## What you need to get started

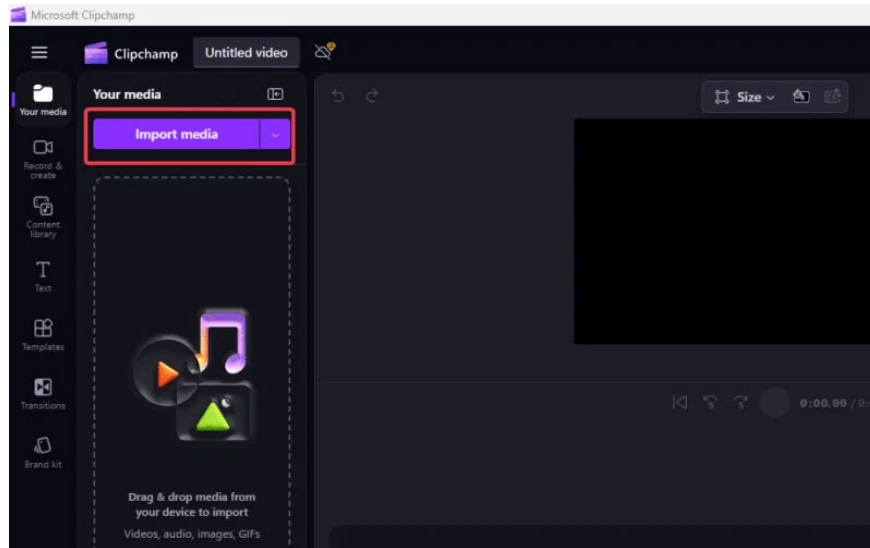
To edit by cutting video transcripts in Clipchamp, you need the following:

1. A personal or corporate Microsoft 365 account to access Clipchamp.
2. Make sure the video has dialogue to record.
3. Use Clipchamp's Windows app or a Chromium-based browser.

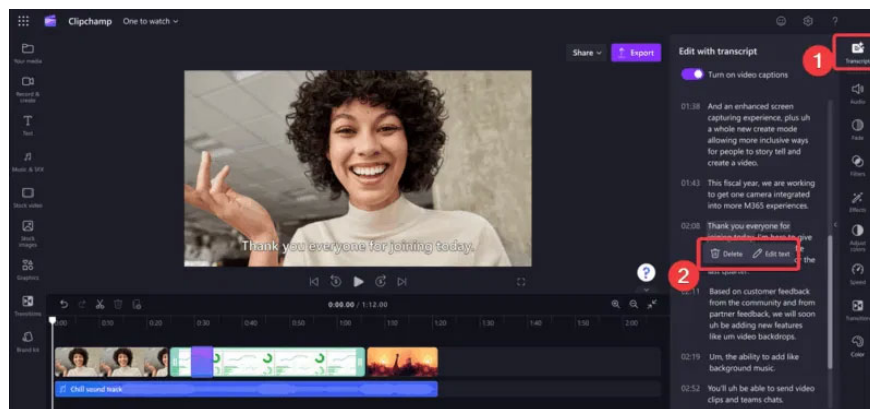
**Note :** This feature is rolling out to corporate subscribers first before individual users can get it later.

## Trim video with transcript in Clipchamp

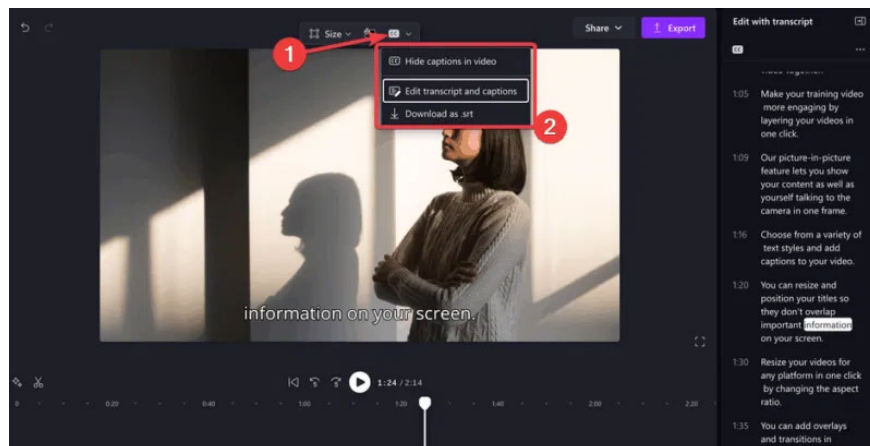
To use this feature, launch Clipchamp and click **import media** .



Locate the **Transcript** tab on the right panel and click **Generate Transcript** . Once the video transcript is available, highlight the unwanted parts and click **Delete** to automatically trim them.



You can click the subtitles (cc) button to edit or download as a .srt file . You can also export your video to OneDrive or SharePoint .

## Tips for best results

Some things to keep in mind when trimming videos by removing transcripts in Clipchamp are:

1. Use clear, high-quality audio for accurate transcription.

4. Always save a backup copy of the original video for comparison after editing.
