

# How to easily share Wi-Fi on iPhone and Android.

WiFi sharing has been around for a long time, built directly into Android and iOS, allowing users to share WiFi networks between devices securely without having to waste time entering passwords. Below is a very simple way to share WiFi on iPhone and Android using a QR code.

In fact, sharing Wi-Fi passwords between two phones is very common and frequently used in our daily lives. If a device has already been connected to a Wi-Fi network, you can easily share it with nearby Android and iPhone devices without having to provide the password to them.

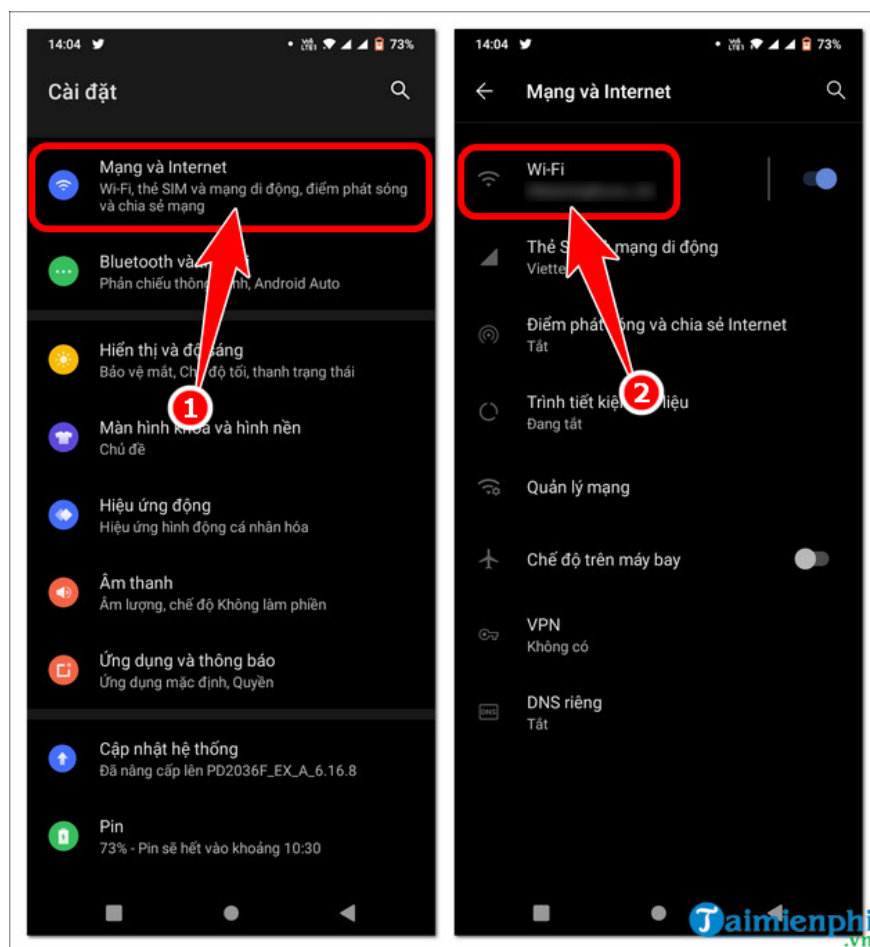


## How to share Wi-Fi on Android and iPhone without a password

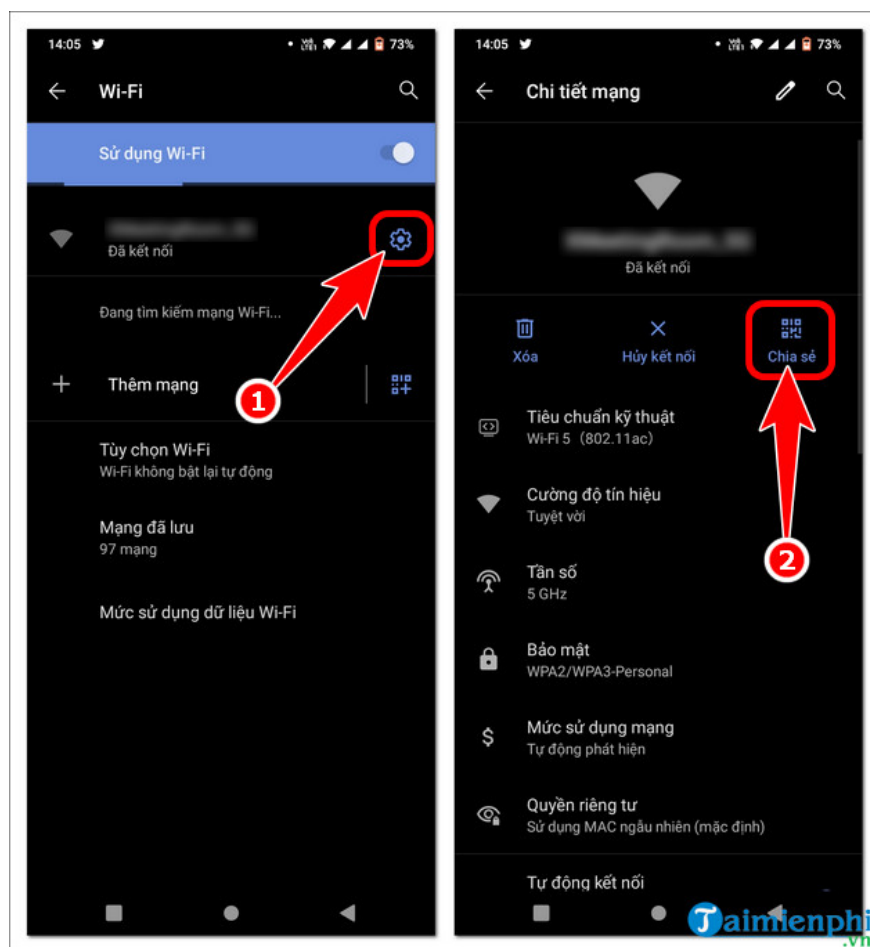
### *1. How to share WiFi on Android using a QR code*

#### *2. Detailed instructions*

*Step 1:* Open **Settings** , select **Network and Internet** => click on **the Wi-Fi network** you are using.



Step 2: Tap the **Settings icon** next to the connected Wi-Fi network => tap **Share** .



*Step 3:* The QR code will appear as shown below. Other devices simply need to scan the code, and the device will automatically connect to the network without needing to enter a password.

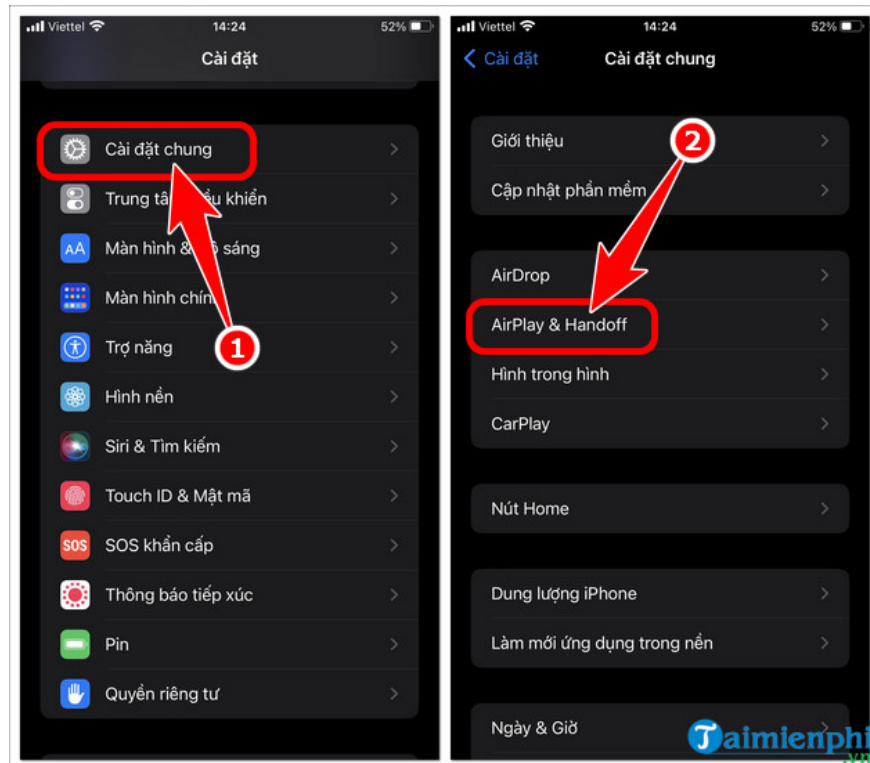

## II. How to share Wi-Fi on iPhone without entering a password

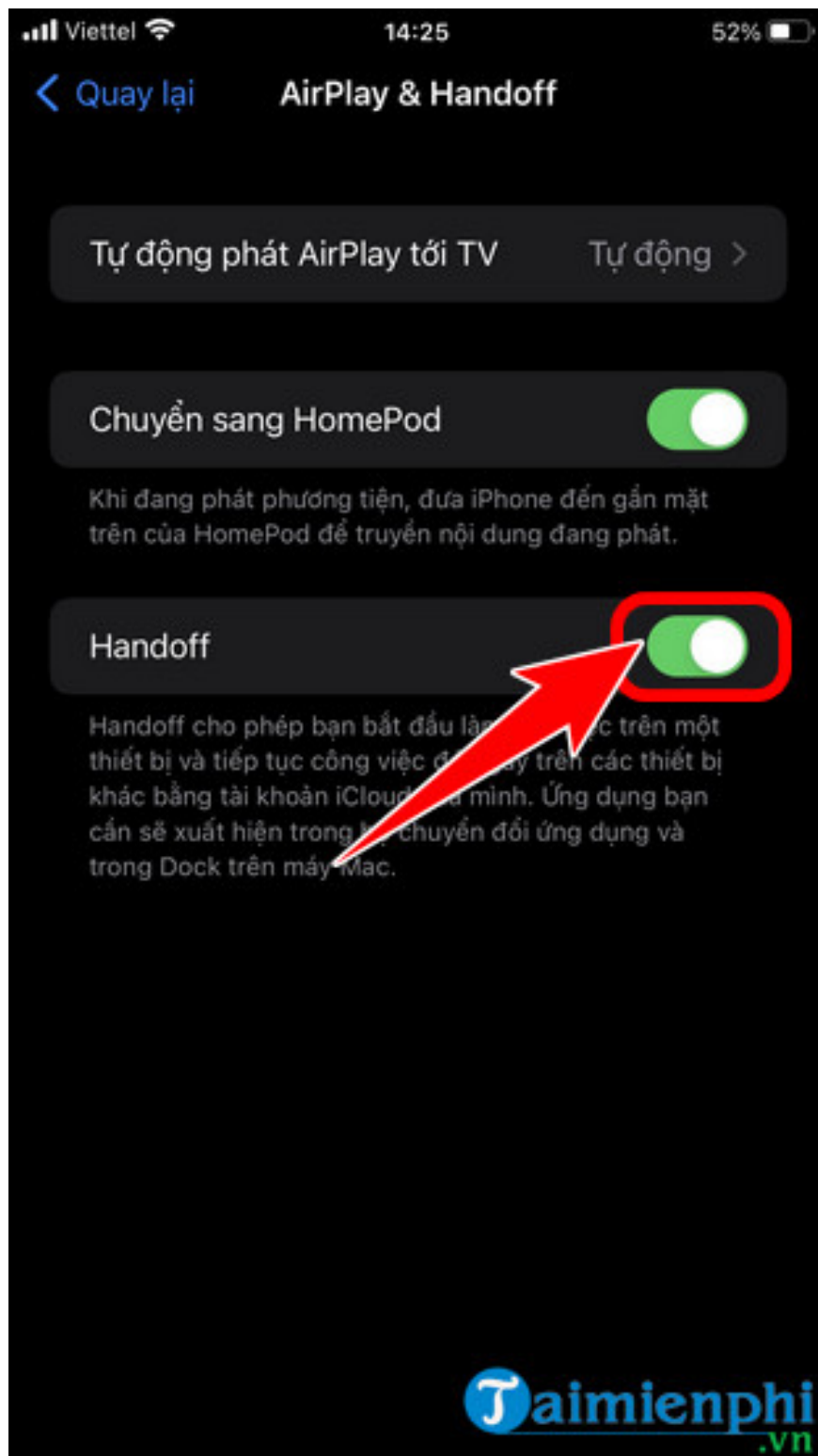
Currently, sharing WiFi on iOS only works for two iPhones and requires an **iOS version of 11** or later. One device must already be connected to the WiFi network being shared.

### 2. Detailed instructions

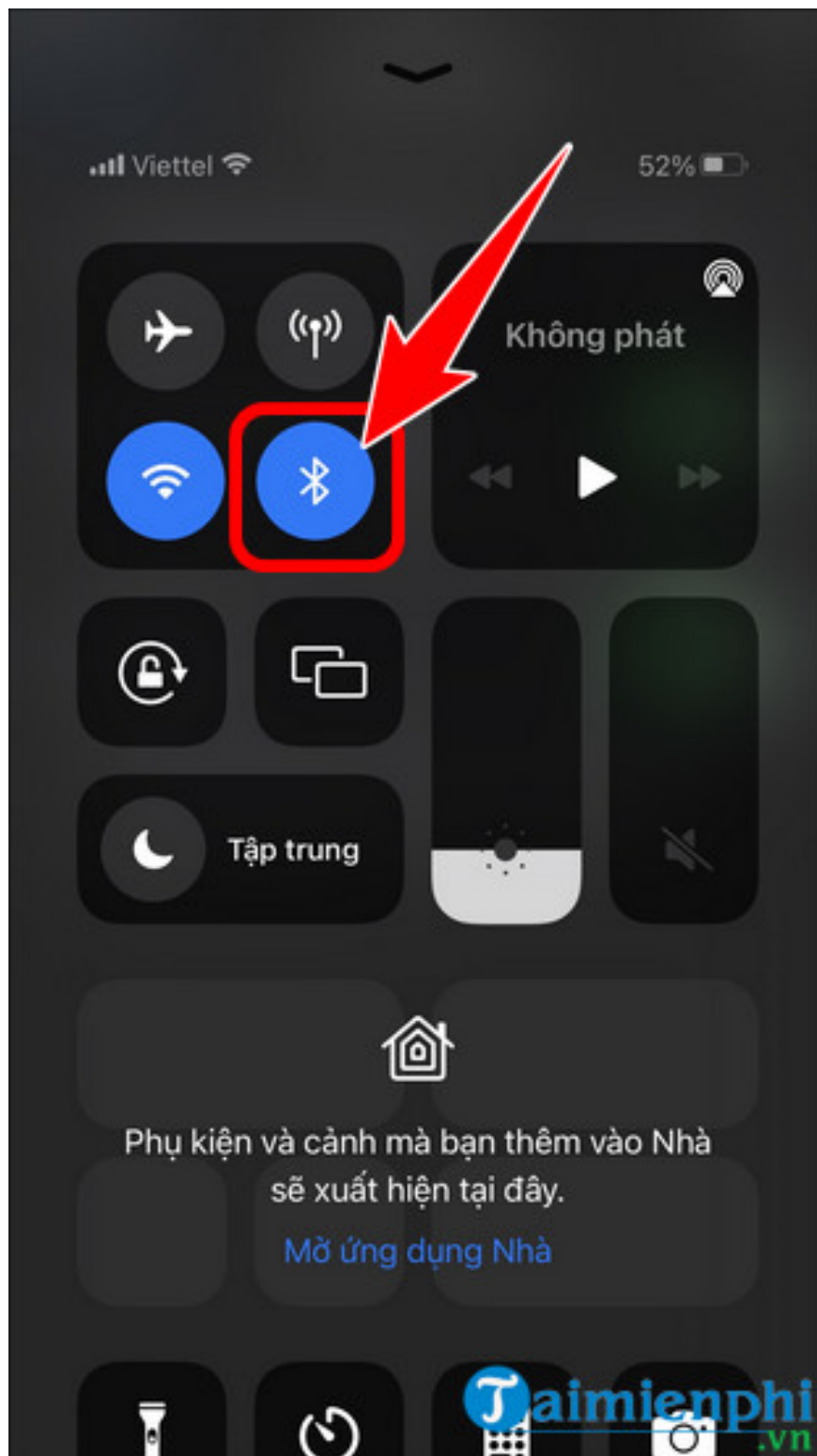
Step 1: Go to **Settings** , select **General Settings** => click **AirPlay & Handoff** .



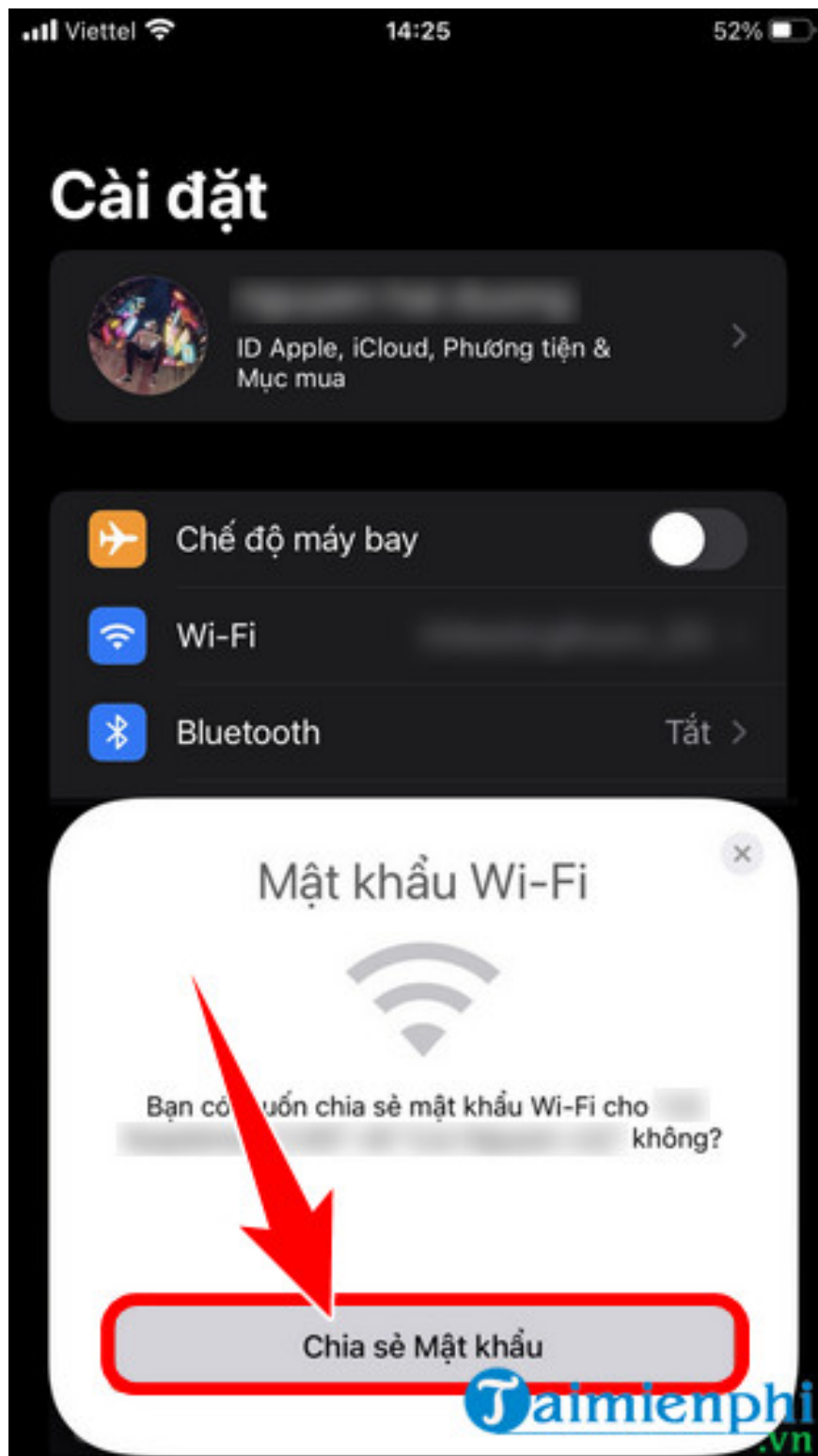
- Turn on the **Handoff** button .



Step 2: Turn on **Bluetooth** on both iPhones and place them close together.



*Step 3:* A **notification** like the one below will appear on the Wi-Fi sharing device . Click "**Share Password**" to complete the process.



### *III. Notes on sharing Wi-Fi on Android and iOS*

- Ensure both devices are within range of the active Wi-Fi network.
- Troubleshoot minor issues by restarting your devices before sharing Wi-Fi.

In addition to sharing WiFi on Android and iPhone, readers can also **create a WiFi hotspot on their laptop using Free WiFi Hotspot Creator** , turning their computer into a WiFi hotspot without having to buy a new router.
