

How to duplicate, create copies of images and videos on iPhone phones

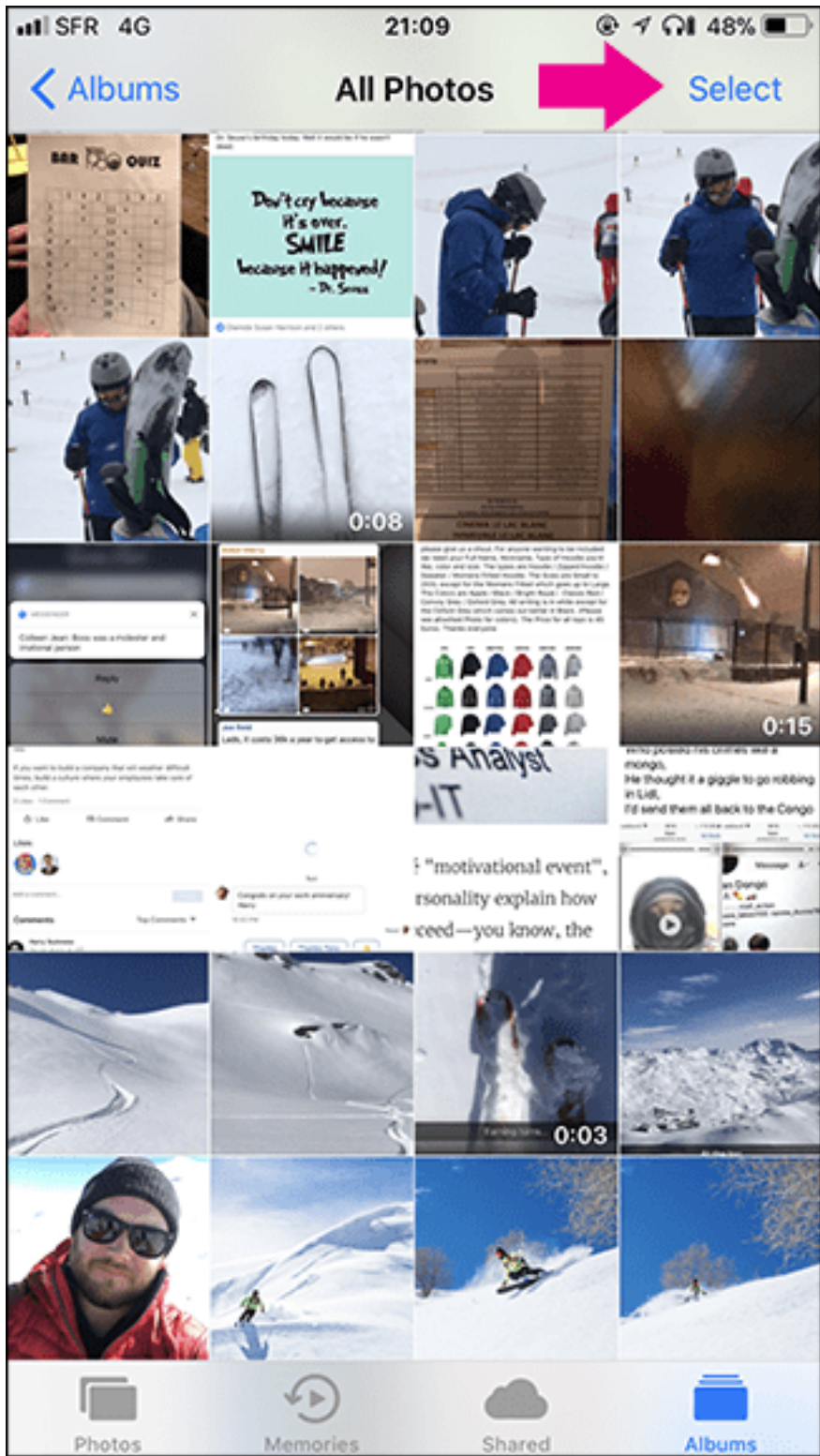
Storing duplicate files in the device is not a good thing. However, with images and videos, this is not always true. Fortunately, cloning images and videos on iOS is extremely easy.

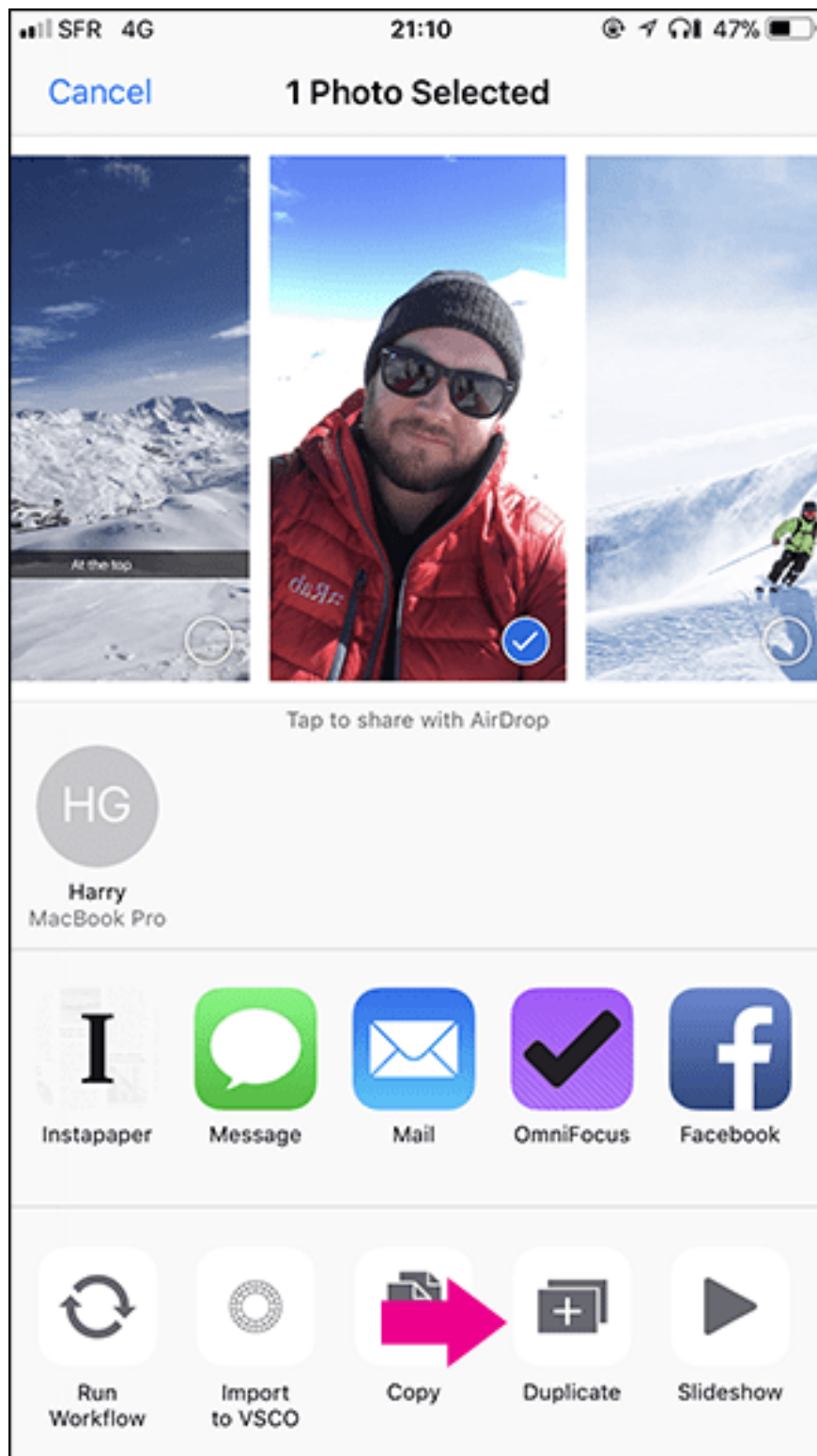
Storing duplicate files in the device is not a good thing. However, with images and videos, this is not always true. Fortunately, cloning images and videos on iOS is extremely easy.

1. Instructions on how to check the iPhone / iPad battery level without jailbreak

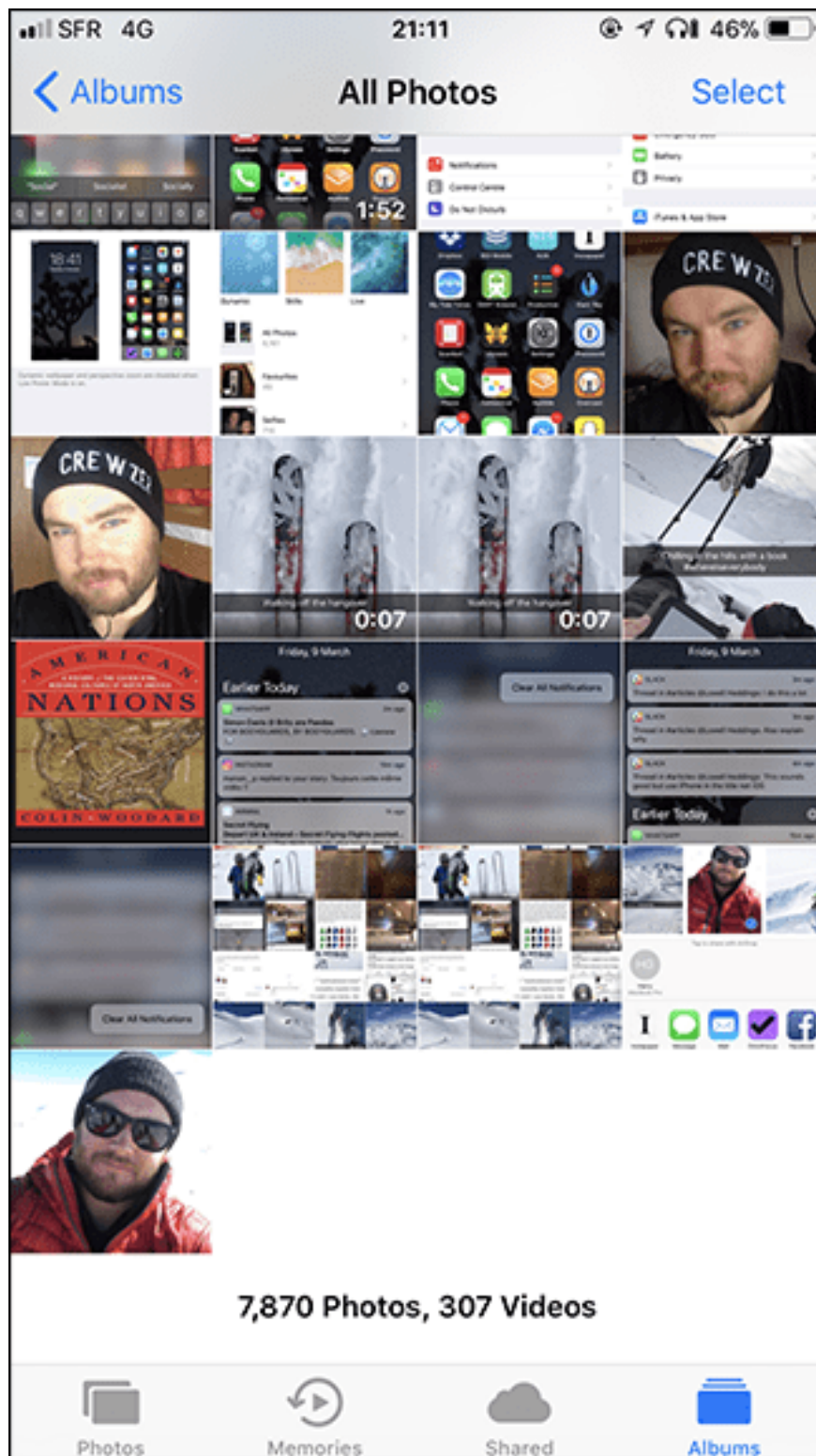
Especially when editing images and videos, these duplicate files are used a lot. You can use them as reference for comparison before and after editing images; You can also use it to compare video speed after slow and normal speed. Whatever the reason, you need to do the following.

Open the **Photos** app, select " **Select** " in the top right corner, then select the image or video you want to duplicate.





So you've created a new copy and look exactly like the old one. Now you can use it to edit, share or share. The only downside of cloning is that the new copy will be saved as the latest capture / recording file in Camera Roll. This makes it difficult for you to organize photos and videos. It also takes up memory, so use this iPhone trick in a calculated way.
