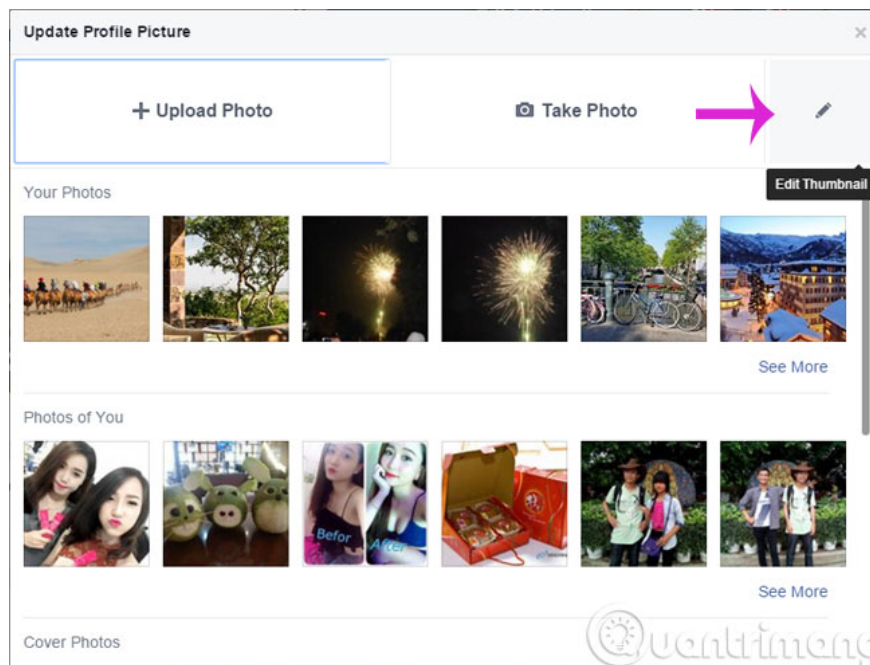

Note : This edit will not affect the profile picture on the personal page.

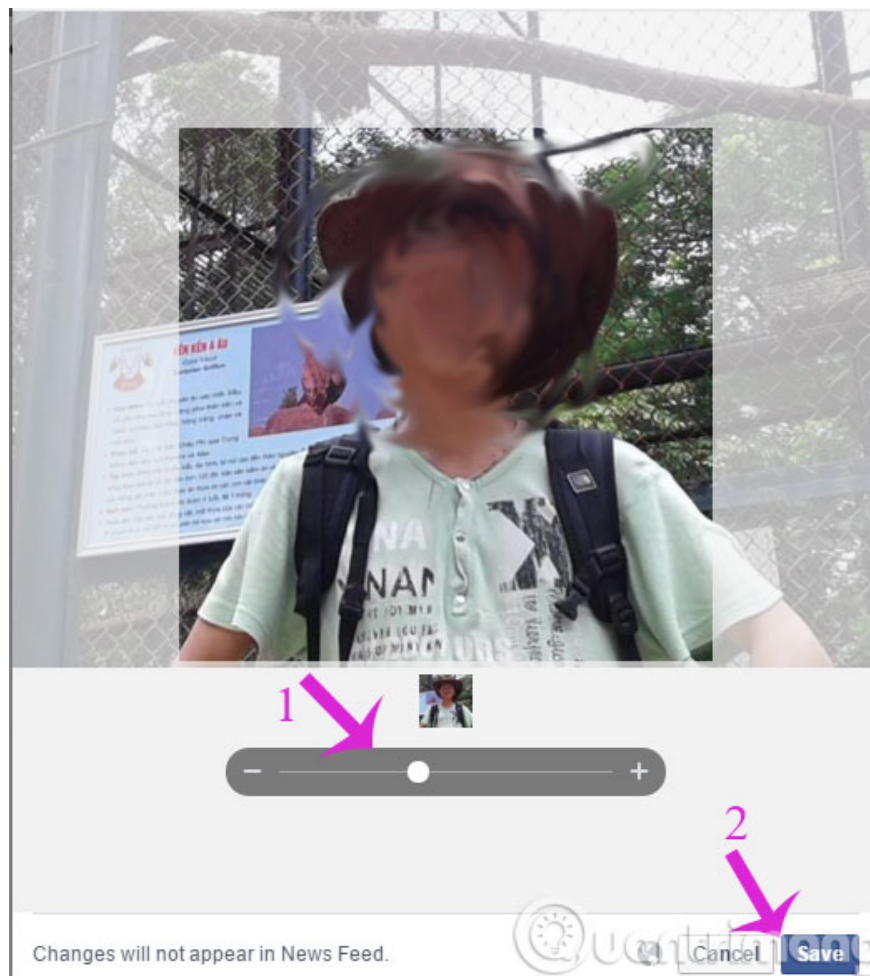
## Step 1: Access your Facebook profile and click on Update Profile Picture
