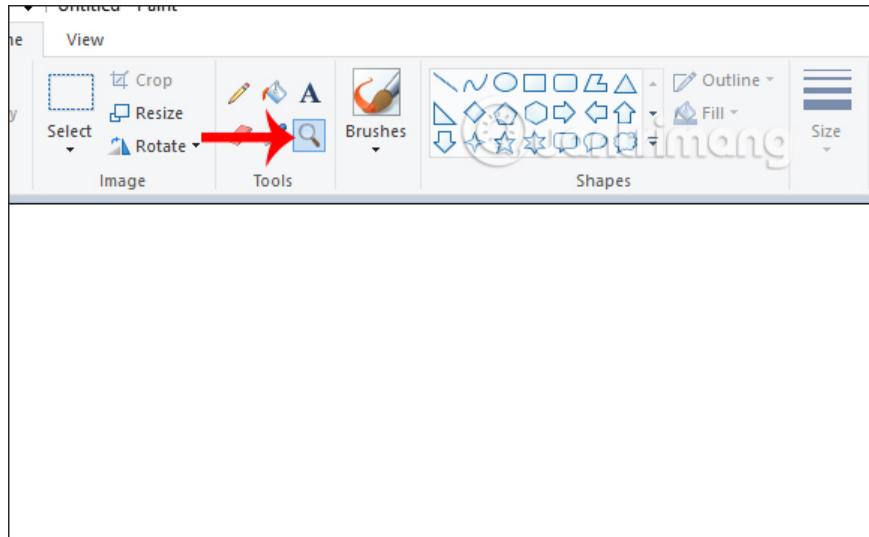
Pixel Art is a type of drawing on a computer using pixel-based graphics software. This pixel art is often used for games on a computer, game console or mobile device. Often to draw Pixel Art-style works, you will immediately think of specialized photo-drawing software for this type of art. However, we can use Pain to paint Pixel Art with very simple steps. The painting steps will be able to display the content through colorful squares. The following article will guide you how to read Pixel Art painting with Paint.

Pixel Art painting tutorial on Paint

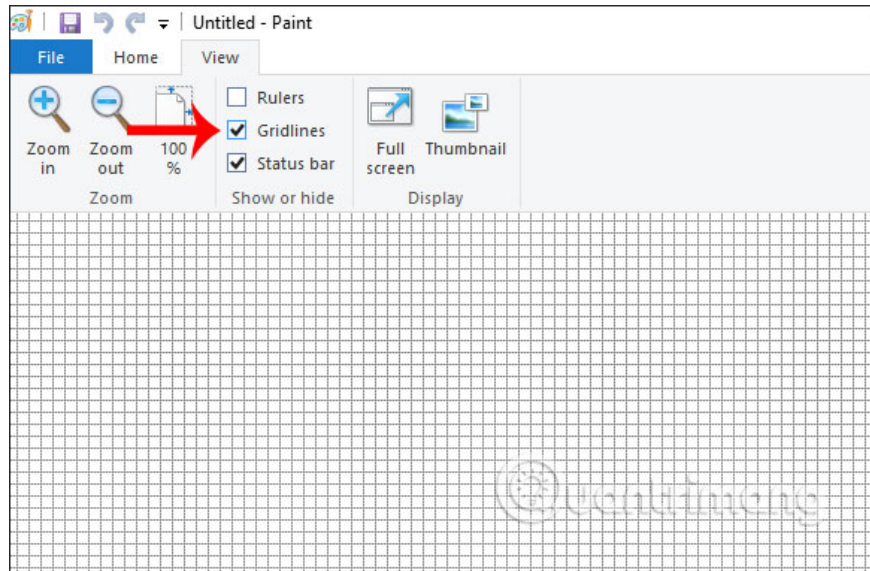
Step 1:

We open Paint on the computer as usual. Next click on **the magnifying glass icon** , then press the white area again and again. We will click until we see **an enlarged 800% image area** , via the size bar at the bottom of the screen.



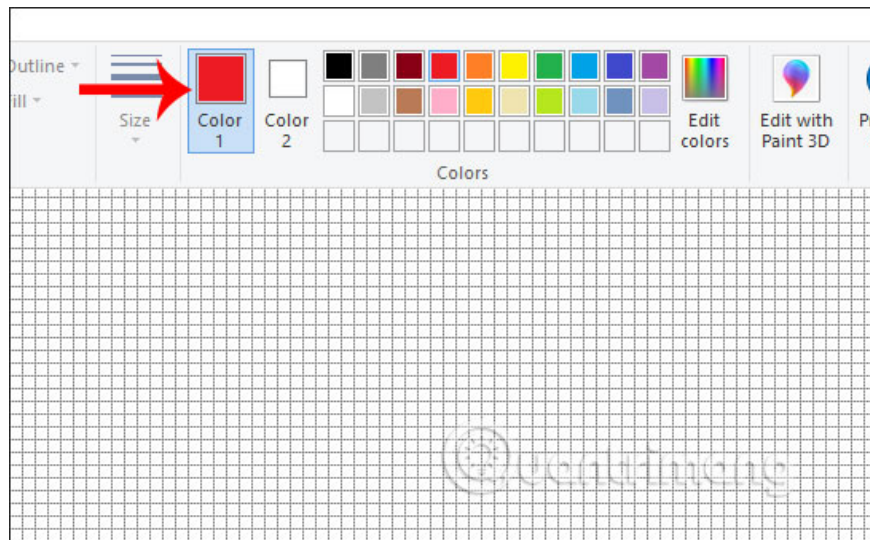
Step 2:

Next the user selects the **View tab** and then ticks **Gridlines box** to create a grid. This makes it easier for us to paint Pixel Art.

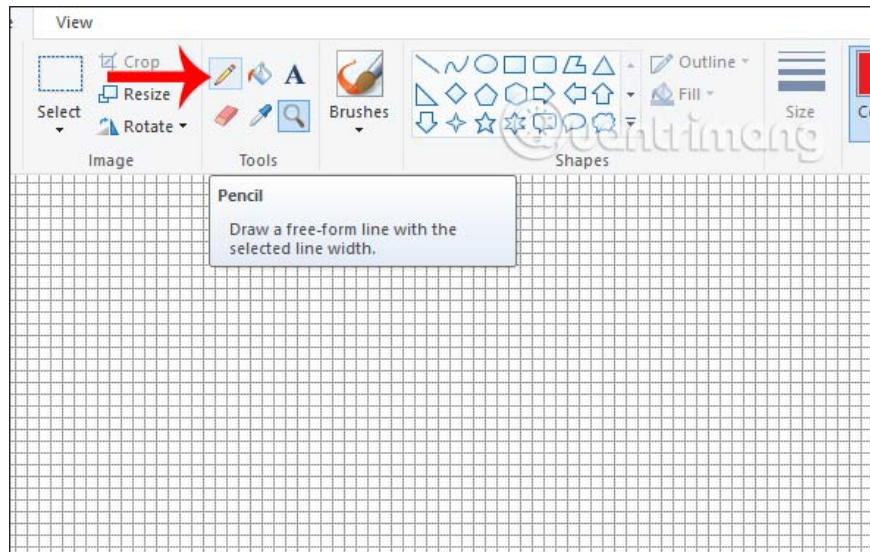


Step 3:

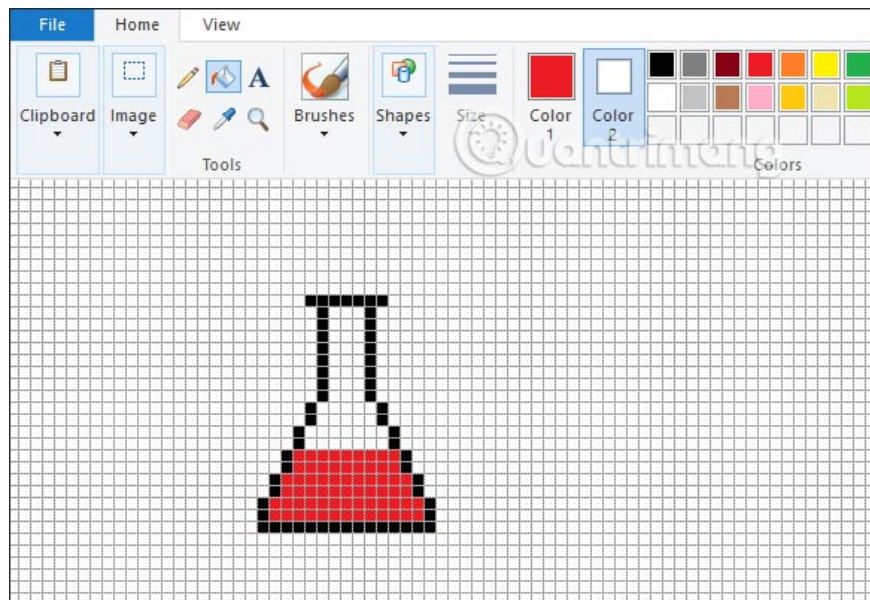
We click again on the **Home tab** to paint. Click **Color 1** to select the color you want. If you want to color fast for a large area of the image, the user selects the color and then clicks on the paint bucket icon Fill with color and clicks on the spot you want to paint.



Click on **the Pencil icon** to select the brush.

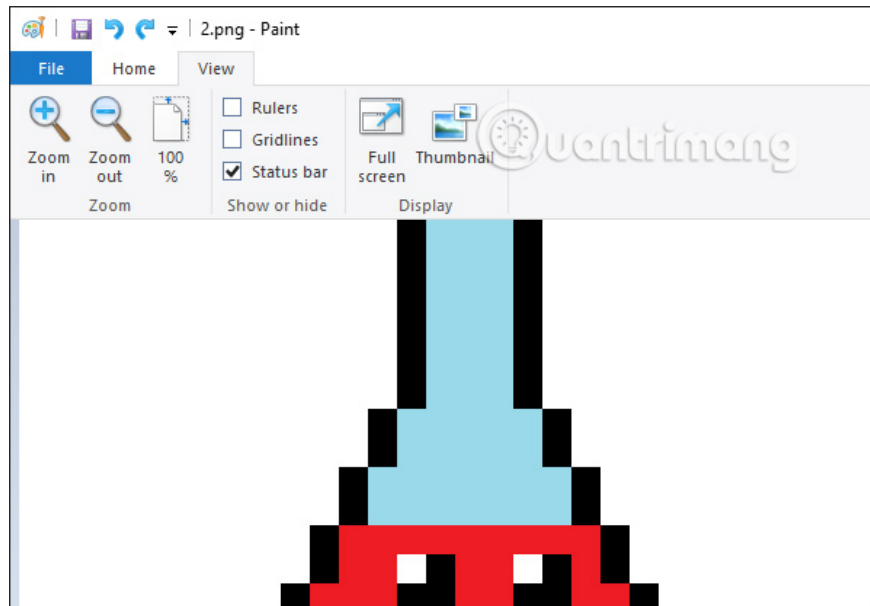


We will draw each stroke and detail for the image, according to the given image to follow. If you want to return to any operation, just press Ctrl + Z. If you want to delete any area, click the eraser icon.



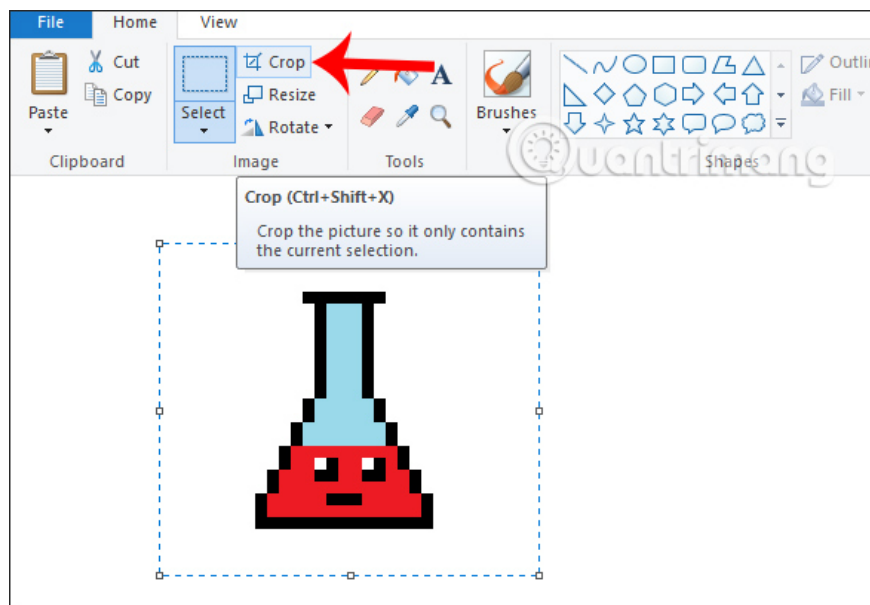
Step 4:

After you've finished painting, click on the **View tab** and then **uncheck the Gridlines box** . Then only the work that you draw will remain.



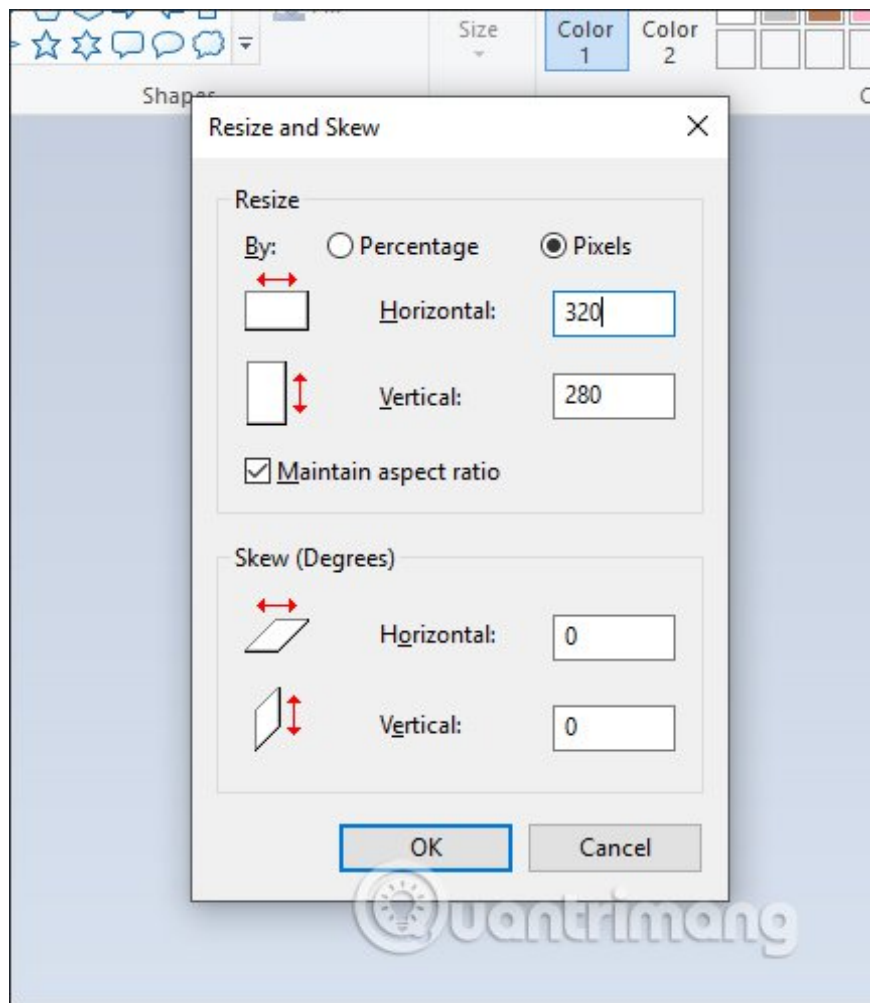
Step 5:

Click **Select** and then use the mouse **around the image** just drawn. Press **Crop** to cut off the leftover area and just take the image you need.

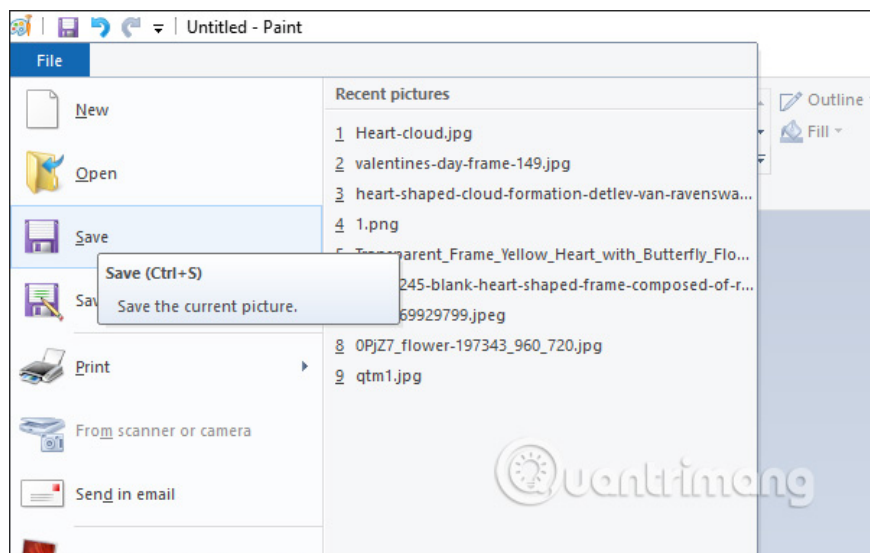


Step 6:

Click **Resize** to resize the image. We **choose to select Pixel** s then add a zero to the size at Horizontal. So when the saved image will not be small after saving it will not be too small. We can also enter the image size if desired.



Then you just need to **click File to Save** to download the image.



With just a few simple steps, you have created Pixel Art works right on Paint, without needing any other tools. Thus users can easily create more unique pictures.
